(continued from last week)

How many times, how many times have I seen that he had written down my experiences.... Because for years and years I didn't read Sri Aurobindo's books; it was only before coming here that I had read The Life Divine, The Synthesis of Yoga, and another one, too. For instance, Essays on the Gita I had never read, Savitri I had never read, I read it very recently (that is to say, some ten years ago, in 1954 or '55). The book Sri Aurobindo on Himself and on the Mother I had never read, and when I read it, I realized what he wrote to people about me—I had no idea, he had never told me anything about it!... You see, there are lots of things that I had said while speaking to people—that I had said just like that, because they came (gesture from above) and I would say them—and I realized he had written them. So, naturally, I appeared to be simply repeating what he had written—but I had never read it! And now, it's the same thing: I had read this passage from Savitri, but hadn't noticed it—because I hadn't had the experience. But now that I have had the experience, I see that he tells it.

It's quite interesting.

Maybe we'll have to reread Savitri?...

In fact, if we wanted to be really good, we would try to translate the whole of Savitri, wouldn't we? What we are doing now with the end [Book X], we would do with all the rest. There is a part I tried to translate all alone, but it would be fun to do it together. We could try. Not for publication! Because there is immediately a debasing: everything that is published is debased, otherwise people don't understand. We would do it for ourselves.

But it's very interesting.

Just the other day I noted something down on the subject (Mother looks for a note, then reads it):

"Very rare and exceptional are the human beings who can understand and feel divine Love, because divine Love is free of attachment and of the need to please the object loved." That was a discovery.

That's why people don't understand; for them, love is so much like this (Mother intertwines the fingers of her two hands) that they cannot even feel or believe that they love if there isn't an attachment like this (same gesture). And necessarily, the consequence of attachment is the will, the desire, the need to please the object of one's love.

If you take away the attachment and the need to please, people scratch their heads and wonder if they love. And it's only when you take away those two things that divine Love begins!

This, mon petit, we'll talk about again, it's a revelation.

That's why they don't understand and that's why they can't feel it.

FROM THE RA WORKING COMMITTEE

NOTE TO THE COMMUNITY REGARDING EMAILS FROM 'FAMC@AUROVILLE.ORG.IN'

Dear community,

We write to you regarding emails that several people have received from the GB-FAMC with the request to vacate at the earliest the Auroville assets they are stewarding to make way for roads or 'lines of force'. It is not in the direct purview of the GB-FAMC to take on matters of planning and development. As you may be aware, the ATDC constituted by the GB under Section 16 of the Auroville Foundation (AVF) Act, which had been directing such work, has been declared invalid by the Madras High Court judgment of 15th March 2024 (<u>attached</u>).

Legal notices regarding this have been sent to the CPWD and the AVF office on 8th April 2024 (<u>attached</u>), and separately to the 'ATDC' on 15th March 2024 (<u>attached</u>).

Therefore we question the decisions of the ATDC on this basis, as well as the fact that it did not have a GB member, which is a requirement of any committee constituted by the GB under Section 16 of the Act.

Additionally, the 'GB-FAMC' was also constituted by the GB under Section 16 of the Act so the only member with 'voting rights', i.e. decision-making power, is the ex-officio GB member named in the Standing Order. The relevant minutes of the FAMC, signed by this GB member, in which he authorises this decision, should be shared when such demands are being made.

With the above in mind, we do not recognise the decisions taken by these groups.

In case you or someone you know also receives a letter from the GB-FAMC with this type of request, it is good to ask questions such as under which authority they are acting and for the detailed plans of the area. Another important action would be, in case any workers or other individuals appear onsite, to ask them for work orders. If they cannot show any, then ask for a supervisor to come onsite with a work order, and then show them the legal notices and court ruling.

Please contact us if you receive such a communication or if someone shows up onsite. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to us.

INVITATION TO A GM ABOUT PRELIMINARY DRAFT REGULATIONS FOR THE TDC

Dear Community,

We request your presence for a General Meeting on the **30th** of **April**, **2024**, in Kalabhumi at 6 pm, regarding formulating draft regulations about the constitution and function of the Town Development Council (TDC).

As you may be aware, on the 15th of March the Madras High Court (MHC) gave a ruling on the Standing Order issued by the Secretary on behalf of the Governing Board (GB) for the appointment and functioning of the TDC (see <u>attached</u>). In a nutshell, the Standing Order constituting the TDC is invalid. A new TDC can be constituted only after new regulations are made, approved by the GB and published in the Gazette of the Government of India.

Another point in the ruling states as follows: However, it will be open for the respondent Foundation, through its Governing Board, to frame fresh regulations in tune with the provision of the Act and the observations made herein.

Many of the observations made in the judgement are related to the role of the Residents' Assembly in planning and development, including choosing the TDC. Therefore, L'avenir d'Auroville (formerly RA TDC), in consultation with the Working Committee, have taken the initiative to draft a preliminary set of regulations to be presented to the GB for their approval.

We would like to present this draft to the community and invite feedback. The meeting will start with a short welcome to the new members of the Auroville Council, Entry Board and Working Committee before presenting the draft preliminary regulations and having a short Q&A session.

