

But the emergence of the new "high" or new level of consciousness, at any stage of evolution, is not a magical phenomenon, which abruptly alters all the preceding levels. Between the appearance of the first amoeba in the world of Life and that of the mammal, we know that it took many millions of years to overcome Matter's inertia and to "vitalize" it. Similarly, from the Neanderthal man to Plato, thousands of years were needed to overcome the resistance of the two previous levels and to "mentalize" Life, to become the complete mental man. Even today, how many human lives are truly governed by the mind rather than by vital passions? The whole task of the pioneers of evolution, at any level, is precisely to join the new height with the former depth; when high meets low, an evolutionary cycle is completed. Likewise, when the pioneer of mental evolution suddenly emerges in the Supramental, his discovery is not a feat of magic that upsets all the former laws. He does not leap to the complete supramental being any more than the Neanderthal man leapt to Plato; he must first "supramentalize" all the previous levels. Certainly, his consciousness is the meeting point of the supreme High and the supreme Low, Spirit and Matter, Positive and Negative, and his own powers are, of course, considerably increased, but they are increased only in proportion to the new resistance he has to encounter. The more evolution progresses, the deeper the layers it seeks to touch: the principle of Life barely colonized the material crust of the world; the mental principle narrowly colonized its immediate past, the mental subconscious and Life's old profligacies; the Supramental principle confronts not only the mental and vital subconscients, but an even more remote past, the physical subconscious and the inconscient. The higher one rises, the farther one is pulled down. Evolution does not move higher and higher, into an ever more heavenly heaven, but deeper and deeper. Each evolutionary cycle closes a little lower, a little nearer to the Center where the supreme High and Low, heaven and earth, will finally meet. The pioneer must therefore clear up the intermediary mental, vital, and material levels so that the two poles can actually meet. When the joining takes place, not only mentally and vitally but also materially, then the Spirit will emerge in Matter within a complete supramental being and a supramental body.

... earth shall be the Spirit's manifest home.

This clearing-up of the intermediary levels is the whole story of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother. The difficulties of accustoming the body to the supramental Agni may, ultimately, have a reason and a purpose. It may not be so much a material difficulty as a strategic one, as it were. Indeed, during that second phase, Sri Aurobindo and the Mother would realize that transformation is not just an individual problem but one involving the earth and that no individual transformation is possible (or at least complete) without some degree of collective transformation. Once collective evolution reaches a satisfactory state of progress, the present material difficulties of transformation, which seem insurmountable, will likely vanish at once. There is never any impossibility, just the question of whether the right time has come. All obstacles, whatever their nature, always ultimately prove themselves to be helpful auxiliaries of a Truth whose meaning and purpose we do not yet know. To our outer, superficial vision, the transformation seems to be exclusively a physical problem, because we always put the cart before the horse, but all difficulties are actually inner and psychological; the visible and dramatic difficulties of the body's growing accustomed to the boiling Agni may be, as we shall see, less a practical or material problem than one involving the whole terrestrial consciousness. But we are speaking in riddles; the problem Sri Aurobindo and the Mother were soon to confront will be better understood with this simple remark Sri Aurobindo once made to a disciple: *I have been dredging, dredging, dredging the mire of the subconscious... It [the supramental light] was coming down before November [1934], but afterwards all the mud arose and it stopped.* Once again, Sri Aurobindo verified, not individually this time but collectively, that pulling down too strong a light causes all the darkness below to groan and to feel violated. It should be noted that each time Sri Aurobindo and the Mother has some experience indicating a new progress in the transformation, the disciples, without their even knowing anything about it, experienced in their consciousness a period of increased difficulties or even revolts and illnesses, as if everything were grating. Now we begin to understand how things work. If a pigmy were abruptly subjected to the simple mental light of an educated man, it would probably cause in the poor fellow subterranean revolutions that would traumatize him forever and drive him insane. There is still too much jungle underneath. This present world is still full of jungles: such is the problem in a nutshell. Our mental colonization is a very thin crust over a barely dried Stone Age.

UNDERAGE DRIVING

Dear Community,

We wish that we all keep taking small steps to hold one and another in our thoughts in the spirit of Auroville.

One small step we may all take is to be conscious of how we ride within Auroville.

