HOUSE OF MOTHER'S AGENDA

(Continued from last week)

All consciousness is power, and the higher we ascend, the greater the power, but also the farther away we are from the earth. Thus if we wish to apply our overmental power, say, to the affairs of this world, it must be brought down from one level to another and overcome the determinisms of all the intermediary levels before it can reach the depths, Matter. Finally, there remains only a dulled and weakened overmental reflection, which must then fight against more and more heavy and rebellious determinisms. This is why the spiritualists have never been able to transform life. The Supramental is the supreme Consciousness-Force in the very heart of Matter, without any intermediary. It is the 'sun in the darkness' of the Veda, the meeting place of the highest Heights and the deepest Depths. Therefore it can change everything. As the Mother has said, 'The true change of consciousness is one that will change the physical conditions in the world and make it into an entirely new creation."

Let us say immediately that the supramental power does not work either through miracles or violence-the very notion of miracle is absurd, as Sri Aurobindo has often repeated: There is really no such thing as miracle, there are only phenomena whose processes we do not understand. For one who sees, there is only an intervention by the determinism of a higher plane in the determinism of a lower plane. Perhaps the mind appears to be a miracle to the determinism of a caterpillar, yet we all know that our mental miracles do follow a certain process. The same applies to the Supermind: it does not upset any existing laws, but simply leaps over them (or within them?), to a dimension where they no longer exist, much as the caterpillar's laws no longer exist for man. Let us be more specific: the habitual repetition of certain vibrations that have coagulated, so to speak, around a person result in imparting to him an apparently stable structure; that person then claims to obey the 'law' of his nature. But this so-called law is no more inevitable than choosing a certain route to go home rather than another; it is merely a question of habits. The same holds true for the entire cosmos: all our supposedly absolute physical laws are also coagulated habits, with nothing absolute about them whatsoever, and they can all be undone provided one is willing to take another route, that is, change to a different consciousness. An ordinary law, Sri Aurobindo wrote, merely means an equilibrium established by Nature; it means a balance of forces. It is merely a groove in which Nature is accustomed to work



in order to produce certain results. But if you change the consciousness, then the groove also is bound to change. There have been a number of 'changes of grooves' in the course of our evolution, beginning with the introduction of Life into Matter, which changed the material groove, then the introduction of Mind into Life, which changed the vital and material grooves. The Supermind represents a third change of groove, which will change Mind, Life, and Matter. This change has already begun; the experience is in progress. Essentially, the supramental process works to free the consciousness contained in each element. It does not upset the universal order, nor does it violate anything; it only applies its power to cleave through the darkness so that it may radiate its own light. 'He has cloven wide away the darkness, as one that cleaves away a skin, that he may spread out our earth275 under his illuminating sun," says the Rig Veda (V.85.1). Because the same divine solar consciousness is everywhere, the world and every atom in the world are divine; the Lord of all the universe is also 'the One conscious in unconscious things' of the Rig Veda. Matter is not a crude substance incapable of change except through the assault of our hands or our heads (which have scarcely produced anything but monsters); it is a divine substance that can respond instead of resisting, and change instead of enslaving us in its old habit of gravitation and decay. But Matter is a clouded or sleeping Divinity, a 'somnambulist,' as Sri Aurobindo calls it, a 'lost, buried sun,' says the Veda. The Inconscient is the Superconscient's sleep.... The apparent Inconscience of the material universe holds in itself darkly all that is eternally self-revealed in the luminous Superconscient. The Supramental, then, will use its own light to awaken the corresponding light-the same light-in Matter:

The truth above shall wake a nether truth.

For the law is eternally the same: only like can act upon like. Only the highest power can free the nethermost power.

NOTE:

- The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

- The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).
- A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.
- A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

Council's Communications to the Community

Various Council Topics:

- N&N support Council have appointed Muniandi and Dharmesh as managers of N&N and have helped bring the support group together.
- Call for a new organisation in Auroville In Nov, the Council made a call to the community for a sub group, they are preparing a presentation to the community.
- RAS membership Following a second call to the community on 7th April, 7 members came forward and met with the Council and Working Committee. The final appointments are to be shared after consultation with the RAS.

Mandates and Policies

- RAS mandate Last year, the Council constituted a sub group (Mael, Martin, Dan, Allan) to review the RAS mandate. This group has shared a draft mandate with the Council which is being reviewed.
- AvC mandate As the RAS and AvC mandates overlap and should compliment each other, we intend to review the AvC mandate once we have a draft of the RAS mandate finalised.
- RAD & CA AvC with the help of community members is working on a survey to get the pulse of the community on the RAD policy.
- Entry Board The Council has arranged to meet the new Entry Board on the 12th of May to discuss various topics.

Challenges

- Recently the Council has been facing difficulties with the attendance of members, some members have reviewed the Participatory Working Group (PWG) document which provides guidelines for the functioning of the working groups. We are in the process of addressing this issue as a team.
- Council struggles to reach out to the community including units and services due to the @auroville.services domain and certain individual email addresses being blocked by the administrators of the @auroville.org.in domain. It has come to our knowledge that some community members have not been able to reach us with their concerns.

The CRC has been following up on various conflicts involving Aurovilians. When possible, a mediation has been organised in order for the parties to hear each other's grievances and to find the best possible solution together.

We have received concerns from community members in regard to some offensive posts on Auronet involving racism and defamation. Constructive criticism is an essential aspect of our own personal and communal development and must be welcomed. But when this criticism becomes offensive to the most universal human sentiments and values, as also established by the Mother and Sri Aurobindo, then this does not serve our collective aspirations towards Human Unity.

We, at the Conflict Resolution Council, request everyone to kindly self-reflect on this topic, and to focus on affecting change towards a constructive, even reconciliatory outcome rather than widening divisions.

Please note that for obvious confidentiality reasons, we are not reporting individual or community conflicts in our monthly reports.

Only finalised mediations will be mentioned anonymously. Arbitration and appeal processes however, will be announced upon start and completion, also in a general manner only.