AN ANNOUNCEMENT FROM TLC (THE LEARNING COMMUNITY)

Dear community,

We would like to inform the wider community that in a meeting called by SAIIER board on Wednesday 17th April, TLC (The Learning Community), was informed that SAIIER has decided to withdraw all financial support for TLC (facilitators' maintenances and running budget) and reclaim all assets accumulated over the years. We were also told that we will need to vacate TLC Base Camp by July '24.

TLC has been under the SAIIER umbrella for many years, categorised as a "middle school". Those who know us understand well that we clearly do not fit this definition.

We are not a school. We are a community of learners, working with all ages, from nursery to adult education, as well carrying out research projects on Integral Education.

While this news has come as a shock, and there is sadness and a sense of loss, we feel that this is an opportunity for TLC to finally embark on the journey we have known for some time will benefit our community.

Discontinuing under the SAIIER umbrella will enable us to continue our active research on Integral Education without having to justify or compromise on our visions, goals and their implementation, which clearly do not fit with the definitions of a school as set down by SAIIER.

We have met with TLC's parents and facilitators to share and reflect on this new phase of TLC, and to update the community on our ideas for a way forward.

The news brought up a mix of surprise and sadness, together with positive energy and a will to move into this next phase with inspiration and joy, believing in our capacity to flourish and grow from this experience, adults and children alike.

It was clear that all present know that TLC is not Base Camp! It is much, much more $\frac{1}{2}$

There are many practical aspects of this new phase to work out.

We are in communication with FAMC to move TLC to an alternate umbrella. Here too, we have met with much resistance blockages, yet we are determined and feel able to move through this period with grace and gratitude, and find solutions to enable the continued growth of this beautiful project which has undergone a deep journey of 16 years. We aspire to continue and deepen within the Auroville context of un-ending education and a laboratory of research into human consciousness and evolution.

We have faith, trust and feel Her support and guidance.

We reach out to our wider Auroville community for your support, be it in your love and good wishes or in any practical way you would like to offer help •

We would like to thank those who participated in the recent Matrimandir lake petition.

Below are the details of the results:

The Matrimandir Lake Petition, April 2024

Submission Period: 6th - 18th April (13 days)

Total Verified Signatures: 463

- In Favor of Halt: 461 (Aurovilian: 445 / Newcomer: 10 / Auroville Youth Below 18: 6)

- Against Halt: 2

(Aurovilian: 1 / Newcomer 1 / Auroville Youth: 0)

- Abstentions: 0

We have entrusted the list of signatures to the RA Working Committee.

Considering the past record of results of petitions on Matrimandir related issues, this is one of the largest manifestations of community engagement for a topic related to the Matrimandir in recent years.

On April 18th, a group of residents met and handed over the petition results (without disclosing the name of the signatories) to the executives. Regrettably, they were not open to dialogue with the delegation of residents.

Meanwhile, as seen in the latest public postings by the MM executives, they are determined to continue the excavation work, despite the call to halt the excavation from a large number of community members through the petition.

We will arrange an open reply to their letter as well as prepare for further actions to try to prevent additional damage to the Peace area of Auroville.

POSITIVE NEWS FROM AUROVILLE FARMERS

This report is to celebrate that despite the obvious recent setbacks, challenges, and all the negativity, Auroville farmers continue to do what they have always done and will do for as long as we can - grow healthy food for Auroville in ways that support the local ecosystem.

Last month, Auroville farmers sent **3,128** kilos of vegetables and **3,301** kilos of fruit to Foodlink to be distributed to the Auroville community, mainly through PTPS and Solar Kitchen, with 46 different sorts of vegetables and 24 different sorts of fruit harvested last month. In addition, nearly 20,000 (19,764) eggs were sent to Foodlink, along with 6,327 litres of milk, 846kg of various sorts of rice and 327 kg of polished and unpolished varagu (the latter procured from the bioregion and processed in Auroville).

When you think of how all this food has been produced/grown using farming methods that benefit both our natural environment as well as our bodies, the benefits to us both individually and collectively go far beyond the financial units in which this food is counted. Next month, we hope to also include produce from Auroville farms distributed through other channels, some of which spreads the blessings from our farms to Puducherry and beyond. MONTHLY TRANSPARENCY REPORT APRIL 2024

As part of our commitment to transparency, we are happy to present our report for April.

Overview

New admissions: 15 (215 since April 2023) Rabies suspect cases: 0 Adoptions and Releases: 7 Vaccinations administered: 9 ABC shelter dog sterilisations: 17 (66 since February) Deworming: 56



This month was a disaster as we only received Rs. 82.800 in monetary contributions which includes Rs. 50.000 funds from BCC which is the second month in a row where we don't come even close to covering our monthly running costs of Rs. 3 lakh. We urgently need support! Please donate!

Expenditures

<u>Animal Food</u>: This month we fed our dogs 1.8 tons of rice, 2 tons of chicken, and 600 eggs, supplemented with donated food items like vegetables and daal which cost us approx. 1.35 lakh.

