OPEN REPLY TO ANU, ARUN, JOSEBA, SELVARAJ AND TINE REGARDING LAND EXCHANGES

Dear Auroville Community,

We, the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly, feel compelled to address the recent <u>statement</u> circulated by a group of five residents illegally impersonating us. This statement contains several misleading claims and misrepresentations that we wish to clarify.

Firstly, the ongoing Residents' Assembly Decision-making process (RAD) is not "unqualified" or "anonymous". It is a legitimate participative process initiated in response to serious concerns about land exchanges conducted since 2022. These exchanges have been carried out without transparency, proper consultation, or due process, resulting in estimated losses of over INR 200 crores (USD 24 million) to Auroville.

Here are useful documents for your reference:

- 1. Working Committee report on land, May 2024
- Table of all recent land exchanges, with estimated values as of May 2024 and map of these exchanges.
- Map of Auroville communities located inside and outside of the Master Plan area (according to the Perspective 2025 document)
- 4. Extract from the Meeting Minutes of the GB Land Committee with approval by GB members, obtained from the Ministry of Education through an RTI filed by an individual, which includes the intention to exchange outlying Auroville lands

The claim that this RAD will be "catastrophic for Auroville" is unfounded. On the contrary, it aims to protect Auroville's lands and ensure their use aligns with our community's founding principles. The Mother's vision for Auroville was not just about building infrastructure, but about creating a living embodiment of human unity in diversity. This is, we believe, the cornerstone of Auroville.

Regarding land consolidation, we agree it's an important goal. However, it must be done transparently, ethically, and in accordance with established procedures (Indian financial laws and the Auroville Foundation Rules, 1997). Additionally, there is a Due Diligence procedure (SOP) that had been approved by a previous Secretary and was in use until 2021. Recent exchanges have not met these standards. For example, parts of AuroOrchard, one of our oldest and most productive farms, were exchanged at drastically undervalued rates without any consultation or information, causing significant loss to Auroville. Other communities such as Felicity and Djaima have also started being subjected to the same fate. The statement's implication that those supporting this RAD are rejecting the Master Plan or are "ignorant" about it is also misleading. All that we ask for is adherence to proper processes, including consultation with the Residents' Assembly and respect for all three authorities of the Auroville Foundation as outlined in the Auroville Foundation Act. The Master Plan was created 25 years ago with the primary purpose of protecting Auroville land - not destroying it. Certain Auroville lands have a precious history and play a vital role in our collective reality, and these need to be respected rather than plundered.

We want to emphasize that **this RAD** is **not about blocking progress**. It's about ensuring that any land exchanges or sales are conducted fairly, transparently, and in the best interests of Auroville as a whole. The resolution calls for a pause on exchanges until trust is rebuilt and proper processes are established - not an indefinite ban.

To all residents of Auroville, we encourage you to participate in this RAD, regardless of your stance on the issue. Your voice matters in shaping the future of our community. If we don't act now to address these concerns, we risk irreversible damage to Auroville's physical and spiritual fabric.

Auroville, the 'city at the service of Truth', was founded on principles of unity and peace. Let's honor these ideals by engaging in open, honest dialogue and participative decision-making. If we don't do it now, then when?

EMERGENCY RESIDENTS' ASSEMBLY DECISION-MAKING PROCESS AGAINST LAND SALES/EXCHANGES BY THE AVFO 28 TH JUNE – 7 TH JULY 2024

Dear Residents,

The Governing Board (GB) has approved the proposal by the Secretary to exchange all Auroville lands outside the Master Plan area, totalling 1054 acres (see Map - https://shorturl.at/gw00A). This information was shared with the community in January of this year and started circulating again on the day of the most recent meeting of the GB, which took place on the 31st of May.

Therefore, the Working Committee of the Residents Assembly is calling an Emergency Residents' Assembly Decision-making process (3.3 RAD policy, 2023 - https://shorturl.at/tAl34) to ask the Residents' Assembly to express its views on this decision that will directly impact all Aurovilians on various levels, while causing irreparable damage to Auroville's physical body and the loss of a number of areas of historical significance.

