

HOUSE OF MOTHER'S AGENDA

(continued from last week)

The second phase of the work of transformation thus drew to a close. After working for fourteen years, from 1926 to 1940, in an individual, concentrated manner, with a handful of carefully chosen disciples, Sri Aurobindo and the Mother had come up against a wall. The moment the supramental light approached the earth to join with the same light involved in Matter, torrents of mud would rise up from the collective subconscient and drown everything. To help humanity out, Sri Aurobindo remarked, it was not enough for an individual, however great, to achieve an ultimate solution individually, [because] even when the Light is ready to descend it cannot come to stay till the lower plane is also ready to bear the pressure of the Descent. It is very significant that the culmination of the second phase of the work of transformation should coincide with the outbreak of the Second World War. When the pressure of the Light descends into one human body, the body of the world, too, begins to glow. What do we really know of the good of the world, or of its evil?

Confronted with that collective resistance, Sri Aurobindo and the Mother hesitated momentarily, wondering whether they should not cut themselves off from the rest of the world, forge ahead alone with just a few disciples, effect the transformation, then return to the collective work by communicating to the rest of the earth the transformation accomplished (or partially accomplished) in themselves. (This same idea has impelled many spiritual, occult, or chivalrous groups in the past to select a secret place far away from the rest of the world, sheltered from the contamination of collective vibrations, to do their work.) But they soon realized that this was an illusion and that afterward the gap or the atmospheric gulf,3 as Sri Aurobindo would put it, between the new accomplishment and the old world would be too great to be bridged. Furthermore, what is the point of an individual success if it is not communicable to the rest of the world? If a supramental being suddenly appeared on earth, no one would even see him! Our eyes must first be unsealed to another way of life. If you advance on the path that is open in front of you, said the Mother, without patiently waiting for the rest of creation, that is, if you achieve alone something very close to the Truth as compared to the present state of the world - what will happen? The whole is thrown off balance; not only the harmony but the equilibrium of the whole will be upset, because a certain part of the creation will not be able to follow. And instead of a full realization of the Divine, you will have a small, local, infinitesimal realization, and nothing of the goal will be achieved. Moreover, emphasized the Mother, if you want to do the work in a solitary way, you absolutely cannot do it in a total way, because every physical being, however complete he may be, even if he is of an altogether superior nature, even if he was made for an altogether special Work, is only partial and limited. He embodies only one truth, one law in the world - it may be a very complex law, but it is still only one law - and the full transformation cannot be realized through him alone, through one body.... Alone, you can attain your own perfection, become infinite and perfect in your consciousness. Inner realization knows no limits. But outer realization, on the contrary, is necessarily limited, and a minimum number of physical persons are necessary in order to achieve a general action.

In 1940, after fourteen years of individual concentration, Sri Aurobindo and the Mother opened the doors of their ashram. The third phase of the transformation began, a phase that has expanded today to a world scale.



THIRD PHASE - THE ASHRAM

In India an "ashram" is traditionally a spiritual or religious community whose members are gathered around a Master and who have renounced the world to devote themselves to meditation, concentration, and yogic practices in order to attain "liberation." As we might imagine, though, Sri Aurobindo's Ashram had little to do with this particular definition, except for the fact that the disciples were indeed gathered around Sri Aurobindo and the Mother. It was not an exotic kind of monastery, and still less a place for refuge and peace; it was more like a forge: This Ashram has been created... not for the renunciation of the world but as a centre and a field of practice for the evolution of another kind and form of life. Even before his arrest in Bengal, at a time when he was not even remotely dreaming of founding an ashram, Sri Aurobindo had said: The spiritual life finds its most potent expression in the man who lives the ordinary life of men in the strength of the Yoga.... It is by such a union of the inner life and the outer that mankind will eventually be lifted up and become mighty and divine. Hence, Sri Aurobindo wanted his Ashram to be fully involved in everyday life, right in the midst of the world-at-large, since that is where the transformation had to take place, and not upon some Himalayan peak. Except for the main building, where the Mother lived and where Sri Aurobindo's monument is located. the 1,200-odd disciples of all nationalities and all social classes (men, women and four to five hundred children) were scattered throughout the city of Pondicherry in more than three hundred different houses. There were no protective walls in the Ashram. except for one's own inner light; the bustle of the bazaar was just next door.