<u>Staff Costs</u>: Total staff costs for this month for our workers, paid animal care staff, 2 veterinarians, and volunteers was Rs. 1 lakh this month.

<u>Medical Costs</u>: This month we spent Rs. 40.000 on urgently needed medicines, syrups, blood tests, hospital visits and materials for sterilizations.

Kitchen Roof collapse

The infrastructure of the old shelter is continuing to deteriorate at an alarming rate. This month the kitchen roof collapsed as the old support beams broke posing a severe threat of life to our workers. We had no option but to convert a half-finished dormitory into a temporary kitchen. As in the last few years, the infrastructure of the shelter had never been maintained properly and only sub-standard materials were used for construction, it is a race against time until it becomes unsafe to house animals there. We kindly ask Aurovilians and dog lovers to help us with their time, energy and donated materials to fix up the shelter.

Temporary halt of free sterilizations

Regrettably, despite our best efforts to secure funding, we are unable to continue offering free sterilizations for dogs adopted from our shelter and for financially disadvantaged dog owners. Until additional funds become available, we must suspend this service. However, we will continue to provide sterilizations every Monday at our cost price of Rs. 3,000 (Rs. 2,500 for Aurovilians). We apologize for any inconvenience and remain committed to ensuring the well-being of all dogs in the AV community and bioregion.

Inspection of the Department of Animal Husbandry

Our new neighbor, the Red Earth Riding School raised an objection that the shelter would relocate to the allotted Auroville land next to it, stating incorrect facts about the dog shelter. We have invited a delegation from the Department of Animal Husbandry on April 17th, 2024, to inspect the allocated site for the construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter. The delegation was presented with architectural plans crafted by esteemed architects, which were thoroughly reviewed and found to meet all safety standards, particularly in relation to the adjacent Red Earth Riding School, ensuring the well-being of both horses and dogs.

Following the site inspection, the delegation visited the existing Auroville Dog Shelter, where it was confirmed that, contrary to complaints raised by the Red Earth Riding School, the actual number of dogs residing at the shelter is presently 250 (plus 33 puppies), not 1.000 as falsely stated. Moreover, it was affirmed that all dogs are microchipped, vaccinated, dewormed, and sterilized, and are maintained in good health and good condition despite the challenging situation of the deteriorating old shelter facility. The Department of Animal Husbandry approved the new site and recommended starting the construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter immediately.

We thank everyone for your continued support of the Auroville Dog Shelter! We are moving forward towards a bright future for our canine friends and everyone who loves animals.

The infrastructure of our old dog shelter is deteriorating rapidly, posing serious risks to both our workers and the well-being of our dogs. Years of neglect and the use of substandard materials and unprofessional work have contributed to the shelter's current state, with internal fences, enclosures, roofs, and electrical lines in urgent need of repair.

OPEN LETTER IN RESPONSE TO THE LATEST INVITATION TO COLLABORATE BY AUROVILLE FOUNDATION OFFICE

Dear Koshy Varghese,

Thank you for the invitation. I will not be able to attend the event at this time. It is good to hear that there is interest from the Auroville Foundation Office to hear from the Residents. Unfortunately, this call also comes with the fact that there has been over 2 years of systematic attempts by the Auroville Foundation Office to silence, intimidate, expel, dismiss and ignore residents of Auroville.

This systematic take-over has happened through various methods; creating a parallel and illegitimate (by the word of the Auroville Foundation Act) administration in Auroville, dismissing any residents working in Auroville that do not comply to the wishes of the Office of the Secretary, withdrawing the stipends that support hundreds of people livelihoods (both in and around Auroville), destroying homes, and making countless unilateral decisions that go against the spirit of collaboration that Auroville is known for and cherishes. This is not to mention the verbal threats by the Auroville Foundation Office to many Aurovilians, the criminal court cases on a number of Aurovilians, and withholding of visa applications creating an atmosphere of insecurity and intimidation that is unsuitable and unprofessional. This call to meet and participate while all these actions remain on-going can only feel performative, superficial and tone deaf at best. One wonders what is the true reason to host an event such as this and sending an invitation that blatantly ignores the current situation that many understand as an existential threat to the Auroville community.

Collaboration and participation are absolutely necessary to build Auroville, but it must be a true collaboration, and one that acknowledges the reality that this community is currently facing. Unfortunately, collaboration is impossible in the climate the Auroville Foundation Office has created. There have been too many threats to those who think or do differently than what the Secretary likes for anyone to truly offer diverse ideas on how to build Auroville. Freedom of thought and speech are vital aspects of building a diverse, resilient, and forward thinking community. The intimidating actions of the Secretary have caused immense damage to the goodwill we depend on to create community, to foster the honesty, care, and bravery to share and build Auroville together. I fear that this feeling of discomfort to speak one's mind will plague Auroville for years beyond the Secretary's tenure in Auroville. I request that those working in the Office of the Secretary truly consider the implications of their actions and policies over the last 2 years, and swiftly take the necessary steps to remedy the situation in order to help restore balance and a spirit of creativity. A few meaningful steps that would surely demonstrate a real willingness to collaborate would be to withdraw criminal court cases against Aurovilians, cease to ignore the role and function of the Residents Assembly in choosing their own working groups, halt the hasty sale of Auroville land that has only incurred major financial loss to the community, re-institute the maintenances and funding for groups which have been cut, and issue visas in a timely manner.

