CHAPTER XXVII - THE GNOSTIC BEING

These are the first major results of the spiritual transformation that follow as a necessary consequence of the nature of Supermind. But if there is to be not only a perfection of the inner existence, of the consciousness, of an inner delight existence, but a perfection of the life and action, two other questions present themselves from our mental view-point which have to our human thought about our life and its dynamisms a considerable, even a premier importance. First, there is the place of personality in the gnostic being, — whether the status, the building of the being will be quite other than what we experience as the form and life of the person or similar. If there is a personality and it is in any way responsible for its actions, there intervenes, next, the question of the place of the ethical element and its perfection and fulfilment in the gnostic nature. Ordinarily, in the common notion, the separative ego is our self and, if ego has to disappear in a transcendental or universal Consciousness, personal life and action must cease; for, the individual disappearing, there can only be an impersonal consciousness, a cosmic self: but if the individual is altogether extinguished, no further question of personality or responsibility or ethical perfection can arise. According to another line of ideas the spiritual person remains, but liberated, purified, perfected in nature in a celestial existence. But here we are still on earth, and yet it is supposed that the ego personality is extinguished and replaced by a universalised spiritual individual who is a centre and power of the transcendent Being. It might be deduced that this gnostic or supramental individual is a self without personality, an impersonal Purusha. There could be many gnostic individuals but there would be no personality, all would be the same in being and nature. This, again, would create the idea of a void or blank of pure being from which an action and function of experiencing consciousness would arise, but without a construction of differentiated personality such as that which we now observe and regard as ourselves on our surface. But this would be a mental rather than a supramental solution of the problem of a spiritual individuality surviving ego and persisting in experience. In the supermind consciousness personality and impersonality are not opposite principles; they are inseparable aspects of one and the same reality. This reality is not the ego but the being, who is impersonal and universal in his stuff of nature, but forms out of it an expressive personality which is his form of self in the changes of Nature.

Impersonality is in its source something fundamental and universal; it is an existence, a force, a consciousness that takes on various shapes of its being and energy; each such shape of energy, quality, power or force, though still in itself general, impersonal and universal, is taken by the individual being as material for the building of his personality. Thus impersonality is in the original undifferentiated truth of things the pure substance of nature of the Being, the Person; in the dynamic truth of things it differentiates its powers and lends them to constitute by their variations the manifestation of personality. Love is the nature of the lover, courage the nature of the warrior; love and courage are impersonal and universal forces or formulations of the cosmic Force, they are the spirit's powers of its universal being and nature. The Person is the Being supporting what is thus impersonal, holding it in himself as his, his nature of self; he is that which is the lover and warrior. What we call the personality of the Person is his expression in nature-status and natureaction, — he himself being in his self-existence, originally and ultimately, much more than that; it is the form of himself that he puts forth as his manifested already developed natural being or self in nature. In the formed limited individual it is his personal expression of what is impersonal, his personal appropriation of it, we may say, so as to have a material with which he can build a significant figure of himself in manifestation. In his formless unlimited self, his real being, the true Person or Purusha, he is not that, but contains in himself boundless and universal possibilities; but he gives to them, as the divine Individual, his own turn in the manifestation so that each among the Many is a unique self of the one Divine. The Divine, the Eternal, expresses himself as existence, consciousness, bliss, wisdom, knowledge, love, beauty, and we can think of him as these impersonal and universal powers of himself, regard them as the nature of the Divine and Eternal; we can say that God is Love, God is Wisdom, God is Truth or Righteousness: but he is not himself an impersonal state or abstract of states or qualities; he is the Being, at once absolute, universal and individual. If we look at it from this basis, there is, very clearly, no opposition, no incompatibility, no impossibility of a coexistence or oneexistence of the Impersonal and the Person; they are each other, live in one another, melt into each other, and yet in a way can appear as if different ends, sides, obverse and reverse of the same Reality. The gnostic being is of the nature of the Divine and therefore repeats in himself this natural mystery of existence.

NOTE:

- A Newcomer becomes an Aurovilian once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming Aurovilian is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible participate in all community decision-making processes.
- A confirmed Aurovilian becomes officially a Resident of Auroville once the individual has filled in and signed the B-Form and his/her name has been entered in the Register of Residents (RoR) maintained by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVF).
- A Resident of Auroville is eligible to become an executive of a Unit or Service of Auroville and to get an ID card issued by the Auroville Foundation.

Dear Community,

We are sending out this friendly reminder to all those who have had or are having difficulties getting a letter of recommendation for new visas or for extensions of existing visas.

Please inform us if you are a Newcomer or Aurovilian who:

- · requested a letter but have not received it and your visa has expired:
- received a letter with a negative remark;
- received a letter for less duration than what you are eligible for (ie, one year instead of 5 years);
- any other issues you have faced in the application process for a visa recommendation letter or for the visa application process itself.