FROM THE RA TDC



RA TDC MEETING WITH MATRIMANDIR EXECUTIVES

On August 21st, 2023, the RA TDC met with the Matrimandir (MM) executives.

Please find below some points that were addressed during the meeting:

1.Polarisation

The meeting started with a short discussion on the perceived polarisation that Auroville is going through. The RA TDC explained that there is no polarisation about the development of the city itself, as most Aurovilians are here to build the city the Earth needs. What is being questioned is the method: the topdown authoritative approach being implemented since December 2021 is the source of disagreement and polarisation. The RA TDC, as well as numerous community members, believe that only a holistic approach can pave a sustainable road to human unity.

2. GB, IAC and RA to work in mutuality

As is stated in the Auroville Foundation Act (AFA), and reiterated in the judgement dated August 12th, 2022, the GB, IAC and RA should work in mutuality.

As per the AFA, the RA has the right to constitute committees, so they regularly select community representatives in various fields, such as the RA TDC. The RA TDC was selected in June 2022 in accordance with the procedure specified in the various legally valid Standing Orders and the Auroville Act. This selection was communicated to the Governing Board vide email dated 28th June 2022. The TDC selected by the RA does not cease to exist just because of the failure of the Governing Board to take cognisance of it.

The AFA also states that the GB has the right to constitute committees too, but that any non-GB members within these committees shall not have the right to vote on decisions. Therefore, it can be said that the ATDC is currently not validly constituted, as it consists solely of non-GB members.

3. NGT judgement and legal repercussions

Reminder: all areas in Auroville fall under the ruling of NGT judgement, which states that no further construction is to be started in any area of the project (except the Crown where there are no trees) until proper township plans have been prepared, and prior Environmental Clearance has been granted. Hence, regard of anv activity in to cutting trees construction/development is in violation of the NGT judgement of 28.04.2022, reiterated by the hon'ble NGT on 14.03.2023.

The RA TDC has informed MM executives of the same vide email, as a reminder, since the Matrimandir area - aka the Soul of Auroville - is undoubtedly a part of the Auroville project.

4. Environmental Clearance As mentioned in the point above, proper township plans need to be prepared and prior Environmental Clearance (EC) needs to be granted before any further construction. The procedure to gain EC involves an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) which is extensively described in the EIA Notification 2006, including non-negligible aspects in a project like the MM lake, such as vegetation, topography, and seawater processing:

a) Vegetation: trees being cut

EIAN extract: "Will the construction involve extensive clearing or modification of vegetation? (Provide a detailed account of the trees & vegetation affected by the project)"

b) Topography: adding a sizeable water body

EIAN extract: "Construction, operation or decommissioning of the Project involving actions, which will cause physical changes in the locality (topography, land use, changes in water bodies, etc.)

- · "Impoundment, damming, culverting, realignment or other changes to the hydrology of watercourses"
- "Changes in water bodies or the land surface affecting drainage or run-off"

c) Seawater processing: building a desalination plant EIAN extract: "Risks of contamination of land or water from releases of pollutants into the ground or into sewers, surface waters, groundwater, coastal waters or the sea"

Desalination is a highly energy-intensive process that is often powered with fossil fuels, with emissions that contribute to global warming. A major issue of desalination is the coproduced waste called 'brine' which has a high salinity along with chemical residuals and is discharged into the marine environment. This often harms the marine environment, causing fish to migrate while enhancing the presence of algae, nematods and tiny molluscus. Sometimes, micro-elements and toxic materials appear in the discharged brine. No matter how much attention is attributed to minimising the negative impact, a desalination plant cannot - by any stretch of the imagination - be considered "eco-friendly" at this time.

5. MM Test Pond update

History: An agreement was reached around 2018 after numerous discussions with the then TDC and the Water Group. wherein the test pond would be built and then tests would be run after a certain amount of time (3-4 years) to check the quality, performance, and reliability of the construction. The aforementioned tests would include the characteristics of the water (monitoring of temperature, chemical composition, evaporation, oxygen levels), resistivity of the materials to the pressure (cement blocks and liner), etc. This in turn would allow for adjustments and improvements to be made, as there are numerous variables that could affect this development, especially in view of the sheer size of this project.