AN OPEN REPLY TO THE MATRIMANDIR EXECUTIVES (ANTOINE C, DIVYA KARUN, JOHN H, JUDITH R AND SUNDAR K)

24th April 2024

We would like to respond to some of the key points in two recent postings by the present Matrimandir executives, '<u>Matrimandir diary</u>' and '<u>Regarding a petition to halt the</u> excavation of the Matrimandir Lake'.

1) **Test lake:** It is important to start with this topic. There was no clarification in your letter for why the executives chose not to complete the test lake and didn't conduct a proper study, before continuing on to the second phase of the lake. This appears to many of us as highly unprofessional and in contradiction to statements which were previously made. Why is this all being done in such haste? In reality, the deadline to complete the lake for the Mother's 150th anniversary is a selfimposed mandate by the present executives and a limited number of their specific supporters.

2) Large hill: According to the executives, a large hill was "Mother's wish". As we know, she said many things on different occasions and in different contexts. She never said anything in a 'religious' and dogmatic manner. She did not mention the size of the hill. We may eventually need hills and/or have a plan to utilise the excavated soil but let us finalise a plan for the whole project as well as the unloading locations, and get the logistics ready before digging so extensively. It is furthermore questionable that combining this idea with a hydropower generator along the hill slope would be sustainable. The current industrial approach has been seriously questioned since the manifestation of the test lake and this generator along the hill would be another addition of a lifeless and short-sighted industrial approach. Are we repeating here the problems of the past, or are we here to find solutions to these problems from the past? Is it not the time in our history to learn more from nature and live better with nature instead of further manipulating and destroying it? When Roger signed a simple lake drawing in 2005, it was only said "at least 2m" for the depth of the lake. Is 10m not a very obvious exaggeration? This is the only drawing Roger has signed. Interestingly this drawing contains 5 peninsulas and a small island which were totally discarded in the current lake design. It is a rather absurd logic from Michael Bonke that in order to create a tall mountain he has decided to dig the whole lake to 10m deep. In reality 5 meters depth of water would be sufficient to maintain low water temperature in order to minimize daily water evaporation.

3) HDPE liner: It has come to light that the HDPE liner in the test lake is actually already leaking and a lot of harvested rainwater was lost. We are aware that the small HDPE pond in one of the Gardens of the Unexpected in Matrimandir was continuously leaking as well. Some of us were told by the executives and the lake team some years ago that the test lake's HDPE lining will be supervised and conducted by a specialised team from Germany. Indeed they came, but have the results been tested and checked? What if the leaking points were at the bottom of the lake covered by the layer of gravel? There is no leak detection system installed in the test lake nor planned for the lake. We were also told that the HDPE water channel along the Oval will bring beauty and living organisms inside water. Today it is a known fact that it emits a bad smell and the fish and plants are dying in the channel on a daily basis. How are the Matrimandir executives and technical teams learning from these previous experiences and are they readapting their larger plans accordingly?

4) Water usage: Regarding the usage of groundwater for the lake project, we were publicly told several times by Michael Bonke that it is safe to put drinking water in the newly proposed HDPE underwater storage (highlighted in yellow). It was explained that it will help to raise the water level of the lake and this stored drinking water will be supplied to the city. It is important to note that the only source of clean water in Auroville is groundwater pumped from aquifers that are being depleted faster than they can recharge. So far there is no state approval for the desalination plant and pipeline for Auroville and the project has not advanced for many years. We are not objecting to the desalination plan but this is the present reality. Further, all the run-off water from the garden's watering is going to the oval water channel and eventually to the lake, therefore the oval water channels and the test lake have already been partly filled indirectly by the groundwater. As the recent massive tree cutting in the area will raise the general temperature of the whole Matrimandir peace area, we sincerely hope that there won't be more additional intensive watering in the gardens when the groundwater situation in the area is increasingly on the brink.

5) Absence of approvals: We are aware that there is no site approval nor building permission given to the test lake as well as for the current phase of the lake. The record shows that the past Matrimandir executives applied to L'avenir d'Auroville/TDC in 2008/2009 and 2018 to obtain the necessary permissions. However, no green light has been given yet for the present design. This goes against community approved processes. Matrimandir being a unit directly under the Auroville Foundation does not justify this bypass. In the official communications, L'avenir d'Auroville/TDC emphasised several times that no groundwater is to be used in the test lake (or the lake project in general). The present executive appointments were done by a process of the Residents' Assembly. The Selection Committee was composed of RA selected members, representatives from the FAMC, Auroville Council and Working Committee. The then FAMC Auronet announcement dated 1 April 2022 in which the selection committee made two specific points: 1) We recommend that a review of the work plan is done annually and; 2) It is expected that the executive team will present the proposed 4-year plan to the community. Based on a thorough review of the records / Auronet posts, N&N announcements, etc., the team has never presented its proposed work plan to the community. If nothing else, the team would do well to now conduct an annual review as directed by the selection committee.