It is very important for us to have a record of this information so if have not done so already, please write workingcom@auroville.services or visit us during our open house time on Tuesday mornings from 10 to 12 at the old Koodam office (entrance and parking opposite the Auroville Library). Names and personal information will be held in confidence.

LEGAL UPDATE

Dear community,

On 23rd January, the Madras High Court admitted three new cases, two of which were filed by us, and one of which was filed by an individual resident (who is a member of the Exit Review Group aka Termination Committee). These three cases challenge the recently gazetted Regulations about Admissions & Terminations and about the Selection of the Working Committee. The matter was heard briefly on 1st February and was adjourned for <u>a second hearing</u>, scheduled on 9th February.

In an open letter to a resident on 26th January, we clarified many misconceptions that exist about these court cases. You can read it <u>here</u>.

Additionally, cases challenging the membership and legitimacy of the Secretary-appointed 'TDC' and those illegally impersonating the Working Committee were heard and debated at length on 29th and 30th January respectively. Follow-up hearings are scheduled on the 8th of February for the TDC case, and on the 22nd of February for the Working Committee quo-warranto case.

We will keep you updated on new information as and when available.

For now, we invite everyone to concentrate within so that these cases may bear a favourable outcome for Auroville.

OPEN LETTER TO THE COMMUNITY

Dear friends and members of the Auroville family,

We are very aware that these last weeks and months have been particularly heavy on most, shaking to the core many residents and Auroville well-wishers.

Attacks on the heart of Auroville have intensified, with callous land exchanges, rushed massive clearing and tree cutting, and new regulations which aim to indirectly change the Act by nullifying the role of the Residents' Assembly.

Plans to exchange over 900 acres of Auroville's outlying lands, moves to take full control over who is allowed to be an Aurovilian and who should be removed, more maintenance cuts, the planned installation of a barbed-wire fence around all of Auroville's city center area, and the allocation of land and buildings to external institutions are all changing the original purpose and scope of Auroville as it was envisioned in the Dream of the Mother, and will unfortunately be cutting Auroville off from the local bioregion.

We have reached out many times to the Governing Board across the last two years, repeatedly proposing our active support and involvement in manifesting a truly collaborative approach for developing Auroville. Sadly, all these attempts have simply been ignored - never has the Governing Board even taken the time to answer or acknowledge a single one of our emails. Instead, the authoritarian and regimented takeover of Auroville has only intensified, making it utterly clear that for the Governing Board and its Secretary, collaboration and mutuality - in the spirit set forth by the Mother and Sri Aurobindo - were never an intended venture. To face such a brute force of coercion, censorship and falsehood has been increasingly distressing for many, including ourselves.

However, even if the times we are going through are tough and distressing, we have not lost hope. Sometimes, it takes a very little sparkle of light to change the tides. And, undoubtedly, <u>Auroville is a land of miracles</u>. Its very existence would seem to many to be an impossibility; yet, with the Mother's force pouring through the hard work of residents and all those who belong to the extended Auroville family, Auroville has taken off and has grown tremendously in the past 50 years. Nothing in Auroville has ever been perfect, but in retrospect one must acknowledge that Auroville has already achieved an impressive number of milestones. Nowhere else in the world has a small township of Auroville's scale realized so much, with people of goodwill from all across India and the globe.

Auroville is a unique place in the world, an unprecedented experiment in human unity, a gem for all of humanity. The path forward is still long, but much distance has already been traveled and <u>Auroville will not fail.</u>

We invite everyone to aspire and act with us for a truer and even more luminous Auroville to manifest, with the goodwill, participation and collaboration of all. This goes hand in hand with protecting the beautiful achievements that Auroville has manifested so far. Let us continue to stand for our truths in the face of forces which seek to appropriate, twist and repurpose Auroville for hidden agendas and private interests.

May Auroville continue to shine as a beacon of hope in the sea of transformational struggles that humankind is facing today, all over the planet. The bigger the challenges, the bigger the faith and aspiration we must collectively live up to and embody. Let us continue to dare the Dream - this is also Auroville's true purpose.

And may we always remember Mother's clear, unshakable and powerful words: "Auroville WILL be."





OUTCOME OF THE EMERGENCY RA DECISION-MAKING REGARDING SELECTION OF THE WORKING COMMITTEE

27TH JANUARY - 4TH FEBRUARY 2024

Here are the results of the Emergency Residents' Assembly Decision-making process, which has been initiated through a petition signed by more than 300 members of the Residents' Assembly (RA) (3.3 RAD policy, 2023 - https://shorturl.at/tAl34), to approve or disapprove the following resolution:

The Residents' Assembly resolves that the Working Committee shall be selected by the Residents' Assembly in the manner it chooses, as stated in the Foundation Act, 1988 - https://rb.gy/tflcgd.