Update: The RA TDC raised these points as well as other technical details such as water security (only rainwater run-off used, no groundwater), trees surrounding the lake, possibility of islets or peninsulas. The MM executives described their vision and expounded their views on most of the points raised, which was appreciated by the RA TDC. The MM executives shared that the aforementioned tests are being run periodically to see the evolution of this data, despite the fact that the test pond is actually not even finished yet. Nevertheless, their plan is to continue to expand, without waiting for the completion of the test pond and the associated test results.

6. Auroville: its role and "raison d'être"

The beginning of the meeting was quite bumpy, when judgement was passed on issues such as Aurovilians forgetting why they are here, the status or worthiness of individuals within Auroville, or the perceived absence of community within Auroville. Not only does this go against the RA TDC's values, it also was not the right platform for this type of discussion, as the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the MM lake. Following a reminder to not fall into stories and judgements, the meeting followed a relatively peaceful course.

However, the RA TDC left the meeting feeling deeply unsettled by the manner in which the MM executives stated that they would not be consulting with the community. The MM project just like any other project carried by an Aurovilian individual, unit or service - is representative of Auroville for the world at large, and therefore concerns our entire community.

ACCESSIBLE AUROVILLE PUBLIC BUS SERVICE

Dear All

Accessible Auroville Public Bus service started in 2016 with help of an Italian donor, who contributed to purchase a public bus to Auroville. Since 2016, we have received good support from Aurovilians, guests and all. The service self-sustained by collecting contributions from the bus users to cover the running expenditures. We were supported by the AVI Canada to cover the yearly maintenances such as, Insurance, Fitness Certificate, Yearly Maintenance of the vehicle. Since the covid-19, the users of the bus have reduced and it became hard to cover the running cost of the bus. Therefore, we often request help from the community to support. We tried different options to increase the bus users but still no progress. Only during the season, the bus is filled with people. So, it shows that most of the aurovilians are willing to use the individual vehicles to visit Pondicherry, other than using the public transport.

We do not get any financial support from the BCC for our monthly running cost or yearly maintenance. We tried a few times with BCC to support the public transport in Auroville to avoid an increase of individual transports, taxis, etc,. It was never accepted by the BCC since 2016.

Therefore, we invite Aurovilians, New Comers, Volunteers and Unit workers from Pondicherry to use this service to support the public transport in Auroville. While increasing the number of users, the service will sustain itself without any financial crisis. So far, the service could function because the financial gaps were generously covered by advances given by Auroville Vehicle Service, but it cannot continue. Let us join together to reduce the carbon footprint and the traffic around us.

By supporting public transport, you could have a safe Journey, reduce the carbon footprint and save money.

Last week, we took an advance of a lakh rupees to cover the annual maintenance of the bus (Repainting the vehicle, renewal of bus insurance, mechanical work, tyres replacement etc,.). We need to pay back this amount to Auroville Financial service in a month. Therefore, we kindly request you to contribute small or big to cover the loan amount.

Our current method embraces the values of self motivation and encourages proactive responses, providing our members the opportunity to explore self discipline and growth, while retaining a macro perspective of our society and the world.

So how can you help, and why?

We currently receive a budget from BCC (4 maintenances+5,000rs budget), however it only covers approximately one third of our monthly expenses.

Our hope is that our matching donation campaign can collect enough money for these maintenances, so that YouthLink can continue to offer free programs.

We also believe that YouthLink currently serves a secondary purpose of being an informal training centre, for the organisation produces youth that are well connected within Auroville, have a strong understanding of Auroville's structures (both social as well as organisational), and are proactive and vibrant, both as individuals and in teams.

And we believe that we can still do more. Every day there are interesting offers and opportunities of collaboration that find us from inside and outside Auroville, as well as ideas from our team. We currently find ourselves not having the time and space to fully concentrate on all the avenues we could explore, hence we are also looking to expand the team in the near future, moving into avenues such as intensive courses and vocational training.



And so here we are in this Great Battlefield, In the midst preparing the psychophysical base From which the new species That will replace the corrupted reign Of the transitional humans, The Supramental being, Will emerge. PREPARING THE BASE

The importance of the descent of the Supramental Consciousness-Force and Light, although partial, on 29 February 1956¹, cannot be simply brushed aside.

