

This passage is the stage at which the supermind gnosis can take over the lead of the evolution from the overmind and build the first foundations of its own characteristic manifestation and unveiled activities; it must be marked therefore by a decisive but long-prepared transition from an evolution in the Ignorance to an always progressive evolution in the Knowledge. It will not be a sudden revelation and effectuation of the absolute Supermind and the supramental being as they are in their own plane, the swift apocalypse of a truth-conscious existence ever self-fulfilled and complete in self-knowledge; it will be the phenomenon of the supramental being descending into a world of evolutionary becoming and forming itself there, unfolding the powers of the gnosis within the terrestrial nature. This is indeed the principle of all terrestrial being; for the process of earth-existence is the play of an infinite Reality concealing itself first in a succession of obscurely limited, opaque and incomplete half-figures which by their imperfection and character of disguise distort the truth of which they are in labour, but afterwards arriving more and more at half-luminous figures of itself which can become, once there is the supramental descent, a true progressive revelation. The descent from original supermind, the assumption of evolutionary supermind is a step which the supramental gnosis can very well undertake and accomplish without changing its own essential character. It can assume the formula of a truth-conscious existence founded in an inherent self-knowledge but at the same time taking up into itself mental nature and nature of life and material body. For the supermind as the truthconsciousness of the Infinite has in its dynamic principle the infinite power of a free self-determination. It can hold all knowledge in itself and yet put forward in formulation only what is needed at each stage of an evolution; it formulates whatever is in accordance with the Divine Will in manifestation and the truth of the thing to be manifested. It is by this power that it is able to hold back its knowledge, hide its own character and law of action and manifest overmind and under overmind a world of ignorance in which the being wills on its surface not to know and even puts itself under the control of a pervading Nescience. But in this new stage the veil thus put on will be lifted; the evolution at every step will move in the power of the truthconsciousness and its progressive determinations will be made by a conscious Knowledge and not in the forms of an Ignorance or Inconscience.

As there has been established on earth a mental Consciousness and Power which shapes a race of mental beings and takes up into itself all of earthly nature that is ready for the change, so now there will be established on earth a gnostic Consciousness and Power which will shape a race of gnostic spiritual beings and take up into itself all of earth-nature that is ready for this new transformation. It will also receive into itself from above, progressively, from its own domain of perfect light and power and beauty all that is ready to descend from that domain into terrestrial being. For the evolution proceeded in the past by the upsurging, at each critical stage, of a concealed Power from its involution in the Inconscience, but also by a descent from above, from its own plane, of that Power already self-realised in its own higher natural province. In all these previous stages there has been a division between surface self and consciousness and subliminal self and consciousness; the surface was formed mainly under the push of the upsurging force from below, by the Inconscient developing a slowly emergent formulation of a concealed force of the spirit, the subliminal partly in this way but mainly by a simultaneous influx of the largeness of the same force from above: a mental or a vital being descended into the subliminal parts and formed from its secret station there a mental or a vital personality on the surface. But before the supramental change can begin, the veil between the subliminal and the surface parts must have been already broken down; the influx, the descent will be in the entire consciousness as a whole, it will not take place partly behind a veil: the process will be no longer a concealed, obscure and ambiguous procedure but an open outflowering consciously felt and followed by the whole being in its transmutation. In other respects the process will be identical, — a supramental inflow from above, the descent of a gnostic being into the nature, and an emergence of the concealed supramental force from below; the influx and the unveiling between them will remove what is left of the nature of the Ignorance. The rule of the Inconscient will disappear: for the Inconscience will be changed by the outburst of the greater secret Consciousness within it, the hidden Light, into what it always was in reality, a sea of the secret Superconscience. A first formation of a gnostic consciousness and nature will be the consequence.

- The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.
- A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation.
 An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).
- A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.
- A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

FROM THE RA WORKING COMMITTEE

CORRECTIONS TO STATEMENT MADE BY THE ILLEGITIMATE WORKING COMMITTEE REGARDING THE ONGOING RAD

Dear community,

It has come to our notice that those illegally impersonating the Working Committee (AVFO 'WC') have published a misleading statement (attached) regarding the ongoing emergency RAD. We would like to clarify that:

