

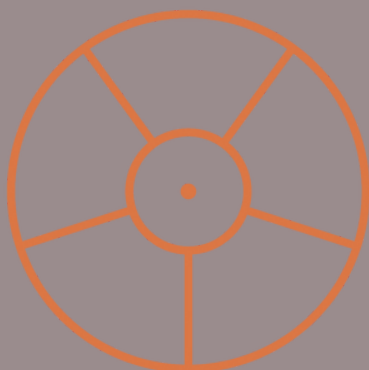

It is possible, however, to have some idea in advance of the major problems confronting the seeker. When *Agni* burns in our mind, in our moments of inspiration, we know it creates a great tension, an almost physical heat. When it burns in our heart, in our soul-moments, we know that our breast feels like a red-hot hearth, hot enough for the skin to change color and to such a degree that even an inexperienced eye can perceive a kind of glowing radiance around the yogi. When *Agni* burns in our vital, and as we call the force or open to the cosmic world, there is likewise a kind of concentrated pulsation at the level of the navel, almost a tremor of fever throughout the body (since a large amount of force is entering through a tiny channel). But what about the warm gold dust, *this wine of lightning*, in the cells of the body? *It begins to boil everywhere*, says the Mother in her simple language, *like a boiler about to explode*. The rishis, too, spoke of being broken "like a half-baked jar" if one went too quickly. Furthermore, if it were uniquely a matter of creating something entirely new, the problem would be somewhat simpler, but we must do with what we have, evolve from our present state to another state, from an old form of organization to a new one. The old heart, the old lungs are still there; at what moment, wondered the Mother, is the heart going to be stopped and the Force set in motion? The difficulty is in the change-over. Countless experiences in tiny doses are therefore necessary to accustom the cells so that they do not panic during the transition. Thus, the first problem is to prepare the body, and this requires years and years, perhaps centuries. Sri Aurobindo worked for forty years and the Mother for fifty years at this preparation. The practical, immediate necessity, then, is to endure, to outrun death. *The basic question*, the Mother said, *in this race toward transformation is to know which of the two will arrive first: the person seeking to transform the body in the image of the divine Truth, or the body's old habit of disintegration*.

For, naturally, the work must be done in one lifetime. From one life to another, it is possible to recover the achievements of the soul, the mind, and even the vital, which in the current life will result in spontaneous blossomings, innate talents, something already developed. One needs only go over the lesson for ten or twenty years to capture the thread of former lives; there is even a rather striking experience in which one sees precisely the cutoff point where the work already accomplished in past lives ends and the new phase begins. Thus one simply picks up the trail where one had left it. But the cellular progress in the body, the progress of the physical consciousness obviously cannot pass into the next life; everything gets scattered on the funeral pyre or dissipates in the earth. So if we want a continuity in human evolution, if we want the supramental being to manifest in our own flesh rather than in some new, unknown organism that would supersede our mental humanity, it is necessary for *one* human being to accomplish the work in *one* lifetime. If it succeeds once, it can be transmitted to others (we will return to this point later).



Sri Aurobindo used to say that it would take three centuries – and he had a clear vision – for a full supramental being to emerge, luminous, light, etc., as we have previously tried to describe him. Short of a full supramental being (even Plato was not born in a day), we must then build in our flesh a *transitional* being, a link between the human and the superhuman, that is, a being who not only would have realized the supramental consciousness but whose body would also have acquired enough immortality, as it were, to last through the transition period, and enough power and suppleness to effect its own transmutation, or to engender a supramental being through its own energy, bypassing the usual method of earthly birth. Indeed, the heavy animal and human heredity weighing on our subconscious, and automatically transmitted by physical conception, is one of the major hurdles to the transformation, at least as difficult as the boiling *Agni*, if not more difficult. This is the second problem. Perhaps it is, in fact, the true problem, far greater than the other, more conspicuous problems of the body. Such are the two fundamental problems confronting the seeker: to impart to the cells of the body the consciousness of immortality, which is already there in our soul and even in our mind, and to cleanse the subconscious completely. The progress of *Agni* in the body depends, it seems, on these two conditions. Thus, as always, the work is a work of consciousness.