Riding slowly and using indicators at turns to let the elderly feel safe and also to be watchful for their safety on dug up unruly patches, avoid speeding so that the fine soil doesn't fly into the eyes of our fellow travelers, avoid high exhaust fume vehicles and minimize the use of cars to keep the carbon print in check, refrain from honking to keep the sound pollution low - - these would be some of the easily done little things for our beautiful city.

Unfortunately cases of motor accidents in Auroville have increased recently due to road construction with no street lights after dark in many of these stretches.

We apologize to all for this inconvenience and we would like to find ways to arrange temporary street lights.

We also have been informed of many minors riding around Auroville and neighboring villages on big motor bikes. We appeal to the parents to refrain from allowing their under-aged children to ride motor vehicles.

If anyone comes across such minors, please write to the Auroville Council so that we can contact the parents/guardians to take road safety measures.

We would like to inform you that the legal age for driving with a license for a gearless motorbike up to 50cc is 16 years and to ride a bike with gear or to drive a car, the legal age is 18 years. According to the Indian Motor Vehicles Act, if an underage person is found driving on the roads, their parent or guardian might have to face up to 3 years in prison and a penalty of ₹25000. Also, the driver who was driving the bike will not be able to get a driving license till they turn 25 years of age. In case of an accident, no insurance claim can be filed if the bike was driven by a minor. If caught by the police without a valid license, a ₹5000 penalty will be levied even if you are of the legal driving age. Please respect the traffic rules and regulations.

OUTCOME OF THE RA DECISION-MAKING PROCESS TO APPROVE THE FOLLOWING PROPOSALS:

- 1. EMERGENCY RAD BY THE RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY; and**
- 2. EMERGENCY FUNCTIONS TO THE WORKING COMMITTEE TO SELECT MEMBERS OF WORKING GROUPS**

Here are the results of the RAD (Residents' Assembly Decision-making), called by the petitioners, on the following topics:

1. Emergency RAD by the Residents' Assembly (tinyurl.com/RADProposal1)
2. Emergency functions to the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly to select members of working groups (tinyurl.com/RADProposal2)


A total of **409 valid votes** have been submitted online and in-person for the "Emergency RAD by the Residents' Assembly" proposal;

... and **405 valid votes** have been submitted online and in-person for the "Emergency functions to the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly to select members of working groups" proposal.

The number of participants exceeded the 10 per cent quorum required to validate the decision (236 votes). Based on data received from the Residents Service, the total adult population of our community eligible to participate in RADs (age - above 18, confirmed Aurovilians) is 2355 (as of the month of August 2023).


RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION ON THE EMERGENCY RAD BY THE RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY:

- 98% (402) participants voted in favour of the above proposal.
- 0.73% (3) participants rejected it.
- 0.98% (4) participants abstained.



RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION ON THE EMERGENCY FUNCTIONS TO THE WORKING COMMITTEE TO SELECT MEMBERS OF WORKING GROUPS:

- 93% (376) participants voted in favour of the above proposal.
- 4.7% (19) participants rejected it.
- 2.5% (10) participants abstained.



Therefore, the Residents' Assembly approved both proposals. These decisions are effective 14 August 2023.

We would like to remind you that, according to the [RAD Policy](#), "8. Responsibility for implementing decisions made through this RAD process lies with the concerned working group/s or resident/s".

AUDREY PASSED ON

Audrey Langworthy Wallace-Taylor, one of Auroville's major artists, left her body on 18 August during a family visit in USA. She had just become 90. From the moment she joined us in 2006, Audrey was an active, generous Aurovilian who persistently endeavoured to bring Art in Auroville to the forefront by her classes and exhibitions. Her son wrote, on 19 August:

Hello friends of Audrey,

Audrey, who has been visiting in the U.S., found out she had pancreatic cancer on the eve of her intended return to Auroville. She had no real symptoms except sleeping a great deal - 12-16 hours a day, sometimes more. She got very good care from a hospice organization here in Portland, Oregon, where I (her son) live. She, my wife Megan and I had a pretty joyful time. Audrey painted and drew when she could, when she was inspired. Her visit to the U.S. had started at her daughter Barbara's place in Port Townsend, Washington, which was a joyful reunion, full of laughter. She also had visits from her grandchildren during her time here.

