

CHAPTER XXVII - THE GNOSTIC BEING

As a consequence of the total change and reversal of consciousness establishing a new relation of spirit with mind and life and matter, and a new significance and perfection in the relation, there will be a reversal, a perfecting new significance also of the relations between the spirit and the body it inhabits. In our present way of living the soul expresses itself, as best it can or as badly as it must, through the mind and the vitality, or, more often, allows the mind and the vitality to act with its support: the body is the instrument of this action. But the body, even in obeying, limits and determines the mind's and the life's self-expression by the limited possibilities and acquired character of its own physical instrumentation; it has besides a law of its own action, a movement and will or force or urge of movement of its own subconscious or half-emerged conscious power of being which they can only partially — and even in that part more by an indirect than by a direct or, if direct, then more by a subconscious than a willed and conscious action — influence or alter. But in the gnostic way of being and living the will of the spirit must directly control and determine the movements and law of the body. For the law of the body arises from the subconscient or inconscient: but in the gnostic being the subconscient will have become conscious and subject to the supramental control, penetrated with its light and action; the basis of inconscience with its obscurity and ambiguity, its obstruction or tardy responses will have been transformed into a lower or supporting superconscience by the supramental emergence. Already even in the realised higher-mind being and in the intuitive and overmind being the body will have become sufficiently conscious to respond to the influence of the Idea and the Will-Force so that the action of mind on the physical parts, which is rudimentary, chaotic and mostly involuntary in us, will have developed a considerable potency: but in the supramental being it is the consciousness with the Real-Idea in it which will govern everything. This real-idea is a truth-perception which is self-effective; for it is the idea and will of the spirit in direct action and originates a movement of the substance of being which must inevitably effectuate itself in state and act of being. It is this dynamic irresistible spiritual realism of the Truth-consciousness in the highest degree of itself that will have here grown conscient and consciously competent in the evolved gnostic being: it will not act as now, veiled in an apparent inconscience and selflimited by law of mechanism, but as the sovereign Reality in self-effectuating action. It is this that will rule the existence with an entire knowledge and power and include in its rule the functioning and action of the body. The body will be turned by the power of the spiritual consciousness into a true and fit and perfectly responsive instrument of the Spirit.

This new relation of the spirit and the body assumes — and makes possible — a free acceptance of the whole of material Nature in place of a rejection; the drawing back from her, the refusal of all identification or acceptance, which is the first normal necessity of the spiritual consciousness for its liberation, is no longer imperative. To cease to be identified with the body, to separate oneself from the body-consciousness, is a recognised and necessary step whether towards spiritual liberation or towards spiritual perfection and mastery over Nature. But, this redemption once effected, the descent of the spiritual light and force can invade and take up the body also and there can be a new liberated and sovereign acceptance of material Nature. That is possible, indeed, only if there is a changed communion of the Spirit with Matter, a control, a reversal of the present balance of interaction which allows physical Nature to veil the Spirit and affirm her own dominance. In the light of a larger knowledge Matter also can be seen to be the Brahman, a self-energy put forth by the Brahman, a form and substance of Brahman; aware of the secret consciousness within material substance, secure in this larger knowledge, the gnostic light and power can unite itself with Matter, so seen, and accept it as an instrument of a spiritual manifestation. A certain reverence, even, for Matter and a sacramental attitude in all dealings with it is possible. As in the Gita the act of the taking of food is spoken of as a material sacrament, a sacrifice, an offering of Brahman to Brahman by Brahman, so also the gnostic consciousness and sense can view all the operations of Spirit with Matter. The Spirit has made itself Matter in order to place itself there as an instrument for the well-being and joy, yogaksema, of created beings, for a self-offering of universal physical utility and service. The gnostic being, using Matter but using it without material or vital attachment or desire, will feel that he is using the Spirit in this form of itself with its consent and sanction for its own purpose. There will be in him a certain respect for physical things, an awareness of the occult consciousness in them, of its dumb will of utility and service, a worship of the Divine, the Brahman in what he uses, a care for a perfect and faultless use of his divine material, for a true rhythm, ordered harmony, beauty in the life of Matter, in the utilisation of Matter.

NOTE:

- The Newcomer probation year becomes effective only after the NC kit has been returned and should not exceed 18 months from the date of confirmation.
- A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).
- A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.
- A meeting with the Secretary of the AVF will be arranged by the Entry Secretariat according to the availability of the Secretary and not at any personal request.

FROM THE RA WORKING COMMITTEE

UPDATES ABOUT LAND EXCHANGES (AUROORCHARD, PEBBLE GARDEN, AURO OCEANIC, AND MORE)

Dear community,

As you already know, AuroOrchard, one of Auroville's largest, oldest and most productive organic farms, is currently under existential threat due to a recent land exchange which was negotiated in secret by the Office of the Secretary and its appointees.

Here we would like to share with you an important update about this and other land exchanges.

In the past weeks, the new owner of the 10 acres of exchanged AuroOrchard land started fencing his newly acquired 'property'. This indeed included, as previously announced by us (and repeatedly denied by the Land Officers and appointees of the AVFO), the farm's main irrigation system, its borewell, the house in which two residents live, as well as the godown, cowsheds, an old and venerable Banyan tree, orchards, cultivated areas and even the entrance of AuroOrchard. We are shocked that until recently, the Secretary-appointed land officers continually made false statements that none of these vital infrastructures were on the exchanged plot of land. This has proven to be absolutely untruthful and we strongly denounce such disinformation and opacity in the 'city at the service of Truth'.