First, the ability to endure. In practice, one finds that immortality is always closely related to truth: what is true is immortal. If we were completely true, we would be completely immortal, from head to toe. Until now, however, hardly anything except our soul has been immortal, because it is the truth of the Spirit within us, passing from one life to the next, growing, evolving, becoming more and more conscious. The mind, too, as it becomes sufficiently integrated around the central Truth of our being, as it thinks the Truth and wants the Truth, is immortal. One can fairly easily remember one's past formations: some truths appear exceedingly familiar, some yearnings for truth inexplicably poignant. The vital also is capable of immortality as it becomes sufficiently integrated with the central psychic Truth: we emerge into another dimension, as familiar as eternity, though this is rather uncommon since our life-force is generally engrossed in all kinds of petty activities instead of building a true life. The more we go down the scale of consciousness, the thicker the falsehood and the more real is death – naturally, because in essence falsehood means decay. The vital is already fairly obscure, but the body is full of falsehood. Old age and illnesses are among its most prominent falsehoods; how could what is True become old, ugly, worn-out, or ill? Truth is so obviously radiant, beautiful, luminous, and eternal. Truth is invincible. Death and old age can only attain us because of our lack of Truth.

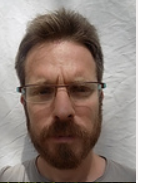

- The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.

- The date of becoming Aurovillian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovillian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- A confirmed Aurovillian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).
- A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.
- A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

## FROM THE RA WCOM

Dear Community,

A number of you have contacted us for advice about how to respond to the request from the AVFO BCC to Aurovilians who are receiving a 'Silver Fund' maintenance, to fill out a self declaration form.

We copy below a statement by the RA BCC providing information about the Silver Fund.

While the RA BCC recommends that you reply to the AVFO BCC's email or meet with them, we would like to add that some of the fields of the "Self Declaration Form" seem very inappropriate to us. This form also brings up privacy concerns, which is a fundamental right under Article 21 of the Indian Constitution, and we do not want to encourage this administrative culture in Auroville.

Our recommendation would therefore be that, if you decide to respond to the AVFO BCC's request, you only provide the information that you feel comfortable sharing with them, and simply state that after sincere consideration you reaffirm that you do not have sufficient funds to meet your basic needs and therefore still need this financial support from the Auroville community. This could be done either via email or in person.

We hope this clarifies. Feel free to get in touch with us and with the RA BCC if you have any further questions.

Also please inform us of any further email exchange you may have with the AVFO BCC.

Lastly, if you have received this request from the AVFO BCC and neither you nor a family member are receiving a 'Silver Fund' maintenance, please inform us and the RA BCC.

### **Statement by the RA BCC:**

#### **Advice & Information for Responding to the Maintenance Self Declaration Form**

Dear friends,

You may have received an email with a 'Self Declaration Form' to be filled in, related to a 'special category' of Maintenance that you are receiving. If so, you are probably receiving what we call a 'Silver Fund' Maintenance.

The Silver Fund Maintenances are Maintenances that were provided to Aurovilians over 70 years of age, who had lived and worked in Auroville for at least 20 years, and were in need of financial support. These Maintenances were allocated on a permanent basis, unless people voluntarily chose to give it up (for example in cases where they started to receive a "good" pension from their home country). In some cases, the BCC shifted eligible senior Aurovilians to a Silver Fund Maintenance to free up Maintenances in the service they were working in for new people to be able to join. Receiving a Silver Fund Maintenance did not imply that the Aurovillian had stopped working, but it did offer the Aurovillian financial security regardless of how much they were able to continue working.

We feel concerned that the FO BCC might be considering ending this Maintenance support. When first allocating the Silver Fund Maintenance, similar questions were asked as the ones detailed in the Self Declaration form (although this was typically done in person, and based on good faith). We would advise those who have been asked to fill in a Self Declaration Form to reply to the mail or to meet with the FO BCC. Although we cannot know if this will result in the Maintenance support continuing, what we have observed is that lack of communication does lead to them cutting budgets and Maintenances. If you are receiving a pension and this pension is insufficient, we advise you to mention this in the form. Be sure to mention any kind of work that you continue to do for Auroville.