"You don't understand the way of my working. You can as well say, "You have the Supramental force, why don't you use it and finish all this muddle?" But it is not like this that the work can be done. The world is not ready for the Supramental force and if it is used without preparing the base, things will shatter completely. I have to prepare the base and then bring down the force." (Excerpt from Words of the Mother - I, Collected Works of the Mother, Vol 13)²

The Supramental Avatars Sri Aurobindo and the Mother of course prepared the base. That is why 1956, 1969 and 1972 happened and the Supramental evolution is happening, unstoppably continuing towards a Life Divine on Earth. And for their torchbearers the individual psychophysical base must also, still, most importantly be prepared. Thus the first two requirements of Integral Yoga, Psychicisation and Spiritualisation, and then Supramentalisation, prior to the Divine Manifestation of the new species the Supramental being in the coming near future.

But it is not necessary to go through what the Avatars went through, having the Grace of progressing through the experiences of others. One can't anyway, that is why there are Avatars for that special role and purpose of ushering in a New Age. A most difficult avataric endeavour as revealed in Sri Aurobindo's and the Mother's comprehensive writings, also from their very close disciples from whom the Mother's Agenda³ and subsequent revelatory compilations such as Mother or the Mutation of Death⁴ have arisen.

For the torchbearers, the best choice is to follow and practice the easiest and most joyful path advised by the Avatars Sri Aurobindo and the Mother themselves, which is the Sunlit Path of Surrender, of Bhakti to the Supreme Divine, so that one becomes a conscious, consenting, willing instrument, through whom the Divine Mother Shakti Herself does the Sadhana according to each one's unique role.

Thus in Auroville we have these as Core Ideals and guidance straight from the Divine Mother Herself:

One then goes beyond the mere mental gymnastics when either conducting or participating in a Satsang.

"In the context of yogic philosophy and practice, the Sanskrit word "Satsang" (सत्सङ्ग) can be broken down into two components: "Sat" and "Sang."

- Sat (सत्): This term generally translates to "truth" or "reality." It refers to that which is eternal, unchanging, and real in the highest sense.
- Sang (सङ्ग): This term translates to "association" or "company." It refers to being in the presence of, associating with, or gathering with others.

When combined, "Satsang" can be translated as "association with the truth" or "gathering in the company of the truth." In the context of a collective yogic practice, Satsang typically refers to a gathering or assembly of individuals who come together to engage in activities that promote spiritual growth, self-discovery, and the pursuit of truth or enlightenment. Satsang can include various practices such as:

- Spiritual Discourses: Often, a knowledgeable teacher or guru leads the gathering by sharing teachings, insights, and wisdom from yogic philosophy, scriptures, and other spiritual texts
- Chanting and Singing: Participants may engage in the singing of devotional songs, mantras, and chants. This can create a meditative and uplifting atmosphere.

- Meditation: Guided or silent meditation sessions might be part of a Satsang, allowing participants to go inward and cultivate a deeper connection to their inner selves.
- Question and Answer Sessions: Attendees may have the opportunity to ask questions related to their spiritual practice, philosophy, and personal growth.
- Sharing Experiences: People might share their personal experiences, insights, and challenges on their spiritual journey, fostering a sense of community and mutual support.
- Service and Acts of Kindness: Satsang can extend beyond formal gatherings to include acts of service or seva, where participants engage in selfless actions to benefit others.

The essence of Satsang lies in creating an environment where individuals can come together to explore and deepen their understanding of spiritual truths, elevate their consciousness, and support one another on their paths toward self-realization and enlightenment. It emphasizes the importance of surrounding oneself with positive influences and like-minded seekers who are dedicated to inner growth and self-discovery."