Further, we state that the Notification - https://shorturl.at/eklmV - published in the Gazette of India on the 12th of January, 2024, by the Secretary of the Governing Board concerning the selection of the Working Committee members, does not follow the letter of the Foundation Act nor its spirit.

In addition, this Notification violates the whole spirit of <u>Auroville's Charter</u> - https://shorturl.at/cgij0 - which the Auroville Foundation Act set out to protect and promote (Ref. AVC/03/2024).

A total of 647 valid votes have been submitted online and in-person.

The number of participants exceeded the 10 per cent quorum required to validate the decision (240 votes) - according to the Master List data, the total adult population of our community eligible to participate in RADs (age - above 18, confirmed Aurovilians) is **2400** (as of the month of January 2024).

Kindly note that as per the RAD policy (https://shorturl.at/tAl34) "Only confirmed Aurovilians can participate in decision-making. Those who have been announced as confirmed Aurovilians by the Entry Board are eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes along with those who have been entered into the Register of Residents maintained by the Secretary's Office. It does not include under 18-year-olds, newcomers and any other Auroville statuses".



99,2% (642) participants voted in favour of the above resolution.

0,3% (2) participants rejected it. 0,5% (3) participants didn't know.

Therefore, the Residents' Assembly approved the above resolution.

We would like to remind you that, according to the <u>RAD Policy</u>, "8. Responsibility for implementing decisions made through this RAD process lies with the concerned working group/s or resident/s" (https://shorturl.at/tAl34).

RESIDENTS OPEN LETTER TO THE AUROVILLE FOUNDATION OFFICE

Dear Mr. Srinivasaragavan and members of the Auroville Foundation Office,

Thank you for inviting us to the planned meetings at the Sri Aurobindo auditorium.

We appreciate the intention of offering a 'platform for Residents of the Auroville Community to participate, to express their wish to work in any area of activity, any concerns, inputs, and suggestions, etc.', and for the Foundation office's working groups to 'share recent developments, and information with the Residents and respond to their doubts and questions.'

A number of us have been attending previous similar meetings, and the experience has been predominantly of a one-way communication from the Foundation office and its working groups with residents' questions being bypassed or inadequately answered.

A true fraternal exchange between the pillars of the Auroville Foundation involves giving the Resident's Assembly its rightful place and function, as envisaged by the Mother for Auroville and enshrined in the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988.

Drastic and far-reaching decisions, that ideally includes mutual collaboration and joint planning between pillars of the Foundation, have been taken by the Office of the Secretary in many domains (including areas that are the explicit responsibility of the Residents' Assembly.)

Informing the residents after such steps have been taken (and in some cases even gazetted) obviously does not replace the participatory process and consultation that was supposed to have preceded them.

It is this serious over-reach by the Foundation Office, and numerous actions going against Auroville's very principles, ethos and ideals, that has regrettably forced Aurovilians to seek justice by approaching the Indian Courts.

And since a number of matters are now sub judice, it does not seem appropriate to discuss these in the proposed format, unless the talks are based on a genuine openness of the Foundation Office to listen, incorporate residents' inputs and modify or retract its decisions, which may allow the cases to be settled out of court.

We look forward to the time when respect and mutuality between the pillars of Auroville will be duly restored, and a truthful and trusting collaboration becomes possible once again.

We all owe this to Sri Aurobindo and the Mother on whose vision Auroville is based, and whose Presence, Protection and living guidance we invoke for the future of this unique experiment which 'no nation could claim as its own, where all human beings of goodwill who have a sincere aspiration could live freely as citizens of the world', working together to manifest 'the city the Earth needs', also called by Mother 'the cityat the service of Truth'.

A collaborative process would include the Auroville Foundation office issuing pending visas in a timely manner without the many conditions attached, dropping criminal charges placed on Aurovilians, halting and reversing non-consensual land exchanges, ceasing the takeover of city services, restoring the maintenances of farm and forest workers and other people in services, paying the employees' gratuity, and refraining from selling our health care system to the highest bidders.

A show of good faith would be acknowledging and addressing these concerns and would be seen as a meaningful step from the AVFO to attempt to heal and restore the peace and harmony that it insists as the agenda for the upcoming meetings.

May Mother's Light and Grace guide us all.

VOICES AND NOTES

A NEW VERSION OF HUMAN UNITY IN AUROVILLE

Socrates says, "An unexamined life is not worth living."

Contemplating this statement alone is enough to examine life within this seemingly "Human Unity."

In the interviews, what do newcomers emphasize? An accurate and proper understanding of Human Unity! But what kind of Human Unity?

