(The last Canto reviewed by Sri Aurobindo before his departure in 1950)

A silence sealed the irrevocable decree, The word of Fate that fell from heavenly lips Fixing a doom no power could ever reverse Unless heaven's will itself could change its course.

Or so it seemed: yet from the silence rose One voice that questioned changeless destiny, A will that strove against the immutable Will.

A mother's heart had heard the fateful speech That rang like a sanction to the call of death And came like a chill close to life and hope.

Yet hope sank down like an extinguished fire.

She felt the leaden inevitable hand Invade the secrecy of her guarded soul And smite with sudden pain its still content And the empire of her hard-won quietude.

Awhile she fell to the level of human mind, A field of mortal grief and Nature's law; She shared, she bore the common lot of men And felt what common hearts endure in Time.

Voicing earth's question to the inscrutable power The queen now turned to the still immobile seer: Assailed by the discontent in Nature's depths, Partner in the agony of dumb driven things And all the misery, all the ignorant cry, Passionate like sorrow questioning heaven she spoke.

Lending her speech to the surface soul on earth She uttered the suffering in the world's dumb heart And man's revolt against his ignorant fate.

"O seer, in the earth's strange twi-natured life By what pitiless adverse Necessity Or what cold freak of a Creator's will, By what random accident or governed Chance That shaped a rule out of fortuitous steps, Made destiny from an hour's emotion, came Into the unreadable mystery of Time The direr mystery of grief and pain?

Is it thy God who made this cruel law?

Or some disastrous Power has marred his work And he stands helpless to defend or save?

A fatal seed was sown in life's false start When evil twinned with good on earthly soil.

Then first appeared the malady of mind, Its pang of thought, its quest for the aim of life.

It twisted into forms of good and ill The frank simplicity of the animal's acts; It turned the straight path hewn by the body's gods, Followed the zigzag of the uncertain course Of life that wanders seeking for its aim In the pale starlight falling from thought's skies, Its guides the unsure idea, the wavering will.

Lost was the instinct's safe identity With the arrow-point of being's inmost sight,

Marred the sure steps of Nature's simple walk And truth and freedom in the growing soul.

Out of some ageless innocence and peace, Privilege of souls not yet betrayed to birth, Cast down to suffer on this hard dangerous earth Our life was born in pain and with a cry.



Although earth-nature welcomes heaven's breath Inspiring Matter with the will to live, A thousand ills assail the mortal's hours And wear away the natural joy of life; Our bodies are an engine cunningly made, But for all its parts as cunningly are planned, Contrived ingeniously with demon skill, Its apt inevitable heritage Of mortal danger and peculiar pain, Its payment of the tax of Time and Fate, Its way to suffer and its way to die.

This is the ransom of our high estate, The sign and stamp of our humanity.

A grisly company of maladies Come, licensed lodgers, into man's bodily house, Purveyors of death and torturers of life.

In the malignant hollows of the world, In its subconscient cavern-passages Ambushed they lie waiting their hour to leap, Surrounding with danger the sieged city of life: Admitted into the citadel of man's days They mine his force and maim or suddenly kill.

Ourselves within us lethal forces nurse; We make of our own enemies our guests: Out of their holes like beasts they creep and gnaw The chords of the divine musician's lyre Till frayed and thin the music dies away Or crashing snaps with a last tragic note.

All that we are is like a fort beset: All that we strive to be alters like a dream In the grey sleep of Matter's ignorance.

Mind suffers lamed by the world's disharmony And the unloveliness of human things.

FROM THE WORKING COMMITTEE

LEGAL UPDATE

Dear community,

Several cases were listed in the Madras High Court on Monday 22nd April. These are the cases related to the Working Committee and the TDC, and the cases challenging the new set of Governing Board regulations (on Admissions & Terminations, and on the selection of the Working Committee).

The cases related to the appeal made by the Secretary against the order of Justice Quddhose of August 2022, recognising the RA and its Working Committee, was initially postponed to Thursday 25th April and then it was deferred again. The cases challenging the new Governing Board regulations were discussed briefly on April 22nd and then adjourned to 19th June. These are the regulations that were stayed by the High Court in February and the stay will continue until the next hearing.