"La Sierra Nevada in Northern Colombia is the highest snowcapped mountain in the Tropics that rises up to 5700m high in 50 kms from the Caribbean coastal city of Santa Marta. There, live 4 indigenous groups that are of prehispanic origin, the Kogis, The Arhuacos, the Wiwas and the Kankuamos. First time I heard about the Arhuacos was in 2011 when a Colombian friend took me to the Sierra Nevada in hope of visiting their territory. Unfortunately, they wouldn't allow any tourists or guests to visit their sacred land, the Heart of the world, as they call it. It's only in 2016 that finally I managed to get an invitation to stay one day, one night with them. From then on started an exchange when we realised that their spiritual healing based on their tradition had the same principles of those of Ayurveda and the flora had many similarities with the one described in the ayurvedic scriptures or in the Siddha pharmacopeia. Since then, I have been going regularly to learn their tradition, their spiritual healing practice, their community organisation, their sense of individuality within the community, learning the wisdom from the Mamos of the community (the spiritual leaders). I came back recently from there and speaking with a few AV friends they suggested that I do a little presentation on them, their purpose in life and what we are implementing health-wise using food, vegetables and aromatic herbs as natural medicine... A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

MATRIMANDIR LAKE EXCAVATION CONTINUES





The second segment of the Matrimandir (MM) Lake continues to be excavated, uprooting all but one of the mature Neem trees in the area. The second segment is around 2.5 times the size of the test segment. Large quantities of earth have been removed to lower the ground level by 4-5 meters. According to an RA TDC report, around 125 trees are threatened by the work which is a violation of the NGT judgement stating that no further construction is to be started in any area of Auroville. Earlier this month, Narad - who was given the task of building the MM gardens by the Mother - resigned from his work in protest against the current actions of the MM executive team.

Apart from the damage to the flora and fauna of the MM gardens, questions regarding hastily pushing ahead with the next section of the lake have been raised by Jan Imhoff, the engineer in charge of the design and testing of the MM lake. In May 2023, Jan wrote an open letter to the MM executives questioning their decision to start the excavation of the second section before the test section had been finished and evaluated. He wrote that "There is no merit in barging ahead with the next sections of the lake in order to finish the project quickly. We have to adhere to the plan as agreed upon 3 years ago and complete the first section, thoroughly test it and show that it performs well... Failing to do so will create a gigantic maintenance nightmare and lead to a monumental waste of resources." In a "Note on Planning" released earlier this month, Jan argued that a project on the scale of the MM lake ought to have Planning Approval due to "[the] significant impact on a large number of people, on the environment and on the surroundings, Auroville as well as the villages in the vicinity". It is currently unclear how the lake can be constantly filled and maintained with the necessary quantities of water, without having a detrimental effect on the local water table.

VISITORS CENTER INFORMATION SERVICE TEAM TOLD TO REMOVE BOOKS

On 19th August 2023, the team working at the Visitors' Center (VC) Information Service was instructed by email to remove all written material by 1st September 2023. The mail, sent by the AVFO-appointed 'VC executives', stated that the intention was to "move and merge the book selling activity into the space that is presently taken up by the AV Papers book shop; [and] to end the activities of the information giving activity in the VC campus, as this will be taken up by the VC executives". In the following days, all books and relevant documentation were moved out of the space. It is unclear what information the AVFO team will present to visitors, however the Info Service team have been told that they may continue to communicate information to visitors verbally.

NEW CROWN ROAD 'HOLES' POSE HEALTH HAZARDS

Mosquito larvae have been observed in many of the anchor holes in the paving slabs laid along the Crown Road. There are hundreds of these holes, originally used to lift the slabs into place with a crane. So far the holes have not been filled in by the road contractors and have been left to fill with water after the recent rains. As mosquitos breed in stagnant water, the holes have become a breeding ground, raising concerns of a potential increase in mosquito-borne diseases in and around Auroville.

It is possible that mosquitos are also breeding unobserved in the new Crown Road stormwater channels, which was a concern raised by Satprem in his <u>report</u> dated 28th February 2023. At that time, Satprem advocated covering the stormwater channels with cast iron grills, stating that "the proposed system is not at all suitable for [the] Auroville context".

In addition, several reports of injuries due to people inadvertently stepping in these holes have also been reported. A concern was also raised regarding cows possibly breaking a leg by stepping in a hole since they are not easily visible at night or when filled with water and leaves.





SRINIVASAMURTY'S 'NOTE OF GRATITUDE'

On 31st July 2023, former Undersecretary of the Auroville Foundation Srinivasamurty, shared a <u>note of gratitude</u> on the occasion of his last day of service at the AVFO. The note was published in the RA News & Notes on 4th August 2023, and by the <u>AVFO's 'WCom'</u> on Auronet on 1st September 2023. The note has not yet been published in the AVFO News & Notes. Srinivasamurty served as Undersecretary for nearly 30 years and covered the Secretary role on a number of occasions when the Secretary post was unfilled.