We also recently learned that 2.5 additional acres of AuroOrchard land have been exchanged, again without consultation with AuroOrchard residents and without following due process. This deal was done with the owners of Auro Oceanic, a private resort which was located within the Master Plan city center area. Although we are in favour of land consolidation, this needs to be done carefully after studying the benefits and the losses, which doesn't seem to currently be the case.

In particular, it is worth noting a few specifics:

- In 2020, the Auro Oceanic building and land parcel (0.3 acres only) had been evaluated by an empanelled Income Tax evaluator, for a total value of Rs. 3.88 Crores. On the other hand, the AuroOrchard land's market value is estimated at around 8 Crores per acre, which means Rs. 20 Crores for 2.5 acres. This means the Auroville Foundation has lost over 16 Crores in this deal. This huge value imbalance raises the question: who benefits from these deals?
- This is confirmed by the most recent actions of Satish & Co, the landowners of Auro Oceanic. After having acquired the 2.5 acres in AuroOrchard, they are now reportedly attempting to sell this land to other private investors, and are negotiating a price of Rs 3000 per square foot. This equates to about Rs. 33 Crores for the 2.5 acres. (13.2 crore is the cost for one acre, the total cost of 2.5 is 33 crores.)
- Exchanging land that has been purchased and named by the Mother herself, and without the knowledge or consent of those taking care of the land, is absolutely contrary to the principles and ethos of Auroville.
- Land exchange is being carried out using AuroOrchard and other farmland without due consideration for the present and future food security of Auroville, which is expected to be a self-supporting community.

Additionally, other areas of Auroville are under threat of land exchange, such as Djaima and Pebble Garden. In both cases, essential infrastructure (such as borewells and irrigation pipes) are located on the areas approved for exchange. In Pebble Garden, this again poses an existential threat to a world-leading example and pioneer in sustainable architecture and environmental regeneration. It is important to note that there are other lands outside the Master Plan area that the Residents' Assembly has previously agreed could be exchanged. Why then are these precious and productive plots being given away?

We will keep you updated as the situation unfolds.

We call for the community to collectively pray for the guidance of Mother's Force in the new year.

We strongly believe that each intention, aspiration and action can make a difference.

IMPORTANT! LATEST MOVE IN THE TAKEOVER OF AUROVILLE BY THE GB!

Dear Community,

We are sharing with you the latest set of regulations that have been published in the Gazette of India by the Secretary to the Governing Board of the Auroville Foundation. They are called the "Auroville Foundation (Framework for Selection of Working Committee) Regulations, 2024".

Once again the Governing Board and its Secretary are aggressively and secretively taking over one of the functions specifically given to the Residents' Assembly (RA) in the Auroville Foundation Act (Section 20) and upheld by the Hon'ble Madras High Court in its interim order of September 4th, 2023.

While the procedure for selecting the Working Committee as outlined in these new regulations may seem to give a say to the voice of the RA, in fact the Governing Board has given itself all the power since it gives final approval to the members of the 'Selection Process Committee' and the method of selection.

This is another move towards completely silencing the voice of the wider community, with the exception of a small number of sycophants, and continuing a complete takeover of every aspect of Auroville's life and development while trampling on the letter and spirit of the Act and Auroville's aspirations and ideals.

We will keep you updated as things develop.

As sincere Aurovilians, we must continue to use our voice as members of the Residents' Assembly, one of the 3 statutory authorities of the Auroville Foundation, to speak our truth and stand for our beliefs and Auroville's values.

RESOLUTION

We, the Working Committee of the Residents Assembly, (Aravinda, Bharathy, Chali, Hemant, Sauro, Valli) call for the following Resolution of the Residents' Assembly to be ratified via an Emergency RAD:

The Residents' Assembly resolves that the new 'Auroville Foundation (Admission and Termination of persons in the of Residents) Regulations, 2023' Register https://shorturl.at/w0238 - published in the Gazette of India on the 4th of January, 2024, by the Secretary of the Governing Board, is an overreach by the Governing Board and usurps the powers given to the Residents' Assembly as per the Foundation Act.

Further, we state that the Residents' Assembly, as one of the three statutory authorities of the Auroville Foundation, asserts its right to carry out its functions as detailed in the Auroville Foundation Act, with the purpose "to further development of Auroville in accordance with its original Charter" (first paragraph of the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988 - https://rb.gy/tflcgd.

SUMMARY OF THE ISSUE

The Governing Board has recently promulgated a new set of "Auroville Foundation Regulations 2023", which has been published in the Gazette of India by the Secretary. These regulations intend to replace the existing entry and exit processes decided by the community and to create a committee constituted by the Governing Board for this purpose called the 'Admission and Termination Scrutinizing Committee'.

t is apparent that these new regulations are inconsistent with the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988, and the Auroville Foundation Rules, 1997 - https://shorturl.at/bpwxl, on multiple counts.