6) **Garden development:** As you have mentioned garden development, unfortunately this is another area where a severe lack of transparency prevails at Matrimandir. The old designs which are currently implemented by the Matrimandir team in the garden of Light and Wealth did not go through a proper community process.

This is the reason that the previous executives had to reorganize a more open and transparent design approval process in collaboration with the then RAS, Working committee and the Auroville council. The community was invited to the selection and national/international panels have participated in the selection and improvement of the designs. Why has a similar open and transparent process not been initiated for the Lake and its surrounding garden?

7) **Safety concerns of sliding doors:** Since you mentioned this item in your letter, the so-called 'golden sliding door' at the Matrimandir entrance has been deemed unsafe by government certified engineers and other professionals. We hope the Matrimandir executives will share the sliding door design approved by certified engineers before implementing the design again. Matrimandir welcomes many visitors daily, including VIPs and occasionally VVIPs. Safety within the Matrimandir compound should be up to code by national as well as international standards.

8) Soil excavation: After 4 years of construction of the Test Lake there is still no viable method to transport the soil to its intended final location. This basically doubles the cost of excavations, crores of rupees are lost, diesel fuel is being burned and polluting the environment. Also, the different excavated soils are being mixed in the 'temporary' hills. We find this to be highly unprofessional and wasteful, and your 'explanation' that they will be reused in the reverse order that they were excavated is not credible since the layers have not been kept separate. These unique soils are a precious natural resource. We can utilise them for different purposes according to their specific quality, such as Earth-based buildings (CSBE, rammed earth and poured concrete) or leveling the road for the subgrade, at the condition that they are not mixed. This is yet another reason for us to request you to halt the excavation work immediately.

9) **Transparent communication and consciousness:** We were told many times by some of the executives: "We are doing Mother's work." It is rather alarming when such dogmatic statements are made, especially to fellow Aurovilians, while it seems to be made without any accountability to Auroville's future sustainability and the ecological balance of the bioregion. Such a response cannot be an excuse for refusing to exchange, closing any possibility of dialogue or transparency. Communication and transparency are of the foremost importance in an administration or organisation, and consciousness in all actions and works is what is expected of all of us here in Auroville.

Last but not least, as you have mentioned the Lotus pond, we also learned that Michael Bonke has a plan to replace the Inner chamber crystal to a "translucent" quartz sphere. There are already samples that only a small circle of people were allowed to see. The present executives have already allowed it for a change to a crystal sphere at the <u>Lotus pond</u> under Matrimandir without informing the community of this change. A translucent crystal will not permit the Sun's ray to reach the Earth as seen presently, both figuratively and symbolically. It is not the mandate of Matrimandir executives to change major features of Matrimandir according to their preferences.

We understand this is a lot to take on. We are sharing these points with you because we deeply care and are concerned. We take this moment to express our sincere and heartfelt wish to engage and dialogue about our collective future. You remember... We built Matrimandir together, with the many challenges and different approaches, and opinions, etc. We want to continue the work at Matrimandir together. Can we invite a genuine collaboration?

THE GRIFT: A GIFT THAT KEEPS ON TAKING

The Governing Board, a g(r)ift that keeps on taking. Auroville is in chaos. Spirits are low. What is going on? The Governing Board (GB) is appropriating the whole of Auroville as their own. Jarring as these paid bureaucratic employees have not put an iota of their personal wealth or effort into its creation. All this seems to be ignored for the most part by the IAC (except for two members) who are entrusted with the task of advising the GB and to ensure that the residents can carry out their daily activities freely. Nothing could be further from the truth with regard to "freely carrying out our day to day activities".

Be it land, trees, homes, workplace and lastly even the literal fruits of our farms, everything is grabbed and run into the ground or controlled by a small group of Avlian members that hold multiple posts -(highlighting the lack of recruits)- with absolutely no accountability to the residents. The best efforts of the Secretary's enforcing agent is the FAMC, who cuts maintenances of your current activity, service or unit to be "realigned" by whatever it is that they (on behalf of the secretary) believe is required, they even extort taxes for visas and have the gall to back date this new policy - which has not been passed by or approved by the Residents (as stated in their own mandate for the adoption of new policies). The GB minutes were hidden for long, but after multiple RTI's and the "severe displeasure" of the CPIO and his advice, they are now posted on the AVF website. These read like the notes of a cabal who hatch new plans or nod in approval of each new grift or outrage. Straight faced, they suggest that the employed staff should be treated on par with Aurovilians, their children shall be educated for free and health services and other community organised services must be provided by Auroville, the burgeoning paid staff has taken over teachers quarters and appropriated other assets it believes are its own claiming that GOI grants were provided for its construction -never mind the change of purpose... The paid staff, without committing to Auroville or investing a gram of voluntary work or personal monies shall, it is decreed, be entitled to our community services. The FAMC questions none of these exploitative ideas, they proceed at the behest of the politically appointed GB and nod their heads eager to persecute Aurovilians with relish and zeal.