Auroville is divided into two groups. The first group, driven by the fear of deportation, remains silent and is deeply dissatisfied. The second group, driven by their interests, not only turns a blind eye to all the challenges in this community but also easily approves of the death of Auroville and its natural surroundings.

Have you ever paid attention to your fingerprint? Pay attention. You see the brain of the tree right there.

The approval seal of the second group comes with silence, perpetual encouragement, and closing their eyes to the truth. But what is the truth?

Have you ever seen someone who destroys a tree in their spiritual journey? Have you witnessed someone who, in their spiritual quest, tries to harm or distress others? Where in the spiritual books have you read, they say, "Don't listen to people's words, and silence those who disagree with you!"?

Isn't this complete stagnation that you observe in Auroville? If Auroville's slogan is a life without politics, then what exactly is happening in Auroville? What is your goal in this duality?

You are stopping the path of a new generation that can contribute to the development here. You don't reward those who put their heart and soul into it. Is money the only thing other than energy? You cut down trees. Those who agree with you have the best conditions. In essence, you are drying up the spirit of Auroville. Where do you see a picture of spirituality in the current situation of Auroville? Or helping each other. Stern and rude faces versus faces of despair, dull and frozen. Those who don't dare to speak the truth.

War is not just bloodshed and massacre. Auroville is practically in a war. They execute it oppositely—with a smile, displaying kindness, spirituality, and helping the human spirit. Show respect to the creators of Auroville, from whom you have only learned to memorize phrases and put their images on the wall. If they weren't there, none of you would exist.

When we talk about our problems to those affiliated with the second group, they say, "Go to Matrimandir, meditate, and ask Mother and Aurobindo for help." So why did you establish administrative sections in Auroville!

Instead of making things difficult for the new generation, give them importance and provide opportunities to implement their ideas. It's no longer necessary to cut down trees to attract tourists. Ask the new generation for economic development, not to dry up their roots or cut down their stems.

Reduce the theatrics, and stop playing games with the members of this community. Have the courage to listen to criticisms and speak up. The approach adopted by Auroville's second team is a sign of weakness and fear. You cannot block the truth, and the truth lies in the hearts of those who live the real Auroville, not in the memorized words of its creators.



FUTILE RUMOURS OR PLAUSIBLE SCENARIOS?

(A PERSONAL REFLECTION)

Over the past three years, the government of India, Auroville's host country, which had been a rather discreet and benevolent partner in previous decades, has decided to precipitate the course of events and intervene vigorously in the Town's construction. We don't really know what motivates them, or what their precise aims are for The City of Dawn. Auroville is undoubtedly seen as a potential "window on modern India", justifying draconian authoritarianism and massive investment to complete it as soon as possible.

However, we can't help thinking that Mother, invisibly presiding over the materialization of Her City, of Her Dream, is somehow authorizing this new stage in its growth. It's a fact that, since 1968, gestation has been slow and administration often casual and erratic. This observation has been made by Aurovilians and outside observers alike. In short, the government's current determination to turn things around could well be the instrument Mother is using to regain order and speed up the movement.

Apart from those Aurovilians who applauded and encouraged this rather robust external intervention, a good number of residents felt shaken, hurt and betrayed by methods they felt were arbitrary, opaque and sometimes brutal. When it feels like a blind bulldozer is coming to indiscriminately raze forests, homes and even individuals to the ground, there's no choice but to save oneself, let oneself be crushed or fight back. posal, regardless of the consequences, in order to preserve their gains and above all what they consider to be the spirit of Auroville.

These residents have therefore decided to resist and battle with determination, using every means at their dis

It has to be said, however, that most Aurovilians are not very young any more, and are growing tired of this never-ending trench warfare. Some are wondering whether it isn't time to acknowledge the government's strong will to build the town at high speed, and to initiate a reconciliation between them all, in order to preserve, in all this tumult and upheaval, the Auroville values on which they have worked for so long. Perhaps the time has come to go back to fundamentals, "to plan A", as one Aurovilian wrote recently, to the aspiration and inner flame of Auroville's beginnings, revived in the midst of circumstances perceived as hostile, in spite of them and perhaps due to them, like a painful but salutary wake-up call.

To stay or to go? Some are asking themselves the question. Some have not had the choice, and the outcome of a forced expulsion – or one provoked by the absence of a visa renewal – may await others. Some, too affected by the current heavy atmosphere, have chosen to leave on their own, perhaps thinking they would bring with them the spirit of Auroville, but which would inevitably be diluted elsewhere, in an environment not as spiritually favorable as the soil of India. The most convinced, the most courageous, the most sincere and persistent too, have already decided to stay, come what may, and to concentrate above all on their work, inner and outer, in consciousness as well as in matter, as Mother had asked of them.