- 1) Satprem Maini has not been issued with a Leave India Notice. He is holding an Exit Permit, which is very different.
- 2) The Office of the Secretary does not have the authority to decide to remove a resident from the Register of Residents, as per the Auroville Foundation Act (1988) and the Admission and Termination Regulations (2020). Only the Residents' Assembly, either directly or through a committee appointed by it for this purpose, can make this decision after following due process. Moreover, absence from India does not automathically imply removal from the RoR. As per section 6.1.ii of the Gazetted Admission and Termination regulations of 4th April 2020, removal from the Register of Resident can be examined in cases where the resident has not been residing in Auroville for a consecutive period of three years, or if a resident's behaviour may be incompatible with Auroville's ideals or the laws of India or that a resident is not engaged in any community work or meaningful activity relevant to the life and growth of Auroville, which is not the case of Satprem and Mael. Neither the Office of the Secretary nor its appointees have any role to play in this
- 3) In a communication dated 17th October, 2023, from the GB FAMC it is stated: "As it has come to the knowledge of FAMC that Ayyappan is not in the Registry of Residence, according to Code of Conduct, he cannot be an executive of an Auroville unit." There was a joint resolution of the GB FAMC and the AVFO 'WC' attached to this communication. Why does the AVFO 'WC' now say that Ayyappan was not removed from the RoR if this is the reason given for removing him as an executive of the Earth Institute?
- 4) Ayyappan was aware and agreed before the start of the RAD that his name could be included.

We trust this clarifies the facts of the situation.

We take this opportunity to remind all residents that every voice matters and participation in this and all community decisionmaking processes is important, no matter your opinions or choices.

Note sent to AVFO - wrt ROR

The Council sent an email to the Foundation Office in July requesting a copy of the ROR. A Council member also went to deliver a hard copy of the letter and was informed by the Secretary of the AVF in person that it is the role of the group of people she recognised as the Working Committee to follow up on the completion of the ROR and that they are looking into it. There has been no other update since then. The Council has not received any acknowledgment of our mail nor received a reply.

Talam and Masterlist update

It was decided between the Working Committee selected by the Residents Assembly and the Auroville Council to maintain a copy of the Masterlist, independently of the one which depends on Talam's services, to ensure its continued accuracy.

Updation of email addresses

An initiative was explored in collaboration with RAS and resource persons to update the email address for all residents. This was because since the takeover of the @auroville.org.in email service, which included the takeover of many email addresses and the blocking of certain domains and email addresses from communicating with @auroville.org.in, many of the current (new) email addresses have not been updated in the records of the Residents' Service for several reasons.

The wider intention of this initiative was to ensure that Aurovillians are able to participate in RA processes using their new email addresses. Also because RAS is no longer able to invite @auroville.org.in email addresses to participate in RA processes for several reasons.

This initiative has been suspended for the time being.

Reaching out

The Council recognised the necessity to reach out to Aurovilians who tend not to participate in community processes and are therefore left unheard in the community. It is important to try to create harmony among residents and to find out the reasons for non-participation so that the residents together can come up with solutions to encourage participation effectively. The first step for this endeavour was to contact such residents.

Further to this, it was brought to our attention by some residents that there are many people who do not feel safe in the present situation in Auroville and are apprehensive about being targeted or being pulled into a legal case. To bring more awareness and trust among the residents, the Council members are continuing to meet various people from different sectors of the community either individually or in small groups to understand and to come up with ways of connecting and communicating with all, beyond the barriers of language and other restraints.

As a priority, the Council wants to reach residents who have language restraints, for example, the Chinese, Korean, Russian, Tamil etc. and are also in the process of collecting names of representatives from each community, to create whatsapp groups so that communicating with all residents is easier and faster.

Auronet access

Although Auroville Council does not have free access to use Auronet any longer, some residents without access have expressed a wish to have their access restored. Therefore we took it upon ourselves to try to help them with this.

Two Council members met with an employee at the AV Foundation Office and asked for the list of those who still have access to their auroville.org.in email accounts, and those whose access has been rescinded.

He said that the Officer on Special Duty for the Governing Board should be contacted. The Council members phone number was taken to schedule a meeting with him but we received no invitation.

Regarding the list of names who have had their access blocked to Auronet and how their access might be restored, they were told to contact the Auronet admin team. A Council member organised to meet the Auronet admin team to understand the situation but they did not appear for the meeting.

No street lights

In August an attempt was made to have the street lights reinstalled along stretches of Crown Road that were under reconstruction and in an unsafe condition. We contacted TDC and Electrical Service who both considered this situation. We were informed that the road needed to be built before the lights were installed and that the road was going to be built in the near future.

Workshop with Ginn and Letlapa from South Africa

Some of the Council members attended the "Equity Matters" workshop facilitated by Ginn and Letlapa (from South Africa) which was organised by some residents. The workshop was an attempt to bring conscious communication into awareness in daily life and approach issues with the attitude of forgiveness despite differences (short documentary link).

Conflict Resolution Council

Council has approached the CRC with the intention of strengthening the team and to look at the next steps towards making CRC independent from Council.

Migration of email domain issues

In September, with the migration of the Google domain auroville.services we experienced a lot of disruption to our work. All of the links to our files in our drive have changed which created complications.

RAS' Financial Service account blocked

RAS informed the Council and Working Committee in July that their FS account was blocked and therefore their access to funds.