As we are all aware, since 2022 there have been an unprecedented number of land exchanges that have been carried out by the current Secretary and her appointees with the approval of the GB.

These exchanges have been carried out without transparency or due process and without any consultation with those living and working on these lands, and have resulted in a conservatively estimated loss of over INR 200 crores (USD 24 million) to Auroville, in addition to the loss of important parts of Auroville's physical body and legacy (please see the summary below of the main issues, and for more details please see the Working Committee report on land https://shorturl.at/DgmsV, published in May 2024).

PREAMBLE

The Residents' Assembly (RA) objects to the sale and exchange of lands by the Auroville Foundation Office (AVFO), as carried out since 2022 by the current Secretary with the approval of the Governing Board (GB). In this RAD, the RA resolves that all land exchanges and sales must be paused until such time as confidence and trust between all 3 authorities of the Auroville Foundation has been re-established (namely the GB, IAC, RA) and all three jointly agree on a process to follow if and when land exchanges are absolutely necessary.

RESOLUTION

We, as members of the Residents' Assembly, resolve the following:

- Immediate Halt to Land Sales/Exchanges: An immediate pause on any further sale or exchange of Auroville properties.
- Review and Reversal of Land Deals: A thorough review
 of the land deals undertaken by the current Secretary and
 authorized by the Governing Board, with a focus on
 reversal and restitution for any wrongful transactions.
- Full Investigation: A comprehensive investigation into all land exchanges conducted by the current administration since 2022.
- Future land deals: To be made with all due process, respecting the Auroville Foundation Act and its 3 authorities (namely the RA, IAC and the GB) and Indian law.

These are necessary steps to protect Auroville land and ensure its use aligns with the original purpose and ideals of peace and human unity.

AUROVILLE DOG SHELTER

MONTHLY TRANSPARENCY REPORT JUNE 2024

As part of our commitment to transparency, we are happy to present our report for June.

Overview

New admissions: 9 (236 since April 2023 - among them several

pets dumped by heartless owners)

Donations and Cease and Desist Order

This month, our funding situation has improved despite many bureaucratic hurdles. Auroville's new Donation Channeling Group is gradually becoming operational, and we finally received the donations already collected in May and June from AVI USA. However, due to immense bureaucracy, there are significant delays before donations reach the shelter. This directly impacts our dogs' safety and the shelter's overall running. We hope that the situation will improve in the next month.

We have received information from several reliable sources that the former management of the IACC shelter has intensified its disinformation campaign against the Auroville Dog Shelter. They have been contacting not only local donors but also international donors, spreading completely false information about our shelter. These falsehoods include claims that dogs are dying, that we have closed access to the public, accusations embezzlement, and even allegations that we bribed the Department of Animal Husbandry to issue favorable reports. These actions constitute defamation and have caused us severe financial damage, as some regular donors have stopped their contributions. We have issued a cease and desist order to the former managers of IACC to stop their sabotaging actions, which have plunged the shelter into a severe financial crisis over the past few months. We hope that reason will prevail and these attacks will cease immediately. If not, Auroville officials will have no other option but to file defamation charges.

We are deeply grateful to the Foundation for Animal Welfare Projects (<u>FAWP.NL</u>), a wonderful animal care organization in the Netherlands, who listened to our call for help for their generous donation of €3,000. Their support has come at a critical time, enabling us to uphold and continue the high standard of our animal care. We hope that the Donation Channeling Group and FAMC will release this urgently needed donation quickly.

This month, Rs. 295,620 arrived in our FS account, including donations sent by AVI USA covering our basic monthly running costs of Rs. 3 lakh. Additionally, Rs. 40,000 in donations were received in our AV Foundation - Auroville Dog Shelter account from generous local donors. Our Milaap Fundraiser generated Rs. 76,224, which will help us prepare our dogs and shelter for the upcoming monsoon season. You can view the fundraiser here: Milaap Fundraiser.