At the start of the AVFO takeover of Auroville, Srinivasamurty signed a number of <u>emails</u> and <u>filed FIRs</u> (criminal charges) against 6 Aurovilians on behalf of the Secretary.

In April 2023, he was suspended from his role and replaced by B.S Sathyanarayan. It is unclear what the charges against him were, however in a blog published on Auronet, an Aurovilian well acquainted with Srinivasamurty claimed that the charges against him were "vindictive" and that he had sought legal advice.

Srinivasamurty's note read "Auroville has made me what I am today, hoping more of inner progress and though the outer development may appear to be more of ignorance, pride or ego, still. But it has been the most valuable phase of my life, having started my career here in Auroville! ... But for the unfortunate event in the last part of my service, which taught me hard lessons, I joyfully learnt so much & felt humbled to come across so many sincere aspirants, great scholars and even so called politicians to be deeply spiritual and evolved in their personal lives..."

RA TDC - 'IF WE WANT TO TRULY BE THE CITY THE EARTH NEEDS'

The RA TDC wrote to the Secretary and the AVFO 'Land Board', sharing a <u>report</u> regarding the recent tree-cutting in Revelation Forest Sanctuary. Several of Tamil Nadu's ministers in the Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change were copied into the letter. In June 2023, for 2 days, workers employed by the AVFO 'Land Board', cut a total of 1,863 trees aged between 3-15 years old. Most of the trees were rare evergreen species which are slow growing and can take around 200 years to mature. The report states "this has a huge impact, which unfortunately cannot easily be quantified, to biodiversity loss and a young, yet functional, ecosystem".

In the accompanying <u>letter</u>, the RA TDC urged the Secretary and the AVFO 'Land Board' to consider the environmental impact of the current rushed implementation of the Master Plan, not just to Auroville itself but also in the wider context of the earth's climate crisis. They wrote "In this age when the planet is on the verge of going into an unprecedented climate crisis, all planning must be based on the highest levels of environmental sustainability and climate resilience if we -Auroville - truly want to be the City the Earth Needs".

FOREST GROUP FACT CHECK OF AVFO 'FAMC' REPORT ON FORESTS

The Forest Group has <u>circulated</u> a rebuttal to the recent report of the AVFO 'FAMC' on forest work in Auroville. The document includes the original report and can <u>be found here</u>. Some points include:

- Despite the claims of the AVFO 'FAMC' that "Many of the land parcels in the City area (300+ acres) have been purposefully planted with trees on the infrastructure Right of Ways (RoW) and other City Center areas", the forest was not planted there purposefully, most forest was planted before any gazetted Master Plan existed, and certainly the planting did not occur to impede development, as the report implies. Many foresters have been working in collaboration with Town Hall for development of the City,citing successful instances, such as the Gaia area.
- The AVFO 'FAMC' report also claims that "Many land contours have been changed by digging out large water catchment areas without city detailed planning or approval from the Auroville Town Development Council and solely with the intention to block any city development and maintain hold over the lands enjoyed by the stewards' family and friends." The Forest Group notes that these accusations deny the history of Auroville, in which reforestation and the creation of water catchment areas was a collective work and that the foresters' vital work protected the land from encroachers.
- Other claims of bad financial management and foresters enriching themselves by sale of timber are addressed, as well as the accusation that foresters have not made the effort to set up a sawmill, despite the fact that this has been tried but license has not been given by the government. The foresters note that "Again, it is surprising that your institutional memory is lacking as, in 2012, Chandresh helped draft a letter for the Working Committee to request the AVF to apply for a license and subsequently 5 months later Torkil himself milled up 3000 CFT of Auroville timber in various surrounding sawmills." Both names mentioned are members of the current AVFO 'FAMC'.

CHANGING THE NARRATIVE

In June 2023, the RA WCom shared <u>via massbulletin</u> their <u>response</u> to the AVFO 'WCom' <u>Annual Report</u> August 2021 - August 2022. The report contained a number of often-repeated narratives that continue to be spread by the supporters of the AVFO to justify the ongoing takeover of Auroville's assets. As the RA WCom notes "With the benefit of nearly 12 months of hindsight since the end date of this report, it is clear that many of these erroneous statements do not reflect the reality of the situation, however, we still continue to hear many of these narratives being repeated." The response addressed numerous errors in the AVFO 'WCom' annual report, the most common of which will be shared in upcoming editions of the Bulletin.

