We are writing to update the community about the membership of the Residents' Assembly Service (RAS). We are pleased to inform you that Peter L. has been confirmed as a RAS member to replace Manas who has resigned with effect from the 31st May 2024. The current RAS team now comprises Peter and Tatiana, with the support of resource persons as and when needed.

With this in view, we would like to invite residents to apply to join this important service to our community. LAND REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

An approximate total of 28.73 acres of prime road-side Auroville properties have been exchanged for Total of approx - 38.63 3/4 Acre gained, these are located primarily in the Green Belt with approx. only 16 acres in the city area.

All Auroville properties that were exchanged are on the state or national highway. All Auroville lands have been evaluated at the minimal guideline value instead of the market rate. We note that only the AV plots have a low acre guideline value compared to other plots nearby or even on the same Survey number whose subdivisions have a square foot rate!

Many Av lands that were exchanged have lost investments like; access, water pipes, wells, houses, trees etc (none of these assets are listed in the sale document under the schedule of properties where they should be).

The AVFO is using the perfect circle ideology held by a minority of members that have been conveniently empowered by the AVFO, in order to privately gain by selling the Auroville Assets developed over 55 years (many which were purchased and named by the Mother Herself) for undeveloped lands with the excuse that they need to follow the outdated MasterPlan and complete the Green Belt circles!

Will the uncorrupted empowered members realize the fraud and have the courage and decency to resign?

After the huge success of last Friday's soft launch, our Mobile Vet Clinic will offer again this **Friday, June 21st from 11.30 until 1.30 pm** its services to the AV Community in front of the **Solar Kitchen Parking Lot.**

We are happy to present to the Community the plans and architectural drawings and give detailed information about the construction of the New Auroville Dog Shelter which will not just be an animal sanctuary but an amazing place for every Aurovilian, guest, and visitor. Please provide us with your feedback, your suggestions, and criticism as this is an important project for the entire Community to participate in. In a few weeks, we will give a public presentation of the new Auroville Dog Shelter incorporating valuable Community Feedback.

For Friday's Mobile Vet Clinic, you can bring your animals if they need our services. Please note as the shelter is completely overcrowded with barely any funding, we cannot accept at the time being more puppies, but we are happy to provide the following services:

- **Free Consultations:** Receive expert veterinary advice to ensure your animals' health and well-being.
- **Basic Medical Care:** We are able to address minor ailments and provide necessary treatments.
- **Cost-Price/Donation-Based Vaccinations:** Affordable vaccinations to keep your dogs protected. (We don't have funds for cat vaccinations at the moment)
- **Spay/Neuter Bookings:** Schedule sterilization surgeries, an essential step in managing the growing puppy population.
- **Animal Care Information:** Valuable tips and advice on how to keep them happy and healthy.
- **Volunteering Information:** Lots of opportunities to volunteer in the old and for building the new Animal Care Shelter!

VOICES AND NOTES

THE AUROVILLE THAT WAS

When I joined forty years ago, Auroville was a predominantly young society of idealists with minimal material needs. Most of us lived in huts, under a keel roof; in the greenbelt, with no electricity and hardly any phone. When the windmill did not turn, we had no water either; then a bullock cart from Grace delivered to us water in barrels: free of charge, of course.

I don't remember a single car. Didn't Roger utter, in a famous interview, "no car enters the city"? Bicycles were the current transport; in Mother's years, in Aspiration even these were collective property and the motorbikes were used for work only. Via the Pour Tous baskets we got whatever food was available; in the eighties, it was still rationed. There were no 'summer holidays' (and certainly) no air conditioners; all year long we stayed in Auroville, coping with the long blackouts. Auroville will be and was our faith. Nothing else mattered.

In that atmosphere of freedom, the illimitable freedom of yearning souls whose wealth is to live with nothing, the presence of the Mother was tremendously strong. Those were her children, the children of the 1968 revolution, which Auroville had preceded by three months. The abysmal disparities between the poor and the rich had come to end, and so did the petty goals of a comfy life. The residents still lived according to the Mother's guidelines, spontaneously; in fact, often below. Revolution had come from within, the revolution of the Spirit.

This is the Auroville I joined, and those were the people who attended our general meetings. The life conditions were harsh, we were not numerous and we did not vote; we just raised our hands, took decisions on the spot and these were implemented. We came to the meetings well prepared; there were informative articles in the News and Notes and we debated a lot among ourselves. Our adhesion was sincere, anyone was free to speak; the participants were motivated and what we decided was genuinely felt. If something went wrong, or someone did wrong things, the community was promptly informed; a general meeting was called and the process started all over.