Expenditures

Animal Food: This month we fed our dogs 1.8 tons of rice, 2.1 tons of chicken, and 700 eggs, supplemented with donated food items like vegetables and daal which cost us approx. 1.1 lakh.

Staff Costs: Total staff costs for this month for our workers, paid animal care staff, 2 veterinarians, and volunteers was approx. Rs. 1 lakh this month.

Medical Costs: This month we were able to start buying urgently needed medicines again for Rs 32.700 - We are almost out of vaccinations and need urgently to provide tick treatment with Bravecto to our dogs to prevent a tick fever outbreak. This will cost us approximately Rs 90.000 - If you want to contribute to raise the funds for this important medicine, please contribute to our FS 251391 or to a variety of AV-approved donation gateways which you can find on our website: www.aurovilledogshelter.com

Restarting of our ABC Program

Thanks to the generosity of some wonderful dog lovers, who sponsored 20 ABC surgeries we were able to restart our free and donation-based sterilization program again. We have weekly surgeries with a limited capacity of a maximum of 4 dogs to offer for Rs. 3.000 per dog (Aurovilians Rs. 2500) including if needed, free vaccinations. We still have a long waiting list of shelter-raised dogs to get sterilized. We offer free sterilizations for every puppy which had been adopted from our shelter or in cases of financial problems for the owner. Our goal once the new Auroville Dog Shelter has been built to receive government grants to be able to offer free sterilizations to everyone and thus stop the suffering of many newborn puppies while keeping the dog numbers down and the Community safe from rabies and other diseases.

Weekly Mobile Vet Clinic

At the beginning of June, we launched a soft trial run of a new service we provide to the Auroville Community. The mobile vet clinic is open every Friday from 11.30 am until 1.30 pm at the parking lot in front of Solar Kitchen to provide free veterinary advice from our vet team, give health checkups to all kinds of animals, not just dogs, offer cost-price vaccinations and reserve sterilization slots. We also have always a bunch of cute puppies with us hoping that some will get adopted and give information about our fostering program.

The response of Auroville residents on their way to their Solar Kitchen lunch was overwhelming and we are happy to get in direct contact with many people, talking about our animal care work and the services we are offering and sharing our plans for the future of animal care in Auroville. In week 2 we upgraded the simple mobile clinic with an information panel with maps and details about the construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter. For the next 8 weeks, we will collect all feedback, integrate as much as possible in our detailed project planning, and present our vision for the new Auroville Dog Shelter in an event at Savitri Bhavan beginning of September. We also will try to set up soon on our website www.aurovilledogshelter.com a possibility for the AV Community to provide direct online feedback, suggestions, and criticism about the new Auroville Dog Shelter, which is so much more than just a place to care for dogs, but will become a place for all Aurovilians, visitors, and guests and have a big impact on the entire Community.

We hope to be able to expand the mobile vet clinic from Auroville to the neighboring villages in the next few weeks to provide daily veterinary help free of charge or donation-based for every animal in the bioregion of Auroville. We need to heal, vaccinate, sterilize, and ensure the health of animals in the entire area, as it will have a direct impact on Auroville. The danger of rabies has to be eliminated and the number of new puppies controlled. We urgently need funds to be able to expand our services to the villages around Auroville.

Infrastructure Improvements

Despite the rapidly deteriorating condition of the old shelter, which is severely overcrowded and falling apart, we must endure another monsoon season at the current location due to delays caused by individuals opposing the construction of the new Auroville Dog Shelter. In response, we have built a temporary kitchen after the roof of the old kitchen collapsed.

Thankfully, several wonderful new volunteers have joined the shelter, including a particularly skilled individual who has been instrumental in helping our team rebuild, improve, and repair the failing infrastructure. To address the extreme overcrowding and ensure safe conditions for our dogs during the monsoon season, we have decided to construct additional dog enclosures and self-made doghouses. These measures will help protect our 280 residents through the rainy season until we can finally relocate to the new shelter. We ask kind-hearted Aurovilians and dog lovers to assist us with their time, energy and donated materials to make the shelter rain-safe before September. If you have old roof sheets, materials, cement, or strong plastic tarps, please consider donating them to the shelter.