FAMC member resignation

In July, we received a resignation, for personal reasons, from one of the RA FAMC members. We apologise for the lapse in not announcing it to the community.

Unity Pavillion refuses community meetings

Early in July, the UP did not allow the RAS to hold a Residents' Assembly Meeting (RAM). They received an email from the Wcom recognised by the Auroville Foundation office requesting them for highly questionable reasons not to allow any meetings for RA selected working groups.

Later in July, the Council was able to book the UP for a meeting with a group of residents as part of our push for harmonising the community.

Council Balance Sheet

We received a request from AVFO to approve and sign the Council balance sheet for last year. The signature requested was for an executive or trustee but with Council members being neither executives nor trustees, we explained the same to them and agreed to sign the copies only as team members of Council. There is an additional requirement of maintaining monthly expenses and submission to them.

Entry Board needs support

The EB expressed that it will need new members or resource persons in the near future to support their functioning. They also asked us to help them with finding resource persons.

Arbiter Coordination team member resignation

One of the Arbiter Coordination team members informed us of their resignation.

Mandates and Policies

Entry Policy

Some members of the Council are working with the Entry Board team to review the Entry policy. It's an ongoing process and will be shared with the Community once finalised.

RAS mandate and policy

Council has been working on the RAS mandate in collaboration with the RAS. We are in the process of finalising it before presenting it to the community for feedback.

Selection Process Review Task Force (SPRTF) 2023

The work of the SPRTF 2023 was finalised by the Council. This will be shared with the community shortly.

RAD Resolutions

Council created and signed two resolutions for the Emergency RADs held in August.

CRC REPORT FOR JULY AND SEPTEMBER 2023

The Conflict Resolution Council (CRC) Subgroup of AV Council: (for AVC: Ashwini, Suryan; Other members: Svenja, Sophie (Admin/Coordination).

We intend to involve more able and skilled members from the community. To know more please write to avc.conflicts@gmail.com

- The CRC was approached by a few residents with regards to a community conflict. When we offered a facilitated meeting, the community members decided to hold a community meeting amongst themselves first, where it was decided to deal with the issue internally and not to involve any outside party for the moment.
- A mediation was attempted in a community, involving the location of an improvised car parking within the community. However, the facilitation was not needed beyond a certain point, as the residents of the community managed to find a harmonious understanding amongst themselves and solve the matter at hand to the satisfaction of all parties involved.
- The CRC was alerted about a recurring aggressive dog issue. As the dog owner is not currently in Auroville and is planning to repatriate his dog to his home country, the CRC assured themselves that the dog is safely taken care of at present, before starting its trip overseas. We would like to thank all those involved in the process for the extended help and organization.
- It was brought to our attention that a finalized arbitration (2009) in the Simplicity community had not been fully implemented at the time. 2 CRC members helped to bring the matter to a harmonious closure.

Please note that for obvious confidentiality reasons, we are not reporting individual or community conflicts in our monthly reports.

Only finalized mediations will be mentioned anonymously. Arbitration and appeal processes however, will be announced upon start and completion, also in a general manner only.

OBITUARY

KLARA BROGLI LEFT HER BODY

On Monday 30 October, Klara Brogli, Aurovilian resident of Surya Nivas, left her body in her native country, Switzerland. She was 81. Due to a medical intervention which substantially reduced the quality of her existence, Klara chose for termination of her life for which In Switzerland officially recognised assistance can be found. [She had indicated to a friend that this could be shared with her Auroville family.]



Klara had been coming to Auroville since 2001 and joined in 2004 for good. She started volunteering with office work at the then Development Group and worked for years in the SEWA team where her care and support for the financially underprivileged became evident.

She was an open and curious woman, always ready to reach out and give a hand. With her background in investment banking and as a lawyer by profession, she displayed clear insight in Auroville's faring and was keen in choosing her projects. The Auroville Puncture Service was one of them, and she became its executive in due time.

Always eager to embrace new technology, Klara also had the courage to build the second steel framed house in Auroville in which she lived the last 20 years, expressing her elegant and highly aesthetic sense in finely detailed elements of house and garden.

Klara was deeply interested in Auroville's experimental organisation and collective processes. She cherished the Charter of Auroville, and had an enormous trust in Auroville's succeeding. Recent developments have shocked her to the core.

Friends will miss this fine-styled person with her free spirit henna-red hair, her strong will and independent stance, her sharp observations, and often dry humor and wit.

May you be in peace, dear Klara.

LUCAS POSADA PASSED AWAY

On 13 October, Colombian Lucas Posada arrived with his 10-year old son Salvador in Chennai to start his newcomer year in Auroville, while his wife and daughter would follow a month later.