The Secretary of the Auroville Foundation has also made an appeal in the Supreme Court in Delhi, against the Order of the Madras High Court of 15th March quashing the Standing Order constituting the Governing Board's 'ATDC'. The appeal was heard in the Supreme Court today, 29th April, with a bench that included the same judge for the appeal of the NGT case. An interim stay has been granted and a new hearing has been scheduled for the second week of July. We are waiting now for the publication of the order to understand the extent of the stay and the implications.

We will keep you updated on any new developments.

AUROVILLE COUNCIL REPORT, JANUARY, FEBRUARY, MARCH, AND APRIL 2024

Council's communications to the Community through Massmail and N&N

25/12 - <u>Update on the RAD policy</u> - The RAD policy has been updated with the new amendment

24/01 - <u>AvC report</u> - October, November and December 2023 report

AVC internal organisation:

The work of the Council on reviewing mandates and policies is ongoing, however, the current existing processes cannot be implemented under the present circumstances. Often many of the GB services and groups are no longer following the RA policies and are simply imposing their decisions.

Coming together:

The Council has been in dialogue with different sections of the community as a means to overcome the current divisiveness in our community.

Council Budget cut

From the beginning of March 2024, the AVC budget was stopped by the GB BCC.

Room vacate FAMC mail and WCom response

On 11th March 2024, <u>we received a notice</u> in our personal emails to vacate the Council room from the GB FAMC mentioning that we were unauthorised members. The current Council members have been selected by the RA Selection Process and this particular room has been reserved for RA selected groups. Individual responses were mailed to the GB FAMC by some AVC members from their personal emails. Meanwhile, in collaboration with the other RA working groups, a response was drafted, sent to the GB FAMC, and pasted onto both the access doors to the room. We would like to mention that a group of residents have been safeguarding this room 24/7.

Matrimandir executive meeting with Council

As a follow-up to our meeting in December 2023, the Council met with the MM executives in April requesting clarifications regarding the current work on the lake.

The MM executives shared their wishes to continue with the Harald Kraft design of the lake which Roger Anger approved. They believe this task was given to them when they were selected as executives.

The Council brought up concerns from the Community regarding the ecological and sustainability issues of a design of such large proportions. The executives responded that these are being looked into by their technical experts. They admitted that right now it is challenging for them to dispose of the soil, but it is their intention to make a hill out of it as per the Mother's vision.

The Council also reminded the executives that they had promised to communicate regularly with the community regarding the evolution of their work which has not been done so far. They have expressed the intention to do this in the future.

Silent presence keeper's team during Council meetings

Silence presence keepers (SPK) continue to support the Council on a regular basis.

Entry Board member resignation

Matilde informed us belatedly that she has resigned from the Entry Board as of 12th December 2023.

Selection Process

On Tuesday 26th March in a GM, the three working groups (WCom, Entry Board and AVC) presented the tasks and skills required for the upcoming Selection process.

The Council worked on the Application Form for all the WGs for the Selection process.

Mandates and Policies

A study group was formed in January 2024 to look into the PWG document as a result of an invitation to the community <u>in December</u> 2023.

Dismissal of AV Security team

In January 2024, the Auroville Security informed us that they received a notice from the AVFO to resign.

Task force outline document

A document to support the creation of task forces was initiated.

Conflict Resolution Council (CRC)

The mandate for CRC is being reviewed.

Entry Policy

Auroville Council mandate and RAS mandate and policy

Both documents have been studied and are under review by a sub group.

Open House

The Council continues to keep an hour every Thursday from 10 to 11 am for residents to share their views and concerns.

Resignation of the Conflict Resolution Council (CRC) members

In February we received a mail from the CRC team informing us that they are stepping down as many of their decisions cannot be implemented due to the current climate created by the arbitrariness of decisions from GB Working Groups.

Following this we have met with the facilitation coordination team to check whether they are still willing to continue with issues that arise. They have informed us that in the current

context if two parties are on board for mediation, they are willing to be the facilitators. However, they cannot participate effectively in arbitration processes.

Meanwhile, some members of the Council are following up with the CRC emails. The Council has been also reflecting on whether to delegate all conflicts to an independent expert group. The new Council team will take the matter forward and decide the future of the CRC.

MARTIN PASSES AWAY

Martin was an amazing man: generous of spirit, hard-working, and dedicated to the people and projects that he had committed to. He originally arrived in Auroville in 1997 with his family from Switzerland- Nadja, Luca and David.