MoU with Mettupallayam Veterinary College

We are pleased to announce that, following a long period of increasing cooperation with Mettupallayam RIVER College, the Auroville Dog Shelter has officially entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with this esteemed animal care and teaching institution. The official MoU documents were signed on June 29th by our executives and management, alongside the Dean of RIVER College. This marks a significant milestone in the history of our shelter. Moving forward, we will not only serve as an animal care facility but also as a center for education, learning, and research for veterinary students from Mettupallayam College. Our veterinary team is excited to provide mentorship and guidance to the students, who will gain hands-on experience by volunteering at our shelter.

A Last Call about The Responsibility of Auroville

As a city, Auroville holds the responsibility of managing its municipal services, including the dog shelter. The operation of the shelter is crucial for public health, as it helps prevent the spread of diseases like rabies and canine distemper. It also maintains community safety by managing the stray dog population through sterilizations. Covering the shelter's basic running costs is a fundamental responsibility that underscores Auroville's commitment to animal welfare and community well-being, in line with the values of Sri Aurobindo and the Mother.

In June, our manager had a brief discussion with the FAMC, but regrettably, we were informed that the monthly funding of Rs. 50,000 from the BCC for the shelter will not be increased. This leaves us in a constant struggle for survival, uncertain if we will have enough funds to provide food and medicines for our dogs. This financial strain prevents us from expanding our services or repairing the shelter to ensure it lasts until the new facility is operational. We urgently need to provide necessary medical care, such as BRAVECTO tick treatment for all our dogs this month, and continue offering free vaccinations and sterilizations.

We extend our heartfelt thanks to everyone for your continued support of the Auroville Dog Shelter. We are especially grateful to the donors who visited our shelter, witnessed our work, and chose to help us navigate this challenging period. Despite ongoing resistance, we remain optimistic about beginning construction on the new Auroville Dog Shelter soon.

ARTISTS IN RESPONSE

A sphere 1 meter in diameter, composed of approximately 1500 palmyra seeds and suspended like a satellite among the trees, welcomes us to a collective exhibition put on by 24 Aurovilian artists, and organized by no one knows who, no one knows exactly how and where.



There were no announcements, no flyers printed, zero communication. Word spread among friends and in a week the exhibition was visited by more than 300 people.

The exhibition was in the forest, in an Aurovilian territory of great importance for some, because from there the first pioneers started to "build" Auroville, but of no significance for others because it is not part of the coveted city center.



The exhibition is entitled "Artists in Response" and the works on display try to respond to the current critical situation and to play with frustrations, hopes, foolish choices, abuses, utopias, and everything that makes us participate today in this endless adventure.



The exhibition winds through the forest and reveals itself gradually. Here and there, small white ceramic Peace Warriors show us the way. We come across an apocryphal altar dedicated to the great god of the golden chicken, a Milky Way that dialogues with the Crown Road, tiny JCBs that work to play down our nightmares, interactive installations that invite us to write down our thoughts and to remember that we are all here for a very particular reason. There is even an installation that takes us back to the prison where Sri Aurobindo was locked up, and a mirror that takes us behind those bars. Luckily we are surrounded by trees and not by walls!



And then metal sculptures like still-life emerging from the earth, wooden masks camouflaged like dancing sprites, and panels, photographs, ceramics, paintings, around fifty works giving new life to the forest and turning it into an active museum, a place of exchange, a living nature.



Along with the exhibition, small events entertained visitors every evening. Little theater plays alternated with screenings of short movies or photographic collages, and then juice, biscuits, and chatting in that peaceful atmosphere that we all need now more than ever.