SECURITY

Dear community,

As you may already be aware, the Auroville Safety and Security Team's emails (<u>avsecurity@auroville.org.in</u>, <u>avsecurity.office@auroville.org.in</u>) have been disabled, since 14.04.2023.

As of now our team has not received any explanation or justification as to why this action was taken, despite voicing concerns to the sysop team over the disabling of communication to an essential service of Auroville.

In light of this, and because we are an emergency service and wish to remain available to the community, we have created the following temporary email address: aurovillesafetyteam@gmail.com

We have also not received any information or notice regarding the recently circulated Office Order issued by the Office of the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, which seems to include a change of executives and team members for this service. Our original team continues its work, temporarily focusing the scope of its services for the next few months on the following:

1. managing the guards currently employed, and the volunteer patrols.

2. managing the check-posts, and other entrance points and junctions.

3. managing vehicle access and requests.

4. responding to the following types of incidents and dispatching them to services or working groups: thefts, harassment, unwelcome presence.

5. administrative assistance for: birth/death certificates, police complaints, police verification reports, passport verification etc... (AVSST office: 0413 2623 400)

6. escorting external ambulances, fire department, police etc... to the locations of incidents as and when needed.

VOLKHER OF BOTANICAL GARDEN PASSED AWAY

In the evening of Thursday 11 May, German Aurovilian Volkher Eike Riech quietly left his body in his Mahalakshmi Home apartment. He would have been 82 in June and had been suffering severe rheumatoid arthritis.

Having worked as an Ocean Scientist before coming here, Volkher first arrived in Auroville in '97 and became Aurovilian two years later.



Being keenly interested in geological and environmental issues, he was drawn to Auroville's green work, and worked and lived during his first years in Darkali, Discipline and Aurogreen.

He then moved to Vikas and started working at the Botanical Gardens, where he initiated and maintained the centre's elaborate cactus gardens which he kept up until health issues interfered four years ago. However, his interest remained and pretty soon Mahalakshmi Home would have its own cacti arrangements in gardens and balcony. His smiling presence there will be missed.

Volkher's body is presently at Farewell, and can be visited from 10 am - 12noon and from 3 – 5pm. Friends who are willing to keep a silent presence during those times are most welcome and can contact smiti@ or via WA 94420 70212. Data re the funeral will be shared when available.

BERND OF HERMITAGE LEAVES HIS BODY

At around 3am in the morning of Thursday 11 May, Aurovilian Bernd Theilmann peacefully passed away in his home at Hermitage at the age of 74. Having gone through years of dialysis and further physical challenges, this last half year had been difficult and taxing for him.



Before coming to Auroville, Bernd and his partner Agnes, both from Germany, stayed in Delhi from 1983 till '89 with Bernd working as technician at the Max Mueller Bhavan there. After this, the couple came directly to Auroville where Bernd assumed stewardship of the place they called 'Hermitage', the development of which has been the love of his life ever since. In 1992 Bernd officially became Aurovilian. Aided by his strongwilled and good-natured personality, all his energies went into the planting of lakhs of trees in his endeavour to transform the place into a paradise which, indeed, gradually grew up around them.

Bernd's body will remain at Hermitage where friends are welcome to visit during the coming three days from 3 till 5pm. Info re funeral will be share as/when available.

We warmly salute and thank a dedicated green worker who so much added to Auroville's natural wealth, and our warmest condolences and love go out to Agnes and Christine Garcia who was his loving partner for many years.

IT IS NOT ABOUT BUILDING A CITY

When we talk or write about what Auroville is going through right now, many like to quote the words of the Mother and Sri Aurobindo. But in this way, extrapolated from its context, their words serve our thoughts and become easily manipulated. It would seem to me more honest to express our thoughts speaking in the first person, using our own words to adapt the teaching of the 'masters' to a more contemporary note.

Anyway, just to contradict what I wrote above, I like to quote a text instead, found in the Notebooks of an Apocalypse by Satprem (vol1, pag 159). It is the interpretation of Mother's thought about the construction of the Matrimandir, written almost 50 years ago. If you read it and try to replace the word Matrimandir with the word City, it could have been written today. I guess we haven't progressed much in 50 years...

"Those who think that the Matrimandir must be built "at all costs" and that the Goal is to build one Matrimandir or two hundred Matrimandirs are grossly mistaken. It is not a question of building the Matrimandir: it is a question of building the people of the next world by using their symbolic effort. Mother does not care about tons of cement. She cares about an ounce of sincerity, a pure little gesture, consciously made. If each of the workers' gestures were really filled with consciousness, the Matrimandir would shine all by itself like a divine Act and those men would already no longer be men, but divine beings. TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN

As artists and members of the Auroville Art Service we are concerned about recent communications about the possible dismissal of the executives that have built, represented and assisted our arts cooperative since its formation 10 years ago. They have tirelessly and thanklessly helped, supported and represented us as Auroville artists with all our difficulties and issues, doing a job that is not easy and which very few people wish to do. As artists themselves they understand the unique difficulties that artists go through in being creative, sharing our creations with the world, and finding ways to survive with very little financial support, as well as embracing the ideal that art is for everyone. We are very happy with the work they have done and expect that they will be able to continue this work for the foreseeable future. As there have been no clear reasons given for dismissing the executives, we would appreciate being informed of the reasons, as this affects over 70 people and activities under this service. This kind of action also does not reflect the spirit of Auroville and ignores the collective processes which are there to help us honour the will of the Mother who asks us to find more integral and inclusive ways of solving difficulties and disagreements.

The Auroville Art Service was formed as a cooperative in order to assist artists in Auroville and for artists to support each other as a collective. As Auroville is a growing point of convergence of many cultures, races, social strata, languages and experiments, the AV Arts Service has worked to bring together different people, by fostering unity between people through artistic means as well as by nourishing individual experiments and group efforts and creating platforms for artistic research, creation and administration.

We wish to move forward together with greater harmony and goodwill, where the spirit of "unity in diversity" exists for all artistic self-expression.

We disagree with the intentions to dismiss the executives of Auroville Art Service, as well as Auroville's other services, and request that any valid issues with them be presented openly to discuss together as a community towards a real and integral unity.