The Governing Board is creating a committee appointed by itself which has all the power to admit or terminate Aurovilians, Newcomers and even Volunteers. Any appeals to the decision of this committee are reviewed by an Appellate Committee consisting only of Governing Board members, and finally the Secretary can veto any of the decisions of the above committees. This gives absolutely no weight or respect to the residents of Auroville to take part in these decisions, vis à vis entry and exit to Auroville and in direct contradiction to provisions in the Auroville Foundation Act related to this function given to the Residents' Assembly. We remind all of Mother's words: "Only those who have resolved to stay in Auroville for good have the right to intervene in its organization" (The Mother 22.1.1971).

Unlike the previous <u>Admission and Termination Regulations</u>, <u>2020</u> - https://rb.gy/tdeq08, these new regulations were created and approved by the Governing Board without consultation with the Residents' Assembly. And these regulations strip away the rightful role of the Residents' Assembly to be actively involved in the development, governance and growth of Auroville, disregarding the very raison d'être of Auroville as a self regulated experiment in Human Unity based on the teachings of Mother and Sri Aurobindo.

VOICES AND NOTES

THE ORIGINAL ADMISSION FORM TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE MOTHER – 1970



I bring once more to the general attention the admission form to be submitted to the Mother for acceptance, along with complementary instructions she signed too. I have an original copy of that form; others are kept at the Auroville Archive.

Mother's town and her guidelines are indissolubly linked; besides being her architect, Roger Anger had the task to draft major policies that the Mother would integrate and sign. The excerpts below are part of the throve that Roger passed me in the eighties, as a researcher c/o the Centre of Human Unity instituted by Kireet Joshi. We believed that we would make it, flying in the sky was our normal way to be.

At page 1 of the Admission Form is the text "To be a true Aurovilian": the psychic awakening. On page 2 eight points unfold:

ADMISSION TO AUROVILLE

- 1. The first condition for living in Auroville is "to be convinced of the essential unity of mankind and the will to collaborate in the material realisation of that unity."
- 2. The admission to Auroville is subject to Mother's approval.
- 3. Once approved, in the beginning the individual is taken for a probationary period of one year, which may be lengthened or shortened, during which he can see for himself how far he fits into the Auroville life. During this period he is expected to meet his own expenses, but in certain cases Auroville bears the expenses. The amount needed per month will be roughly Rs. 200/-to Rs. 300/- per person.
- 4. One is expected to work for Auroville at least 5 hours a day, including Sundays. The nature of work and other details are decided individually for each case.
- 5. When Auroville meets the individual's needs and requirements, one is expected to offer to Auroville all that he has and can in respect of material possessions.
- 6. 'Drugs' are prohibited in Auroville.
- 7. Climatic conditions: Tropical near the sea.
- 8. It should be remembered that in all matters the final decision rests with The Mother."

This prompts several considerations. One is that the Mother did not introduce newcomers' fees; in 1985, when I left the Sri Aurobindo Ashram for Auroville, this still applied. This was essential to allow young, committed idealists to join; in the Galaxy plan, which the Mother submitted to the Ford Foundation on 13.3.1969, one third of the inhabitants was foreseen to be below 20.

Another essential tenet is point n. 5, highlighting that people would be taken in charge only if they had no alternative means of subsistence: "When Auroville meets the individual's needs and requirements, one is expected to offer to Auroville all that he has and can in respect of material possessions": pensions, bank accounts, properties, outer incomes would be surrendered. As Satprem did: he offered his pension to the Mother, and she graciously provided for his needs. According to that form, people maintained themselves the first year; but if not even this they could afford, yet worked proficiently for the community, they were taken in charge immediately. At par with those already accepted, they were granted a basic accommodation and the Auroville Prosperity, in kind, similar to that in vigour at the Sri Aurobindo Ashram. Along with the meals, the Auroville Prosperity provided the simple items necessary to one's day-today life and some pocket money.

The applicants had to sign the admission form and submit it to the Mother, who would decide. Additional guidelines, also approved by her, completed the picture. In 1986 Roger gave me a copy of a major document, along with his first report on the town (7.9.1965); these were the first two documents I received from him, and which I translated from the French: the initiatory journey had begun.

That document concludes so:

"RESIDENT OF AUROVILLE STATUS

After the probationary period Auroville will support to the extent of its means all the people accepted by the Mother, and for whom an individual caution-money will be given.

Needless to say, from that date onward the duties of the selected people must conform to the agreement with Auroville, freely accepted by them. These agreements are sufficiently specified in all the definitions, all the teachings and goals pointed out by Mother, so as to be known by everyone and put into practice. No rule, law or constraint is necessary at Auroville, if the members of the community agree to replace these outdated methods by an active sincerity.

STATUS OF AUROVILLE CITIZEN

The Mother Herself will decide when a member of the community will become an Aurovilian – which implies that he has acquired the Auroville consciousness.

So far, there are no Aurovilians."

Today, as during Mother's years, this is the pledge we should sign and live: loyalty to the Mother is all we need.

AS A TOURIST IN AV

All you could do as a tourist in Auroville until last year was pay a visit to the Visitors Centre and its shops, and a long walk through the trees that took you to a view of the Matrimandir and its gardens. Nothing more than this. Not so much for such an important place. Now, fortunately, there are a lot of new things to see!