Day before yesterday she had a fall in the middle of the night. She never really recovered. Barbara came quickly, and we were all with her when she died - which she did with the same grace with which she lived - yesterday morning. She was in no pain at the end, and seemed to be in meditation when she passed.

All along and through everything she had every intention of returning to her beloved Auroville -- her home -- and planned again and again to do that with Barbara, but it was not meant to be.

Please know that her heart was with you all.

AN ETERNAL ARTIST: AUDREY WALLACE TAYLOR

A Tribute to a fellow artist & curator

Audrey's presence in Auroville over last several years has been very inspiring and rejuvenating for many of us who have been struggling with our artistic instincts and periferal engagement with arts. Especially for me, who has been running an architectural practice as my mainstay of work life in Auroville, but have always had close interactions with many an artists through my work at Kala Kendra over last two decades.

Audrey's moving to Auroville, with her ever youthful, spirited self, that always was radiant with a smiling presence, energetic art works; Always ready to explore and experiment, her artistic endeavours were an amazing, refreshing change for someone like me. We hit off very early after she moved to Auroville and we met often in early years, over a cup of tea at the gallery, or simply casually, discussing the future of art, collective ways of working, exhibiting, contributing to public art of Auroville and just engaging with all other artists. Non judgemental, soft and straightforward was her way. Her art was of course delightful, be it her paintings of landscapes, water colors and sketches, and my favourite was her phase when she was painting cows. She was one of the few artists I have resonated my radical views on art, especially in Auroville context. This was seen prominently when I put up my controversial installation, The Sleeping Beauty, for a show RED, which Audrey curated at Kala Kendra. She supported completely and totally, also organising some artists meetings for support, when this work was removed from the Town Hall premises and vandalised during the show at the Gallery. Such was her spirit, open, fearless, strong and yet humble, friendly and all embracing, the diverse ways of art expression..

Fascinated by the forms nature, landscapes, experimenting with colors, textures and techniques, she reinvented herself, almost every few years. Her presence in almost all the exhibitions that we did together or with other artists, was a constant. Always enriching, enlivening, in midst of this complex community life of Auroville, with its diversity of views and aesthetics of arts, Audrey made her point with clarity, and invariably the discussions we had were revolving around art and life one enriches through arts. I will be always grateful for her presence at all our shows and programs, we organised at Kala Kendra, while setting up a gallery space, interactions and collaborative pieces we did for Sri Aurobindo Auditorium's side entrances with Nele & Audrey will always be my favourite. When she came up a few years ago with an idea of a huge wall mural painting she did with other artists, at the entrance wall of Bharat Nivas, The Indian Pavilion (now unfortunately gone by works of other artists, when the management changed), we worked together with a village artisan to create a sleeping calf, amidst the galactic painting she did, that was welcoming with its swirls, fineness and play of colors and textures. Her work life in Auroville as a constant support to anyone who wanted to take the first steps in the art world, by sketching, painting, learning techniques or simply just expressing, will be a unique memory to most of us.

Audrey managed to create her own niche in Auroville, after living a successful full life as an artist in the United States, even in her twilight years. Her energetic presence almost in all the art events, discussions, will be missed forever. Seldom I have seen artists fully devoted and dedicated to their art life, as I saw and knew Audrey Wallace Taylor. My years of connection with her and her work will be eternal. Though in last few years, my personal contact was very little, her presence and smile on Auroville roads, on her moped will be sorely missed. Her making India and Auroville as a playground for the experimental works, classes of art as a therapeutic practice for many young and old, was an immense contribution to make art accessible to all; She made friends with so many of us, with close contact with many of us, by her dedication, consistency and appreciation of art as a life in Auroville. She is an epitome of an ever youthful, never aging youth of Auroville, where she lived a life full of memories, creativity, beauty and pure joy of being. Audrey, Auroville will forever miss you and your beautiful presence on our roads and art shows; We will hold you close to our hearts for ever whenever we will see or learn to appreciate the beauty of daily life in Auroville, in India, be it through a memory of your abstract works of art or your sketches or your adorable paintings of the cows of villages around Auroville, or your work with the ladies and kolam. I am fortunate to have one of your sketches you gifted me with at the opening of my Dustudio, over a decade ago, that was made during your evening walks around your residence, at Creativity. Thank you for leaving us with these wonderful memories. May the Divine hold you close and may your journeys ahead are full of light, laughter and your beautiful presence with which you enriched our lives.