In case you are informed that your Maintenance will be cut, consider requesting information regarding their guidelines for receiving this Maintenance. Please keep the RA BCC and RA WCom informed of their reply.

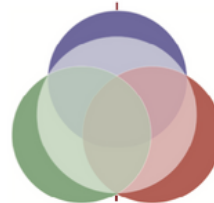

### DEBORAH SMITH OF GOLDEN BRIDGE POTTERY

Long-term friend of Auroville Deborah Smith of Golden Bridge Pottery in Pondicherry passed away at her residence on Friday 21 July.

Educated at Stanford University in Japanese language, Deborah apprenticed to master potter Yamamoto Toshu in the Bizen region of Japan in 1968.



Later in the ceramics department of the University of Southern California, she met her partner Ray Meeker.

Deborah, like many of her compatriots, at that moment in time, was drawn to the philosophies of the East and soon made it to Pondicherry where the Mother invited her to start a ceramic studio on Ashram land. That is Golden Bridge Pottery, a world born of the experience of Deborah and Ray. A world that has inspired and nurtured generations of clay artists in India, who are breaking new ground in ceramics today internationally.

Deborah retired from actively participating at GBP in 2019, choosing to take time to pen her memoirs. Her quiet demeanour and soft-spoken personality will be sorely missed.

The Sunlit Path of Bhakti to the Supreme Divine Mother is the key to a more easy and joyful journey towards the Life Divine

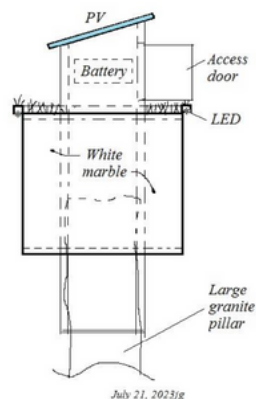
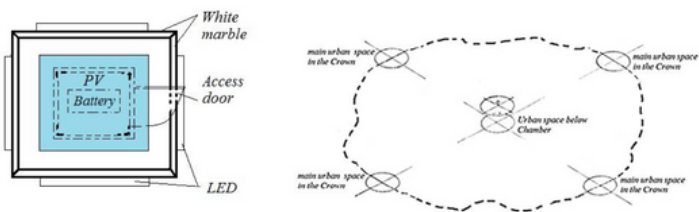

## THE CONSCIOUS TRANSMUTATION AND INCREASE OF ENERGY

"The practice of Brahmacharya is the first and most necessary condition of increasing the force within and turning it to such uses as may benefit the possessor or mankind. All human energy has a physical basis.... To raise up the physical to the spiritual is Brahmacharya, for by the meeting of the two the energy which starts from one and produces the other is enhanced and fulfils itself.

This is the metaphysical theory. The application depends on a right understanding of the physical and psychological conformation of the human receptacle of energy. The fundamental physical unit is the retas, in which the tejas, the heat and light and electricity in a man, is involved and hidden. All energy is latent in the retas. This energy may be either expended physically or conserved. All passion, lust, desire wastes the energy by pouring it, either in the gross form or a sublimated subtler form, out of the body. Immorality in act throws it out in the gross form; immorality of thought in the subtle form. In either case there is waste, and unchastity is of the mind and speech as well as of the body. On the other hand, all self-control conserves the energy in the retas, and conservation always brings with it increase. But the needs of the physical body are limited and the excess of energy must create a surplus which has to turn itself to some use other than the physical. According to the ancient theory retas is jala or water, full of light and heat and electricity, in one word, of tejas. The excess of the retas turns first into heat or tapas which stimulates the whole system, and it is for this reason that all forms of self-control and austerity are called tapas or tapasyā, because they generate the heat or stimulus which is a source of powerful action and success; secondly, it turns to tejas proper, light, the energy which is at the source of all knowledge; thirdly, it turns to vidyut or electricity, which is at the basis of all forceful action whether intellectual or physical. In the vidyut again is involved the ojas, or prāṇasakti, the primal energy which proceeds from ether. The retas refining from jala to tapas, tejas and vidyut and from vidyut to ojas, fills the system with physical strength, energy and brain-power and in its last form of ojas rises to the brain and informs it with that primal energy which is the most refined form of matter and nearest to spirit. It is ojas that creates a spiritual force or vīrya, by which a man attains to spiritual knowledge, spiritual love and faith, spiritual strength. It follows that the more we can by Brahmacharya increase the store of tapas, tejas, vidyut and ojas, the more we shall fill ourselves with utter energy for the works of the body, heart, mind and spirit."