The route starts from the entrance to the Bharat Nivas area, and we are immediately among sellers of drinks, sandwiches, and coconuts.



A little further on, a cartoonist offers me a caricature of my face for 300 rupees. It reminds me of Montmartre, where on the way up to the famous Cathedral, there is an entire square dedicated to portraitists. Perhaps it is a kind of obligatory stop to reflect on oneself on the journey to the sacred places.



Shortly afterwards I was offered entry to the Kalakendra Art Gallery and the India Space for just 50 rupees. "Two buildings for the price of one! - says the woman sitting at the register - and in the India Space you can enjoy an exhibition about the master plan of Auroville! I leave both alone and continue along the path.



After a series of stalls selling handicrafts and bijouterie, I arrive at a 3-meter-high sculpture of an elephant, which acts as a reminder of a museum that has appeared out of nowhere. Wildlife Museum, the sign says, 30 rupees. I want to see it inside because I remember that building. They were the spaces of the old Post Office of Auroville and the Center for Evolutionary Research, now occupied by life-size sculptures of snakes, tigers, and apes. Evolutionary Research has turned into a tribute to animal life. Even Mr. Darwin would be happy. Stupendous!



I continue my journey and finally leave Bharat Nivas, pass next to the statue of Sri Aurobindo who seems to be there watching the tourists parade, and take the same old path to the Matrimandir. I feel better now, they've finished sucking my money in the Bharat Nivas amusement park. I'm finally walking across the greenery of Auroville, even if now and then scenes of devastated forest and roads under construction appear. It's progress, baby, if we don't evolve we'll be left behind, I hear a voice behind me.

Having arrived at the sight of the Matrimandir, I am at the end of my journey. Tourists are eager to take self portraits in all poses, with the famous golden globe in the background. And they don't seem concerned to see the devastation that surrounds it. Where once a splendid belt of lush trees shone, now the Matrimandir stands among an immense field of excavated red earth, as a survivor of a world that no longer exists. Somebody decided that a huge circular lake was needed, and they knocked down everything to make room for it.

At least I hope they will make it suitable for swimming, so tourists can cool off from the summer heat, or take a boat ride or an aperitif at sunset with the Matrimandir in the background. Wonderful spot for a magnificent selfie.



At the end of the day the tourists are happy I guess. I saw them laughing and having fun and they will return home satisfied with the nice trip. They will remember this magical place and maybe they will return when the city is finally built. And buying a timeshare overlooking Crown Road wouldn't be bad to spend their holidays here for a few weeks a year. Why not?

TRANSPLANTATION, TRANSFORMATION AND TRANSITION

Due to its openness, vastness and straightforwardness, India was the perfect incubator for this international project dedicated to human unity. With its heightened sense of spirituality, this nation represented the most nurturing cradle for a project of such nature.

The seeds were planted. Research budded, discoveries burgeoned, and progress effloresced. Mother India continued to support the project through a Foundation Act and a team of 12 national and international veterans to help this community grow. For years, this project sprouted up, branched out and flourished, garnering awards, distinction, and recognition worldwide. A social fabric was woven, bridges were built, services were rendered.

Then, out of the woodwork emerged another type of Aurovilian, green with envy as well as around the gills. It seems that there has been too much of watching the grass grow, and not enough of making the cement flow. Despite signing up to protect this place through its Foundation Act and Charter, dubious and destructive actions from within and without harrowed through and threw it helter-skelter. For 2 years, a hitherto heavily scrutinised question has found answer: a tree falling in a forest certainly makes a sound. Perhaps only because we were all here to hear it, as well as the trimming, the lopping and the cropping. How much wood can a good truck chuck if a good truck could chuck wood?

From the start, the only collective and individual aspiration directed at these anti-green greens is to turn over a new leaf, to lay down the plebeian plough, clamorous clippers and sharp shears in exchange for compost and a watering can (to complete the Holy Trinity of plant growth ingredients, sunlight is needed, but there is already more than enough of that in this area, even more so now). Indeed, despite not all of us being born with a silver trowel, a bit of practice, some patience and a lot of perseverance might do the trick to cultivate one's inner green thumb!

Now more than ever, this budding project is in dire need of fertile ground, and supportive soil so that it may strike (firm, fearless and final) root and blossom out like a sprout in spring, despite the forceful pruning that it is undergoing. Perhaps it will bloom where it was planted. Perhaps it will need to go out on a limb, sprout wings and fly to better horizons.

If the contemporary goals of our mother nation are less inclined towards spirituality, if an international community has no place anymore in this affable nation, if land is deemed too scarce and therefore arises the need for it to belong to a nation in particular and not humanity as a whole, then where will we land? Community, transparency, and honesty would help in figuring out which way the scales will tip, but the past 2 years have shown that this is scarcely to be expected when dabbling in such politics.

One thing is certain: the roots of the transplant remain unscathed and they run deep, the mycelium is motivated; we continue to root for the united colours of humanity, for the unified people of human unity. We shall keep the faith, get to the root of the matter, and continue planting seeds!