For the past 12 years he has been an integral part of the Botanical garden team, tending to the Plumerias and other garden



areas he had created, as well as welcoming and mentoring so many of the volunteers who came to the gardens. When one walks through the central area of the gardens, from the plumerias to the main pond and back through the bamboo area, one can appreciated the manifested beauty of his karma yoga.

But his life in Auroville has been far wider and richer than just these years at the Botanical gardens. He, along with Shivakala his wife, contributed to the lives of so many, taking responsibility to support and guide youngsters from the local area through college, providing for them a safe and secure home to grow up in. Some came as young as five years of age, others came when they were a little older, but all told, there are more than ten young ladies in the world today who have received the love and support of Martin in their lives and through their education – in their own words:

"He took us into his arms and raised us as his own child. Never did we feel that we are an outsider to the family."

"Not only a father, a good friend, and a mentor. We and this universe are going to miss such a wonderful human being. We love u dad. I love u my better half."

"He fulfilled the role of father perfectly in our life and gave us a meaningful future. The soul who smiles and hugs each time, making us to feel secure whatever problem you have"

"He created a family bond without blood relations but a family that is connected by heart and soul fully"

"He had taught us everything in life. He taught us of how to respect, love, care and be responsible. Without him we are nothing. All our stepping stones to success is filled with his sacrifice and love."

"Martin had a heart of gold.

Thank you Martin, you've made the world a better place"

He also for many years ran the kitchen at New Creation School, always with his happy smile and cheery countenance, making sure that all the kids were well fed. His connection to New Creation was preceded by his first port of call which was Forecomers nursery, where he took charge after Ed had left, and after the kitchen he was for many years at the nursery in Matrimandir, where he developed his passion for the Plumerias and enthused everyone with his love for plants.

He had a great appreciation for the landscape of Tamil Nadu and was particularly attracted to the rocky landscapes of Gingee where he has created a sanctuary forest – a place he would often retreat to at the weekends to spend time in quiet reflection as well as working to develop the area.

He was quite simply a wonderful example of how one can be in this magical place called Auroville. A person who took full responsibility for life and lived it to the full, making the space we live a better place for everyone. He will be very sorely missed.

Love and strength to Shivakala and his large family. Martin, thank you. Be in peace.

MATRIMANDIR LAKE, AN ALTERNATIVE DESIGN CONCEPT APRIL 2024 BODY:

This is the presentation of an alternative design concept for the Matrimandir Lake. This concept addresses the aspiration of a large section of the community for an inclusive, aesthetic, and environmentally sustainable lake around the Matrimandir and its gardens.

To address the concerns and aspirations of the community the 'Matrimandir Lake Task Force' was formed, which has been endorsed by the RA Working Committee. The Task Force in consultation with experts prepared a design brief for a landscape planner/architect to undertake the preparation of an alternative design.


Mohan Rao, the principal Landscape Planner from INDE (<u>https://www.integrateddesign.org/</u>) was approached as he is familiar with Auroville, having visited several times besides being on the professional panel for the last MM garden design in 2020. He and his team are recognised in the country for their landscape projects that seamlessly blend aesthetics with the environment, social issues, and sustainable technologies.

Mohan has prepared a preliminary design concept, covering all aspects of the vision of the Mother, which calls for the Matrimandir and its gardens to be surrounded by a lake, a challenge on many levels; ecological, aesthetic, functional, and technical. We present here the full 30-minute Zoom presentation by Mohan, first shown at CSR, Auroville, in March 2024.

We are hopeful that despite differences, we will be able to find a way forward that includes the concerns of the community for an inclusive, aesthetic, and environmentally sustainable lake around the Matrimandir and its gardens.

REVISED TARIFF OF ECO SERVICE

Dear Community members

The Eco Service is revising its Tariff - after 5 years. Every year the general costs go up at least 10% and things have become dearer post lockdowns. Our employee wages, staff welfare, material, infrastructure maintenance and operational costs all have become considerably costlier than 5 years ago.

The revision is as follows :-

Residential & Educational Establishments:	Previous	Revised
Glass, Plastic & Paper -	40/bag	70/bag
Mixed/Unsegregated Waste & Landfill	100/bag	175/bag
Sanitary	150/bag	175/bag
Commercial Establishments :	Previous	Revised
Glass, Plastic & Paper -	40/bag	100/bag
Glass, Plastic & Paper - Mixed/Unsegregated & Landfill	40/bag 100/bag	100/bag 200/bag

Mixed use spaces where residences and commercial units are combined will be charged as per the Commercial tariff.