The AVFO doesn't stop at appropriating GOI funded buildings, it has equally grabbed the Town Hall paid for by the European Commission, and structures or homes built and belonging to stewards.

The collective funds of the residents in the form of contributions, or profits of units have disappeared from collective reporting, the FAMC feels no obligation to report to the community nor to answer emails or letters, they are seated high above us and are no longer concerned by such mundane administrative niceties or duties. We do not know how many members of the illustrious group are left but for three, each besotted with their own personal agenda of frustration - Complicated Accounting based on mistrust, making money never mind the atmosphere, punishing folk believed to be cheaters (except for the cheaters employed by the above persons or the secretary mind you). The composition of the FAMC designated by the Secretary has a high concentration of actual millionaires, they have a lot to say on what the rest of us are allowed to have or do. Meanwhile, over the last 2 years they have not produced a single report of the monies that they are supposed to administer on behalf of the community. They extol the virtue of transparency and parsimony ... "a simple life" they proclaim. They demand a forced contribution for people requiring visas, they help themselves to your FS account at a whim, and they ensure that they alone can decide on your projects and if you have the right to fund-raise for it. They alone will decide what work you should do, and if you are fit for it. All of this along with a steady stream of forms for re-orientation or re-education, reporting, accounting methods for proclaimed transparency (except for themselves). The forms and rules appear to have the goal to ensure that they have all the necessary documentation required for the Governing Board and Secretary to delist and remove you from Auroville (reminiscent of the communist era). It's quite astonishing how they are all happily going along with the program that will ensure the powers to remove older Avlians- its a brave new world, change is necessary, the old broken egg to make an omelette phrase perhaps soothes them as their "brothers and sisters" are deported, delisted and removed.

Who are these folk? Aside from the a bevy of new bureaucrats and officers, a small group of non avlians, newcomers and newish Aurovilians provide the needed assistance, these have little understanding of AV's history, have never experienced AV before the Foundation and have no reference about what the early days of values and aspirations were, have provided no effort in creating anything here, but are excited about their roles as they are handed our community made services, like our archives, our community finances, housing and other postings. This work normally requires collective trust for this responsibility and is given to people who have contributed considerably to AV or made the effort of building up the service. Next amongst these are a small number of older Avlians who have decided that their frustrations are a Divine movement, and that they represent the wishes of the Mother, thus they are no longer obliged to perform their mandates as representatives of the RA and are suddenly unable to comprehend the Foundation Act in their bid to hold on to power. The ends justify the means, never mind the community, consciousness in matter or common sense. They have taken to abusive cult methods. They remain silent when lands are sold at a loss, when homes or trees are destroyed or when Avlians are thrown out, they are also quick to cry victim of bullying (the irony) when the community voices its opposition to their ideas. Perhaps frustrated by the lack of yogic advances in their own lives, they have resorted to wholly external displays of "progress"; conflating the Auroville Charter with building the city. They have departed from any core value of spiritual teaching and have entered the dangerous level of stridence that allows all abuses towards their fellow residents as justified. They excuse the increasing violations of the Act, and are apparently silent at the numerous visa's (over 100) and maintenance (for over 300 old Avlians) that have been removed along with numerous long time employees that were dismissed without severance. Houses have been demolished where people are living. A life's work of dedication is worth nothing to these brave souls who forge ahead accompanied by a motley crew of new adepts, police or other hired hands of the office. Thereby providing this politically armed take over of Auroville with a convenient clothing of legitimacy, even if it is admittedly thin and getting thinner by any measure of decency or humanity.

But how is this allowed to happen? There is nothing decent or human with the way things are being enacted... the MoE under which Auroville is situated remains mute and other stalwarts of decency in the GOI look the other way. They prefer the laughable lies and glib sound bites that are offered. Mumblings of anti development, anti government, foreigners etc are all conveniently vague accusations to arouse a resentful eye and carry on the punishments. After all it's far simpler than the more complex truth or denouncing the disturbing and outrageous actions perpetuated by this cabal.

And what is lost? A multilayered society, a lifetime of work done with enthusiasm based on goodwill, freedom of expression and devotion by so many that has built the Matrimandir, greened the plateau and created a hub of inventiveness .. all of this takes great faith and trust. A faith and trust that is so obviously and easily abused by this new order of bureaucrats and their following. They seem unaware that most Aurovilians on maintenance (18k a month) will always give a contribution to service offered freely, because we understand the costs and appreciate the service. Bureaucrats do not understand these codes nor do they wish to. They want Aurovilians to service their needs while they malign them and destroy or take their homes. To beat them into compliance to follow their ideologies and hair brained ideas.

The visitors tour recently implemented with the imagination of a Govt tourist dept provides a template of the ideas of success and development the GB has in store for Auroville. For a fee you are urged to purchase kitschy trinkets and cheap food items (not necessarily made in Auroville) that are sold every few metres along the path way that leads to various sights on the way to the Matrimandir viewing point, a selfie spot with a "I love Wildlife" background and cement replicas of wildlife (of which the habitat has been decimated by these same folk) are some of the entertainments provided.