Whenever the heart took over, there were no parties or rivalries. Living by the heart, there were no secrets. Merged in a world where ethnicity, culture and status were superseded by the vision of something magnificent we were called to build made us one; sharing harshness and difficulties, we braved them all and lived content. The Ideal only existed.

Evoking the years of my Auroville apprenticeship, when youth flocked at the quest of a society of brotherhood, equality and freedom, today seems evoking a fairytale. But it was a fairytale that we lived, day in and day out; we would have not exchanged our sort for anything else in the world. Whatever duress we had to go through was nothing, compared to the magnificent destiny awaiting us, just for simply living the Dream.

With gratitude, proud of having shared the Dream with the founders of Auroville. One day, when the original spirit takes over again, that Dream will be.

TUNNELLING AS RESISTANCE, AS SELF-ORGANIZATION, AS SEEKING

Since antiquity, tunnels have been used in war for both offence and defence. For defence against a powerful enemy, the weaker side has to go underground for survival. Digging a cave provides shelter. Creating a network of tunnels provides a lot more, it allows for resistance.

Tunnelling is not retreating in fear, but actively responding, in what is a bleak, losing situation. Tunnellers are resisters. And should be seen as seekers. The tunneller has to abandon all that they were doing in life and focus all their energies on a dark wall, the task in front of them. They work persistently and patiently towards a small hope, in the form of some light and fresh air, and to connect with another human in an opening.

Why talk about tunnelling today? We have to see clearly that we are all being bombarded. Constantly. In many ways. While the vast majority are not under the explosive bombing raids, the large

number of wars on the human and the planet make the present the darkest moment in human history, and at a time of amassing the greatest power, the future appears even more grave. That gives an historic opportunity for everyone to tunnel. As a seeker. And as a resister.

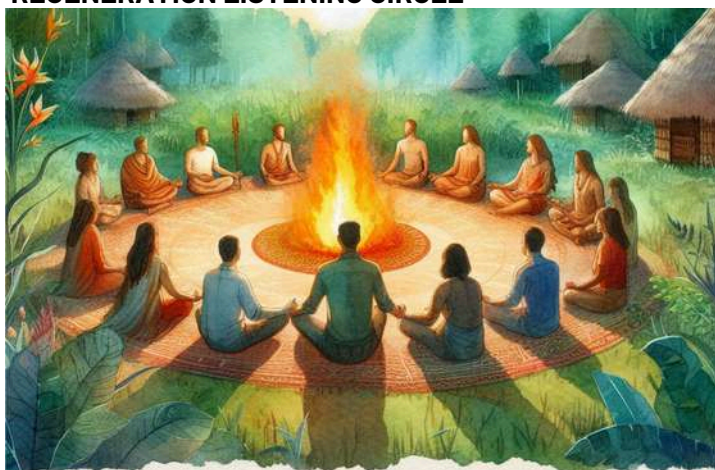

Travel Tips:

Several travellers were "boarding denied" as check-in staff didn't accept the **e-FRRO Stay Visa** as valid document without backing it up with additional documentation. Therefore we advise to take beside the Stay Visa document (please make sure your current Passport details are in it) your Original Visa, which is maybe in an older expired Passport. If not available anymore, take at least a photocopy of the original Visa.

Indian nationals can now be issued long-term, multi-entry **Schengen visas** valid for two years after having obtained and lawfully used two visas within the previous three years. The two-year visa will normally be followed by a five-year visa, if the passport has sufficient validity remaining. During the validity period of these visas, holders enjoy travel rights equivalent to visa-free nationals.

Srilankan Tourist Visa 30 days single entry fees waiver scheme for citizens of China, India, Indonesia, Russia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan is valid until further notice. Indian Nationals can apply for E-tourist visa through the given link <https://www.srilankaevisa.lk/> Indian Nationals are entitled to visa exemption for the purpose of tourism and short-term business engagements, for a period not exceeding 60 days. Visa on arrival at the immigration checkpoints on arrival for the purpose of tourism, for a period not exceeding 15 days.

The **Embassy of the Republic of Turkey** announces that Turkish authorities has commenced requiring the "Electronic Airport Transit Visa" (e-ATV) for Indian & Nepalese passport holders traveling to Mexico, Panama, Colombia and Venezuela, Transiting via the Istanbul Airport.

eVisa fees waiver scheme has been introduced for citizens of India, China, Indonesia, Russia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan, with immediate effect, valid until May 31st, 2024 (Last date of arrival) for tourism only. To avail of the scheme, please select the 30-day single entry eVisa option.