We want to restart our 24-hour rabies rescue again, but in order to do so, we need to build a quarantine facility, as mandated by the Animal Welfare Board that every shelter must be equipped with one. As IACC shelter was never equipped with such a facility, we had to build a makeshift isolation facility, which proved to be insufficient, especially during the outbreak of canine distemper when the number of affected animals increased rapidly.

### THIS TAMIL NADU MAN TURNS 100 ACRES OF BARREN LAND TO AN INDIGENOUS FOREST



This is the story of D. Saravanan, a true environmentalist at heart, who dedicated nearly 25 years of his life to turning barren land into a green lush forest spread over 100 acres, now known as the Aranya Forest and Sanctuary in Poothurai village, Tamil Nadu. Born into a small farmer family near Villupuram district in Tamil Nadu, Saravanan always had a special connection with nature. At the age of 14, he participated in the 100-day march for the 'Save the Western Ghats' rally which deeply influenced his path in life. After being active as an environmentalist in his youth days, Saravanan took up the project in Auroville in the year 1994. And with the help of the residents, students and the local community, Saravanan decided to grow a 100 acre of land into an Indigenous forest. It was not an easy task, from bringing water into the land, nourishing the soil, collecting rare local seeds, fighting poachers and planting thousands of trees on barren land. Saravanan dedicated 30 years of his life, sweat and dreams to what we today call Aranya Forest and Sanctuary. Thanks to his exemplary work and dedication, the forest has 700 species of indigenous plants like Diospyrus Melanoxylon, Gloriosa superba, Memecylon Umbellatum and Derris Ovalifolia.

The forest is also home to six man-made water bodies and pristine ravines. Saravanan now dedicates his time to planting more trees, taking care of the forest and providing education to the local community and students about the importance of Indigenous forests. A true environmentalist at heart, Saravanan truly believes that we are just the takers of the earth and when it's time, it is our responsibility to hand over this planet to the next generation.

#### REPLACEMENT BOREWELLS POLICY



*L'avenir d'Auroville*

This is to inform the Auroville Residents that L'avenir d'Auroville/ ATDC will no longer approve new and replacement borewells in the Auroville City area. Green Belt will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. Exceptions will be made only if no other water supply possibilities are available.

Auroville has more than 100 borewells for a small number of people. Historically this has grown on a community-basis but the future growth requests a more professional and sustainable approach. Most existing borewells have capacity to serve more people than one community alone. Water needs to be shared, as no one community can claim this as its own resource. For this reason, the ATDC, will not give permission for new borewells unless it is clear that the need for water cannot be met by any other existing sources. The platform for interconnection of borewells and sharing of water, is Auroville Water Service (AWS). It is AWS who is, on behalf of the Auroville Foundation, the custodian of all the bore-wells and related water-infrastructure in Auroville and the service is established for this purpose. Water supply in Auroville is managed by this service and will be more and more so until the management of all water related infrastructure is held by this organization. As Auroville expands, it is high time to switch to this mode of management for this much needed resource.

Drilling of new borewells and replacement borewells on Auroville land must be done only with the permission of ATDC, without which it will be a violation.'

The Funds and Assets Management Committee (FAMC) issued Guidelines for Fundraising on 16 June 2023.

After receipt of feedback, an updated version of the guidelines has been prepared. Please see this version: V2 dated 5 July '23, attached below.

For the implementation of the Fundraising Guidelines by the recently formed Donation Channelling Group (a sub-group of FAMC) the following steps will be taken to start with:

**Registration of projects**

For the registration of projects for which donations are already being received or for which donations are proposed to be raised, an on-line Project Registration Form (PRF) has been designed. Project holders are requested to fill up the form and upload it on the designated portal as mentioned in the form.

**Release of funds process**

For the disbursement of donated funds to projects, an on-line Funds Release Form (FRF) has been designed. This form needs to be filled up and uploaded each time a project needs to get the funds released from Unity Fund to the project account.

