

The creation of a supramental being, nature, life on earth, will not be the sole result of this evolution; it will also carry with it the consummation of the steps that have led up to it: for it will confirm in possession of terrestrial birth the overmind, the intuition and the other gradations of the spiritual natureforce and establish a race of gnostic beings and a hierarchy, a shining ladder of ascending degrees and successive constituent formations of the gnostic light and power in earth-nature. For the description of gnosis applies to all consciousness that is based upon Truth of being and not upon the Ignorance or Nescience. All life and living beings ready to rise beyond the mental ignorance, but not ready yet for the supramental height, would find in a sort of echelon or a scale with overlapping degrees their assured basis, their intermediate steps of selfformation, their expression of realised capacity of spiritual existence on the way to the supreme Reality. But also the presence of the liberated and now sovereign supramental light and force at the head of evolutionary Nature might be expected to have its consequences in the whole evolution. An incidence, a decisive stress would affect the life of the lower evolutionary stages; something of the light, something of the force would penetrate downwards and awaken into a greater action the hidden TruthPower everywhere in Nature. A dominant principle of harmony would impose itself on the life of the Ignorance; the discord, the blind seeking, the clash of struggle, the abnormal vicissitudes of exaggeration and depression and unsteady balance of the unseeing forces at work in their mixture and conflict, would feel the influence and yield place to a more orderly pace and harmonic steps of the development of being, a more revealing arrangement of progressing life and consciousness, a better lifeorder. A freer play of intuition and sympathy and understanding would enter into human life, a clearer sense of the truth of self and things and a more enlightened dealing with the opportunities and difficulties of existence. Instead of a constant intermixed and confused struggle between the growth of Consciousness and the power of the Inconscience, between the forces of light and the forces of darkness, the evolution would become a graded progression from lesser light to greater light; in each stage of it the conscious beings belonging to that stage would respond to the inner Consciousness-Force and expand their own law of cosmic Nature towards the possibility of a higher degree of that Nature. This is at least a strong possibility and might be envisaged as the natural consequence of the direct action of supermind on the evolution. This intervention would not annul the evolutionary principle, for supermind has the power of withholding or keeping in reserve its force of knowledge as well as the power of bringing it into full or partial action; but it would harmonise, steady, facilitate, tranquillise and to a great extent hedonise the difficult and afflicted process of the evolutionary emergence.

Farewell beautiful young soul, may you shine on forever.



COMMUNITY SHARING

FROM OUR SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT IN VARANASI:

From 30th October to 1st November 2023 an international colloquium was held at the prestigious Banaras Hindu University. The subject was French Indology through intercultural approaches. It was inaugurated on that particular date because the organizers wanted to pay homage to the French writer, lover of India and the Mother's disciple, Satprem, on his 100th birth anniversary. Michel Danino, member of the Auroville International Advisory Council, gave a brief keynote address on the beginnings of French Indology in the 18thcentury and the different misunderstandings that arose at that time. Nicole Elfi, Aurovilian of the early years, spoke on Satprem and Auroville, including a few parallels with the present situation. Claude Arpi, Aurovilian and Tibetologist, made a presentation on Alexandra David-Néel, that French adventurous lady who explored not only Benares, but Tibet and Tibetan culture and religion. Christine Devin, Aurovilian and lover of Hindi and Sanskrit, spoke of the great French statesman Clemenceau and how he was fascinated by India and its metaphysics.

We can say without exaggeration that the contribution of those people was much appreciated and gave rise to lively debates.