During the night journey to Auroville, their non-AV taxi collided with a trailer that cut into them. They were taken to JIPMER where Lucas was diagnosed with multiple injuries, punctured lung, fractured leg and hip, and head concussion. The child was in shock but recovered when his mother Gloria, Lucas's wife, arrived 24 hours later.

During two weeks in ICU, while inwardly working on himself and receiving good energies and prayers from many friends, he seemed to make promising progress, was moved to a private room, flourishing in the care extended to him. And then, in the morning of 31 October, Lucas suffered cardiac arrest and passed away. He was 60 years old.

In his volunteer time here, Lucas had worked at Last School and Bharat Nivas while living at Serendipity, and had been in touch with many residents. He and Gloria were now coming back to officially start their newcomer process with son Salvador and their 14-year old daughter Gaia.

Lucas has been searching all his life, traveling the world as a teacher and artist. A few days before his passing, he mentioned in a moving first voice message to those who had been supporting him in their prayers: "I want to send to all those people that have been sending love and all those beautiful caring intensions..., I am so grateful, my family is so grateful..., this is precisely the reason that I always knew that I wanted to be in Auroville... I am very very grateful to everyone..."

We pay solemnly tribute to this open minded, tolerant and generous man who made in such short time span a deep and lasting impression on so many, and who wrote: "There is a deeper meaning to life and we need to re-align ourselves to the divine energy."

Our warmest condolences go out to Gloria, Salvador and Gaia – and welcome them in our midst.

OUTCOME OF THE EMERGENCY RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION-MAKING PROCESS ON UNAUTHORIZED REMOVAL OF RESIDENTS FROM ROR

Dear residents,

Here are the results of the Emergency Residents' Assembly Decision-making process, initiated by the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly, to approve or disapprove the following resolution:

Preamble

There have been two separate communications on Auronet and through Massbulletin from the Office of the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, announcing that Mael Shanti Vidal and Satprem Maini have been removed from the RoR. The announcements are dated April 13th (about Mael) and September 29th (about Satprem), 2023, and signed by Mr. Sathyanarayan, Accounts Officer/Under Secretary In Charge, in the office of the Secretary to the Governing Board. In addition, the GB FAMC has resolved jointly with the illegal Working Committee (Anu, Arun, Joseba, Partha, Selvaraj, Srimoyi, Tine) to remove T. Ayyappan as executive of the Auroville Earth Institute because his name is not in the RoR.

As per Section 19.2 (a) of the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988, and the Auroville Foundation (Admission and Termination) Regulations, 2020, as published in the Gazette of India in 2020, adding and removing any individual in the Register of Residents is the sole prerogative of the Residents' Assembly either directly or through committees appointed and empowered by the RA for this purpose.

This has been confirmed by the Hon'ble Madras High Court in its <u>recent court order</u> dated 4th of September. It is to be noted that no process under the Act or the Admission and Termination Regulations has been initiated or approved to enable the Secretary to the Governing Board to remove any names from the Register of Residents.

Resolution

We declare the announcements and acts as mentioned above as invalid and against the approved regulations and principles.

We hereby resolve that Ayyappan, Mael, Satprem and any other residents whose names have been removed or omitted without due process, remain bonafide members of the Residents' Assembly (see translation at the bottom of the email).


A total of 741 valid votes have been submitted online and in-person

The number of participants exceeded the 10 per cent quorum required to validate the decision (239 votes)*.

* - Based on data received from the Residents Service, the total adult population of our community eligible to participate in RADs (age - above 18, confirmed Aurovilians) is 2387 (as of the month of October 2023).

Kindly note that as per the RAD policy "Only confirmed Aurovilians can participate in decision-making. Those who have been announced as confirmed Aurovilians by the Entry Board are eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes along with those who have been entered into the Register of Residents maintained by the Secretary's Office. It does not include under 18-year-olds, newcomers and any other Auroville statuses".

EMERGENCY RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION-MAKING PROCESS ON UNAUTHORIZED REMOVAL OF RESIDENTS FROM ROR:



98% (725) participants voted in favour of the above resolution.

0.81% (6) participants rejected it. 1.3% (10) participants didn't know.

Therefore, the Residents' Assembly approved the above resolution.

We would like to remind you that, according to the RAD Policy, "8. Responsibility for implementing decisions made through this RAD process lies with the concerned working group/s or resident/s".

AUROVILLE INTERNATIONAL USA MATCHING CAMPAIGN 2023



Donations

This month we received Rs. 304.127 in monetary contributions which includes Rs. 50,000 funds from BCC, just enough to cover our running costs of Rs. 3 lakh.



Milaap Fundraiser

Our fundraiser to construct individual dog houses for our dog population to shield them from the coming monsoon rains has achieved 46% or Rs. 55.340 of the Rs. 1.2 lakh donation goal. Thanks to Jamie, a wonderful dog lover from the US who raised \$ 875, and our friends from AVI USA, we reached our goal and will be able to construct new homes for our dogs very soon.