OPEN LETTER TO THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE AUROVILLE LIT FEST

Welcome to Auroville!

You must have come expecting to meet the community members of that innovative, special community founded by the Mother and based on the vision of Sri Aurobindo.

But:

Did you know that at present there is no freedom of speech in Auroville?

Did you know that in Auroville, the city dedicated to the ideal of “human unity”, some “foreigners” are being expelled for no other reason than expressing a different opinion than the present administration’s one?

Did you know that quite a few Aurovilians have been barred from posting their writings in the internal online forum of Auroville?

Did you know that a good number of people have been summarily dismissed from their responsibility, and their monthly allowance cut, just because they have dared contradict the position of the present administration vis-à-vis things like development or organization?

Did you know that opposing certain viewpoints of the present administration is publicly branded as opposing the government?

Did you know that foreigners who have been in India for 30 or 50 years, who are great lovers of Mother India, whose heart is full of gratitude for the country that allowed this adventure on its soil – did you know that these foreigners are spoken of as if they were anti-national?

You are writers and thinkers. For sure you are in favor of freedom of speech.

We urge you: inform yourselves, find the truth about this place and what is happening at the moment, thank you very much,

WHAT'S IN A PARK? PART 3: CONTENTS

I won't go into what buildings could be in the proposed parks as it is not my field but, as you can see from part 1, there are many buildings and functions that can occur in parks. They can be very dynamic and engaging.

But from a vegetation point of view, what's in these parks? Are they formal or wild? Or something in between? Or both? Or gradients of these based on identified natural physical aspects, such as canyons?

Are they highly managed or minimally managed? A combination of both based on what is concluded to make sense? Different parks with different themes?

The great thing about parks, from a vegetation point of view, is that many different experiments can be done and a huge amount of variety of species can be chosen which can be used to promote a theme or idea. For example, despite most highly flowering trees not really providing good shade, they can be incorporated into the landscape in a flower themed area, another area could portrait the different fruit trees and varieties within those trees (such as different types of mangos). You could even have a few mango trees with a [whole variety of mangoes](#) growing on them. It is really a case of being imaginative.

Despite a good overall annual rainfall, there is usually a period of about six months of drought every year. This should be considered with vegetation choices even if we recycle our "wastewater".

Personally, I would say that there should be formal areas maintained as lawns with a tree here and a tree there but, the current recycled wastewater stinks and is unhygienic so such a setting should be restricted to a minimum due to our lack of water, which is necessary for this. Having gradients of formal > less formal > wild/natural is probably more realistic.

I think most people think the native, wild, vegetation in the area is low, thorny, and essentially not very inviting. Actually, it can provide good shade and be open/accessible underneath; it is possible that we have lost the plant species that would have previously grown in the shade of more established areas and that would have rendered it harder to move through. As is it, many areas can be both wild and accessible, once there is enough shade to reduce the number of plants on the ground that could otherwise survive (when there was still enough sunlight reaching the lower areas).




Figure 1 Example of a wild area that is still very accessible and is not even managed to be park-like.

A rather long amount of time (20 years) is required for this vegetation to grow into something rewarding (as most things, no?). But why not use fast growing trees instead? Well, most of those are short lived or need a lot of water, or don't do well in storms, or lose their leaves in the summer or attract pests or don't support the local ecology or some, or all, of the above. There are a few trees that break the trend of course, as nature is not black and white, but there are not many. In many cases, plants considered alien invasive species have been used in Auroville as they were the most adapted to such harsh growing conditions based on what was at hand/understood at the time.

They grew fast and improved growing conditions for native species to be able to survive. Now we have a larger choice of species to choose from because of all the work and research that has been done here over the last 30+ years. So, do we need to get rid of those “alien invasive species”? Not, necessarily. Many will die out or be contained when there is more shade, due to the local vegetation growing beneath and eventually growing above, as is already happening throughout. Does a certain management of them need to occur? Of course. But eradication would be a waste of resources as they are currently resources themselves, in many ways: e.g., timber, fodder, biomass, shade.