In the meantime, rumours are circulating among these poor Aurovilians who have been tearing themselves apart for three years, feeling bullied, mishandled and harassed, as in the recent sad episode of the brutal felling of trees on the Crown Road, on the already-built stretch from the solar kitchen to Mahalakshmi Home. This massive and hasty assault was felt by many, and not only in one of the two opposing camps, as an ultimate and unnecessary provocation - as if the animosity towards the "foresters", responsible according to their detractors for all Auroville's problems, had been transposed into a destructive rage against the trees themselves.

The rumor machine has always been very active in Auroville, but in the current climate of fear and uncertainty, it's easy to see how it can literally run out of control. Most of the rumours we've been able to pick up may just be fantasies without any serious basis. But, as there's no smoke without fire, these rumours could just as well be theories conceived in certain brains, and therefore as likely hypotheses to consider, as nebulous potential roadmaps. Let's take a look at a few of these scenarios, from a non-exhaustive list, in an attempt to analyze their validity and relevance to the Auroville vision as defined by Mother.

1. Temporary trusteeship. Some on the Foundation's side argue that the Governing Board would have been given a five-year mandate (more or less) to complete the road infrastructure, according to the galaxy plan, as well as an unspecified number of buildings, and that at the end of this term the keys of power would be handed over to the residents. Balance would then be restored between Auroville's three governing bodies as defined in the 1988 Auroville Foundation Act: the Governing Board, the Residents' Assembly and the International Advisory Council. In many countries around the world, such trusteeships exist for towns whose mismanagement the central government wishes to rectify. This temporary trusteeship would enable Auroville, sleepy and lost in its green shrine, to be put back on track for irreversible urban development. If this were really the case, we'd have to bear this self-proclaimed salutary and restorative intervention for a few more years. We should then hope that Aurovilians will re-appropriate a genuine spirit of fraternity, start working together for the development of the Town, finally convinced of the urgency of the inevitable construction to be carried out, and that they will manage to reconcile on a new roadmap synthesizing current oppositions, such as for example accepting without rear thought the concept of the galaxy but adjusting it to 21st century advances in standards, methods, and even building materials. It would also be essential to avoid falling into the old trap of vindictive purge campaigns, such as "hunting down collabos", which would be a regrettable step backwards, into the old world that we need to forget and move beyond. Under this scenario, the damage could be circumscribed, and Auroville's derailment avoided.

- 2. AuroUniversity, AuroSmartCity, AuroDisneyland? The previous rumour, however, could be the result of a concerted plan to get the message across to any recalcitrant members of the community, and to put any resistance to sleep. And the governmental authority, through the members of the Secretariat and the Governing Board chosen by it, would remain in a position of absolute power indefinitely. The temporary would then become the permanent, and the government, eager to recover its stake, would become the administrator of either a profitably managed mega-university campus, or another SmartCity ruled by artificial intelligence and algorithms, or - the worst solution - that of a lucrative tourist complex, a kind of spiritual mega-Disneyland, of which Aurovilians would perhaps become mere figurants. The gigantic fance surrounding the city which has just been gigantic fence surrounding the city, which has just been enigmatically decided by the Governing Board, would serve to protect and secure the area from any unwanted intrusion. Such a wall would mark clearly a break with Auroville's environment, annihilating all natural links and exchanges with the Green Belt, the villages and the bio-region, literally suffocating the town's breathing and energy flow. These scenarios or hypotheses, which many fear and anticipate for Auroville, clearly do not correspond to the Dream of Her founder, and would mean a deviation, a misdirection from its vocation, which Mother so clearly defined in 1972: "a center of transformation, a small nucleus of men who transform themselves and set an example to the world."
- 3. The Great Replacement. According to this scenario, Auroville would be emptied of all its current residents, sooner rather than later, and replaced by younger, more plastic and less reluctant residents. The status of Aurovilian, as defined by Mother, would be effectively abolished. Residents would be made up mainly of volunteers for ephemeral, interchangeable use, deprived of any decision-making power, as well as visitors constituting a significant source of income. Construction would proceed unhindered, under government supervision. The international character of the project could be maintained, and the teachings of Sri Aurobindo and Mother made compulsory for all. This could keep up appearances for distant or superficial observers, making them believe that Auroville still really exists. What this short-sighted vision fails to grasp is that Auroville would then be nothing more than an empty shell, devoid of any interest, and deprived of the power of attraction that has made it so appealing up to now. Aurovilians are not ashram sadhaks, nor spiritual soldiers capable of reciting Savitri in one breath. They are representatives – specimens – of real humanity, with all its imperfections and shortcomings. Every Aurovilian, Mother rightly said, represents an impossibility to be solved, for such is the material on which Consciousness must work in order to transform it. Many Aurovilians arrived without ever having read a line on yoga, but willingly adhering to the statements of the Auroville Charter, and joyfully advancing along the path of the Great Adventure, invoked by Mother, they gradually imbibed the atmosphere of Auroville and Mother's consciousness, and became for many "Warriors of Light". Of course, the new residents could also eventually absorb and embody the spirit of Auroville, but in the best of the cases, this roadmap of the Great Replacement would set us back several decades. Without necessarily implying total failure, this scenario would be harmful, both for Auroville and for the world
- 4. Tabula rasa: "Clean slate" or "clean house", this is the most dizzying (or delirious) of perspectives, no longer the Dream, but pure nightmare. All residents are evicted, the forest is razed to the ground, and all buildings are demolished within the perimeter of the town, with the exception, presumably, of the Matrimandir. Sheltered by the famous and mysterious fence, all infrastructure and buildings could then be built, freely and without constraint, in an accelerated manner, according to the Master plan in hand. In many countries around the world, and even in India (Lavasa) and Malaysia (Forest City), there are brand-new cities, some of them sumptuous, but completely uninhabited, ghost towns, veritable urban deserts. And yet, according to some inspired thinkers, more or less versed in occultism, all it would take is to build the city according to an immutable sacred geometry, a "magic yantra", for the supramental to naturally invest these brand-new, immaculate buildings. As human beings are not worthy of the Dream, the long and chaotic phase of transformation would be dispensed with.