Donations in kind

We are very grateful that our Thursday donation pick-up drives continue to be a resounding success. As we have many small puppies in the shelter and only inadequate housing facilities, we rely on donations of cloth, cardboard, and paper to keep them warm and alive through the monsoon season. We have prepared a donation barrel for individual donations which will be set up this week in front of PT.

Expenditures

Animal Food: This month we fed our dogs: 1.450 kg of rice, 2.000 kg of chicken, 300 kg of pedigree, and 650 eggs, supplemented with donated food with a total cost of Rs. 1.1 lakh. If you can and want to contribute, why don't you sponsor a ONE-DAY-FOOD-PARCEL for our dogs for Rs. 3.500? It would make our dogs very happy!

Animal Health: Every Saturday our two veterinarians are performing 4 sterilizations and have limited slots available for either AV Community or privately owned dogs of Aurovilians. We hope to be able to expand this service to other dog lovers in the future. Despite our extremely tight budget, we are committed to providing free or donation-based sterilizations for adopted former shelter dogs. For other dogs, we charge our cost price of Rs. 2.500 per dog, which includes one night of boarding in the shelter. Additionally, if you opt to leave your dog in our shelter for post-op aftercare and daily vet checkups, medication the rate is Rs. 250 per day per dog and is only possible if we have an enclosure available.

Vaccinations: are available at the shelter (please pre-book) for Rs. 500 per dog. Our purchasing price per vaccination is half of this amount so your contribution helps pay it forward for the vaccination of one street dog. We are right now negotiating with a new supplier and hope to be able to reduce the price for vaccinations soon. We provide free vaccination boosters for adopted puppies from our shelter.

Rehoming: In response to solving the extreme overcrowding in our shelter, we have initiated a rehoming, adoption, and fostering initiative. Our goal is to gradually reduce the number of dogs from 300 to a manageable level, allowing us to enhance the care for each dog and eventually be able to resume rescue operations again. Despite our best efforts, but because of the lack of a proper puppy quarantine area in our old shelter, a virus has killed many of our puppies. If you can, please sign up for our foster program which allows you to give a temporary home to our puppies from 1 week to 3 months and can save lives!

Staff Costs: Veterinary Salary, workers, staff members, and animal handlers amount this month including Diwali bonus to Rs. 1.14 lakh.

Medical Costs: This month we spent Rs. 26.649 on urgently needed medicine, syrups, vaccinations, x-rays, blood testing, and puppy milk powder

New Auroville Dog Shelter

Thanks to the incredible pro-bono work of Shailaja of PATH Architects and Helmut we are happy to announce that the plans for the new dog shelter will be finished in the next two weeks and be submitted to AVF. We hope that after a successful budget negotiation, we will be able to start the construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter very soon.

Dear Community,

Until recently we were able to promptly bring your gas bottles to your homes with the electric van which we have been using over the years for the delivery at your request.



This **electric van broke down** a month ago and a major part needs to be replaced. The charge controller board which controls the electrical current going to the individual cells has failed, and this electronic board alone costs Rs.1.3 lakh.

We do not have the funds to cover this amount so we look for your generous support.

Until the electric van is repaired, from the month of November onward we will temporarily increase the delivery charge from Rs.50 to Rs.60, to cover the overhead cost as we are currently hiring a petrol vehicle to do the gas bottle deliveries.

IT IS THE BODY

To all Receptives, in Bhakti to the Supreme Divine Mother, preparing and consciously hastening the advent of the new species the Supramental being:

You know, some things that were hampering the body, some old habits that had come back, I only had to tell him: off they would go. And through me, he did the same for others. He always said that he and I did the Work (in fact, when he was here, it was he who did it; I only did the external work), that he and I did the Work, and that all that was asked from the others was faith and surrender, nothing more

If they had trust and gave themselves in perfect trust, the Work was done automatically.

In your body's cells, it is therefore a universal progress that is being made, it's the earth that progresses.

"You see, it's not a question of just these cells here: it's a question of cells in, well, quite a lot of people, hundreds, maybe thousands -all that clings anywhere and in any way to the higher Consciousness. DOGS ARE NOT THE PROBLEM!



According to Mother "every animal is an emanation of the Divine and should be treated with the same love, compassion, and respect as we would show to any other living being."