And on the last day, as in a sort of unexpected closing ceremony, more than one hundred Aurovilians gathered there and went beyond the exhibition area, further into the forest, to get together in a magical clearing dominated by a large banyan among whose branches a magnificent palm-leaf dragon was floating. Nothing special happened, but we were just there, sitting in a semicircle, listening to the sound of the leaves, the birds, and our breathing.

A great adventure, indeed.

WAKE UP, AUROVILLE!

As we approach the third year of unprecedented changes in our community, I feel compelled to share my deepest concerns about the direction we are heading. I see disturbing similarities between what's happening in Auroville and the rise of authoritarian power consolidation all over the world.

Signs of Authoritarian Control

Let's be clear: the actions of the new Auroville Foundation administration bear hallmarks of authoritarian control that should worry us all. We've witnessed the systematic dismantling of our self-governance structures, the cornerstone of Auroville's unique experiment. Our Working Committee, Town Development Council, and other resident-led bodies have been forcibly replaced by appointees loyal to the new administration. This centralization of power is a classic move in the authoritarian playbook.

The suppression of dissent is another red flag. Many of us have faced threats to our housing, livelihoods, and even our right to stay in Auroville for voicing concerns. Friends have had visas revoked or denied without explanation. Our community platforms for open discussion have been seized and censored. These are not the actions of an administration interested in fostering the human unity and free progress that Auroville stands for.

We've seen the bulldozing of our carefully nurtured forests and the imposition of a rigid, outdated development plan that disregards decades of community planning and environmental stewardship. This top-down approach, enforced through intimidation and destruction, flies in the face of Auroville's collaborative spirit and ecological values.

The new administration's narrative paints a false picture of Auroville as a failed experiment needing drastic intervention. They label those who disagree as "anti-development", "anti-government" or "unruly foreigners", using nationalist rhetoric to divide us. This tactic of creating in-groups and out-groups, of demonizing a portion of the population, is straight out of the totalitarian handbook.

Financial and Information Control

Financial control is another area of concern. The takeover of our community funds, opaque land deals, and arbitrary cutting of stipends to long-term residents all point to a consolidation of economic power that leaves us vulnerable to further coercion.

Perhaps most troubling is the assault on our freedom of expression and access to information. The seizure of our communication channels, likely surveillance of emails, and possible attempts to rewrite our history through control of the Archives are classic moves of authoritarian regimes seeking to shape reality to their liking.

A Call for Reflection

I ask you: how can these actions possibly align with the ideals of human unity, freedom, and collective progress that are at the heart of Auroville's purpose? How can we fulfill our role as a laboratory for human evolution if we're not free to experiment, to make mistakes, to grow organically?

To those who support these changes, believing they will lead to faster development or better management, I urge you to look deeper. Are bulldozers and intimidation really the way to manifest the city the earth needs? Is silencing dissent and centralizing power truly the path to human unity?

I understand the frustrations with Auroville's slow progress in some areas. But let's not let our impatience or personal grievances blind us to the dangerous path we're on. Authoritarian systems may seem efficient in the short term, but they inevitably lead to stagnation, corruption, and the suppression of the human spirit.

To those in positions of influence who are enabling these changes, perhaps seduced by promises of power or resources, I implore you to reconsider. The history of totalitarian regimes is full of early supporters who later found themselves victims of the very system they helped create.

Preserving Auroville's Vision

We must ask ourselves: what kind of Auroville are we creating? One where diverse viewpoints are valued and true collaboration flourishes? Or one where a single vision is imposed by force, where fear replaces trust, and where our highest ideals are sacrificed in the name of efficiency?

The Mother envisioned Auroville as a place belonging to humanity as a whole, where the free will of individuals would be respected. She explicitly stated that handing over the management of Auroville to any single group was "an absolute impossibility." Yet this is precisely what we're facing now.

Our Responsibility and Path Forward

We stand at a crossroads. Will we allow the erosion of the very qualities that make Auroville unique and valuable to the world? Or will we find the courage to stand up for our founding principles, to insist on our right to self-determination, and to continue our experiment in consciousness and human unity as it was intended?