MONTHLY FARM GROUP REPORT FOR OCTOBER

- 1. FUND RAISING FOR FARMS; since maintenances have been cut farmers are having to devise different ways to be financially self sufficient. As this withdrawal of funds was made with no discussion or prior warning, many farmers need bridging support until they have time to restructure the farms to become financially sustainable again. At the same time Farm Group lost control of all the farm accounts and so is unable to channel money where it is needed. In discussion with AVI centres and others, various ways of both raising the money and channeling it to farms are being considered. An Aurovilian video maker is in the process of making videos about the situation of each of the farms and what each plans to do to become financially sustainable.
- 2. FOODLINK; various topics have had to be addressed:
- a. Milk; farmers were very disappointed that the results of milk test were sent to a wide range of groups, including the Secretary before even contacting them. After years of rumours it is good to have regular milk tests using the new Foodlink milk testing machine provided it is calibrated and working properly. This episode has shown farmers that they need to get their act together to create and maintain proper standards. The whole affair has shaken and diminished the trust between farmers as well as between Foodlink and dairy farmers. There is now a feeling that not all dairies can be trusted. This atmosphere has also affected those dairies upholding good standards and doing the right thing. Now, as presently the Dairy Sub Group no longer exists, there is no forum for dairy farmers to decide what standards to uphold or to create a process for what happens if a farmer falls below them. Foodlink is communicating directly with individual farmers in an environment where trust between Foodlink and dairy farmers has been greatly reduced.
- **b. Vegetables**; as with milk, there have for years been rumours about farmers who buy vegetables in Pondy and then pass them off as their own in Foodlink. Standards for vegetables are normally maintained by each farmer keeping careful data about the vegetable growing process and collating this with details of harvests; together with peer review from other farmers. The problem has been that farmers are unable or unwilling to keep this data so it has been impossible to prove anything about the conditions under which vegetables are grown. After a recent meeting with the research team Foodlink is going to come up with some sort of standardization grades for different qualities of fruit and vegetables. In the end, however, it is consumers who will decide about this and the quality of food they want to eat. Vegetable group had a meeting to discuss pricing and possible frameworks to facilitate transparency and arrive at self-standardisation norms and practices.
- c.Relationship of farmers and Foodlink; now that Foodlink is independent with a new team with no farming experience, the relationship between farmers and Foodlink will have to be rebuilt. The new Foodlink team has been working with farmers in a top down way, making promises they couldn't possibly fulfil. A meeting called by Foodlink during the last month allowed farmers and Foodlink people to talk to each other but it was obvious that the relationship between the two groups will need a lot of effort if it is to work. Foodlink will also have to work hard at creating positive connections both within and outside Auroville if they are to become the distribution centre that the community needs. As a result of this lack of trust and difficult communications some farmers feel that dependency on Foodlink ought to be minimised and farms do their own distribution. This could, however, lead to farms competing with each other to the detriment of everyone.
- **3. FARMING STANDARDS**; in the light of these issues there were discussions about how farmers could create and maintain standards through the grain, dairy and vegetable sub groups. This will require that group members create a standard that everyone adheres to and that there are processes in place to work with farmers who fall below those standards. There is a need to push for voluntary standards, transparency and collaboration so farmers can stand together.
- 4. FARM ASSESSMENT; some data collection has been completed but no assessments have yet been made. There is a small team under Farm Service conducting assessments on farms. They have visited many farms including Annapurna and agreed with the Steward to include his response to their assessment in their report. It is very important that all farmers have a voice in this process and that her/his views on the data are included.

5. FARM ASSETS;

- i. ANNAPURNA LAND EXCHANGE; Annapurna was visited by members of the AVFO-WC and Land Board wanting to exchange 22 acres of roadside land for Peramboke land. The 22 acres includes a pond producing 40% of Annapurna's water supply. It was explained that exchanging this land will have large consequences for the farm and its production. An alternative plot of about 5 acres on the other side of the road was suggested. Everything is very unclear.
- **ii. BUDDHA GARDEN ROAD**; everything is still very unclear. Without finance the farm will be unable to move.
- iii. HOUSING ON FARMS; the farms were recently sent a list of housing on their farms compiled by Housing Service. All farmers were recommended to check carefully as mistakes have been found.
- **6. GRATITUDE FARM REPORT;** the report clearly showed the project fell short of its projected goals. With a first year budget of Rs2.79 lakhs on a 0.6 acre plot, they produced 20% of their projected yield and earned 7.5% of their projected income. In response a factual report has been created addressing the shortcomings which the Core Group will share with FAMC copying Farm Service. These groups will be requested to reflect on the projects obvious limitations.
- 7. FARM LABOUR; with no overall Auroville support for payment of things like gratuities all farmers need to be aware of their legal financial responsibilities towards their workers. Tomas will meet with SEWA for clarification about this. Core Group recommends that all farmers be clear and are able to follow the proper legal and financial process regarding this. (SEWA welcomes anyone, farmer or worker, to contact them if they have questions about this).
- **8. NEW ORGANISATIONAL HELP**; a new person wants to help with Farm Group admin and has been welcomed with open arms to help with meeting notes. Core Group meetings are now held on Wednesday instead of Tuesday. In the future both admin people will explore what is needed by the group and how to organise it to fit in with their existing schedules.


This tribute to Pashiji could not have been better composed. Congratulations dear Paulette!