Paths can occur in certain wild areas also and such areas are mainly covered (a good example of a wild area that is very accessible is between Gaia and Grace/Surrender. Bliss used to be a good example, unfortunately now it is fragmented and the paths blocked by the “development” of the Crown).

To show an example of what local vegetation can look like after 20+ years and the requirements to get there and to maintain, I will be conducting a walk on **Sunday, the 27th of August, at 4pm** in [Espace](#). Maybe see you there.

AWAKENING SPIRIT

NOW WE HAVE TO GO ON

It has to be *worked out*, as they say, realized in every detail, but the change IS DONE—the change is done.

Which means that the material conditions, which were elaborated by the mind, FIXED by it (*Mother clenches her fist tight*), and which appeared so inescapable, to such a point that those who had a living experience of the higher worlds thought one had to flee this world, abandon this material world if one really wanted to live in the Truth (that's the cause of all those theories and beliefs), now things are no longer like that. Now things are no longer like that. The physical is CAPABLE of receiving the higher Light, the Truth, the true Consciousness, and of man-i-fest-ing it.

It's not easy, it calls for endurance and will, but a day will come when it will be quite natural. It's only just the open door—that's all, now we have to go on.

(*silence*)

Naturally, what was established hangs on tight and defends itself desperately. That's the cause of this whole trouble (*swarming gesture in the earth atmosphere*)—but it has lost the battle. It's over. It's over.

(*silence*)

It has taken this Consciousness... a little more than a year to win this Victory. Naturally, as yet it's visible only to those who have the inner vision, but... its done.

(long silence)

That was the work Sri Aurobindo had given me, that was it. Now I understand.

But it's as if from every side—every side—those mental forces, mental powers were rising in protest, violent in their protest, so as to impose their old laws: "But things have always been this way!..." But it's over. They won't always be this way, that's all."

You bet! Thrilling, if we can make it work and arrive, at the end, together, to a new Hope. A new Earth. Auroville!



Restorative Yin & Yoga Nidra: Deep Relaxation for Body & Mind - with Emma **Friday, 25 August - 9:30am – 12:00pm**

The workshop will be divided into two parts. The first one will include theory and practice, where we will journey through conscious relaxation, exploring a contemplative Yin Yoga practice to restore the natural condition of the deep tissues in the body while releasing tension in the physical, energetic, and mental layers. Master Class-Sivananda Yoga - with Mani **Saturday, 26 August - 9:30am – 12:00pm**

The workshop starts with basic breathing and pranayama practices followed by sun salutations and 12 classical hatha yoga poses given by Swami Sivananda and Swami Vishnu Devananda. The asana sequence is framed in such a way that the entire spine is massaged and rejuvenated with free flow of prana starting from cervical, thoracic, lumbar to sacrum. Sufficient relaxation is given between the asanas to balance and maintain the effort and relaxation pattern of the nervous system. This rhythmic alternation between effort and the relaxation pattern of the nervous system will prepare you automatically for the final relaxation more easily and effectively. Finally, the workshop concludes with proper guided relaxation.

The Healing Power of Gayatri Mantra - with Sabrina **Saturday, 2 September- 9:30am – 12:00pm**

In this workshop, Sabrina will share with you a very old and powerful tantric healing technique, based on the japa (repetition) of Gayatri Mantra. 34 YEARS OF EXISTENCE OF THE AUROVILLE EARTH INSTITUTE - OPEN HOUSE 31ST AUGUST

The Auroville Earth Institute (AVEI) will complete its 34 years of existence next **Thursday, 31st August 2023**. This date is symbolic, as it corresponds to the date when Satprem Maïni joined Auroville, on 31st August 1989, to found AVEI and to build Auroville. AVEI was officially registered later as a sub unit of the Auroville Building Centre.

Despite the lies, false allegations and mean attacks of the illegitimate WC and illegitimate FAMC, Satprem goes on managing remotely AVEI –dedicated to its [mission and activities](#), to train people, research and propose low carbon, cost effective and appropriate earth technologies to build Auroville and worldwide. 34 years of endeavour and hard work from a [dedicated team](#), can be summarized as follow.