This is not about resisting change or progress. It's about ensuring that change comes from within, guided by our collective wisdom and aspirations, not imposed from above through force and fear.

I call on all Aurovilians to wake up to the reality of what's happening. Inform yourselves. Speak out. Support those who are working to protect our community's core values. Remember why you came to Auroville in the first place.

We have a responsibility not just to ourselves, but to the world that looks to Auroville as a beacon of hope for a different way of living. Let us not dim that light. Let us instead rekindle our commitment to building a city that truly belongs to humanity as a whole, free from the shadows of authoritarianism and fear.

Conclusion

The future of our unique experiment hangs in the balance. What we do now will determine whether Auroville continues as a living laboratory for human unity or becomes just another failed utopia, crushed under the weight of autocratic control. The choice – and the responsibility – is ours.

OPEN LETTER TO THE LURKING COMMITTEE (AKA: ANU, ARUN, JOSEBA, SELVARAJ AND TINE)

MATRIMANDIR EXCHANGED!

One of the most dramatic land developments in Tamil Nadu's and India's history since independence occurred on July 1, 2024. The Auroville Foundation announced that Matrimandir was exchanged for four villages.

The new owner was not Indian, but Korean. The Lucky Hyun-Sung Group has bought Auroville's centrepiece, along with the entire section inside the crown. The terms are on the Auroville terms. LHS will own the MM until it dies. It cannot sell or bequeath it to anyone. It will be like a steward but has the authority to develop the area for one and only one purpose: golf.

The Korean payment would allow Auroville to create a new master plan: Crown to Hem. And the resources to develop it. The Mother's Dream could come true without ownership of the centre. The Koreans have given their word that they will not change the MM. Aurovilians will have access to the MM at the same times as they have today, except for when there are golf tournaments.

This exchange has the blessings of the entire Indian government. The heads of state exchanged gifts, the Tamil Nadu state government officials were flying to Korea, even the land bureaucrats of the TN district are being invited to Korea to meet their equivalents. The Koreans want everyone to know that this is an important reciprocating deal. They are happy to fully support the teaching of Korean language and manufacturing processes in the local schools while training people to go to Korea and teach Sanskrit and yoga.

There was both silence and exuberance in Auroville. The Auroville Foundation consists of three entities: the Governing Board, the Residents Assembly, and the International Advisory Council. The IAC was most vocal about how happy it was to expand to include Koreans with senior UN experience. The Governing Board which did a coup-d'etat on itself by reversing the terms of recently penned land exchange points for a two-decade old master plan declined to comment. Aurovilians were mainly silent as they just wanted information on:

- How would the MM access change and how it would reflect on the Mother's dream;
- 2. How would the population of Auroville change; and
- 3. How much money would trickle down for the development of the city.

Details would be provided by August assured many government officials. Some ideas releasesd included a note about The Youth Bhavan, a new unit targetted to be hosted within the Korean Pavilion (another new building with a great view). It would help Aurovilian youth learn golf by offering golf scholarships.

Local villagers were reading thru fliers printed in Tamil. The panchayats would become one large Auroville panchayat. All the villagers would keep their lands, but the population would be counted as Aurovilians and new tiers of Aurovilians would be created. Some villagers were glad that Auroville would manage their garbage: "Auroville is the cleanest place in India and we are tired of living in filth and stench and want to live like Aurovilians." They were most happy about jobs and polite, clean tourists.

Even the Pondicherry government was involved with many officials in transit to Korea. The airport and port were targetted for special upgrades for flights, airships, and cruise-liners.

A concept plan of the golf-course was also circulated, 18-holes circling the MM. The challenge was that it would be the world's most hot and humid course, with both water hazards and cooling pools. Golfers would wear new swimable golf gear. The big German-style lake would be replaced by a Tamil-style series of ponds.

Environmentalists were most elated to hear this news. Also that the Koreans were not only golf-enthusiasts, but also bird-watchers and there would be also some effort to develop the Kazhuvelli Bird Sanctuary.