On the ground more disturbing activity takes place. Let's look at the carving off of Auroville properties, these are done secretivelytake the example of AuroOrchard Farm, the oldest best run farm which provides over 60 percent of Auroville's food. The Mother expressly reserved this area for organic farming. One fine morning, the residents in AuroOrchard wake-up to find their access, fields, farms, homes, cowshed, well, water supply being fenced up by a new owner! Barely has the shock been absorbed when another wave hits them. Another area to the east has been sold. They only find out when they are alerted to a stranger on the property by the sound of a chainsaw. Upon investigation you find this new owner cutting down trees on the property they have cared for on behalf of the community for 55 years.

The tone deaf sycophants are jubilant, they refuse to see the scam for what it really is. "Development" and "Consolidation" are the droning beats that excuse the dance of destruction and grift. You can read their enthralled postings, in awe of their own inspiration, "HOMA" one squeals with pride at her own "inspiration", is suggested as the new name for this atrocity located on a tiny plot that has been acquired in exchange with an ugly building, (that will require crores to make decent). Completely missing is any concern for what has been done to another part of the community nor the details of food and financial losses incurred.

You may note that many of the persons subsumed in the fold of the grifters have contributed little or nothing—neither funds nor energy—to Auroville. Despite this, we find ourselves subjected to constant verbal and written assaults by them. Casually using phrases from the Mother to justify their attempts to appropriate, seize, sell, dispose of assets painstakingly built over the years, diligently scraping together money bit by bit to create a shelter, only to be reminded repeatedly by these new paid bureaucrats that 'everything belongs to the Collective!'. However, it's clear that, in their perspective, 'everything belongs to the Collective' actually means 'everything belongs to them'.

It certainly does not belong to the community residents. The words of the Mother stating "only those that have resolved to live permanently in Auroville have the right to intervene in its organisation" is not one of the quotes that is useful to them... it will not be read nor obeyed to...

Our collectivity is a messy mix of lives, cultures, goodwill and badwill, the "human condition" in other words. But what an extraordinary attempt this adventure has been to defy it. We are made up of so many types and kinds. Perhaps our tolerance of dishonest or difficult persons has allowed some of the more perverse elements we see at work today grovelling around the corridors of power. Issues of racial insensitivity could also have become a room for progress and growth. Instead these challenges were not faced due to our inability and unwillingness to deal with our issues head-on.

Today, the "shadow cabinet" (as they have been known for years) are effectively in power. These people have consistently prevented Auroville growth by refusing permission for building after building, so besotted and fearful of doing something against the masterplan. They have consistently blocked any efforts in participatory planning and collective input. They have a successful propaganda campaign. Over the years the truth has been morphed to ensure that they are the victims, that ecology is the enemy, and that foresters have blocked building Auroville. In their eyes Auroville equals the city and that the city equals the Master Plan, and that the Mother blessed the Master Plan, (she did not it was made after she left her body). They are the ones that have shrunk Auroville to the size of the current version of the MP and thereby delegated Auroville lands to being "outside the MP". Some of the shadow cabinet members are not happy with what is going on and the poor manner of the execution of the work. But they will stay silent and never make their views known or speak up openly for their fellow Aurovilians or against the abuses. Doing so may reduce their future chances of influencing the next administrator, or may turn the proverbial "eye of Mordor" on themselves. They will remain quiet to authority but will howl and cast aspersions on Aurovilians... it's so much safer. There are the Lakshay's and Vikram Ram's of this world, (again folk who have nothing to show in terms of work in Auroville) but who are eager to destroy, they egg-on the powers by providing salacious gossip or exploiting race differences and faults to justify the takeover and grift.

A large portion of our residents are unhappy but are mute or subservient to authority. In a place dedicated to perfection and progress it is easy to be frustrated in Auroville and it is easy to browbeat Avlians into believing their failure. More prefer to not understand what is happening. They remember things that didn't work that well (or did not work well for them) and prefer to hope that it all will work out for the best, or that they will manage to pass personally unscathed by the events - an ostrich type of spirituality as it were. Another group is a little more clear-sighted, they dare to disagree with the abuse and clear misinterpretation of the Act. These few will be paying the price with their visas, maintenance, homes or businesses. These threats are to ensure the silence of all the other groups and make sure that no one else dares to stand up for the dream.

AUROVILLE'S GOLDEN AGE: GEORGES (VIKAS)

The Avatar's opus is society; all types must be represented, in the alchemical crucible of transformation: the demons and the

angels – and the mediocre too. Auroville parades all of them.

"Georges was an exceptional person, a kind soul, sincere and with nothing but goodwill for all" wrote an Aurovilian at his passing, eight years ago, when he reached the other shore.



Memories surface, fragments of reminiscences, like autumn leaves reminding me the wonder of springtime. Georges hailed from a remote village in the mountains of Southern France, a terrestrial paradise where wild horses roamed free. As a child, he walked for hours in the woods, with his father and his little sister, picking up pebbles, leaves, grasses, flowers, and anything that stroked their tender imagination; his father chose the winner of the day. As a teenager, Georges sat with a book on the branch of a tree on the edge of a cliff, lost to the world for hours. His mother was a pious Christian with strong social concerns, true to the Gospel – and his father an idealistic communist: this was Georges' initiation to life. When one is well-born, half of the work is done, the early Ashram sadhaks used to repeat. Surely Georges was one of them.