A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

NEW ADMISSION AND TERMINATION REGULATIONS TO GIVE FULL AUTHORITY TO THE SECRETARY AND GB

New Admission and Termination Regulations were Gazetted by the AVFO on 4th January 2024. As with the newly gazetted Working Committee regulations (see below), they were made without any consultation with the RA. These regulations essentially hand absolute power to the Secretary and the Governing Board (GB) to control who lives in Auroville. According to the new Regulations, an "Admissions and Terminations Scrutinising Committee" (ATSC) will be formed, which is intended to replace the current Entry Board and the newly-formed Exit Review Group which was recently approved by the RA via an Emergency RAD. The ATSC will consist of five members, out of which only two would be residents, and the three remaining "non-resident members ... shall be persons having knowledge and expertise in the field of administration". According to the newly published Regulations, the two RA members will be "nominated by the Governing Board", essentially giving full power of approval to the GB.

Some other changes outlined are:

- The ATSC will scrutinise all applications from volunteers and newcomers and will approve in each case. However, the final power would now lie with the Secretary, who "shall either accept the decision of the Admissions and Terminations Scrutinising Committee or disagree for reasons to be recorded in writing".
- The procedure to become an Aurovilian has been revised. Applicants must first complete a period of time as a volunteer (at least 3 months). It is stated that the volunteer should meet their own expenses but in "certain cases" the Auroville Foundation may provide a maintenance.

- Several new steps are outlined in the process of becoming an Aurovilian, including the completion of a new "Auroville Orientation Programme" organised by AWARE. It is unclear what would happen to the 200+ people who have completed their Newcomer process and been confirmed as Aurovilians by the Entry Board, but haven't been entered into the Register of Residents (RoR).
- The ATSC will have powers to recommend the removal of any resident, including those who are already on the RoR, following a process outlined in the document. However the final decision would again rest with the Secretary.
- The Central Government is empowered to communicate the removal of any resident or applicant through the Secretary if they have "reasons to believe that any volunteer, newcomer, resident or any other person in Auroville is a threat to national security or possible offender under any Act administered in India".

On 6th January, the RA WCom sent out a <u>massbulletin</u> stating that "We have been advised by our lawyers that at first reading this seems to be in direct contradiction to provisions in the Auroville Foundation Act... We are exploring immediate steps that can be taken and will keep you informed".

The RA WCom has since launched an Emergency RAD asking the RA to reject the new Regulations. Your participation is essential. Please watch the <u>video</u> and check your inbox for your personalised voting link. In-person voting is also possible, and all the details are available <u>here</u>.

ENTRY SERVICE OFFICE LOCKED

On 15th January 2024, the office of the Entry Service had its locks changed without warning or consent. The Entry Board sent out a <u>massbulletin</u> the following day, stating that "At the moment we find ourselves unable to continue our work as usual as we can't access the office and the computers. We'll be unable to meet new applicants and conduct interviews". This takeover of the physical office comes nearly 1.5 years after the Entry Board & Service were locked out of their Google Workspaces.

WORKING COMMITTEE REGULATIONS NEWLY GAZETTED BY AVFO

On 12th January 2024, <u>new regulations</u> for the selection of the Working Committee were gazetted by the AVFO. These regulations were made without consulting the RA, a move which appears to be in direct contravention of the Auroville Foundation Act which states that "The manner of choosing the members of the Working Committee and their term of office shall be such as may be decided by the Residents Assembly".

The Regulations announce the constitution of a 'Selection Process Committee' (SPC), which would be appointed by the Governing Board (GB) after a call to the community for nominations. The functions of the SPC would include reviewing and proposing amendments to selection processes (SP) and placing them before the RA for feedback. However, the decision of whether or not to incorporate the feedback received would remain with the SPC.

The document also outlines new criteria for membership of the Working Committee including having been on the Register of Residents for more than 5 years. It also stipulates that although the new Selection Process would be presented to the RA and the GB, its approval would lie in the hands of the GB.

DESTRUCTION CONTINUES ACROSS AUROVILLE

Since the Supreme Court placed a stay on the NGT verdict on 13th December 2023, Auroville residents have witnessed unprecedented levels of destruction, in particular tree cutting and land clearances. Areas such as Centre Field, Transition, Revelation, Youth Centre & Bliss, Aurovelo, Anitya, and the Southern Service Node have been cleared of vegetation by JCBs. In Svedame, JCBs arrived and started clearing the land but residents managed to stop the work when it became apparent that the workers did not know where community infrastructure lay. In Kalabhumi, the borewell was disconnected and the residents were transferred on to the Auroville Water Service supply without discussion or consultation. Residents were informed that this was because the Crown Road will "pass over/near the Kalabhumi Borewell"; however, the necessary land next to Kalabhumi is still in private hands at the present moment.

No information has been formally shared with Aurovilians about the purpose for the widespread and sudden land clearances, although some details have been shared by CPWD workers on the ground. According to the workers, the intention is to clear all of the 'right of ways' for the Crown, Outer Ring Road and Radials as outlined on the map below. This is despite much of the necessary land still being in private ownership and the fact that the plans appear to deviate in many respects from the Master Plan itself. SAMADHI SERVICE TREES FELLED WITHOUT WARNING

On 4th January, many of the trees lining the Crown Road between Lila Loka and Solar Kitchen were suddenly felled. No prior warning was given and no safety measures were in place. A number of people (including children) reported narrowlymissed accidents as large trees suddenly came down on roads or cycle paths. Reporters from Tamil news media such as <u>Dinamalar District News</u>, <u>Sathiyam News</u> and a number of <u>local</u> <u>newspapers</u> were present on site and covered the event.