**General points to be noted**

1. All registered units / activities / projects seeking donations and grants (non-GOI) have to register with the DCG before Sept 30, 2023. After this date, funds will be released for registered and approved projects and after receipt of the Funds Release Form (FRF) and Donor Information Form (DIF).

2. The Project Registration Form (PRF) includes a self-assessment checklist which is based on the Fundraising Guidelines.

3. Projects seeking donations for the first time have to register before starting the process of fundraising (contacting potential donors), including approaching the AVIs.

4. Only registered projects will be able to access the donation website(s).

5. Approvals of registrations will depend on the size and complexity of the project, but will be done mostly within seven working days of submission. Rejection will be done only after discussion with the project holders and with the FAMC.

6. There will be a threshold limit (to be determined and depending on the size of the project) below which funds can be withdrawn from Unity Fund without the need of a FRF.

7. Projects will have to submit quarterly reports to the donors and the DCG. Further disbursement tranches will not be released without this report.

8. If project holders do not comply with the fundraising guidelines and DGC processes, the DCG may stop the disbursement of the next requested tranche and may recommend appointment of new project holders to the FAMC.

9. If the totally collected donation amount of a project exceeds the project budget as prepared for the purpose of fundraising, the excess amount will be used for similar projects, in consultation with the project holder.

10. The privacy of donors will be protected and their names will be shared only for compliance with applicable statutory provisions.

11. Foreign Contributions: Section 8 of the Foreign Contributions Regulations Act (FCRA), 2010 provides for a cap on administrative expenditure of 20% of the amounts received during the year.

12. Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) contributions: Rule 7 of CSR Rules provides that the administrative overheads shall not exceed five percent of total CSR expenditure of the donor company for the financial year.

13. If donors wish to contribute to the corpus of a unit, trust or Auroville Foundation as a whole, this will need to be specified by the donor upfront and has to be approved by FAMC prior to its transfer.

14. Donations received will not be transferred to personal Auroville Financial Service accounts.

15. The unclaimed donations will stay with the Unity Fund till the end of the Financial Year. Thereafter, it shall be transferred to City Services Account.

We hope that everyone appreciates this is an essential step towards improving our accounts and inculcating transparency and accountability in our systems.

To get your feedback on the Guidelines, forms and the PRF checklist, a meeting had been arranged at 4:00pm. on Wednesday, 19 July, in SAIER Meeting Room (I Floor). Sorry due to timelines of submission & coming out of this N&N, you could not read this in time. But we had published this, along with the draft forms on the Auronet on 13 and 17 July.

**FUNDS AND ASSETS MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE****Guidelines for fundraising****Version V2: 5 July 2023****1. Background and Context**

1. Auroville has been conceived as a universal township for the manifestation of the Auroville ideals and vision as given by the Mother. Auroville Foundation has been established as an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education, Government of India by an Act of Parliament 'for the purpose with a view to making long-term arrangements for the better management and further development of Auroville in accordance with its original charter and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto'.

2. The development of Auroville as a township requires significant funding, of which a major part will come from donations, grants and contributions while the recurring expenditure of Auroville will increasingly be met from Auroville's own income-generating activities as part of the vision of Auroville being a self-supporting township.

3. These guidelines have been prepared for the purpose of having transparent and effective processes relating to fundraising and the expenditure of funds raised.

4. This version of the guidelines for fundraising supersedes earlier versions.

**2. Alignment with the Auroville ideals**

1. Projects for which fundraising is undertaken should align with the ideals of Auroville.

2. Funds for Auroville township development shall be raised and spent only for development in accordance with the Auroville Master Plan as prepared and approved under section 17[e] of the Auroville Foundation Act.

3. Fundraising activities and documentation need to outline clearly how Auroville's development will benefit from the funds proposed to be raised.

4. The inclusion of a road map for environmental, social and financial sustainability in project proposals is recommended.



### 3. Reporting

1. Donors and grantors will need to be given regular updates on the impact of their contributions.

2. Auroville units, activities and projects that make use of donated funds should have a robust donor relationship program in place to ensure that donors and grantors are regularly informed about project progress.

### 4. Transparency

1. A high degree of trustworthiness and transparency shall be maintained in project operations, including financial management, governance, and impact reporting.