Commercial establishments include:

- Units
- Restaurants
- Guest Houses

We would like to once again remind all community members the following:

a) Please do not send us pillows, mattresses, clothing, ceramics or books that can be sent to either the Free Store or given to the Library.

b) Please rinse bottles of medicines, honey, creams, pickles, sauces before binning.

c) Please send the milk, jam and soy milk bottles to either PTDC or PTPS

d) Please bring in your E-waste items directly to Eco Service whenever possible instead of putting them into the bins.

Do keep in mind that effective segregation at source will surely result in lower billing as well as in reducing our workload.

The revised tariff will come into effect w.e.f. 01.06.24 (1st June 2024)

VOICES AND NOTES

ENTROPY

The degree of disorder in systems names the entropy. Before Auroville started in this landscape was entropy or disorder or disharmony. It was semi deserted place with a strong erosion. Sunbeams reached this territory, they made soil hot, dry, unfertile. Some of the sunrays returned in cosmos.

If sun reached the plants, they caught the beams and started photosynthesis process, in results the oxygen and biomass were born. If a cyclone fell down some trees, in that place very quickly appear new plants: the nature is excellent doctor for itself.

New roads are entropic place for ever. No plants, no animals appeared on the roads. There are cemetery of all kind of life. That's the ecological catastrophe. Bulldozers attacked peaceful green oasis and had awful results. Asuric technic kills the life. Ugliness is winner beauty, break more than create.

First Aurovilians had the green fingers. We can read in "Auroville Today", January 2022, p.10 : "Claude planted, planted, planted over 50000 trees in Auromodele area. Many of the big trees today are standing straight, witnessing the labor of that time".

I think the Mother would be happy of green work the first Aurovilians and unhappy of bulldozers. Mamma mia! Let bulldozers will stop for eternal life. I hope we shall overcome some days. The green ecosystems will be more strong than black destructive power. Don't worry with bulldozers, be happy with life. There is a Latin expression: "Amor vincit omnis" – Love wins everything. Life wins counter force. Aurovilians are ecofriendly, bulldozers are killers of trees. The camaraderie is between Aurovilians, but not between iron aggressive machines.

MISQUOTING THE MOTHER? THE YIN-YANG LAYOUT

The Mother and Roger are often misquoted. A recurrent case is the yin-yang model, even at the recent community meeting the Secretary called. No, the Mother did not discard it. It is Roger who, out of it, evolved the Galaxy.

The yin-yang layout – the second one the Mother approved – was reproduced in the Ashram '*Bulletin*' of November 1967, printed for Darshan. It was vividly described in two famous interviews winning over many people: "= 1", in 1967; and the "*Journal of the Indian Institute of Architects*" (JIIA), in 1971! The lines of force in the Galaxy substituted the two macrostructures, but the dynamism of the spiraling concept remained as the one keystone.

Roger presented to the Mother what will be known as '*the Galaxy*' only in January 1968. Postcards of the yin-yang model had already been printed, with Mother's handwritten message "*Auroville the Town of the Future*".

Auroville was born in the sixties, those years nothing was deemed impossible. Macro buildings mimicking towns were the symbol of that age and Paolo Soleri was a signpost; invited by Piero Cicionesi (the Matrimandir in site architect), the celebrated architect visited Auroville and a few Aurovilians settled in Arcosanti. The yin-yang layout, banning all cars while featuring a circular monorail supra elevated, many bodies of water (a constant, in Roger's vision), and wondrous descriptions of spaces and habitats, belong to that bold era. When I asked Roger why a so fantastic layout was abandoned, his answer was simple: he kept working on the concept because the two megastructures, where most inhabitants would live, hampered the sight of Matrimandir. This is how the Galaxy, whose main feature is the lines of force, was born. Just in time for Foundation Day.

These excerpts from the interview by Luigi and Aryamani, on 10.3.1996, explain how Roger, using as starting point the dynamic yin-yang model the Mother had approved, evolved the Galaxy:

R.: "... I brought her another concept which was interesting – which started to be a little more dynamic, which started spinning a little.

L.: The beginning of the Galaxy, but with two long lines of force.