The Dog Shelter is an animal care facility for dogs who cannot live any longer on the streets

We are committed to providing our residents with nutritious food, medical attention, socialization, and training, all with the ultimate goal of securing a loving and permanent home for each one. Due to decisions made by the former management, the shelter's population has reached 300 dogs, surpassing its maximum capacity and leading to extreme overcrowding. Unfortunately, our old and dilapidated shelter lacks essential facilities such as quarantine units, aggressive dog enclosures, old-age homes, and proper medical devices. Despite these challenges, our team has worked tirelessly to provide proper care, medical assistance, and healthy nutrition. As a result, the dogs are now at optimal weight, vaccinated, dewormed, sterilized, and in good health. To address the issue of extreme overcrowding, we have initiated socialization training and implemented a fostering, adoption, and rehoming program to reduce the number of dogs at the shelter so that adequate care, help, and time can be given to each of them.

The Dog Shelter is not a veterinary hospital

The Auroville Dog Shelter is not a veterinary hospital like BARK India or the India Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education And Research Hospital in Pondicherry as we lack basic medical equipment, qualified rescue drivers, sufficient space, and funds to treat or accommodate an unlimited number of rescue dogs. Our monthly funding from Auroville is Rs. 50,000, with only two maintenances but we have to finance monthly basic running costs of more than Rs. 3 lakh.

The Dog Shelter is not a dumping ground for unwanted dogs

Almost daily we receive calls and messages, both from individuals within and outside Auroville, expressing discomfort with the presence of a dog and attempting to dispose of it by dumping it at the shelter. It's important to note that under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act of 1960, relocating stray dogs, whether owned privately or by the community, is illegal in India. Sections 428 and 429 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, classify abandoning or ill-treating animals, including dogs, as criminal offenses, and individuals may face penalties if found guilty of such actions.

Auroville should be a place of infinite learning and evolution and this should not only apply to human beings alone. Instead of seeing dogs as problems to get rid of, it is important to evolve one's perspective to understand that: "animals are not inferior to man. They are different from men. They have a different consciousness and a different way of seeing and feeling things. But they have a very important place in the economy of nature and a very important role to play in the evolution of consciousness." Explore a variety of blog posts on www.integraldogs.com covering numerous topics aimed at enhancing the understanding and relationship between humans and dogs.

A word about puppies

We often find in the morning a box or bag containing small puppies, some as young as two weeks old, cruelly separated from their mothers and dumped like trash over the shelter fence at night, or older dogs tied to the gate. The attitude seems to be that the shelter will have to take care of them and thus solve "the problem."

Our old shelter lacks a proper puppy quarantine unit and nighttime staff, and despite our best efforts in the past to care for these vulnerable beings, including accepting recently as many as 25 tiny puppies, many of them had no chance of survival and died when a virus hit. We hope to be able to start construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter soon to provide better care facilities but until then, we cannot accept any more puppies, as their chances of survival in the current shelter conditions are minimal.

What to do if you find puppies beside the road?

- Observe from a safe distance: As puppies are unvaccinated there is a possibility that they are infected with contagious diseases which might include rabies which is fatal for humans
- · Check for a mother: Dog mothers do not abandon their puppies but sometimes they need to leave temporarily to gather food. Only if you can be sure that no mother is taking care of them, rescue the puppies, and give them a temporary place in your home or community. Please do not bring them to our dog shelter.
- · Assess their condition: If puppies are hurt or injured please take them to a vet or a veterinary hospital.
- · Provide temporary shelter: A simple box helps to create a makeshift shelter. If puppies are in a danger area, move them a few meters into safety
- · Provide food and water: Not just for the puppies but also for the mother, and change twice a day.
- Share information on social media or local WhatsApp groups to connect with potential helpers, to find foster or adoption homes. Our shelter can assist you with this.

We have opened an account at the Financial Service, 252625 Stefan and Ancolie Solar Batteries for the donations.



A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

SATPREM GIVEN NOTICE TO EXIT INDIA

Satprem was given an Exit Permit by the FRRO in June 2023 after the Secretary of the AVFO removed her recommendation for a visa. He has now been given a notice to exit India at the latest by 31st October 2023. As clarified by the RA WCom in a massbulletin, this is not the same document as the Leave India Notice that was given to Maël in February 2023.

On 30th October residents have organised an open house event at the Auroville Earth Institute to honour Satprem's services and commitment to Auroville, prior to him leaving India.

A report was circulated, cataloguing how the AVFO and their 'working groups' have targeted him and the Auroville Earth Institute (AVEI), its executives, and its staff through actions such as blocking the AVEI's bank accounts, removing Satprem and Ayyappan as executives of the AVEI and blocking Satprem's personal Financial Services account.

EMERGENCY RAD ON THE ROR

On 25th October, the AVFO 'WCom' released an <u>announcement</u> on Auronet stating that "a video is circulating to campaign for votes based on incorrect information". Their announcement did not address the central concern of the RAD, which is that Aurovilians are seemingly being removed from the RoR without any consultation. Instead they claim that "Ayyappan Thulukkanan of Earth Institute was not removed from the ROR, he did not update his ROR". This is in contradiction to their previous statement that Ayyappan was removed from being an executive of the AVEI because he was not on the RoR. The RA WCom responded via a <u>massbulletin</u>, asking "Why does the AVFO 'WC' now say that Ayyappan was not removed from the RoR if this is the reason given for removing him as an executive of the Earth Institute?" The RA WCom's massbulletin also clarified other incorrect statements made by the AVFO 'WCom'.