2. Donors, grantors and other contributors must be able to see evidence of their contributions making the impact as envisaged in the project proposals.

3. Auroville units, activities and projects should be equipped to provide transparent and reliable accounts of the expenditure incurred with the contributions received.

4. Upon completion of a project, a comprehensive completion report of project implementation and impact shall be prepared.

### 5. Administrative costs

1. Administrative costs shall be kept as low as possible while ensuring that project accounting, monitoring and reporting are undertaken correctly.

2. In the case of certain grants and donations a maximum percentage of total project cost which is permitted as administration and other overhead costs may be provided for in the donation or grant agreement / letter or may be determined by statutory provisions. Such caps on administrative and overhead costs shall be strictly complied with.

### 6. Utilization

1. When fundraising is done for a specific project or project component, funds received shall be used only for such project or component.

2. When unspecified donations are received, utilization thereof shall be in accordance with Auroville budgets and priorities as may be set by the FAMC from time to time.

3. Donations and grants received shall be utilized in full for the Auroville projects for which the donations and grants have been raised and there shall be no retention of any part of the funds received by any of the Auroville entities through which such funds are channeled for administrative, accounting or other purposes.

### 7. Accounting and Audits

1. All Auroville donations and grants shall be received only through the official channels of Auroville Foundation.

2. Assets created with donations and grants shall be accounted for as Auroville Foundation assets in the relevant books of account of the concerned unit, activity or project.

3. No donations or contributions shall be received by Auroville Foundation or its units, activities and projects for the benefit of an individual.

4. Financial accounting and audits of projects funded with donations and grants shall be undertaken as per guidelines and manuals as issued by the Funds and Assets Management Committee (FAMC) from time to time.

5. If a donation or grant agreement provides for a project audit, such audit shall be conducted in addition to regular internal and statutory audits.

### 8. Income Tax Relief

1. Auroville Foundation is authorized to issue donation receipts with income tax relief to donors who are taxable in India under sections 80G, 35(i)(ii) and 35(i)(iii) of the Income Tax Act.

2. The applicability of each type of income tax relief will depend on the nature of the project for which funds are being raised.

### 9. Fundraising and expenditure process

1. For each project, program or activity for which donations, grants or contributions are sought, the process fundraising and project implementation trajectory will include, but may not be limited to the following steps:

2. Check the eligibility of the project proposal in the context of Auroville, its objectives and values;

3. Evaluate the project proposal in terms of costs and sustainability;

4. Determine under which section of the Income Tax Act, tax relief can be offered to the prospective donor(s) (80G, 35(1)(ii), 35(1)(iii)) for donations from within India and / or whether the project qualifies as a CSR project with reference to Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013;

5. Approve the fundraising documentation and the prospective donor / contributor target group;

### 10. Raise the funds

1. For each project, program or activity for which donations, grants or contributions are sought, the process fundraising and project implementation trajectory will include, but may not be limited to the following steps:

a. Check the eligibility of the project proposal in the context of Auroville, its objectives and values;

b. Evaluate the project proposal in terms of costs and sustainability;

c. Determine under which section of the Income Tax Act, tax relief can be offered to the prospective donor(s) (80G, 35(1)(ii), 35(1)(iii)) for donations from within India and / or whether the project qualifies as a CSR project with reference to Schedule VII of the Companies Act 2013;

d. Approve the fundraising documentation and the prospective donor / contributor target group;

e. Raise the funds;

f. In the case of foreign contributions, ensure receipt of funds through the dedicated SBI Bank account to be used for this purpose;

g. Receive the funds and issue the donation / contribution receipt with tax relief where applicable;

h. Allocate/ disburse as already determined earlier in the process;

i. Undertake the project and monitor progress;

j. Send periodical progress reports to the donor / contributor;

k. Prepare the completion report;

l. Undertake a project audit, where applicable;

m. Do a project completion review (actual vs. plan review; lessons learned etc.; feedback from donor / contributor etc.)

### Miscellaneous

1. FAMC may establish committees, subgroups or service units to implement or monitor implementation of these guidelines or parts thereof.

2. These guidelines may be updated or amended by the FAMC from time to time.