Seriously, can human unity and inclusiveness be enforced in such a manner? We trust this will not be repeated.


News and Notes remains open to different points of view as the editors have said. We hope it will remain above abusive accusations and false content, in the true Spirit of Auroville.

MATRIMANDIR NOTES

MATRIMANDIR THE SOUL OF AUROVILLE

"Greetings from Auroville to all men of goodwill." Are invited to Auroville all those who thirst for progress and aspire to a higher and truer life..." announced the Mother at Auroville's inauguration on 28 February 1968.



While she sent out an invitation to all people of goodwill who aspire to a higher life to come to Auroville, her directions for accessing the Matrimandir was not quite the same. In September 1965 She instructed the chief Architect, Roger Anger and wrote on his report:

"The park of Unity must be surrounded by some kind of an isolating zone so that it is solitary and silent. One has access to it only with permission."

Later, during his visits to the Mother's room Roger would note down in his diary her directions about accessing the Matrimandir. We reproduce here some of these notes:

June 1971: About Matrimandir

Sri Aurobindo has shown/taught that it is in Matter that the Divine must be manifested; he has insisted on the understanding of this concept of the Mother as Creator. Matrimandir is here to teach people that it is not by escaping from the world while ignoring it, that they will realise the Divine in life. Matrimandir must be the symbol of this Truth. I don't want it to be made into a religion; with all my force I refuse. We don't want dogmas, principles, ritual, absolutely not, absolutely not.

AV Archives; AMW, p. 390

• August 1972: About admissions to Matrimandir: Not for the visitors in principle.

Reserved for Aurovilians but not everyone will be admitted.

The first condition for those who want to go there is to ask. Those who have contributed to the construction will be admitted in the first place. If there are doubtful cases, they should be referred to me. All those who have a doubtful presence won't go.

If there is the slightest doubt, the case will be presented to me. People must be known for their qualifications.

Roger's notes; facsimile at AV Archives; AMW, p. 441

We find more on the same subject in her conversation with Satprem:

"But then, people will not come for "regular meditations" or anything of the kind (the internal organization will be taken care of later): it will be a place for concentration.

Not everyone will be allowed in; there will be a time of the week or the day (I don't know) when visitors will be allowed to come, but anyway without mixture. There will be a fixed time or a fixed day to show the visitors, and the rest of the time only for those who are... serious – serious, sincere, who truly want to learn to concentrate.

[...]

Then, people will be let in in order to concentrate- [laughing] to learn to concentrate! No fixed meditations, nothing of the sort, but they will have to stay there in silence – silence and concentration.

[...]

And SILENCE. No talking inside!

So I think that is good"

Shortly before he passed away, Roger Anger was invited by the Visitors' Reception team of Matrimandir to speak about what he recalled of the Mother's indications regarding organisation of visitors' reception to Matrimandir. The most important thing that was communicated by him to the team was his memory of the Mother telling him to be always conscious of the fact that anyone who goes, is lead, into the Inner Chamber of the Matrimandir comes into the presence of the 'Universal Mother' and therefore it should not be done just anyhow. Care must be taken to prepare all before entering the Matrimandir.

We understand from the above that while Mother welcomed all people of goodwill to participate in the project of Auroville in accordance with the Charter, when it came to the Matrimandir she wanted that it is the individual's aspiration for, their relationship with, the Divine that would determine entry into the Matrimandir, the Soul of Auroville.

The question arises, in the absence of her physical presence, how to determine who is worthy of such a privilege.

The official access policy has been created following the indications and guidelines of the Mother. It welcomes anyone who wishes to visit the Matrimandir at the hour designated to them. There are different categories of visitors including official guests, volunteers, donors and so on. Great care is taken to ensure that all have the possibility to enter the Matrimandir for their personal concentration at the hour/s designated to them. Teams of Aurovilians are engaged in taking care of the different aspects of this work and changes and improvements are implemented as and when needed as an evolving process.

YOUTH INITIATIVES

SAFETY & BOUNDARIES AWARENESS PROGRAM REPORT

The issue of sexual harassment is prevalent across the globe, and Auroville is no exception.

In light of this, YouthLink took the initiative to host an awareness campaign on sexual harassment in October 2022. To follow up on this campaign, we recently hosted a networking event to connect all units and services working in this field to work collaboratively towards education and awareness in the community. From this event came

the (Safety & Boundaries Awareness) SBA program, which links all services within Auroville that work towards addressing issues related to sexual harassment.



SBA's goal was to increase awareness, build an emotional support network, optimise prevention, provide education within the community, and to ensure that Auroville becomes safer for all. We were excited

to offer an awareness program from 10 to 22 April, featuring a variety of events and workshops.

Among the workshops being offered were: Krav Maga, Self-defence, the anatomy and physiology of sex and STDs and a workshop on boundaries & consent. Our events included an Art Day on the theme of healing, classical dance and theatre performances by Yattra, a movie night displaying Moxie and a game show by Chrysalis.



In addition to our program, 'Bravely Speak Out,' a street theatre performance on child protection was presented in vari-

ous locations in villages around Auroville throughout April. It was created by Yatra Arts Media in collaboration with Auroville Child Protection Awareness and supported by AVI Germany.

Interaction & feedbacks

We are happy to say that we had a successful exchange with the community that sparked lively conversations and ignited a sense of inspiration amongst those involved. The program's execution was met with an influx of positive feedback, as people shared with us various initiatives they are undertaking in their personal and professional lives as a result of our program.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude to those that collaborated with us throughout this journey, as well as to the community for being welcoming and receptive despite the complexities surrounding this topic. One of the most remarkable feedback points we received was the growing demand for us to create more educational opportunities on these issues, particularly within schools. It is our shared belief that a generation that is aware of these topics, and willing to produce change, is the only solution to progress.



Our community is a diverse tapestry of cultures, complicating the means for admissible information transfer within educational institutions. Though we have yet to find a permanent solution to this challenge, it is crucial that we initiate conversations that link us to the world at large and widen our perspectives. Our program has allowed for taboo topics to be discussed, and we all hope that each of us continues to spread awareness and bring more light to our lives and those of others.