The speed and scale of the destruction shocked many people, in particular as there seemed to be no logical reason to remove these trees, which had been planted by Aurofuture, the planning group of Chief Architect Roger Anger. The Service Trees that were destroyed along the Grace - Solar Kitchen stretch were direct descendents of the Service tree at the Samadhi of the Mother and Sri Aurobindo in the Pondicherry ashram, and their planting was funded in part by a grant from the European Commission. At 5.30pm, more than five hours after the action began, <u>a massbulletin</u> was sent by the AVFO 'ATDC' informing residents that trees were being cleared "so that infrastructure cables and pipes along the Crown can be implemented".

The RA WCom sent <u>a letter</u> to the Governing Board and the IAC, raising their objections to the tree felling. These concerns were also echoed by the <u>Auroville International (AVI) Board</u> in their letter dated 6th January. Two members of the International Advisory Council also shared their concerns. After AVFO spokespersons sent a Press Release regarding the tree felling, a <u>point by point rebuttal</u> was also sent out by the RA WCom, and was <u>reported</u> in the Times of India.

The RA TDC referred to the ongoing programme of demolition in an update which was shared by massbulletin on January 8th 2024. They wrote "As this text is being drafted, the sounds of JCBs, road rollers and chainsaws echo from all over Auroville... On January 4th, a particularly devastating 'walk' took place along the Crown, with the noise of falling trees paving the way along this path of destruction". They shared their work over the past few months which has included "reporting, documenting and sending letters around several areas of concern with regards to tree clearing, pruning and transplantation work happening despite the NGT ruling that was still applicable then." ALL OUTSIDE LANDS THREATENED BY EXCHANGE

According to information obtained through a <u>Right to Information</u> (RTI) request, all lands outside the Auroville Master Plan may now officially be exchanged for 'consolidating' lands inside the Master Plan. This includes more than 900 acres of land. Outside land include (but are not limited to) Sri Ma, Quiet, Aspiration, AuroOrchard, Sadhana Forest, Auromodele, Annapurna, and many more communities and places holding significance for Auroville. Land at imminent risk are:

- **Forecomers** According to the Land Officer of the AVFO, parts of Forecomers are sure to be exchanged for Poramboke (public lands) in the City and Matrimandir Lake area. Read more about the history of Forecomers <u>here</u>.
- **Pebble Garden** Clearing has started and subsequently stopped at the entrance to Pebble Garden, a world-leading example and pioneer in sustainable architecture and environmental regeneration. The plot under threat includes their storeroom, borewell, and two water tanks. You can read more about the Pebble Garden project <u>here.</u>
- Aranya Reportedly, surveyors have come to measure the Aranya forest area for exchange. You can watch a short video on Saravanan's work reforesting this area <u>here.</u>

In <u>a recent communication</u>, one member of the AVFO 'Landboard claimed that for the last year, they are no longer involved in any sale or exchange of Auroville land. This would mean that no Aurovilian is part of these momentous changes to the physical body of Auroville. This is especially concerning as the deals concern land that is valued at large amounts of money.

In <u>their massbulletin</u> dated 13th January 2024, the RA WCom notes the enormous discrepancies in pricing allowed in exchange, giving the example of the exchange of 2.5 acres of AuroOrchard land for the AuroOceanic private resort in the Masterplan area: "In 2020, the Auro Oceanic building and land parcel... had been evaluated... for a total value of Rs. 3.88 Crores. On the other hand, the AuroOrchard land's market value is estimated at around 8 Crores per acre.... This means the Auroville Foundation has lost over 16 Crores (2 million USD) in this deal. This huge value imbalance raises the question: who benefits from these deals?"

AUROORCHARD EXCHANGE OF CRITICAL **INFRASTRUCTURE**

The new owner of the plots in Hope and AuroOrchard has fenced off his area completely on 24th December, including Jasmin and Aravinda's house, the borewell, the main irrigation infrastructure, a water tank, the godown, the 100-year-old Banyan, the entire cow shed, both farm entrances apart from internet and electrical infrastructure, and crucial cultivated areas. Despite repeated assurances from the AVFO and their 'WCom' that no house would be taken and that they would re-assess the exact plots to ensure that critical infrastructure of AuroOrchard would not be included in the deal, no support has been forthcoming.

In a recent email to the Governing Board and other parties, AuroOrchard management notes that they had proposed an alternative 2 acres for the new landowner to save the infrastructure. This has now been rejected by Mr. Kannan. "saying that we are two weeks too late and that now the fencing has been put and additional paperwork is already completed." However, this issue had been brought up with Mrs Meenakshi. the AVFO Land Officer, on the 17th November, and repeated requests for help went ignored. In the meantime, another 2.5 acres of AuroOrchard next to the road has been exchanged for Auro Oceanic, again without informing the stewards of the land. AuroOrchard supplies 60% of Auroville's fruits and vegetables, and is currently unable to execute its basic functions, which were indicated by the Mother herself. EMERGENCY RAD RESULTS FOR EXIT GROUP

The outcome of the Emergency RAD on the constitution of the Exit Review Group (aka 'Termination Committee'), was announced by the RAS on 26th December 2023. A total of 521 valid votes were submitted online and in-person. 97% (507) participants voted in favour of 9 nominees as members of the Exit Review Group (aka 'Termination Committee'): Ashesh JOSHI, Auradha MARKUS, Buvanasundari SUDHARSEN, Ramesh Rao (Bunty) ACHANTA, Dhandapani SELLAKANNU, Ganesh KALIAPPAN, Pascal François Dominique (Rakhal) VENET, Rakhee KANE, Simonette Albertine (Tineke) SMITS.