The very structure of the radiant galaxy, playing the role of a gigantic, well-protected heliport, would be destined to receive the descent of the new species of supermen from the subtle planes. This unlikely hypothesis is not quite what Mother had in mind when she created Auroville. Worse still, our sorcerers' apprentices may well be in for the surprise of their lives and end up with an unforeseen result. When you stir the cauldron of occult forces, you don't always know what might come out, and the presumptuous magician can sometimes unleash harmful forces of which they may become a slave. In any case, the scenario of an implementation built with brute force alone, even if spiritually tinged, devoid of the aspiration of the human heart and soul, could only result in a flagrant disaster for Auroville.

To avoid the foreseeable downfall of Auroville, to which all these more or less catastrophic roadmaps are leading us, there is only one solution - and one that more and more supporters of both sides of the debate are embracing, for there can be no winners in a fratricidal fight:

at last, come together and work together, with determination, avoiding as far as possible ill-considered, hasty and clumsy decisions. This is the only way to correct the potential deviations, or betrayals, indicated by the scenarios described above, and put Auroville back on the path to its destiny. This outcome is only possible, however, if the large group of moderates succeeds in neutralizing the extremists - those who, on the one hand, don't want the town and are determined to preserve the status quo ad vitam aeternam by systematically blocking all construction projects, and, on the other, those who refuse the slightest dialogue, are closed to compromise and intend to make a clean sweep of all those who don't fully share their same perspectives. So we need to adopt a cruising pace, rejecting both the spirit of systematic blocking that has slowed Auroville's development and the spirit of absolute authoritarianism that would like to speed it up in a hectic and careless way. Perhaps this gathering will not take place in words, too often inspired by the ego and the short-sighted, divisive mind, but in an immaterial, subtle way, in the silence of the depths of the heart. The method remains to be discovered, but this is part of the journey of the Adventure that is Auroville.

In order to save Auroville from all the perils, real or virtual, that threaten it, may Mother's Grace protect and guide Aurovilians by uniting them in Auroville's cardinal virtues:

Fraternity, Resilience, Comprehension, Patience, and above all, surrender to the will of the Divine.

May it be according to Mother's Will and Grace above and beyond any personal preference,

A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

LEGAL UPDATE & NEW CASES ADMITTED AT THE MADRAS HIGH COURT

On 23rd January, the Madras High Court <u>admitted</u> three new cases, two of which were filed by the RA WCom, and one of which was filed by an individual resident. These three cases challenge the recently gazetted AVFO Regulations about Admissions & Terminations, and about the Selection of the Working Committee (see below). As <u>reported</u> by the RA WCom on 2nd February, the matter was heard on 1st February, following which a second hearing is scheduled on 9th February.

In an <u>Auronet posting</u> dated 24th January, a resident aligned with the AVFO addressed the members of the RA WCom, questioning and challenging these new cases. The RA WCom replied with <u>an open letter</u> on 26th January, to clarify some of their misleading statements. The RA Wcom emphasised that the cases were not against the Government because "Officers of the Auroville Foundation are not equated to the Government of India".