BUILDING A PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE(-IST) FRIENDLY CITY:

Auroville is intended to be a city without motorised traffic. However, building a cycle friendly city is not as much about building cycle paths as it is about making paths cyclable, and having some baseline respect for cyclists. To make way for the Crown to be constructed, certain cycle paths were opened to motorised traffic. Today, only one remains open. However, the rest were never closed, and motorcyclists run amuck through all the cycle paths of Bliss, and the cycle path behind Surrender. They are all a "shortcut", and justified by the (Aurovilian) motorcyclists on them by "driving slowly" or being "in a rush". Please find some reflections from a cyclist below:

- 1.I have to breathe your fumes as I sweat to move while you zoom past with a turn of your wrist.
- 2. Often, you say there is plenty of space for you to pass. Yes. You are creating that space. You are widening all the cycle paths by simply existing and allowing your motorised vehicle to compress the soil below, refusing to allow anything to grow. That tree whose root is your speedbump is critical for all cyclists from April-June if we ever hope to leave the house.
- 3.I am no longer afforded the luxury to be in a rush, or cycle fast for pleasure. I will hear your motor but no matter how much I ring my bell and how slowly you drive, you cannot hear me.
- 4. The community ought to know that with the increased usage of cycle paths by motorised traffic, complete creeps are driving through our cycle paths because they all now know it is possible. Not just through Bliss and the one behind Surrender ALL the cycle paths that don't have proper gates. They all actually see them, and it doesn't help that they keep getting wider and more visible. There have been several incidents in the last year of children being chased and having to duck into cycle paths that have proper gates to protect themselves. It is abhorrent. If you don't believe me, speak to a random sampling of 5 kids aged 9-15 years old and you will hear at least one of them has a friend who has had such an experience.
- 5. People drive on high-beam through the cycle paths, which is unsafe even on regular roads but extremely so on cycle paths because the path is intended to be narrow. In the monsoon, I have to stop, squishing my feet into mud and wait for you to pass, because I am literally blind from your light. A few days ago, I was told off by a motorcylist on the cycle path for not having a torch at 6pm when I'm perfectly capable of seeing.

I find it disrespectful to apprehend you 'in the act' since most of those of you doing it have been here over 20 years, and I can't say much to people from our bioregion either because they point at you, asking me why I don't stop you. So please, I beg of you - **STOP**.

The roads for motorised traffic are currently difficult for all and extremely unsafe. There are rarely any signs when roads get blocked, and people are having accidents all the time. There is no defence nor excuse for these realities, especially for our elderly or our children. But please bear in mind - children and elderly people also cycle. Please stop passing on your misery to the guys below you in the chain of hierarchy. When you drive your bike on the cycle path, note everyone you see and knowthey will do it too, and you are why. Please walk and cycle on these paths afforded to us under beautiful canopies, fill your lungs with clean air and blessing your ears with only the music of birds. But please - stop stealing our paths from us.


You can explain what your name means and share your experience of it; you can express it in creative art forms—a poem, a song, a painting, calligraphy, sculpture, handicrafts...

A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

FOREST WORKERS GRATUITY STILL UNPAID BY AVFO 'BCC'

In June 2023, Chandresh and Torkil of the AVFO 'FAMC' <u>cut all budgets</u> and maintenances for the Forest Group. This left 40 Aurovilians without a maintenance from one day to the next and 60 plus local forest workers without pay, many of whom have been working with Auroville for years, some for decades. Effectively, they were fired en-masse by the AVFO 'FAMC' from one day to the next.

In India, there is a legal obligation to pay 'gratuity' after employment is terminated, which corresponds to a portion of salary for each year of employment. While gratuity was, until recently, always paid by the BCC through a dedicated account, the AVFO groups have since decided that it is up to the individual employer or unit to provide gratuity. This has created an untenable situation for foresters, who had not foreseen the need to set aside money for this purpose. They are now suddenly expected by the AVFO 'BCC' to come up with a large sum for these gratuities while their own maintenance is also cut. In an update, the Forest Group noted that "Continued non-payment of gratuity by the GBappointed BCC is untenable legally and morally... the forest group asked the GB BCC and FAMC (including the Secretary of the AVFO) to pay the gratuity and 1 month compensatory wage to the workers. In spite of repeated reminders, this has not yet been honoured."