It is unclear how the Exit Review Group will now be able to function given the new Admission and Termination Regulations.

REPORTS: DECADES OF DEDICATION IN AUROVILLE, AND DOSSIERS ABOUT THE TAKEOVER OF AUROVILLE

The RA WCom shared several detailed reports with the community on 1st January 2024. The first is called "The Development of Auroville's Assets - Decades of Dedication by the Auroville Community", outlining the material development of Auroville since its inception, including several specific case studies. Amidst repeated claims by the AVFO that Auroville has failed and Aurovilians have achieved no development in the past 50 years, this report details some of the community's many achievements.

Also shared were three dossiers which outline in detail the takeover of Auroville by the AVFO, beginning with the arrival of the Secretary in June 2021. The three documents, titled "Takeover of Auroville's Internal Governance", "Censorship & Takeover of Communication Platforms" and "Mismanagement of Auroville Assets & Finances, Natural & Human Resources" can be found via this link.

FOREST GROUP REPORT

The Forest Group released their latest report in December 2023. They expressed gratitude to all of those inside and outside of Auroville who have provided invaluable financial support for them over the past two years and shared the numerous ways that Auroville's forests have been negatively affected due to the actions of the AVFO and their 'working groups'. They stated that "it remains to be seen how the situation on the ground evolves for individual forests. For those who are unable to continue any kind of green work without economic support, from past experience, in the medium term, encroachment, refuse dumping, land speculation, tree cutting and the invasion of aggressive thorny plants and overgrazing will increase. This will in turn depreciate the richness and value of Auroville's forests, jeopardising decades of progress in creating the green and pleasant surroundings which we had previously taken for granted."

CITY SERVICE CONTRIBUTIONS - BACKDATED DEMANDS FROM AVFO 'WORKING GROUPS'

Several Auroville units have unexpectedly received demands from the AVFO 'BCC' for allegedly unpaid contributions, backdated up to 10 years. Some of the payment requests amount to several lakh rupees, due immediately. One of the units in question is AuroOrchard, which is already faced with the loss of its land. In each case, the onus is placed on the unit to prove they have made the correct contribution.

In a massbulletin_sent out on 4th January 2024, the AVFO 'FAMC' announced that "all previous city services contribution waivers approved for individuals'/ services'/ units' contribution dues to the City Services by any of the BCC/s or FAMC/s of the past (before March 2023) now stand canceled". This communication appears to come several months too late, as a number of visa applicants who had waivers in place have been presented with backdated bills which they have been forced to pay in order to receive a letter of recommendation.

MM LAKE TASK FORCE

The Matrimandir Lake Task Force which was announced by RA WCom last month, met with the community on 27th December 2023 and has shared their presentation from that meeting via massbulletin. 

INKY ONKY By Ongkie Tan



Great news for Spanish learners!

A series of three conferences to think about the relationship between spiritual and social life, a question which is at the heart of the Auroville experience. This will be explored through the lens of French academics who work in French research or teaching establishments, and who are regularly staying in Auroville or Pondicherry. They will be offered in French and/or in English. First conference, followed by discussion:

IN FRENCH (we will offer it again in English at a later date)

Divine Anarchy is what Mother said she wanted for Auroville. But people surely wouldn't understand, she added... Rémi Astruc is a French researcher - Paris-Cergy University, UMR Héritages (CY/CNRS/Ministry of Culture) - who has carried out research on different aspects of Auroville. Last year, during a conference at the French Pavilion, He had shared his research on the aesthetics and beauty of the city ("Eco-poetics of Concrete Human Unity", 2022).





GAUTAM'S PICKS:

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE AUROVILLE FILM FESTIVAL 2024

Hey peoples!!

So, to get a feel, an "aura" even, of the myriad films in the festival, I took a gander at the Auroville Film Festival website (filmfestival.auroville.org) and looked at their synopses and trailers and where possible looked up the full films on YouTube.com. Here is my humble selection of the best that the Film Festival has to offer....

The first film that leapt off the screen and tightly grasped my attention was the charming little documentary, "Bangla Surf Girls". This is a story of three slum-dwelling Bangladeshi girls who discover surfing which turns out to be an outlet from the grid-locked rigid societal structure they live in. The film contains a counter-friction, dissent and resistance to the prevailing social mores... which goes to the point of the girls being slut-shamed for surfing.

The three protagonists-the "Bangla Surf Girls"-immediately won me over to their side as I felt an expansiveness with their "escape to the sea". Poignantly, one of the girls says she is only happy when she is surfing, while the rest of the time she is depressed. The fact that the girls have to battle limiting social pressures is, as overarching world-building, deftly handled an bv the documentarian as the central conflict of a well-wrought tale. The girls' increasing self-confidence and growing prowess at surfing gets us to cheer on and root for these girls as the documentary evolves as a delightful, yet gritty, coming-of-age story.