Pondering over the mysterious antinomies of the universe, Georges chose philosophy as his university subject but the grand questions of existence kept eluding him. Confronted with the injustices of society, he started working instead in a factory, while spending entire Sundays (the access was free) in museums, the Louvre in particular, mesmerised by immortal masterpieces.

Striving for a just, humane society, Georges was a typical 1968 offspring seeking a truer life. Travelling widely in haphazard ways he lived in esoteric communities; making his synthesis with no other guru but his inner self, he explored many paths. Repairing houses without charging, content with what people gave him, for years he made a dignified living. Offered money and gifts he didn't seek, to succour someone in need Georges was always ready to give whatever he had at that moment. Taking side with the poor and the oppressed, he was a friend to the gardener, the worker, the villager, shared meals with the humbles and attended their weddings.

Asked how could he leave behind the idyllic surroundings where he grew up and those genuine people, Georges's reply was unwaveringly the same: he was happy, in his small flat in Vikas he had all he needed. 26 square metres, a porch, a minuscule garden which he attended, the green cycle he painted... He refused any maintenance and was so honest that the only time, because of the deluge, he shared a free taxi for seniors he insisted on paying.

He was well versed in the art of parsimony and wore clothes (gifted by his sister) till their very end; recycled objects and every scrap of paper; used water and electricity sparingly; did the house cleaning and laundry himself, first thing in the morning. His simple way of living, consistent with his beliefs, made him a happy free bird. Endlessly giving for the sake of giving, looking for harmony and balance in impossible situations, Georges was cogently aware of Auroville's impossibilities. He sat as a silent observer at the Council's meetings and was a member of the Temporary Feedback Review Committee. When needed, he publicly raised issues, calm and firm.

Georges had a solid culture on art, was widely read on most varied subjects and published two books. He worked at the Seagull bookstore and made new friends, discussing titles with people. He was an avid reader of spiritual matters and particularly of Sri Aurobindo, who often came up in our discussions, with Georges referring to poignant, enlightening texts.

He was his own guru and never compromised, his innate goodness shattered all obstacles. In moments of distress, feeling the downfall was unstoppable, I turned to him, solid as a rock, and hope returned. Compassionate, self-effaced, relentlessly giving, a wise man with no claims whatsoever, irreplaceable, Georges belonged to the higher realms the Mother describes and to them has returned. May his luminous example not be in vain.

MATRIMANDIR – TEMPLE OF THE SUPREME DIVINE MOTHER

The presentation is quite appealing, but upon careful scrutiny seems to lack in depth, both technically and figuratively. These following comments came up earlier in the morning of 19th April 2024 as a response to fellow Aurovilians, and based on unfolding events that were announced to the community later that day, were premonitory:

It's very beautiful in concept, but then the problematic questions come:

- · How to implement this, now that the current one is ongoing?
- Will another court case be lodged to stop the current works?
- This proposal says it's rain-fed only, which will not be enough at such shallow depths. Water will evaporate and dry off in the rainless season (I have experienced this for six years living in our family-owned 4-hectare place in the Philippines, the whole stream in our district dries off).
- Thus the needed depth of the current works. We are on an elevated plateau, remember?
- Did you watch the presentations by Michael Bonke at Savitri Bhavan, on why this depth and the use of plastic sealing of the lake bed? Why bentonite clay was rejected? Why a hill is needed for the circulation of water?
- The Mother in Her Vision of Auroville also mentioned a hill emerging for a specific purpose, and of course the lake, which are happening. Should we not rejoice that these are happening and that someone is funding them?
- Folks talk of not using machines in building and maintaining the lake, but who amongst the Aurovilians will do this with their bare hands these days? We are in Year 2024, are they really living in the modern present preparing for the future, or stuck in the dead past?
- Please consider carefully before organising another protest movement, as the Mother said, protests and resistances to change create disharmony¹, a recognisable stamp of the false-separative egomind.
- We can take the constant development and progress of successful Auroville commercial units thanks to their proactive and forward-looking Executives. Will the Executives allow the workers to make the crucial decisions? The workers can make suggestions, but the final decisions must be made by the Executives. The hierarchical governance structure of any organisation must be respected and imposed. The same with building the City of Dawn, the willing servitors have to allow the Executives of particular units up to Auroville's overall collective management to move it forward.
- We are invited to participate in the Auroville of the Supramental Kalki Avatar Sri Aurobindo and the Mother primarily to hasten the advent of the new species the Supramental being, which will take many generations.

This is our Primary Vision-Goal as outlined in our Three Core Ideals² and our Aims and Principles³, as it is very obvious globally the deteriorating corruption of the old mental world of falsehood of the humans. We have been warned many times by the Mother, "collaborate... or crashing circumstances", "Truth or the abyss". This is why the building of the modern and future-oriented City of Dawn is most important for the whole world, the whole of Mother India and not just for a few.