THE GNOSTIC BEING

A supramental or gnostic race of beings would not be a race made according to a single type, molded in a single fixed pattern; for the law of the supermind is unity fulfilled in diversity, and therefore there would be an infinite diversity in the manifestation of the gnostic consciousness although that consciousness would still be one in its basis, in its constitution, in its all revealing and all-uniting order. It is evident that the triple status of the supermind would reproduce itself as a principle in this new manifestation: there would be below it and yet belonging to it the degrees of the overmind and intuitive gnosis with the souls that had realized these degrees of the ascending consciousness; there would be also at the summit, as the evolution in Knowledge proceeded, individual beings who would ascend beyond a supermind formulation and reach from the highest height of supermind to the summits of unitarian self-realization in the body which must be the last and supreme state of the epiphany of the Creation. But in the supramental race itself, in the variation of its degrees, the individuals would not be cast according to a single type of individuality; each would be different from the other, a



unique formation of the Being, although one with all the rest in foundation of self and sense of oneness and in the principle of his being. It is only this general principle of the supramental existence of which we can attempt to form an idea however diminished by the limitations of mental thought and mental language. A more living picture of the gnostic being supermind only could make; for the mind some abstract outlines of it are alone possible. The gnosis is the effective principle of the Spirit, a highest dynamis of the spiritual existence. The gnostic individual would be the consummation of the spiritual man; his whole way of being, thinking, living, acting would be governed by the power of a vast universal spirituality. All the trinities of the Spirit would be real to his self-awareness and realized in his inner life. All his existence would be fused into one-ness with the transcendent and universal Self and Spirit; all his action would originate from and obey the supreme Self and Spirit's divine governance of Nature. All life would have to him the sense of the Conscious Being, the Purusha within, finding its self-expression in Nature; his life and all its thoughts, feelings, acts would be filled for him with that significance and built upon that foundation of its reality. He would feel the presence of the Divine in every center of his consciousness, in every vibration of his life-force, in every cell of his body. In all the workings of his force of Nature he would be aware of the workings of the supreme World-Mother, the Supernature; he would see his natural being as the becoming and manifestation of the power of the World-Mother. In this consciousness he would live and act in an entire transcendent freedom, a complete joy of the spirit, an entire identity with the cosmic self and a spontaneous sympathy with all in the universe. All beings would be to him his own selves, all ways and powers of consciousness would be felt as the ways and powers of

his own universality. But in that inclusive universality there would be no bondage to inferior forces, no deflection from his own highest truth: for this truth would envelop all truth of things and keep each in its own place, in a relation of diversified harmony, — it would not admit any confusion, clash, infringing of boundaries, any distortion of the different harmonies that constitute the total harmony. His own life and the world life would be to him like a perfect work of art; it would be as if the creation of a cosmic and spontaneous genius infallible in its working out of a multitudinous order. The gnostic individual would be in the world and of the world, but would also exceed it in his consciousness and live in his self of transcendence above it; he would be universal but free in the universe, individual but not limited by a separative individuality. The true Person is not an isolated entity, his individuality is universal; for he individualizes the universe: it is at the same time divinely emergent in a spiritual air of transcendental infinity, like a high cloud-surpassing summit; for he individualizes the divine Transcendence.'


THE FRENCH PAVILION PRESENTS:

The Kabbalah and the Language of Cells

Saturday, 13 May, 5pm, Town Hall—Cinema Paradiso

Filmed Conference by Daniel Souffir, Kabbalist and Energeticist: in French with English subtitles, duration: 60 min

Long distorted by centuries of ignorance and obscurantism, Kabbalah is today experiencing an unprecedented resurgence of interest. An age-old and secret science, transmitted in the past from master to disciples, Kabbalah is above all the science of RECEIVING (in Hebrew "KIBBEL": to receive; and "KAB-BALAH": received, welcome). Well understood, the Kabbalah becomes this Sacred Science



which makes it possible to explain the Universe while acting on it. It thus represents not only the synthesis of the physical and metaphysical worlds, but it provides us with the instructions for use.

For an hour, Daniel Souffir talks to us about our cells with simplicity and intelligence, with the heart, and thus makes this complicated area more accessible. How to speak to our cells with awareness? "What is true for God is true for us. What is true for God and us is true for us and our cells." "We are children of the Divine and we are cells of God. We are God for our cells and they are our children."

Which Diplomacy with the Living ?

As a second step, it will be a question of drawing together the possible applications of these thoughts in the Auroville context.

This third workshop is based work of Baptiste on the Morizot. Baptiste Morizot is a French philosopher born in 1983, whose research focuses on the relationship between humans and the rest of the living. Doctor of philosophy, he is currently a lecturer at the University of Aix en Provence. Like the researchers we have discussed previously (Philippe Descola and Cynthia Fleury), he is driven by the urgency of changing our relationship and our sensitivity to the world. He explores the possibilities of

communication between humans and living beings, based on attention and conflict resolution. This is what he develops in his concept of "diplomacy". He bases his work on his practice of tracking animals such as wolves, bears or panthers. At the crossroads of philosophy, anthropology and political ecology, he seeks to establish the foundations of a more sustainable relationship with the world by exploring and experimenting with the aspects of human intelligence that are at stake.

When describing her early vision of the Park at the center of Auroville the Mother said: "This central point is a park I had seen when I was a little girl (perhaps the most beautiful thing in the world with regard to physical, material Nature), a park with water and trees like all parks, and flowers, but not too many (flowers in the form of creepers), palm trees and ferns (all species of palm trees), water (if possible, running water) and, if possible, a small waterfall." [23 June 1965]

Now, more than 50 years later, almost all of the Matrimandir Gardens which have been built hold small water features, whether they are cascades, or silent lotus filled pools.

In fact, if you stand in the gardens and close your eyes you will be able to identify, with just a little practice, which garden you are in simply by listening to the sound of the water flow in that garden.



Unity Garden is easy to identify with eyes closed, for it contains the large multi jet fountain designed by Roger Anger, architect of Matrimandir. Its sound is that of the solid cascading of its multiple jets as they fall into the white stone clad pool below.