- Trained more than 14,000 people from 94 Nations (10,250 Indians and 3,848 foreigners). Some of these Indian trainees having been awarded national and international prizes for their works inspired by their time here.
- Representation for the [UNESCO Chair](#) "Earthen Architecture, Constructive Cultures and Sustainable Development": Satprem was first granted the representation for India in 2000, which was extended in 2005 to Asia.
- Designed a wide range of equipment to build with earth "Auram", manufactured and sold by Aureka all over the world.
- [Recipient of 15 awards](#): 4 international awards and 11 Indian Awards.
- Finalist for the World Habitat Award 2000 and twice finalist of the Aga Khan Award for Architecture in 1992 and 2007.
- Satprem has worked in 39 countries to transfer his knowledge and promote earthen architecture.
- Satprem has brought back to AVEI more than 1.5 Crores Rs. from his works abroad.
- Created invaluable assets in Auroville with the construction of the [Visitors Centre](#) , [Vikas](#), [Mirramukhi School](#) (presently Deepanam), [Realization](#), AVEI premises and many other small projects.
- [Assistance with training courses and building demonstration houses in Gujarat](#) for the rehabilitation after the 2001 earthquake, which resulted in more than 3000 houses built totalizing more than 1 million m2.

- [Developed a technology for earthquake resistance](#) with compressed stabilized earth blocks (CSEB), which have been approved by 3 governments.
- Built two temples for Lord Shiva: [Dhyanalinga Temple for Sadhguru/ Isha Foundation](#) near Coimbatore and [Sri Karneshwar Nataraja Temple](#) near Auroville.
- AVEI has published [many articles and papers](#) and its works were features in many publications all over the world, the last one being mentioned on page 46 of the compendium [Prayaas Se Prabhaav Tak](#), released at COP 27 at Cairo, Egypt by the Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.

On **31st August**, AVEI will offer an **open house**, where everyone is welcome to see videos, visit our premises and exhibitions, and have some practical hands on. Refreshments and biscuits will be offered.

Unfortunately, Satprem will not be here that day, as he is in a kind of exile, hopefully not as long as the 14 years that Rama spend in the forest.

A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

MATRIMANDIR TREE REMOVAL



The RA TDC [shared a report](#) on the recent Matrimandir (MM) excavation and tree cutting. Despite the test phase of the MM lake still being incomplete, MM executives are quickly moving forward with a second segment of the lake. This means that “various factors such as the viability and impact the lake is likely to have on the environment and ecology” remain unclear. The report shows that the excavation for the second phase is taking place over approximately 4 acres of land and endangers around 125 trees including “a large number of very old Neem trees”. Pictures included in the report show that the excavation has already removed numerous trees and many more are at risk.

These actions, the report states, go against the NGT judgement as well as straying from the recent practice whereby “the [Matrimandir] gardens have been designed through collaborative community participation”.

Narad, who was entrusted by the Mother with the task of building the MM gardens, recently resigned from his work in the MM gardens due to the planned removal of Neem Trees, and the conduct of the MM executives team. He [shared a testimony](#) stating “My dear friend and coworker told me that [a MM executive] had said that they will dig out the very old 50 to 60 year old Neem trees that truly have a presence in them and that [they] and the other executives will tell Aurovilians that they tried to transplant the trees but they died (...) I cannot accept this falsehood and therefore have resigned.”

15TH AUGUST CELEBRATIONS



On 15th August 2023, for Sri Aurobindo’s 151st birth anniversary, a day-long program of events was held in Auroville. This included the usual dawn fire at Matrimandir Amphitheater, which was less attended than usual according to testimonies and [a video posted by Manohar](#).

The AVFO and affiliated groups organised several events to mark both India’s independence as well as Sri Aurobindo’s birthday. Spiritual leader Sri M was invited to hold [a morning meditation at the Town Hall](#) and later participated in [a ‘Unity walk’ along the Crown](#).

An event was also held at Bharat Nivas to celebrate India's Independence day, and the Indian flag was displayed on a [recently installed](#) flagpole in front of Town Hall.

In the afternoon of the 15th, several events were organised by community members with the help of volunteers. Community activities and children's activities - such as storytelling and crafts - were offered as well as the premiers of the first part of Olivier Barot's new movie, [Sri Aurobindo & the Earth's Future](#). Later, the community gathered near the Inuksuk in the International Zone, around a 10 meter-wide flower mandala of Sri Aurobindo's symbol with candles lit by children. In the evening there was a bonfire, readings of Sri Aurobindo's words in English and Tamil, live music and a light dinner. The afternoon and evening community event was attended by approximately 700 residents.