They stated that the purpose of the cases is to uphold a law voted by the Parliament of India. Among other points, the RA WCom also stated that they "are acting under the authority of the Residents' Assembly as the Working Committee selected by it, and ... have been striving to uphold its decisions and its functions". In parallel, cases challenging the membership and legitimacy of the AVFO 'TDC' and AVFO 'WCom' were heard on 29th and 30th January. Follow-up hearings are scheduled on 8th February for the TDC case, and 22nd February for the WCom 'quo warranto' case. As for the Evergreen/Abri/Ami land grab by PKS, court-appointed surveyors visited the site recently and the next hearing is scheduled for 12th February.

ENTRY SERVICE TAKEOVER AND RAD RESULTS REGARDING AVFO ADMISSION & TERMINATION REGULATIONS

On 4th January 2024, the AVFO published new Admission and Termination Regulations for Auroville in the Gazette of India. These regulations state that the Governing Board (GB) has the sole power to nominate a committee to decide who can become Aurovilian as well as the power to expel any Aurovilian from the community. These regulations are in direct contradiction to the Auroville Foundation Act, which states that admission and termination is a matter to be decided by the Residents Assembly (RA), see here. In response, the RA WCom launched an Emergency RAD on 14th January stating that these new regulations are an overreach by the GB. The RA WCom also organised a General Meeting followed by questions at Kalabhumi on 18th January, attended by approximately 300 residents. Their presentation illustrated the key differences between the new Regulations and the previous ones, showing how the new Regulations contradict the Auroville Foundation Act and other relevant documents.

After a voting period of 7 days, the <u>results of this Emergency RAD</u> were published by the RAS on 23rd January. 710 residents participated in the emergency RAD with 98.7% (701 participants) voting in favour of the resolution.




Despite the RAD Results, the Entry Service and Board received a mail from the AVFO 'FAMC' on 1st February at 9pm, ordering that "the Entry Board & Entry Service operations are to be stopped immediately." In an Auronet post, the AVFO 'WCom' also mentioned that "Once the ATSC [Admission and Termination Scrutinising Committee] is formed, it will start scrutinizing the applications for Volunteer/ Newcomer/ Resident both for admission and also for termination."

RAD RESULTS ON THE NEW AVFO WORKING COMMITTEE REGULATIONS

Through a petition signed by over 300 residents, the community called for an Emergency RAD (E-RAD) on the new "Auroville Foundation (Framework for Selection of Working Committee) Regulations" gazetted by the AVFO on 12th January 2024. This E-RAD challenged the new Regulations, affirming the role of the RA in appointing representatives for its Working Committee. You can read the RAD Resolution in English, as well as in Tamil, French, Spanish, Italian, Korean and Russian.

After a voting period of 7 days, the <u>results of this Emergency RAD</u> were published by the RAS on 5th February. 647 residents participated in the emergency RAD with 99.2% (642 participants) voting in favour of the resolution.



PRIVATIZATION OF AUROVILLE'S HEALTH SECTOR

ThOn 30th January, the AVFO published on its website (and then in The Hindu) a notice inviting private hospitals to share their "expression of interest" in operating and managing "the hospital in Auroville". The notice stated that a pre-selection would be made, after which the shortlisted hospitals would be required "to submit their technical and financial bid" to the AVFO. The proposal is "to set up a fully functional Allopathic clinic inside Auroville". The plans mention expected clinic facilities with an exact number of doctors, workers, pharmacists, lab technicians, and watchmen. The notice adds that "Auroville will provide a building to run the hospital", and that "the health facility will be set up in the existing building of Auroville and there will be no requirement for construction of any new building for this purpose".

It is not mentioned which assets would be repurposed for the occasion, however sources indicate that some members of Sante and Arka have already been approached, and that Mahalakshmi Home and the Health Center could also be earmarked.


This move is the first of its kind in privatizing the health sector in Auroville and outsourcing activities related to the health of Aurovilians to a private clinic. It is also a move away from integrated health care as is currently offered to Aurovilians seeking a balance between allopathic medicine and holistic approaches.

INTENSE TREE CLEARING CONTINUES FOR NEW TOWN HALL BUILDING, OUTER RING ROAD AND OTHER AREAS

Tree cutting in the Town Hall area



Tree clearing around the Town Hall parking lot took place last week, on 26th January, a national holiday. Many mature trees, including Neem and other endemic species, were felled in order to make way for a new and larger Town Hall. A <u>picture</u> and a <u>3D model</u> of the planned building were published by AVFO appointees, with our current Town Hall seen to the right of the 3D model. This new building is estimated to be more than triple the size of the existing Town Hall building. The RA was not informed or consulted prior to planning this new construction, and there is no clarity as to where its funding is coming from.



Tree cutting for the Outer Ring Road near Sharnga

On 2nd February, tree cutting started for the planned Outer Ring Road at the back of Sharnga on the Sukhavati side. As with other instances of recent tree clearing, there are no markings, no surveyors, and there were no warnings that the work would begin.