In the Garden of Progress, if you again close your eyes, you will hear the soft bubbling of the springlike fountain that emerges from the topmost stone of a small series of granite slabs, flowing down in a sparkling sheet to a tiny pool at its base.

In the Garden of Consciousness there is a quite different sound to the water feature there.... From its large lotus filled upper pool, water flows over a lip clad with gold tiles to move down a series of descending pools. The sound of the water flowing over the top most lip is that of a smooth sheet of water dropping just 30 centimeters into the first of the six small pools.





All of these water features attract people, who love to either stand and watch or sit quietly, sinking into contemplation aided by the water's soothing sounds.



Most recently added, in the Garden of the Unexpected, there are two water features whose sounds draw quiet listeners at all times of the day.

First, there is a small pool in the section of this garden called "Birth". A single simple jet of water shoots up, not too high, to fall back with a gentle splashing sound into a shaded living pool which features blue, white and violet lilies.

The second water feature in the Garden of the Unexpected is much more visible, – this is the 30-meter-long slender stream which flows from the shallow rectangular pool near a pagoda at the upper end, down to a "mirror pool" at its lower end where the water spreads out into an even sheet just a few millimeters deep before flowing into its recycling sump concealed below. All of the gardens, by the way, use this feature of recycling the water, whether from a concealed underground sump, or from an open pool integrated into the



garden's design. Closing one's eyes in this section of the Garden of the Unexpected, the Garden of Youthfulness, one can hear the gentle tinkling of the water as it drops over small waterfalls that link different sections of the limestone river bed.

The shaded grass nearby is often occupied by people sitting very quietly absorbed in this field of water sound. Another sound dimension is added here, for there are wind chimes fixed high up in the Neem trees which add their melodious notes to the natural water sounds. It is a pleasure indeed to close one's eyes here and drift along the subtle river of sound which flows in this garden.

On hot afternoons in summer, the sound of children splashing happily in these cooling ponds adds their laughter to the magic symphony.

In addition to these existing, developed gardens, there are new water features being developed for two more of the gardens of Matrimandir. In the Garden of Bliss, already built some years ago, the central circular area is being remodeled to enhance the beauty and soundscape of this 18-meterwide circle. This area will feature a series of five large bowls of various sizes which will be filled continuously with water. Overflowing from the circular rims of the bowls, the splashing curtains of falling water will create a musical sound bath. These bowls are now being clad with marble mosaic and soon will be mounted in the center of the garden and joined to its water



circulation system. By the time of our next newsletter, in August, we will be able to show you the visual presence that these bowl-fountains will create. We do not yet know what the water in this garden will sound like, but it is certain that it will be distinctive and easily identified by the closed eyed listener.



Also underway is the construction of the Garden of Light, just adjacent to the Garden of Bliss.

The Garden of Light will feature two water elements: a lower. silent pool and a long central stream which will drop into this pool after flowing, arrow straight, through the full central length of the garden. This narrow stream, V- shaped and about 40 meters long, will be clad with white marble tiles to symbolize a Ray of Light within the garden. Again, there will be distinctive sounds as the water moves, - for the long stream will hold pebbles and small rocks in its central groove so that the flowing water will have

to bubble and swirl around them as it flows towards the silent pool. Here again, with closed eyes a listener will be able to say "Ah! I am in the Garden of Light".

Water is ever-present also in the seven-meter wide rain water harvesting channel which runs, one kilometer long, encircling the whole oval of the Park of Unity, before overflowing into the first section of the Lake which has been built on the south east edge of the gardens.

This water channel is more and more filled with beautiful lilies, and lotuses too. Closing one's eyes here, one may not hear water sounds, but the distinctive calls of the large water birds which come to feed on fish and insects living in the channel will give you a sure clue as to where you are!



Work on the Lake itself is now concentrated on reinforcing and raising its end walls made of concrete blocks, so that the walls will be high enough to contain the rainwater to be harvested from the upcoming winter monsoon. The lake now holds a vast quantity of crystal-clear water, about 3.8 meters deep, which was harvested from last year's winter monsoon. Standing at the lake shore in the evening, with eyes closed, there is very little sound, — perhaps it is this silence itself that will let you know that you are in the presence of this wide still expanse of precious water.

Its silent presence is like a promise of things to come.....

Update & Report March & April 2023



Dear residents,

Legal matters

Working Committee cases at the Madras High Court (MHC)

Original Working Committee case

This case, which received such a favorable judgement on August 12th 2022 and then was appealed by the Secretary, was listed for hearing before the Appeal Bench of the MHC on 24th and 28th April; however the case was not heard due to a lack of time. We are yet to receive a new date for the next hearing.

Writ of Quo Warranto

As announced via two massbulletins on <u>26th April</u> and <u>28th April</u>, we as the Working Committee duly selected by the Residents' Assembly also filed a new case at the MHC against the 7 persons claiming to be the 'Working Committee'. This particular type of case, called a *Quo Warranto*, obliges the respondents (Anu, Arun, Joseba, Partha, Selvaraj, Srimoyi, Tine) to prove in the Court that they are representing the RA and have valid grounds to call themselves the "Working Committee". To summarize the written court order:

- Notices have been sent to the 8 respondents (Anu, Arun, Joseba, Partha, Selvaraj, Srimoyi, Tine and the Secretary of the AVF) and responses must be submitted by 7th of June, 2023.
- 2. Any policy decision taken by the 'Working Committee' is subject to the result of this Writ petition." This means that whether or not decisions made by the group calling themselves the 'Working Committee' can stand and from what date depends on the directions issued in the final judgment.
- 3. The judge has asked for the next hearing to be posted on the 7th of June, 2023.

Petition to quash Office Order appointing/replacing executives

Following the attempted takeover of some of Auroville's essential services (<u>see below</u>), the Madras High Court was approached with a new petition to challenge the appointment/removal of executives by the Office of the Secretary, via Office Order #AF/ESTT/OO/277 dated 12th April 2023. This Office Order was to replace executives, trustees and members for the Visitors' Center, SAIIER Board, Bharat Nivas, Eco Service, Auroville Safety and Security Team (AVSST), Residents' Assembly Service (RAS), Arts Service, as well as a few other teams and services.