Thailand has extended its visa exemption program for tourists from India and Taiwan for another six months, allowing these travelers to enter the country without a visa until November 11, 2024. Travelers from India and Taiwan can stay for a maximum of 30 days without a visa.

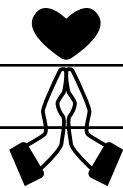

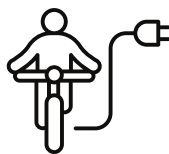

Please find the Land report below!



LAND REPORT

Auroville is currently grappling with governance and funds and assets management issues that jeopardise its founding principles and its foreseeable future. The focal point of our concern today involves the opaque land exchange processes conducted by the Auroville Foundation's Governing Board and their "Land Committee", the Secretary's Officers and some members of the Land Board, which have led to significant financial and ethical discrepancies and the loss of our very valuable lands on state and national highway.

In Brief:

- The AVFO's recent practice of granting access to private properties through Auroville land when viable alternatives exist raises questions about potential underhanded deals.
- Land exchange decisions require consultation with the Residents' Assembly's Working Committee and Funds and Assets Management Committee (FAMC) as per Auroville Foundation Rules 1997 (Section 4(d) & (e)). This mandatory consultation and information sharing have been absent for the past two years.
- Established procedures, including independent land valuation as implemented by the previous Secretary, Mr. Chunkath, have reportedly not been followed for recent exchanges.
- GFR rules mandate permission from the Finance Ministry for property sales by autonomous bodies, which is also allegedly absent.
- Disposing of Auroville properties before revising or reformulating the nearly expired Master Plan, Perspective 2025, is unwise.
- The circular Green Belt area as originally envisioned, is not realistic as over 600 acres are occupied by several village settlements and temple lands.
- Previous land exchanges along main roads have not benefited Auroville. The peaceful green entrances to the Auroville area were deemed an important purchase priority and are now cluttered with commercial development and litter.

Generally it can be observed that:

- Auroville's land consolidation effort was built on voluntary land sales by ancestral landowners and purchases by Aurovilians and well-wishers/devotees world wide. Opaque transactions at a loss dishonour their goodwill.
- Lands purchased during the Mother's time hold special significance and require utmost care, community consultation, and transparent processes in the rare instances of any sale or exchange.
- The recent dismissal of Aurovillian Land Board members and appointment of outsiders, coupled with a total lack of communication regarding land exchanges, raises concerns about conflict of interest and lack of adhering to proper procedures.
- Encouraging sales/exchanges over direct purchases not only results in financial losses but also deprives Auroville of prime properties. The current exchange practices damage Auroville's reputation among local ancestral land owners and donors worldwide.

Some main concerns:

Under the guise of consolidation for development the AVFO has exchanged prime Auroville properties. It has become evident (see list attached) that a large portion of the lands received in exchange are predominantly located in the Green Belt and are therefore not required for "development". The basis for the consolidation itself is no longer tenable.

- **Massive Undervaluation:** Lands of Auroville that are valued between Rs 4.4 to Rs 8.7 crores per acre (and up to 13 crores per acre based on their current market value per square foot, which is common practise given their prime location) have been exchanged at rates alarmingly lower, causing a financial loss to Auroville exceeding 100 crores. It is not known who this considerable amount of money is benefitting, and this enormous financial discrepancy raises strong suspicions of mismanagement and misconduct for the sake of private gain.
- **Enormous Financial Loss:** Specific instances have surfaced where AV land was exchanged at Rs 7 lakhs per acre, a figure grossly inconsistent with market rates and the strategic value of the locations involved (near a national highway or other prime road locations). In a November 2023 exchange the Auroville land was exchanged at less than 1% of its real market value.
- **Lack of Transparency:** Recent land exchange processes have been marked by complete opaqueness and an absence of proper process, including how the land was benefitting Auroville, and an evaluation by an independent, empaneled entity.

The Residents' Assembly and their elected representatives were also not consulted nor involved in these land exchange processes, while they are the first custodians of the Auroville land, which has been entirely consolidated with donations from residents and well-wishers worldwide for 60 years.