Tree cutting has also continued in other areas of Auroville, such as in the Southern service node, in Bliss forest behind the Youth Centre, on the planned radials, and in the location of the planned 'Line of Goodwill'. AUROVILLE SAFETY & SECURITY SUSPENDED BY AVFO

In an ongoing move by the AVFO to suspend and takeover Auroville community-initiated services and administration, the AVFO have suspended the Auroville Safety and Security team (AVSST). On the 19th of January, 5 out of the 6 Aurovilian members of AVSST received a mail from the AVFO 'BCC' informing them that they will no longer receive maintenances for their work, based on their policy for "Realignment of Work for Aurovilians". In a message addressed to the community, the team stated that their emergency telephone number (9443090107) will no longer be available and have shared a list of relevant emergency numbers. Aurovilians have no community emergency first responders or security service for the time being, meaning that any dispute needing intervention would require police presence, a contravention to the Mother's wishes for Auroville.

39TH GB FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The <u>39th Meeting Minutes</u> of the GB's Finance Committee were recently made public. Although these minutes are not dated, their contents indicate that the meeting took place sometime between August and December 2023. These minutes include many elements that concern Auroville as a whole without consulting the residents. In item 39.06, an approval is included to take a loan of 132.1 crores (15.8 million USD) for housing development in Auroville, which would need to be refunded "by future residents of Auroville through their monthly maintenance scheme". There is no clarity as to the possible consequences of this loan if future residents are unable to repay it.

A compilation of extracts from these 39th FC Meeting Minutes, together with a summary of the key points and some additional observations, is available here.

63RD, 64TH AND 65TH GB MEETING MINUTES

On 29th January, the RA WCom published via massbulletin the Minutes of the 63rd, 64th and 65th GB Meetings. These Minutes had been kept in secrecy for months. As noted by the RA WCom, "there are a number of topics and decisions made in these meetings that are deeply disturbing". One decision mentioned is the approval for the budget for a barbed-wire fencing "boundary wall" to be erected around the Auroville city center area, which would effectively cut it from the Greenbelt and neighbourhood. Additional observations on the 63rd, 64th and 65th Minutes will be shared shortly, and included in an upcoming issue of the Bulletin. In the meantime, the RA WCom has invited anyone who "would like to share their own thoughts and observations to do so by writing to workingcom@auroville.services".

MISCELLANEOUS NEWS

- Meetings called by AVFO and their appointees: The AVFO 'groups' organised a meeting of their "community coordinators" on 26th January, for which they invited many individuals through emails and personal phone calls. It was attended by about 60 people. Reportedly, false information was given in this meeting, such as a claim that no maintenances had been cut which is factually untrue as about 160 individuals have been affected by maintenance cuts.
- Another meeting has also been called by the AVFO only for "
 the Residents entered in the RoR" on three consecutive days,
 between 7th and 9th February.
- RA WCom about Visas: In a massbulletin on 1st February, the RA WCom reminded "all those who have had or are having difficulties getting a letter of recommendation for new visas or for extensions of existing visas" to contact them at workingcom@auroville.services.
- Over 100 students from across India in Auroville for "week-long exposure tours": On 29th January, a Press Release posted by the Indian Government's Press Information Bureau revealed that Auroville was hosting a one-week programme under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, an official educational curriculum of the Government of India. The Press Release mentioned that "the emphasis of the initiative [was] on exposing the youth to spirituality and Sri Aurobindo's philosophy". The same day, the news was relayed by The Hindu. Residents of Auroville were not informed of this initiative and programme, nor invited to participate in it.
- Ayodhya Sri Ram temple replica in Bharat Nivas: On 5th February, Bharat Nivas team <u>announced</u> that a "miniature replica of the Sri Ram temple, Ayodhya which is made from pure silver" will be displayed at Kalakendra in the Bharat Nivas compound.
- More closures at Visitors Centre: On 20th January, the AVFO-appointed Visitors Center 'executives' closed two venues with a two-hour notice and dismissed their managers. You can read more in the <u>message</u> sent out by the Visitors Center cafeteria team.
- Meeting of the AVFO 'Farm Service': On 23rd January, the AVFO 'Farm Service' called for a meeting of all farm managers to discuss "desired changes in Management/Procurement/Sales Procedure" of farms. The meeting was headed by Mr Balagandhi, a retired agricultural director from Pondicherry. Among other points, payments for Auroville food produce would soon be paid to the Auroville Foundation rather than to the farms and Auroville farms are now advised to grow produce that has a higher market rate in order to be profitable. The AVFO appointees also insisted that Auroville farms should not do experiments in farming because any information needed can be found on the internet. Following the meeting, the AVFO 'Farm Service' requested the farmers to send them detailed information on their farms, such as assets details, soil test reports, etc.