The case was given a first hearing and admitted on 28th April 2023. We will keep the community informed of the further developments and outcome of this case. Additionally, the Working Committee has provided guidance and legal advice to the executives that were to be replaced.

National Green Tribunal (NGT)

The appeal in the Supreme Court filed by the Office of the Secretary against the NGT ruling of April 2022 was scheduled to be heard in March 2023. However the case has been further adjourned and is expected to be heard on 9th May 2023.

Additionally, a follow-up "Miscellaneous Application" was filed before the NGT by an Auroville resident, in view of the works done by the Office of the Secretary and its 'ATDC' at Darkali, and in response to the <u>report</u> made about the Crown Road in Darkali by the NGT-constituted Joint Committee. The matter was heard on 14th March, and the court order can be found <u>here</u>. The main points of this court order have been summarized by us <u>via massbulletin</u>. Evergreen/Abri/Ami encroachment

The final hearing of the case of land encroachment by PKS took place at the Tindivanam Court on 13th April, and a final judgment was awaited on 26th April. However, this judgment hasn't been made public yet and we are waiting for more information.

Important reminder

None of the judgments so far have invalidated in any way the working groups selected by the RA, including the Working Committee, the FAMC and the TDC. We will update the community as the court proceedings go further.

The RA Working Committee regularly follows-up on legal matters with the help of resource persons. We would like to remind everyone that legal processes do take time and require patience. We fully trust the work of our lawyers and we are confident that the best results will ultimately be achieved for Auroville. Attempted takeover of essential services

Over the past weeks, there has been an ongoing series of attempted takeovers of various services in Auroville by the Office of the Secretary. In all of these cases, there have been no notices given, no hearings, no reasons, no valid written orders - in short no due process has been followed. We published a <u>first massbulletin</u> about the matter on 14th April.

On 21st April, an <u>Office Order</u> 'appointing' new 'executives' to a certain number of services was made public. The services concerned by this attempted takeover are the **Visitors' Center**, the **Residents' Assembly Service** (RAS), the **Eco Service**, the **Auroville Arts Service**, the **Auroville Safety & Security Team** (AVSST), the **SAIIER Board**, the **Bharat Nivas Trust**, the **Guest House Trust** and the **Housing Service**. The Office Order also mentions the creation of new services such as a "Sports Task Force", a "Green Belt Services" [sic] and a "Farm Service".

As announced in our <u>second massbulletin</u> on the topic, published on 22nd April, none of these appointments seem to be valid. We have indeed received legal counsel that before such an appointment can be considered valid for units, three documents are required:

- 1. A resolution from the relevant trust
- A resolution from the 'FAMC' signed by the JSFA (Joint Secretary, Finance Advisor to Ministry of Education and ex-officio member of the GB) who is listed in the Office Order appointing the 'FAMC' according to Section 16 of the AV Foundation Act.
- 3. An Office Order from the Office of the Secretary.

In all of these attempted appointments of new executives and attempted dismissals of current executives, it seems indeed that at least one of the three above-mentioned documents is missing. More information can be found <u>here.</u> We invite residents to be cautious and to inform us immediately if individuals claiming to be newly appointed executives or team members appear on site and do not produce the above documents and do not accept a refusal to hand over.

Visas

WCom member currently abroad

After having received his 'Leave India Notice' (LIN) on 15th February 2023, one of our members, Maël, left the country on 1st March 2023. As a reminder, no reason has been officially given for this LIN, however we suspect this is because of his involvement as a member of the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly.

Maël is still currently abroad and we continue to explore all possibilities for him to return as soon as possible in Auroville, where he belongs, and to prevent others from receiving the same. We would like to thank all the resource persons and friends of Auroville who have helped and are still helping us address this issue with the competent authorities.

Aurovilian denied visa application

One Aurovilian, who was also an RA-selected representative of the community in the TDC, has recently been denied his visa extension by the FRRO Chennai. Upon enquiry, it seems that this Aurovilian had his Letter of Recommendation sent directly by the Office of the Secretary to the FRRO, without receiving a copy himself. It seems that the Secretary included a negative remark in this Letter of Recommendation, which may have resulted in his visa application being denied.

We are doing all we can to help the said Aurovilian, and any other resident who would be facing a similar situation.

Visits to the RRO/FRRO

In several cases, residents have had to submit incomplete visa applications with the FRRO, in the absence of a Letter of Recommendation (LoR) by the Office of the Secretary. For at least 10 individuals, their visa has expired without receiving a new visa, pending the said LoR. We have met several times with the FRRO in Chennai to explain why in certain cases the applications were submitted without the LoR. We have always been cordially welcomed and treated with respect.

Offering support and advice

We continue to offer support and advice to those impacted by the visa situation, and keep doing all we can to address the visa issue. If you have any questions regarding your visa or know anyone who does, do not hesitate to contact us: <u>workingcom@auroville.services</u>.

Register of Residents (RoR)

Unauthorized removal of a resident from the RoR

The residents impersonating the Working Committee have <u>announced on Auronet</u> that, due to his "Leave India Notice", Maël would be removed from the Register of Residents (RoR). This is based on <u>a circular</u> issued by Mr Sathyanarayan, Accounts Officer for the Auroville Foundation Office, which was made public a few days later. We have sent <u>a massbulletin</u> clarifying that this decision is not following any legal or established process, and is a clear case of misuse and abuse of power. This decision by the Office of the Secretary is in direct contravention to the Auroville Foundation Act (1988), the Admission & Termination Regulations (2020) and our internal guidelines and policies. We regret observing one more

case of loss of community value and lack of respect for any basic principle of human interaction. We are following-up on the matter and considering the best ways to address it.