Actions taken so far:

The WCom of the RA has written numerous times to the GB and IAC regarding these discrepancies, we have informed various relevant officials and have requested swift intervention from the Ministry; as the situation will reflect unfavourably on the Central Government's oversight of autonomous bodies (like the Auroville Foundation) and have pleaded to urgently take the following actions:

1. Initiate a freeze on all ongoing land exchange deals in Auroville, with immediate effect.
2. Conduct a thorough investigation by an independent agency into the suspected malpractices and undervaluation of all lands involved in exchanges since 2022.
3. Ensure the return to a due diligence process, including proper environmental impact assessments and public consultations, as well as the involvement of the Residents' Assembly - one of Auroville's statutory authorities - through its bona-fide representatives.
4. Hold the Governing Board and the Office of the Secretary accountable for their actions and take appropriate measures to prevent such malpractices in the future.

We have also sent a legal notice to the District Registrar on 21-9-2022 quoting the General Finance Rules (GFR) that states "No land belonging to the Government or any of its bodies including autonomous bodies, PSUs etc shall be sold without previous sanction of the Government" (Rules 309 of GFRS, 2017) and informing that the Working Committee of the RA has not been consulted (as stated in the Rules and Regulations of AVF Act "Powers of the Governing Board" section: (i) to sell, transfer, lease or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the Foundation in consultation with the Working Committee and the FAMC) .

In May 2022 a letter was sent to the District Registrar and again in March 2023, we have written to the Collector and to other appropriate authorities.

An RTI reply in September 2022 from the CPIO & Under Secretary (UNESCO desk), in response to asking if permission for exchange had been sought, stated that no information is available regarding sanction of the Central Government in order to sell, transfer, lease or otherwise dispose of any immovable property of the Foundation since 1 July 2021. A letter dated the 29th March 2023 from the Under Secretary of the Gol, Department of Higher Education, MoE, to the Secretary Auroville Foundation, sends a reminder of Rule 309 of GFRS 2017 to the AVFO and sends comments in respect of agenda point No.8 of the 56th Governing Board meeting of Auroville Foundation held on 07.11.2020, and further states that the MoE will further examine as per the extant of Gol rules.

An RTI reply on Dec 2023 from the MoE on land exchange states: "henceforth, this Ministry thus devised a set of principles to serve as a checklist for the Governing Board to endorse and approve proposals for land exchange or purchase." ... "2. Further, the approval of the GB for such proposals would be considered final, provided that necessary financial prudence and due diligence is exercised by the GB as per the following checklist/principles:

- I. No govt- fund or grant in aid should have been used in procuring or improving the land being exchanged by AF.
- II. All provisions of applicable statutes, at Central and State level, and safeguards against land alienation as also due process for securing clearances should be followed during land acquisition
- III. The GB should be satisfied that (a) the acquisition is critical for realising the Master Plan (b) the land being exchanged could not have been put to better use to further the objectives of Mother's Charter and (c) the potential benefits outweigh the costs and adverse impacts of the acquisition."

Questions and observations arise on the above checklist principles supplied by the MoE:

1. The Auroville Foundation Rules, 1997, require approval by the RA Working Committee and FAMC and not simply the GB's; however there is no mention of this.
2. Several other countries have provided funds through grants for the development of the lands exchanged. The terms and purposes of these grants and donations must also be respected.
3. So far the mechanism and persons employed by the GB have failed in their tasks concerning land alienation and acting with any professionalism.

They have systematically undervalued Auroville lands, the Govt surveyor has not been present to demarcate the property, creating havoc on site amongst the residents and between the “purchasers”, while the resident stewards are not informed

4. When the Mother has herself written on June 9th 1971 in French that” I authorise that all lands of AuroOrchard shall be reserved for organic agriculture” is the GB then placing its ideas and priorities for development and land use above the Mother’s explicit wishes? What role do the words of the Mother herself have on the GB’s interpretation today?

There have been no 5 year reviews and no detailed Development Plans (DDP) on the Master Plan (Perspective 2025) as required, which leads us to believe that the GB is developing Auroville according to its own wishes and without consulting the residents (as stated in the Act). Also, development is inconsistent with the Master plan in several cases such as: there is no parking lot in the city area envisaged, as has been developed near the Solar Kitchen, a “circular road” is mentioned but there is never any mention of a “perfect circle” or any jargon regarding a “yantra”. These are myths or personal beliefs created by certain persons without any authority.

Reasons to believe there are malpractices:

1. Since 2022 nearly 25 acres of land, abutting state/national highways (with high market value) have been exchanged for 36 acres of land with no public access (substantially lower market value). As we write, we believe more exchanges were or are being negotiated. These lands are not only in the city area but many are in the Green Belt.