It appears that the AVFO 'BCC' has now decided to apply this sudden change in policy to all Auroville units (whether income generating or not) and their employees. A recent email from SAIIER to all schools outlines the change in policy and notes that "We are aware that this is quite challenging and not even possible for many units." SAIIER plans to set up and fundraise for a central account that can help schools cover the gratuity costs, though the scheme is voluntary and the responsibility for funding gratuity is mainly left with the schools. Their email also notes that due to the current situation, there is a concern that workers might be tempted to quit their jobs in hopes of getting gratuity while there is still some funding available.

SATPREM HAS LEFT INDIA

Satprem Maini left India on 31st October 2023, after the Secretary rescinded her recommendation for his Auroville visa. He was subsequently given an Exit Permit by the FRRO. The day before he left, friends of Satprem organised an open house at the Auroville Earth Institute which was attended by around 200 people. This was followed by an evening at the Tibetan Pavilion, the first building in Auroville built by Satprem. Please see here for the presentation given by Satprem during the open house event. Satprem has now arrived safely in France.



RAD RESULT

The AVFO recently removed at least two Aurovilians, Maël of the RA WCom and Satprem of the Earth Institute, from the Register of Residents (RoR), after they were asked to leave India. Ayyappan from the Earth Institute also had his name removed for not updating his RoR details, according to an email signed jointly by the AVFO 'WCom' and the AVFO 'FAMC'. As a result, the Residents' Assembly recently voted on a resolution questioning the AVFO's authority to remove people from the RoR. This RA Decision has yielded the following results:

Total number of valid votes: 741. 98% participants voted in favour of the above resolution. 0.81% participants rejected it. 1.3% participants didn't know.

The number of valid votes represents about one third of the adult population of Auroville, which is thrice the required quorum. As such, the resolution was approved. This vote was considered necessary by the RA WCom, who called for this emergency RAD, as the Auroville Foundation Act reserves the right to determine who is and who is not an Aurovilian solely to the Residents' Assembly.

5TH TAMIL NADU YOUNG THINKERS MEET HOSTED IN SAVITRI BHAVAN

The 5th Tamil Nadu Young Thinkers Meet was organised between 3rd and 5th November in Auroville's Savitri Bhavan. The community was not informed of this closed event.

According to the program of the meeting, speakers from Auroville included the Secretary, Dr Jayanti Ravi; the recently appointed Deputy Secretary, Smt K Swarnambika; and Dr Mollika Ganguly, a recently appointed staff member of the AVFO. Other notable speakers included a spiritual teacher, Swami Mitrananda, as well as active political figures, such as the Chief Minister of Puducherry, Thiru N Rangaswamy. According to testimonies, about 50 young people from ABVP (a student organisation affiliated with the RSS) attended the meeting. Reportedly, some of these attendees were hosted in Atithi Griha guesthouse. The program included a visit to AuroOrchard, one of Auroville's largest farms, attended by many participants.

A NEW WEBSITE FOR STAND FOR AUROVILLE UNITY

Stand For Auroville Unity, the community-aligned campaign that was launched in December 2021 after the forceful events at the Youth Center, Bliss Forest and Darkali, had faced technical issues with its website over the last few months. On 31st October, the Stand For Auroville Unity team published a new website containing information about the current situation, as well as useful resources to understand the crisis. AUROVILLE REDEFINED BY AVFO IN LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

The AVFO recently changed the wording on visa Letters of Recommendation (LoR). The previous wording stated that "Auroville was founded by 'The Mother' of Sri Aurobindo Ashram on 28th February 1968" [see picture here]. Now, it reads that Auroville is "functioning under the administrative control of the Ministry of Education, Government of India" [see picture here]. This fails to acknowledge that the Auroville Foundation is an autonomous body, which functions under three statutory bodies (the Residents' Assembly, the Governing Board and the International Advisory Council) as per the Auroville Foundation Act. Mentions of the Mother and Sri Aurobindo have also been removed.

MM LAKE UPDATE

New aerial images show the extent of the tree cutting at the Matrimandir (MM) to make way for the second phase of the MM lake. This tree cutting is in direct contravention of the April 2022 verdict of the National Green Tribunal (NGT). The verdict stated that proper township planning, in the form of Environmental Clearance and Detailed Development Plans, should be in place before any further construction. Although the AVFO appealed the verdict to the Supreme Court, no stay was put on the verdict by the court, and therefore the verdict still stands.