New procedure before entering into the RoR

We have been informed that lately, new Aurovilians who have finished their Newcomer process and need to sign their B-Form and be entered into the RoR, are asked at the Auroville Foundation Office to give quotations of the Mother and Sri Aurobindo by heart. We believe this is contrary to the guidelines and principles given to us by the Mother, and are profoundly disturbed by this new procedure, which in our view shows a lack of understanding of any genuine principles of integral yoga and an attempt to transform them into external mechanical learning. We would like to remind everyone that the Office of the Secretary has no role, as per the Auroville Foundation Act (1988) and the Admission & Termination Regulations (2020), in assessing the eligibility of those joining the community as residents. This role lies solely with the Residents' Assembly, through its duly constituted Entry Board (aka Admissions Committee).

To date, many 'Confirmed Aurovilians' are still awaiting entry by the Office of the Secretary into the RoR, some of whom have been waiting for over two years.

'Updating' the RoR

More than 10 months after the Office of the Secretary started to "update" the RoR, falsely claiming that it hadn't been done since 2005 (while we have proof of its update up to 2021, before Dr Jayanti Ravi's appointment), no visible results have been shown. The matter seems to be deliberately stalled, in a clear attempt to undermine the functioning of the Residents' Assembly.

Crown Road 'works' and mismanagement

Tree cutting in Darkali

In March 2023, reckless tree cutting took place in Darkali, on the trajectory of the projected Crown. This included the felling of trees outside of the 9.1m corridor (which was not marked beforehand on site) set by the National Green Tribunal's Joint Committee, the destruction of protected species such as Red Sanders, and several violent episodes during which people on site were endangered by the use of chainsaws by reportedly drunk men. The Working Committee closely followed the unfolding of events in Darkali and we have published a number of massbulletins and communications, posted below. We express once again our gratitude to all those who mobilized and strove to uphold the voice of the Residents' Assembly, the values of Auroville, and the need for due processes to be followed and respected.

Tree cutting next to the Youth Center

Following the events in Darkali, more tree cutting took place next to the Youth Center, on private land. We have circulated <u>a massbulletin</u> about this topic on 17th March.

Suspected financial mismanagement

We received many reports from Satprem Maini regarding the way the Crown road is being implemented by the Secretary's 'ATDC' and their contractor, which emphasize that there may be financial mismanagement involved. We have therefore <u>written to the Chairman</u>, and to authorities at different levels, to raise their awareness on this concerning matter. One point of particular concern is the wood that was cut in Darkali, which includes rare and protected species such as Red Sanders, which was sold opaquely, without transparency.

Media - Internal & External Communication

Voice of Auroville - launch of a new journal

We have shared <u>via massbulletin</u> the <u>first issue</u> of 'Voice of Auroville', a journal aimed to inform well wishers and friends of Auroville across India and the globe with factual updates and crisp articles on what is unfolding in Auroville. This first issue was sent out to officials at several levels, to diplomats, and to a vast network of friends of Auroville. We encourage you to share it widely with your own contacts. Censorship in N&N, launch of Community edition

The editors/managers of the News & Notes (N&N) stopped publishing submissions from the RA-selected groups at the end of December 2022. After several exchanges between RA-selected groups and the N&N editors, the Auroville Council passed <u>a resolution</u> effectively dismissing and replacing the N&N editors. This was followed up by the publication of a <u>timeline</u>, explaining step by step what led to this decision. Since this decision hasn't been respected by the dismissed N&N editors, the Auroville Council (in consultation with other RA-selected groups, including the RA Working Committee) have been looking into alternative solutions and on 27th April a community edition of the News & Notes was launched. This publication contains contributions from both the groups selected by the RA and those endorsed by the Secretary. Please find the first issue linked <u>here</u>. Auroville Media Liaison Team

One important team member of the Auroville Media Liaison Service left the team to focus on some other important work. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to this person for the work and energy they have offered. Following this change, the Auroville Media Liaison Team is currently being restructured to adapt to our reviewed media strategy, and change in human resources. Support is needed. Communication to 'The Hindu' and other editors

Following the <u>letter</u> we had addressed to the Editor of The Hindu - Chennai branch, the Officer on Special Duty (OSD) working for the Office of the Secretary sent <u>an email</u> on 10th March to the same editor and to many other media outlets, discrediting the voice of the Residents' Assembly and its duly appointed Working Committee. We replied the following day with <u>a clarification</u>, responding to the fallacious arguments of the OSD. From the start, we have only requested various media outlets to uphold journalistic standards by interviewing both sides when publishing articles related to Auroville's current situation.

Governing Board and International Advisory Council

Governing Board meetings

The Governing Board published its <u>60th</u> and <u>61st</u> meeting minutes online, via the website of the Auroville Foundation. It is regrettable that these minutes were not made available to the Residents' Assembly through its internal communication platforms, as is usual practice. We have sent to the Governing Board an email in which we communicate to them our <u>observations on the 60th</u> as well as our <u>observations on the 61st</u> meeting minutes. We also once again requested that we move towards functioning in mutuality between the three authorities of the Auroville Foundation. We emphasized that to be true to the vision and teachings of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, Auroville must grow through goodwill, patience, compassion and a sincere effort by all towards collective harmony. We did not receive any acknowledgement or reply from the Governing Board, nor any of its members. Additionally, we have seen <u>a letter</u> addressed to the Office of the Secretary by the Ministry of Education, with observations on the 61st and 62nd Governing Board meeting minutes.

We are yet to receive a copy of the 62nd and 63rd Governing Board meeting minutes. We are also not aware of a date for the next Governing Board meeting.

International Advisory Council (IAC)

We continue to be in regular contact with the International Advisory Council via email, and continue to inform its members of the situation in Auroville.

Community interactions

General Meeting on 1st April

We are grateful for the General Meeting called by the RA TDC on 1st April and express our wholehearted support and encouragement to them for taking up the next step of collective, inclusive and participatory planning for Auroville. Please see <u>here</u> for their announcement dated 04.04.23.

We also note that the meeting was scheduled to take place at the Unity Pavilion, but needed to be shifted at the last minute to Kalabhumi, due to RA TDC being <u>called "illegal"</u> by the Secretary's "ATDC". We are concerned about this trend of labeling RA groups "illegal". It is essential for its good functioning that the Residents' Assembly and its various working groups meet regularly and discuss important issues pertaining to the day-to-day affairs of Auroville. It is highly objectionable that the Unity Pavilion executives have refused a meeting that was open to all residents.