R.: Like Yin and Yang, there were two energies.

L.: Two lines of force which hid the view of Matrimandir – the view of the centre.

R.: It hid it without hiding it; but it enclosed the Matrimandir in a kind of valley with buildings around it which locked it in somewhat. It was interesting



but it was a mega-structure. It was extremely theoretical but what was interesting was that the beginning of the Galaxy was there. So, I showed it to Mother. I must say that I felt it was not

up to the mark when I showed it to her. She did not say anything... She said it was interesting but I could feel that it had not reached its potential. I also felt it had established something but that it wasn't entirely there as yet. So the whole team worked on it again. It took another six months – one year – rather six months. I worked on it at Théméricourt, an estate I had in the countryside. We withdrew for months and worked on project number two. I worked a lot with Charles Gianferrari. ... A.: So, you were saying that you had reached a point with this team of finding the lines of force.

R.: Yes, we came up with the Galaxy concept. Then it was only a question of working things out. We made two models, we thought about the type of buildings. After that everything flowed smoothly. When something comes like that, naturally, it is a good sign. There was nothing to discuss. We knew that we had come upon the answer. We knew that we had come into contact with something that was the essence. I went back [to India] with a model which was the small model at that time – and I came to see Mother – and Mother found it.... This time it was accomplished. She said, "It is a movement of nebula which already exists... in the cosmos." For us it was an achievement. And the Galaxy, I don't know who gave it this name. It remained the Galaxy. ..."

AUROVILLE CHANGES ITS NAME TO AUROCITY

In a move that caught many around the world off-guard, Auroville changed its name. Now called Aurocity, it is flying in line with India's future.

Announced in New Delhi, a spokesperson for the national gazette said: "A name like Aurocity makes it eligible for much support from the government. There are vast amounts of funds that can be released and make it India's first smart city. Very quickly."

In Aurocity the response was mixed. Some of the neighbours were supportive: "To us Auroville was not a village. Without bars it was not quite a city either. But now it is clear what it wants to be." "It's just easier for Tamilians, all Indians to pronounce. We never knew if it was 'vill' or 'villey'," said another.

A few Aurocitians were crying: "Auroville was The Mother's name. How can we change it?"

Others were more pragmatic: "In French, ville is supposed to mean city. But it is a French joke, isn't it? There is no city in the 120 largest cities in France ending in 'ville'. If you look, Sartrouville with a population of 52,000 is the largest with a name using 'ville'. Does Aurocity want to be like that town?"

The charter for Aurocity was released with only the one change in a podcast, reminiscent of the original radio announcement by The Mother. Several people gathered on the hill next to the Matrimandir and cheered.

"Now we can become as successful as Aerocity in Delhi and Gift City in Gujarat. We can easily attract one lakh people from Delhi," said one of the people wearing a bright new orange t-shirt saying "Aurocity".

In a tone both serious and humorous, another quipped: "They will have to follow Gift City's example and lift the self-organized prohibition. The wide Crown road with bar-hopping and partying all-night will attract people and increase the economy."

Another concluded: "Aurocity is announcing to India that we are here. Maybe we will change our name to Aurdon or Auroyork when we are ready to announce ourselves to the world."





Travel Tip:

Several travellers were "boarding denied" as check-in staff didn't accept the **e-FRRO Stay Visa** as valid document without backed it up with additional documentation. Therefore we advise to take beside the Stay Visa document (please make sure your current Passport details are in it) your Original Visa, which is maybe in an older expired Passport. If not available anymore, take at least a photocopy of the original Visa.

Indian nationals can now be issued long-term, multi-entry Schengen visas valid for two years after having obtained and lawfully used two visas within the previous three years. The two-year visa will normally be followed by a five-year visa, if the passport has sufficient validity remaining. During the validity period of these visas, holders enjoy travel rights equivalent to visa-free nationals.

Sri Lanka has shifted from the Electronic Travel Authentication (ETA) visa programme to a new E-visa scheme with effect from 17 April 2024. In this context, the ETA website was discontinued on 16 April 2024.

The Embassy of the Republic of Turkey announces that Turkish authorities has commenced requiring the "Electronic Airport Transit Visa" (e-ATV) for Indian & Nepalese passport holders traveling to Mexico, Panama, Colombia and Venezuela, Transiting via the Istanbul Airport.