Even the UN had a special meeting on this event. The UN representative said: "While the rest of the world is at war, it is nice to see a very new development: an International Private Public Partnership at all levels from the citizen to the President, take place." We hear that the retired UN Secretary-General is involved and that is good news.

The size of the deal was not available. The only number provided was by the Koreans. They were keeping aside #1 billion to maintain the MM. "With Auroville's blessing, if there is a need to repair it over the next 50 years, we would be happy to do it. We would like to properly redo the outer shell, so its becomes a perfect sphere, like a golf-ball and less like an ovary."

PSYCHIC BEING

On April 1st, 2011, Fool's Day, I started writing on the psychic being. Appalled by the misuse of the term I never speaks about and here I was, compelled to write about as if a question of life and death. Indeed, it is.

Cycling, as during my solitary walks, I dialogue with 'the child' within, entering another world. To do good to all creatures: this is what 'the child' is about.



I do know that I belong to that other world, where I enter at will, and which I always knew as the real thing: the inner world of my childhood. The outer world is desecrating fiction temporarily concealing the real thing: *kalos kai agathos*, the beautiful and good of ancient Greece.

The higher vital screams in anguish at the squalor I am confronted with. Screams when I read the world news and the local ones. Anguish and hopelessness, wherever I turn. But the more I am confronted with the suffering imparted by my fellow beings, the more 'the child' asserts itself. When the outer being is but a mass of indescribable pain 'the child' takes over, calm, putting forward his raison d' être: the advent of the new world and society.

'The child' in us can and will take over, even if only for a short while, to remind us to never lose hope. We cannot give up, cannot let ourselves go. Shattered to pieces, we must resist and say no to all that wants us to give up. Destruction is all over, within as without Auroville. But we do have the psychic being, our one asset. If others' psychic beings join and resist, Auroville will be reborn out of its ashes. Group-soul! And so will the world, if the psychic beings all over the planet take the rein of the individual personalities and everyone stands for what's high and noble and beautiful, calling it upon earth by the force of the collective soul.

The supramental is to be reached by stages, the journey has begun; the power to bring it down on earth rests with us. To activate that power the psychic must take over: the psychic world – a first step of the ascension – is contingent and real.

The psychic being only can save the world. You. I. LOVE. There is no other way. The psychic being is the soul in us that aspires for a world of justice and equity, of compassion, understanding and charity. This is the purport of educational fairy tales, Sri Aurobindo saw the qualities of the psychic being as typical of the Christian saints. If children are reared that way there are strong chances that, instead of being superseded by mental education (and simultaneously with it, the burgeoning low vital and its passions), the psychic being will keep guiding them through life. Even if this is not visible all the time, its stronghold remains as the guidance and sustenance through the challenge of life.

The psychic being is the knight within us, the champion of the poor and the oppressed, of the weak and the enslaved. If we allow its silent flame, always turned to the light, to organize our lives the psychic being will make of it an expression of integral beauty: beauty of feelings, beauty of deeds, beauty of aspiration and lofty ideals. Even the seemingly insignificant actions of daily life will have their dignity for nothing is unworthy, nothing too trivial for the Divine. Each second spent on earth should be part of an everlasting work of art according to which we should fashion our existence.

The psychic being will not shun from the anti-divine forces that belittle and deny it. Incapable of feelings such as hostility, superiority, judgment or repulsion, the psychic being is the calm, strong warrior that serenely faces Darkness and turns it into Light. For, ultimately, everything is the Divine, the Four Emanations too. Born out of It, to the Divine they shall return, once the grand opus of transformation is achieved.

Still this is not a mere allegory, the characters are not personified qualities, but incarnations or emanations of living and conscious Forces with whom we can enter into concrete touch and they take human bodies in order to help man and show him the way from his mortal state to a divine consciousness and immortal life.





School year 2024-2025

Dear Parents, dear All,

Registration: We welcome all students (new and the already registered ones) from 8 years of age (3rd Grade) to register for the Aikido classes. We restart the year on Monday July 8th, on par with Dehashakti Sports. As you may know, classes take place at the Aikido Dojo at Dehashakti (the Auroville Budokan).