General Meeting on 22nd April

Our team was present at this meeting, and we were able to answer questions from the residents and get a pulse of where the community is at. We thank the organizers for arranging this important community meeting.

Wednesday meetings for residents

Two of our members are present every Wednesday for these meetings, which take place at 5 pm at the Tibetan Pavilion. All residents are welcome.

Miscellaneous

Y-20 summit in Auroville

An event related to the G20, called the Y20 summit and related to youth, was happening from 4th to 6th April in Pondicherry and Auroville. According to the pictures published on social media, the Chairman and some Governing Board members as well as the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation were present at the inauguration in Bharat Nivas. We find it regrettable that neither the Working Committee selected by the Residents' Assembly, nor the wider Residents' Assembly, nor the Auroville youth were formally invited to this event. We however circulated <u>a massbulletin</u> to welcome the delegates, also emphasizing some of the ways in which the Office of the Secretary has systematically targeted youth in Auroville over the past year.

Mishandling of passport data by Office of the Secretary

A circular from the Office of the Secretary, which included the passport details of an Aurovilian and French national, was publicly posted on Auronet and in the News & Notes without getting the prior consent of the concerned resident. Passport details are sensitive information and it is against all established procedures to disclose them publicly. We have contacted the Ministry of Education, as well as the French Consulate, to inform them about this wrongdoing and raise their awareness on risks of data skimming.

New Villupuram Collector

We met the new Collector for the Villupuram District on 10th March 2023. The interaction was friendly and we invited the Collector to visit Auroville, at his convenience.

Tamil New Year Cultural event

It was reported to us by several attendees of a Tamil New Year Cultural event held at Bharat Nivas on 13th April, 2023, that the event was 'hijacked' by the Office of the Secretary and their 'working groups' and was held up for more than one hour by their unannounced presentations. Audience members reported feeling upset by this enforced interaction.

Letters from the Auroville International Board

Following their in-person visit in February 2023, the Auroville International Board and Centers have written on 6th March <u>a letter</u> to the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, which we have circulated at their request.

In a recent News & Notes publication (issue #970, p.6), those impersonating the Working Committee have included critical comments about Auroville International (AVI). The AVI Board Chairman clarified in <u>an open letter</u> how this statement was factually incorrect. We thank again the AVI Board and AVI Centers for their continued support, and for engaging actively with Auroville and its struggles.

Aurovilians passing away

We published <u>a note</u> to offer advice about how to put one's affairs in order regarding belongings, financial assets and other important considerations, in order to ease the complexities and stress on family members and friends after someone passes on. We remain available to help on such matters, and to answer any questions you may have.

Sexual harassment

Over March and April, we dealt with two situations related to sexual harassment. We published <u>a massbulletin</u> on 9th April, providing relevant information and ways to address it within Auroville. We encourage everyone to please ensure that these sensitive situations are held within a process that aims at integrity, confidentiality and fairness towards all involved.

Trafficking & illegal substances

We have recently sent two massbulletins, on <u>27th March</u> and <u>11th April</u>, to inform the community of a recent increase in the movement of illegal substances in the immediate surroundings of Auroville. As announced, we will not get involved in defending or supporting any situations related to illegal substances.

Cancellation of children's play

A children's play by Miraculous Productions was canceled by the venues in which it was scheduled, allegedly under the pressure of those working with the Office of the Secretary, due to it being considered a "political satire". Several residents have contacted us to share their concern about this unprecedented level of censorship.

Other ongoing issues

These are some of the other ongoing issues we are dealing with on a regular basis, but which do not have new developments to report:

- Delegations to various officials: We continue to organize and/or participate in delegations to various officials at all levels, with the help of resource persons and of our liaison officer.
- Maintenances stopped: Our maintenances have been discontinued as of January 2023, along with other RA-selected and RA-endorsed groups. Thanks to the support of many community members and well-wishers, we are still being supported - we are grateful for this show of solidarity. - 'Relocation' of people on "red assets": If you received an email from the 'ATDC' appointed by the GB to this effect, please write to <u>famc@auroville.services</u> and <u>tdc@auroville.services</u>.
- Contributions being requested: If you were previously receiving a waiver because of a fragile financial situation and have received an email from the parallel 'BCC' asking you to pay for your contribution while your situation hasn't changed, please write to <u>famc@auroville.services</u> and to <u>bccoffice@auroville.services</u>.
- Archives: Following the takeover of the Auroville Archives, we have <u>announced</u> the creation of a new Archives service. Please send any new material you have to <u>archives@auroville.services</u> so that it can be properly archived and classified.
- Internal communication being blocked: Communication between @auroville.org.in and @auroville.services is still being blocked.
- Land Board: Most of the current Land Board members have either not been selected by the RA, or have had their terms expire. We are looking into the matter with the Auroville Council and RA FAMC.
- Conflict resolution: We are regularly involved in helping to resolve conflictual situations, either directly or through the CRP3 (a subgroup of the Auroville Council with representatives of AVC, WCom, AVSST, Mattram and resource persons).
- Safety and Security: We continue to liaise with the Auroville Security and the police as and when required.
- Housing issues: We continue to be informed of clear cases of mismanagement involving the 'Housing Service' appointed by the Office of the Secretary. If you are impacted or know someone who is, please contact <u>famc@auroville.services</u> and <u>workingcom@auroville.services</u>.
- Interacting with visiting press: If you are approached by or know of any visiting press, please inform us as soon as possible.

Administrative documents and certificates: For any needed administrative documents please feel free to contact us for information and advice.

In the current climate, the task of the Working Committee is arduous and sometimes discouraging, but we are resolved to stand strong, collectively. We are grateful to be a real team in which all of us complement each other and enjoy working and being together, in spite of the challenging circumstances. We thank all those who express their support, encouragement and care - this means a lot to us.

We continue to dedicate ourselves to fulfilling the mandate given to us by the Residents' Assembly, for the co-creation and manifestation of Mother's Dream.