2. In the disposal of survey nos TH 183/1 & 185 (Auro Orchard), it is noteworthy that similar property (the Universal Farmhouse), located exactly opposite on the same state highway has a current market value averaging 1400/- to 2400/- per sq ft according to its proximity with the road, while the land exchanged in Auro Orchard has over 400 metres of frontage road, but was disposed of at the guideline value of only 16/- per sq ft, causing a conservatively estimated loss of at least Rs 60 crores to Auroville.

4. Commonly accepted mechanisms of price discovery for disposal of land like legal opinions, evaluation by empanelled evaluator, announcement in newspapers, call for tenders, etc, have not been followed in all the above cases, and in several instances the subdivisions of a plot have much higher guideline values than the AV land.
5. There has been secrecy about all the recent land exchanges, the Aurovilian residents working or residing on these plots have not been informed, nor has the Working Committee or the Funds and Assets Management Committee been consulted. It is apparent that two Land Board members who are related have negotiated purchases with their business partners. Property purchase documents show their relatives and in-laws as buyers, who subsequently sell the land to speculators like Mrs. Vijaya (owner of Mother Care Holidays Resorts - Hotel Serena) and Mr. T. Kannan. These speculators appear to be exploiting the situation to acquire prime Auroville properties at Auroville's expense. Sellers are reportedly further being misled about government purchase restrictions and directed to sell to the aforementioned third parties.
6. Lands disposed of have not been surveyed by a government surveyor as mentioned previously; in one case (sale deed numbered 7603/2023), for 10 acres of Auro Orchard the FMB is hastily hand drawn. (This has resulted in the loss of the main access, a house, three cow sheds, two godowns, the primary bore well and the irrigation distribution for the entire Farm. This was an obvious error as none of the above mentioned assets are mentioned in the schedule of property.
7. According to GFRS 2017 rule 309, autonomous bodies are to mandatorily have central government approval before disposal of lands. However, the Ministry of Education replied on December 5, 2023, to an RTI saying "M/o Education has not sanctioned anything related to sales/exchanges/leases/disposals of land as yet", but the District Registrar has registered these land exchanges in spite of lack of these mandatory approvals.
8. The Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly has sent a legal notice to the District Registrar (Tindivanam) on the 21st of September 2022 and on the 18th of November 2022, but necessary action was not taken. On the 3rd of May 2023, yet another letter was sent to the District Registrar (Tindivanam).
9. On the 29th of March, 2023, the Ministry of Education sent an email to the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation (No. 2-13/2020-UU) commenting on the minutes of the 61st and 62nd meetings of the Governing Board bringing her attention to GFRS 2017 rule 309 and pointing out that the same information had been conveyed by them in respect of the 56th Governing Board meeting minutes. This shows that the land has been disposed of in spite of repeated objections by the central government.
10. A letter dated 14th November 2023 from the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly to the Governing Board of the Auroville Foundation and the International Advisory Committee highlights questionable land exchanges.
11. A letter dated 5th Dec 2023 from the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly to the members of the Governing Board and the International Advisory Council again highlights questionable land exchanges.
12. According to the Auroville Foundation Rules, 1997, Section 4(i), the Governing Board of the Auroville Foundation is to consult with the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly and the Funds and Assets Management Committee before proposing disposal of land. However, no such consultation has been done. In fact, the disposals have been kept secret from the above groups and from most of the members of the Land Board of the Auroville Foundation.
13. According to the Foundation Office, these lands are being exchanged to consolidate lands in the city area of Auroville (according to Perspective Plan 2025). However, in reality, many of the valuable lands were exchanged for properties outside of the city area.
14. In February 2022, when Mr. T. Kannan (recent beneficiary of the AuroOrchard land with survey nos TH 183/1 & 185) was approached by the Land Board of Auroville with regard to consolidation of city lands, his request for these same plots of AuroOrchard were refused by LB on behalf of FAMC and WC (due to the Mother's legacy in purchasing the farm, her message regarding it and its purpose). However, since the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation changed two active and effective Aurovilian Land Board members in June 2022 and employed two non-Aurovilian Special Land Officers, permission was granted without following due procedure.
15. In early March 2024, a letter from 4 of the 5 members of the IAC was sent to the GB to halt exchanges until measures towards transparency and fairness to all stakeholders have been taken.