AVFO MAKES A FINAL CALL TO UPDATE THE ROR

On 18th October 2023, the AVFO 'WCom' released a <u>circular</u> from the new Deputy Secretary/ Director of the AVFO K. Swarnambika, requesting that all Aurovilians who had not completed the form to update the RoR do so within ten days, stating that "any application received after that will not be entertained". A later <u>communication</u> clarified that the last day for submission would be 3rd November 2023. The AVFO 'WCom' also <u>released</u> a list of names of people who they claim have not submitted their forms.

The AVFO process of updating the RoR began in May 2022, nearly 1.5 years ago, with an <u>announcement</u> by the Officer on Special Duty Dr Seetharaman. This was the pretext for the attempt to "pause any decisions taken by the Residents' Assembly" that came at the beginning of the AVFO administrative takeover. The legitimacy of the RA-led processes was recently <u>reaffirmed</u> by the Hon'ble Madras High Court, when it was confirmed that, as a statutory body, the RA cannot be restrained from functioning.

DJAIMA, HERMITAGE, ARANYA - POTENTIAL EXCHANGES

After the news that Forecomers and a part of AuroOrchard might be up for exchange created strong misgivings in the Auroville community and beyond, the AVFO is now canvassing other Auroville communities for land exchange potential.

A plot at Djaima (near Kuilapalayam) was recently cleared of undergrowth, reportedly to prepare the piece for land exchange. AVFO 'WCom' and Land Board also announced and made site visits to Hermitage (located is on the far side of the Tindivanam highway next to Sadhana Forest) and Aranya (located closer to Ousteri lake, to the East of Pondicherry).



They met with the stewards and verbally noted that they were looking for underdeveloped parts of these communities to exchange. Hermitage and Aranya are among the oldest Auroville lands, bought with the Mother's blessings before the inauguration of Auroville. Both areas have been re-afforested and contribute today to a fragile yet essential ecological balance and biodiversity.

AVFO REPRIMANDED OVER RTI REQUESTS

Several Right To Information (RTI) requests addressed to the Auroville Foundation have gone to appeal due to incomplete or no answers from the AVFO. The Information Commissioner (IC) has in all these instances expressed "severe displeasure" over the conduct of the AVFO's Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) for not responding, giving incomplete replies or responding outside of the stipulated time frame.

Concerning the Governing Board minutes, the IC also observed that the CPIO was obliged to ensure it is published for the public through the internet, in an easily accessible electronic format.

ACTIVITY AROUND EVERGREEN/ABRI/AMI ENCROACHMENT

The case around the PKS (encroaching party) land grab in Evergreen and on the Ami/Abri corner has still not been resolved in the courts. During the latest hearing on 18th October, PKS' lawyers convinced the Madras High Court on appeal to appoint an Advocate Commissioner to survey the land and define the proper boundaries of the plots. You can find the relevant court order here.

On 21st September, PKS came and installed video cameras on the property contradicting an earlier injunction against him entering the property. Afterwards, PKS and his men came and put pillars down to mark the line of the encroachment. Evergreen residents are kept uninformed by the AVFO-appointed Land Board on the unfolding situation in the courts; they have also not received answers to their queries on how to respond to these actions of PKS.

VISA UPDATE - CONTINUED HARASSMENT OF VISA HOLDERS

The AVFO continues to update its webpage on 'visa statistics' with information that implies there is no issue for foreign residents of Auroville to obtain visas. You can find a link to their visa information page here, clearly stating that '0' visas are rejected and only 2 are pending for the 1,392 requests processed by the AVFO.

These numbers are belied by a daily reality in which many individuals and families are not able to access visas, as other administrative means are applied by the AVFO to exert its control on the foreign population deemed 'non-compliant' with its wishes. Some examples include:

Reduced visas

Since the Secretary's appointment, 6 people received a 6 months visa, while 7 people received only 3 months. On top of that, over 70 people who were due for their 5 year visa only received 1 year visas. This includes elderly community members who no longer have ties to their home countries.

Leaving Recommendation Letters pending indefinitely

In some cases, such as in the case of an active RA WCom member and one former Council member, Letters of Recommendation (LoR) are pending for more than a year. Another 7 people are affected. That means that these individuals cannot leave the country or move around; upon leaving the country, they may not be able to get back in.