DREAMCATCHING RESTARTS

The Dreamweavers Core Team held a community meeting on Saturday 29th July 2023. You can watch [the recording of the meeting here](#). They are restarting Dreamcatching sessions "to explore a more unifying action-oriented planning process for the development of Auroville." Dreamcatching is a form of collective imagining that actively seeks to allow creativity to flow from a higher space. The sessions will be from 6-8am on Mondays. OUTCOME OF TWO RECENT RADS

On 14th August, the RAS [announced](#) the results of the two recent RADs. The first RAD aimed at providing the Residents' Assembly with powers to call for emergency RADs, upon the request of 300 residents (read the full proposal [here](#)). 409 residents participated in this vote, and the proposal was approved by 402 voters (98%).

The second RAD aimed at granting the RA WCom with emergency powers to appoint interim members to other working groups (read the full proposal [here](#)). 405 residents participated in this vote, and the proposal was approved by 376 voters (93%).

On 21st August, the RA WCom sent a [massbulletin](#) in which they clarified that they "equate the term 'Emergency Functions' at this time to be 'Crisis Management Functions', even if there is no specific emergency at any given moment". They also mentioned that they "are in the process of reaching out to people about being appointed as interim members of the RA FAMC", which has been functioning with limited membership over the past months. "The time frame of these interim appointments could be anywhere from 2 or 3 months (till the next selection process tentatively planned for end of Sept.) to 18 months, as specified in the RAD proposal." They added: "However, we would like to make it clear that these interim appointments are not intended to replace or reduce the importance of the Selection Process and the role of the Residents' Assembly as a whole in selecting members for its working groups. The function of the RA Working Committee appointing people to working groups will be used as a stop gap measure only. (...) When the next Selection Process is announced by the Auroville Council and RAS, we urge residents to come forward and offer their time and energy as members of working groups".

VISIT OF THE HON'BLE PRESIDENT OF INDIA

The Hon'ble President of India, Ms. Droupadi Murmu, visited Auroville on 8th August 2023. The program of the visit was shared on 3rd August by the AVFO 'WCom'. Access passes were required to attend the Hon'ble Presidents' speech at the Bharat Nivas Auditorium.

On 7th August at 22:16pm, an [email](#) was sent at very short notice to all those who had registered, asking them to pick up their passes before midnight the same day, which made it impossible for some to attend the event.

The Hon'ble President gave [a speech](#) to Aurovilians and those present, preceded by India's national anthem and the Tamil Thai Valthu (the state song of Tamil Nadu). Among other elements, the Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, expressed gratitude for the teachings and philosophy of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother, emphasizing their impact on seekers worldwide.

Part of the programme also included a visit by the President to the Matrimandir and its gardens, and for the occasion she was invited to plant a tree in the Matrimandir gardens, next to the amphitheater, accompanied by a [signboard](#). It is the first time a public personality's name is officially displayed within Matrimandir premises for a long-lasting homage.

CIRCULAR FROM MRS K SWARNAMBIKA

On 28th July 2023, a [notice](#) was posted on several websites announcing that Mrs K Swarnambika, IPS, had been appointed by the Ministry of Home Affairs at a "DS/Director level" at the AVFO. No information has been shared by the AVFO as to the nature of Mrs Swarnambika's new role. On 11th August 2023, just prior to the 15th August birth anniversary of Sri Aurobindo and the Indian Independence day, a [circular](#) from Mrs Swarnambika was sent to the community via the AVFO massbulletin service. The notice gave Aurovilians an 'action plan' to celebrate Independence Day - hoisting the National flag, sharing selfies with the flag and changing their profile pictures on social media to include it. Information was also given about a program of events hosted by the AVFO 'WCom' at Bharat Nivas. (See above paragraph on 15th August celebrations).

AUROVILLE NEWS PODCAST & AUROVILLE.MEDIA WEBSITE

The Auroville Media Liaison Service (AMLS), an activity approved by the RA WCom, [announced](#) the launch of a new audio series called "Auroville News Podcast" on 6th August. The first episode of this podcast series, which delves into the latest happenings in Auroville, is available on [this webpage](#) as well as on [Spotify](#), [Apple Podcasts](#), and [YouTube](#).