Recently, several Atalantia trees were uprooted in the MM gardens, to be transplanted elsewhere. The root ball that was left on the transplanted trees was far smaller than the recommended standard, usually 8-10 times the stem diameter. Atalantias are a slow-growing species with an unusual bark pattern. They are native to the Tamil Nadu region and can live up to 300 years.



AVFO 'WCOM' HOLDS "PRIVATE INVITATION ONLY" MEETING AT UNITY PAVILION

On 2nd November 2023, the AVFO 'WCom' held a closed meeting at Unity Pavilion. The invitation was sent only to selected "friends", however it circulated widely. Other Aurovilians who were interested in attending were turned away at the door. The invitation indicated the reason for the meeting as follows: "in the recent months, people have become confused by some of the stories and fears that have been spread ... we want to take the opportunity to hear your views and questions and try to answer them as best we can."

Around 20 attended the meeting. Topics reportedly discussed were the 'problem of democracy', the 'problem' of the Residents' Assembly, housing issues, the Prosperity proposal, and the issues with implementing the Crown Road, such as missing plots of land on the planned Crown road, that have not yet been bought and are causing delays in construction.

CHANGING THE NARRATIVE

In June 2023, the RA WCom shared their response to the AVFO 'WCom' Annual Report August 2021 - August 2022 via massbulletin. The report contained a number of often-repeated narratives that continue to be spread by the supporters of the AVFO to justify the ongoing takeover of Auroville's assets. As the RA WCom notes "With the benefit of nearly 12 months of hindsight since the end date of this report, it is clear that many of these erroneous statements do not reflect the reality of the situation, however, we still continue to hear many of these narratives being repeated." The response addressed numerous errors in the AVFO 'WCom' annual report, annual report. One such error is addressed below.

The original statements from the AVFO 'WCom' are presented in italics, followed by the RA WCom responses.

The Galaxy concept is not the same as a city plan

"Auroville was founded on 28th February, 1968 on a wind-swept plateau with degraded hard red soil without a water source... A panel of the galaxy model, Mother's city plan worked out together with her Chief Architect Roger Anger, was on display. It was the beginning of a new era. The Adventure of Consciousness had started in Auroville."

"The AVFO appointed Working Committee continuously and wrongly confuses the "Galaxy" and Auroville's city plan. Expert town planners, architects, and Roger Anger himself have expressed that The Galaxy is an architectural concept that needs to be translated into proper plans. Calling the Galaxy a "plan" is false and is at the root of the long-standing confusion and conflict related to development. City plans should take shape through inspiration from the Galaxy concept. They should result from a truly collaborative process, as stipulated in the Perspective Plan 2025. Any attempt to translate the Galaxy model into concrete city plans have been dismissed and ignored by the AVFO appointed Working Committee due to this obstinate misunderstanding of the city planning process."

How can this foundational myth of European culture, in light of Sri Aurobindo's writings, help us understand Europe and some of its present-day challenges?

This lecture will look at the evolution of Europe from a completely new angle, namely that of Greek mythology, deciphered by the lecturer over a period of almost 30 years. 








GIFT A DRAGON





- Project brief: Auroyali is a construction unit in Auroville under Kattida Kalai Trust. The unit had a site and workshop in the International Zone, which was temporary and was always intended to be moved to another location.

Plot no. TH 165/8 (behind Grand Serena Hotel) is now being allocated to this unit, and the adjacent plot no. TH 164/3 is being given temporary approval (no construction on this will be permitted, only as a stockyard for material).

SURABHI SUPPLIES—Site Application

- Applicant/s: Angelo & lyyappan
- Location/area: Southern Service Node
- Area for which approval is sought: 1700 Sq.m.
- · Project brief: Surabhi Supplies is a registered procurement service under the Service Trust which handles procurement of materials and equipment for all kinds of Auroville projects, units and individuals. As a steadily growing service, it requires a small office/ storage/ yard area for the work.

A site in the Southern Service Node, next to Re-center, is being allocated to this service. This is being allocated on a temporary basis, as the service may have to be shifted to the Industrial Zone at a later stage. Therefore only temporary structures will be allowed to be built on this site.

Constructive feedback guidelines:

Till 2022, while giving permissions, we have asked the project team to include approval from the neighbours. This has no resonance with the ideals of Auroville where we committed to a life guided by no desire, no preferences and no sense of ownership. This 'approval from the neighbours' is no longer part of the application process as this has no place in Auroville.

Similarly when we publish projects for approval, we will discard all personal feedback with respect to 'neighbours choosing neighbours' or 'neighbours choosing development guidelines'.