"Dagh Dagh Ujala" ("This Stained Dawn") is a timely documentary on feminism in Pakistan, centred around a multi-city Aurat March (Women's March). The film wishes to portray the combat with patriarchy and orthodoxy, and establish feminine bodily autonomy through the slogan "My Body, My Choice." What is alarming is the backlash by Pakistan's extreme Far-Right, which labels the movement as "vulgarity, lewdness, irreligious and heresy." Shockingly the March is met with counter-protesters who throw rocks at the women. The film provided for me the notion of the dire immediacy of a need for a feminist movement in Pakistan. The film also relays a strong message about the formations of political organizing, strategies and movements, just as the film "The Square" did for Arab Spring in Egypt.

Out of the Auroville entries, which are mostly short films, the movie "Adithalam" ("Basic Education") hollered at me. It's a charming low-budget film. The most striking feature is its believability. There seems to be nothing fake or phony about the film, it comes across as genuine and authentic, from the acting to the simple plot to the reality of education in a small backward village. The young girl who plays the protagonist Saraswathy steals the show. Saraswathy struggles with her studies—she is in the sixth standard and can't even sign her own name. Dismissed from school by the principal, the heart-warming turning point occurs when a dedicated teacher takes a personal interest in teaching Saraswathy. The film ends with Saraswathy not only taking part in an essay-writing competition, but winning it.

"The Clean Up" starts with a whimsical and even incongruous question as a premise: is a clean-up of the mind a prerequisite for the clean-up of a room, or vice versa? This short film is done in an abstract, wordless way with a lot of dancing. The best part of the film is that most of the cleaning has to do with cigarettes!

"Galaxy & Ganesha" consists of various renderings of Milky Way Galaxy-shaped designs, reifying the vision of transforming Auroville's shape into such a pattern. The technique starts with sketches from tree bark that are rendered Galaxy-like through computer enhanced modifications. The idea is to signify the beauty that is created by the symbiosis between humanity and nature. Pretty brilliant!

Next, we come upon a little gem called "Island Reverie". It is about a man returning to the island of his childhood and realising that he had never left...the most precious thing for him are the people. The film is so profound with artful gravitas that it can only speak for itself. Just take this line: "The golden light shining from within... revealing the weightlessness of the world." The takeaway: learn to trust so that you can open your heart to new experiences. A must watch!

"A Maatram" ("A Change") is a movie in which several lives are intertwined in the course of a day. From the initial few scenes, the film throws hints and suggestions of the connections between the various plot threads, which really are sub-plot threads. Although, I must admit the various sub-plots were not well delineated. In the attempt to "not give too much away", the filmmakers hold back on the clarity of the intertwined connections. Although the connectivity is revealed in the end, the lack of more being revealed makes the film a little confusing.

"Fallin", another short, is through interpretive dance a kinetic expression of what love does, stands for, and means. In the end, however short the film was (five minutes), I had to think: "Okay, that was good."

A very scintillating documentary on the list is "Aware: Glimpses of Consciousness". Using premises such as "What is life?", What is consciousness?", "What does it mean to be aware of being aware?" the film deepens its adventure through the research of six experts in the field.Starting with these basic questions the film unfolds as a compellingly magical entity. The main crux is that consciousness is irreducible and is fundamental, not matter. The argument is that everything, including objects arise in consciousness, and that it is not consciousness that is emergent from the brain. The documentary is an odyssey that tries to portray consciousness as an all-pervading field. It is a journey to the final frontier of science and spirituality themselves—at the confluence of neuroscience, mysticism and metaphysics.

Alrighty then, I saved the best for last: "In the Light of Aurobindo-Plays and Savitri in Auroville". It is about theatre and the artists involved who perform with devotion in, through and from the plays and the epic poem Savitri of Sri Aurobindo. The film delightfully dances with the inward thoughts, feelings and perceptions of the actors as they portray Sri Aurobindo's works and the actual output on stage. Here, Sri Aurobindo's work expresses the possibility (and inevitability) of human evolution. One actor cites the very act of performing takes the texts from the mere intellectual to being truly understood. Another says that he had to let go and trust the text. Yet another says acting became an immersion, a stepping into a hallowed, sacred space, which I saw manifested in the clips from the plays. The whole pivot of the documentary is how Sri Aurobindo's works are purely, beautifully and powerfully put forth transforming the actors, the audience and the very space of the theatre, into a palpable collective experience. The refrain of the "invisible" sticks with me-the ineffability of the works coming to life with the actors as mediums and agents, at the same time, where their inwardness coheres with the collective expression of the piece acted out on stage.

Hey! My name is Gautam Emani. I moved to Auroville almost three months ago. I love the (once again, brace yourselves) "feel" of the place and find myself connecting with a lot of like-minded people, so I have decided to live here indefinitely. I hold an MFA in Creative Writing (Fiction) from New Mexico State University in the US. But please do check out the films I talked about—and as many of the ones I didn't, as you can. This Film Festival will grant you sheer delight. I promise!