Additionally, on 14th August, AMLS [announced](#) that their website [www.auroville.media](#) had been updated and refreshed. They highlighted their [Summary of the current crisis](#) webpage, and encouraged residents to share it with their friends and contacts, in India and world-wide. They also added that "information-sharing and media requires much work", inviting those who feel inspired to help to write to [media@auroville.services](#).

LAND MATTERS - REPORT

A report in recent circulation claims that plots of land in Forecomers are being touted for exchange by the AVFO and their 'Land Board'. Land on the Tindivanam Highway (Murthy's stone carving workshop) and in Djaima have already been exchanged. You can read the full report, which includes other information about land matters in and around Auroville, [here](#).

TREE CUTTING IS ONGOING

Tree cutting along different sections of the Crown is ongoing despite the NGT judgement. This tree cutting, reportedly done by the AVFO 'Land Board' at the request of the Secretary, has over the last few days been carried out at irregular timings, e.g. on Sunday mornings or after dark. Many areas along the planned Crown (such as the area [in front of the Unity Pavilion](#), often used for parking)

are slowly losing their shade. According to [an RA TDC report](#), dated 18th August, these are “severe violations of the NGT judgement” which included protected trees such as palmyras. This ‘work’, being done in contradiction to both the NGT judgement and the RA decision to pause development on the Crown, is being carefully documented by a group of residents.

TOURIST/VIP ACCESS ROAD

Auroville farmers [shared](#) an “expression of concern” with the AVFO ‘FAMC’, ‘Farm Service’ and the Secretary, regarding the planned relocation of 3 Auroville farms in order to accommodate a new VIP access road. An [image](#) shared recently shows that the proposed road would go straight through Buddha Garden, Shambala & Siddhartha Farms. The road, the additional parking lot and convenience facilities that are planned would, according to the farmers’ statement, “obliterate” the 3 farms.

The farmers’ expressed that “This will certainly be a loss for Auroville's agricultural sustainability and productivity ... [this] appears to us to be in direct contradiction to other statements you have made about wanting to increase agricultural production in

Auroville”. The statement emphasised that the farmers’ group did not intend to oppose the plan, but that they urge a proper plan in place for the relocation of the 3 farms prior to the road being built - identifying viable land with access and providing sufficient funds for relocation, for facilities such as accommodation, borewells and storerooms.

A letter from the RA TDC to the Special Officer of the AVFO ‘Land Board’ raised several points regarding the proposed Tourist/VIP access road. They pointed out that this road is not in any version of the gazetted Master Plan that the Secretary claims to be following in order to build the City, and that any road construction would go against the NGT verdict. In recent weeks, the Auroville Dog Shelter received notice that part of the Dog Shelter would also be destroyed to make way for this road. The action was narrowly prevented after the intervention of the Dog Shelter team who appealed strongly to outside agencies.

UPDATE ON KALABHUMI BOREWELL

At the beginning of July 2023, the CPWD surveyor and supervisor visited Kalabhumi and discussed the trajectory of the road with a resident. As per their measurements, the road and channel are actually located 20-30 centimetres away from the borewell, and therefore it could be spared, as long as the work is executed with care and caution.

On July 28th 2023, allegedly upon the request of the Crown Road contractor SP&Co, a JCB was sent to Kalabhumi again, where they continued digging and broke the pipe. After breaking it, they continued digging towards the borewell, stopping around one metre before the well. In the meantime a group of Aurovilians gathered and prevented further destruction. When the JCB left, as water services were not replying to requests for help repairing the pipe, the residents went to get equipment to fix the broken pipe themselves, enabling a temporary connection of the borewell to the Kalabhumi water tank.

On August 2nd, two CPWD site supervisors met with a Kalabhumi resident and discussed possible non-destructive solutions. They stated that the borewell would remain untouched and appeared to understand that it would be easier for them to lay an infrastructure channel under the road to allow the Kalabhumi pipeline and cables to reach the community side. They said that they would take this information back to the AVFO, after which they would work on plans and revert back to the Kalabhumi community. No news has been received since then, and for the moment it appears that the threat to the borewell has been averted.