Attendance: Students joining for the first time are given a one-two month trial period during which they can withdraw if they do not like or it is felt unsuitable for them at the moment. Then to integrate and progress with the practice, students of all ages are expected to be regular and attend at least 2 classes a week out of the 3 offered.

As in any school, a whole year commitment is required; presence is noted down and submitted monthly to the School Board/representative; parents are expected to communicate with us in case the child is/will be absent. Evaluations (kyu passage) will be held once or twice during the year, and possibly a workshop with (an) invited high-ranked Aikido master(s) will be organised if funds are available...

<u>Timing</u>: **Monday, Wednesday and Friday** from **4 to 5 pm** (for the time being noSaturday 9 to 10 am class are offered. Let's see later this year if it is possible for us to organise it...)

Practice outfit: In the beginning, new students can wear long and comfortable pants and a T-shirt (no tight-fitting clothes). A white keikogi (practice suit) will soon be necessary to continue the practice. We have some in stock and will lend them out. Nandini can also make the keikogi for your child if needed and if you are a participant to the service.

Note: Please return the keikogi (with the belt!) to the Budokan if your child has stopped or if it needs to be changed. They will be re-used!

Conditions: 1/ Please note that all students need to be part of the Auroville Health Fund or insured by a personal insurance. 2/ We are maintaining the Budokan/Aikido Dojo ourselves (without city budget) and therefore all students (and the teachers too!) are asked to contribute Rs. 1650/- as an annual contribution, to be deposited in the "Aikido/Budokan" Account # 252731. Thank you for your attention to this. The annual contribution will need to be transferred shortly after the beginning of the school year, or after the successful trial period (August/September). A monthly contribution is asked from non Auroville children. For information, AV Budokan is a sub-unit of SAIIER.



Travel Tips:

Several travellers were "boarding denied" as check-in staff didn't accept the **e-FRRO Stay Visa** as valid document without backing it up with additional documentation. Therefore we advise to take beside the Stay Visa document (please make sure your current Passport details are in it) your Original Visa, which is maybe in an older expired Passport. If not available anymore, take at least a photocopy of the original Visa.

Indian nationals can now be issued long-term, multi-entry **Schengen visas** valid for two years after having obtained and lawfully used two visas within the previous three years. The two-year visa will normally be followed by a five-year visa, if the passport has sufficient validity remaining. During the validity period of these visas, holders enjoy travel rights equivalent to visa-free nationals.

Srilankan Tourist Visa 30 days single entry fees waiver scheme for citizens of China, India, Indonesia, Russia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan is valid until further notice. Indian Nationals can apply for E-tourist visa through the given link

https://www.srilankaevisa.lk/ Indian Nationals are entitled to visa exemption for the purpose of tourism and short-term business engagements, for a period not exceeding 60 days. Visa on arrival at the immigration checkpoints on arrival for the purpose of tourism, for a period not exceeding 15 days.

The Embassy of the Republic of Turkey announces that Turkish authorities has commenced requiring the "Electronic Airport Transit Visa" (e-ATV) for Indian & Nepalese passport holders traveling to Mexico, Panama, Colombia and Venezuela, Transiting via the Istanbul Airport.

eVisa fees waiver scheme has been introduced for citizens of India, China, Indonesia, Russia, Thailand, Malaysia, and Japan, with immediate effect, valid until May 31st, 2024 (Last date of arrival) for tourism only. To avail of the scheme, please select the 30-day single entry eVisa option.

Thailand has extended its visa exemption program for tourists from India and Taiwan for another six months, allowing these travelers to enter the country without a visa until November 11, 2024. Travelers from India and Taiwan can stay for a maximum of 30 days without a visa.



"A SCENE AT THE SEA" (Original title's transliteration: "Ano natsu, ichiban shizukana umi")


Directed by Takeshi Kitano (AKA Beat Takeshi) - Japan, 1991