The original statements from the AVFO 'WCom' are presented in italics, followed by the RA WCom responses.

"Auroville development is too slow"

"The Galaxy Plan became, years later, the main denominator for the Master Plan. But from the very first beginning it was clear what was asked from the Aurovilians: Constructing the Matrimandir, the Matrimandir gardens, the Matrimandir Lake, the Crown and the four Zones (residential, international, industrial, and cultural). In 2008 the Matrimandir was completed (40 years (!) after the inauguration of Auroville). All the other key-elements had hardly started, in any case they were not completed. To give a dire figure of the total built-up area of what Auroville should have manifested: only 3.2% had been realized."

The Matrimandir was indeed finished in 2008 after the inner chamber for concentration was completed and accessible since 1993. There are many reasons for the time it took to complete, particularly the technical challenges that the structure of the Matrimandir presented. Several generations of Aurovilians participated in constructing 'the Soul of the City', and consciousness in building it was often seen as more important than the time frame for completion. In Auroville especially, what is truly important is the evolution of consciousness, which is intrinsically linked to how we do things, the process - rather than the speed. Many temples and holy places have been built over generations - this doesn't diminish their importance or value for the community but rather expresses the reverence and consciousness with which these tasks were undertaken.

The recent emphasis on rushed 'development' over the past 18 months has only created more disharmony, destroyed well functioning infrastructure and resulted in works of substandard quality. Auroville's success and value requires a skilled and conscious approach that is incongruous with rushed attempts to impose concrete-based roads and buildings, especially if it truly wishes to become the "city the earth needs".

REGARDING TWO WRIT PETITIONS

This is to inform the community that 2 Writ Petitions filed by Aurovilians against the Auroville Foundation were dismissed by Madras High Court.

The first Writ Petition WP 13970 filed by Abha Tewari Arpi on 28 April 2023 challenging the Office Orders of 12.4.23 by the Auroville Foundation to reconstitute the management of 14 committees or units under the Auroville Foundation. The petition was filed to quash the same. It was dismissed by Madras High Court on 11.8.23.

In point #10.2 the judge reiterates the powers of the Residents Assembly as per the Foundation Act in section 19, then concludes:

A close reading of Section 19 of the Foundation Act: 'Functions of Residents' Assembly' indicates that its functions are limited to admission or removal of any person from the register of Residents' Assembly, to organize various activities of Auroville, to formulate the master plan for Auroville, and to make recommendations to raise funds for Auroville.

However, the constitution of various committees for efficient discharge of duties and functions of Act is left exclusively to the Governing Board. Therefore, the contention of the petitioner that the Governing Board ought to have consulted the Residents' Assembly before reconstituting the various committees is untenable...

12. For the above stated reasons, this Court does not find any merit in the petition, and the same is dismissed.

The 2nd Writ Petition filed recently by Aurovilian Deepa Dunean Mckenzie of Solitude was rejected at the admission stage. WP SR.No. 87772 of 2023. Deepa asked the Foundation to stop planning and construction of the Outer Ring Road. She also claimed that she was asked to vacate her house without proper legal procedure and would be relocated due to the upcoming outer ring road.

Vide order dated 11.08.2023, the court has categorically dismissed this petition with the following key remarks:

Para 7: '...It is not the case of the petitioner that the property belonged to her. [...] A reading of the statutory enactment, viz., The Auroville Foundation Act, does not envisage any provisions where the property of the respondent would be given to third party either on rent or lease or otherwise. The preamble of the enactment would suggest that the Act had been enacted to provide for acquisition and transfer of undertakings of Auroville and to vest such undertakings in a foundation established for the purpose with a view to make long term arrangements for the better management and further development of Auroville.'

To further elaborate on this point, all residents of Auroville are permissive occupants and have voluntarily signed up for the project which has preset ideals, a Charter and values guiding daily life given by the Mother based on the works and yoga of Sri Aurobindo. None of these ideals relate to holding on to property, in fact one of the key ideals of Auroville is that of non-ownership towards a spiritual goal of being free from the sense of personal possession.