Another means employed is to target children of families waiting for visas abroad. By refusing a LoR to only one child in a family, it is impossible for the entire family to come back as it will mean abandoning one of the children abroad. In this way, statistically only '1' visa has been left pending, while 4 or more individuals are impacted and unable to return to Auroville.

Another 18 visas are pending in the Foreigners Registration (FRRO) online system for no discernable reason, in one case for more than 18 months.

Extending LoRs claiming that the person has been 'blocking development'

A number of individuals have received a Letter of Recommendation (LoR) that comes with a note stating that the person in question has been 'blocking development' ("It is being brought to your notice that the above applicant has been obstructing the work progress as per the Master Plan approved by the Governing Board and gazetted by the Government of India.") They are then recommended for a one year visa, instead of the regular five years.

The FRRO in Pondicherry is following up on cases by visiting the affected persons and completing the visa application process with the reduced visa term. However, these letters are in many cases unusable for those who are abroad and need to get back to India, as Indian Embassies are unlikely to understand the reason and context for these notes and may subsequently refuse to grant the visa.

'Leave India notices' to individuals who question the AVFO

The well-published cases of Satprem (Earth Institute) and Maël (RA WCom) show that even without 'refusing' a visa, the withholding of the Letter of Recommendation, or supplying an LoR with negative remarks on it combined with complaints to the FRRO can result in individuals being given a 'Leave India' or 'Quit' notice.

MONSOON WITH AYURVEDA AND LOCAL PLANTS

During monsoon, the climate is cold and humid, rains and little sunlight increase drastically the moisture in the air and on the ground leading to a more acidic environment, sour taste prevails. The body struggles to keep warm and dry, the digestive power can also be less.

VATA gets cold and gives joint pain, PITTA keeps fermenting, KAPHA bloats and retains water.

An extra focus will be given to Vata imbalances, as it is the right season to reduce or expel Vata toxins (in body: stiffness, bloating, coldness, pain and inflammation in the joints; in the mind: anxiety, anguish, fear, dismay, confusion, doubts)

This is a period to slow down and care for AGNI - digestive fire

IN THE FOOD:

- All meals are warm, cooked in a sauce-pan, easy to digest, light, spicy
- Proteins: Mungdal, beans, chickpeas, lentils (all of these cooked with asefetida to prevent bloating), white meat, egg, peanut
- Vegetables: amaranth, green leaves, carrot, beetroot, cauliflower, bitter-snake-bottlegourd, moringa (drumstick), chow-chow, radish, pumpkin – all should be well washed to avoid contamination
- · Sweet taste with old grains barley, rice, millet, oat, wheat
- Fruits: apple, pomegranate, banana, papaya, grape, guava, pear
- Spices: ginger, pepper, long pepper (pippali), turmeric, cumin, clove, asafoetida, mustard seeds, ajwain, cinnamon, fennel seeds, fenugreek seeds, onion, garlic
- · Ghee or sesame/olive/sunflower oil (cold pressed)
- Drinks: herbal teas, warm or boiled water, with honey or jaggery
- Ayurvedic formulas to take after meals: Panchakola, Trikatu, Hingwashtak churna... with honey

AVOID:

- All food with yeast/baking powder, cheese, yoghurt, curd, lassi, beer
- · Drinking too much liquid during or straight after meals
- · Uncooked vegetables and salads
- Heavy and difficult to digest (fried food, pizza at dinner, etc)
- · Milk coffee, ice cream
- · Carbonated soft drinks

IN ACTIVITIES:

- Be regular in the daily routine, especially in taking meals and going to bed
- Time to keep Vata balanced with Abhyanga (oil massage + steam bath), Shirodhara (warm oil on forehead), Basti (warm oil enema)
- · Foot bath with warm salty water
- · Wash with warm water (shower or bath)
- · Keep body warm: neck and feet especially
- · Soft physical exercise: 30 minutes a day
- Yoga, Pranayama, Meditation-concentration, Qi-Gong...
- Fumigation with eucalyptus, neem, sage
- Nasya (oil drops in the nose) with Anu Tailam at bedtime or in the morning to clear the sinuses

AVOID:

- · Siestas and day naps
- · Intense physical sport or work
- · Moist and cold air, wind, fan
- · Staying humid after being in the rain
- · Long hours in front of the computer
- Skipping meals or fasting
- Staving awake late at night
- · Too many travels

Most of the above aggravate Vata.

HERBS AND MEDICINAL PLANTS FOR THE RAINY SEASON:

- Moringa Moringa Oleifera: to balance Vata and Kapha by increasing the digestive power
- Bhunimba (Nilavembu) Andrographis paniculate: in feverish condition
- Guduchi (Giloy) Tinospora cordifolia: natural immunoregulator
- Haritaki Terminalia chebula with a little of rock salt: to balance Vata and ease bowel movement
- Dashamoolarishtam for joint pain and inflammation, to balance Vata
