"Auroville will be a self-supporting township.

All who live there will participate in its life and development.

This participation may be passive or active.

There will be no taxes as such but each will contribute to the collective welfare in work, kind or money.

Sections like industries which participate actively will contribute part of their income towards the development of the township.

Or if they produce something (like foodstuffs) useful for the citizens, they will contribute in kind to the township which is responsible for feeding its citizens.

No rules or laws are being framed. Things will get formulated as the underlying Truth of the township emerges and takes shape progressively. We do not anticipate."

I thought I had said more than that because I said a good deal

about it, inwardly,—on the organisation, the food, etc. We are going to make experiments.

Some things are really interesting; first of all, for example, I would like each country to have its pavilion, and in the pavilion there will be the cooking of that country,—that is, the Japanese will be able to eat Japanese food if they want to, etc. But in the town itself there will be food for both vegetarians and non vegetarians, and there will also be some attempt to find the food of tomorrow.

The whole process of assimilation which makes you so heavy —it takes so much of a person's time and energy—that should be done *beforehand*, you should be given something which is immediately assimilable, like the things they are making now; for example they have vitamin pills and proteins which can be assimilated directly, nutritious elements which are found in one thing or another and which don't have much volume, — a huge quantity is needed to assimilate very little. Now that they are skilful enough in chemistry, it could be simplified.

People do not like this simply because they take an intense pleasure in eating; but when you no longer take pleasure in eating, you still need nourishment without wasting your time on it. An enormous amount of time is wasted,—time in eating, in digesting, and all the rest. And there, I would like an experimental kitchen, a kind of culinary laboratory for experimenting. People would go to one place or another according to their tastes and inclinations.

And they don't pay for their food, but they should offer their work or their produce: those who have fields, for example, should give the produce from their fields; those who have factories should give their products; or one gives one's labour in exchange for food.

That in itself eliminates much of the internal exchange of money. And for everything we could find things like this. Basically, it shouldbe a city for study, for study and research into a way of life which is

NOTE:

- A Newcomer becomes an 'Aurovilian' once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming 'Aurovilian' is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- The formal administrative step of entering new residents into the Register of Residents (RoR), is done by the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation. For this, a B-Form is filled in and signed by the individual and a meeting with the Secretary is arranged by the Entry Secretariat. However, until such time as a new Secretary is appointed, the meetings of Confirmed Aurovilians with the Secretary will be pending.

Dear Friends,

As you may know, the Entry Service has been functioning with reduced capacity since January 2024.

The actions taken to stop the work given to the Entry Service by the Residents' Assembly persist. However, according to the Auroville Foundation Act, the power to admit and terminate names from the register of residents is within the exclusive domain of the Residents' Assembly. The new regulations were challenged before the Madras High Court and have been stayed, but have not been finally heard and disposed.

Be that as it may, the Entry Board team has been reconstituted according to the Residents' Assembly approved process and 3 ongoing members welcomed 5 new members. The team has been meeting regularly since May 2024.

However, we have been advised not to process new applications for the time being.

We intend to use this time to take up pending work such as requesting mentor reports, and Newcomer self assessments. We plan to resume completing the Newcomer processes, some of which have been left pending for over 6 months as soon as we are advised to do so.

We apologize for the delays, however, it has been due to circumstances beyond our control.

We pray for relief by the courts in due time.

BRIEF UPDATE FROM THE SUPREME COURT



The appeals on the verdicts of the NGT and of the Madras High Court on the ATDC standing order were briefly discussed on Friday, 29th November.

The counsel appearing for the Foundation office argued that the protests continued in spite of the interim stay. Our counsels requested a postponement. The Supreme Court gave an order reporting the positions of both parties and fixing a date for final hearing on 8th January 2025 without any other directive. The matter is simply in these terms. The full text of the order is <u>attached</u>.

Any other messages that have been circulating in various forums from other parties are false.

REGARDING STATUS OF JAYANTI RAVI AS SECRETARY, AVF

Dear Community,

Regarding the status of Dr. Jayanti Ravi as Secretary of the Auroville Foundation, please find attached a <u>Press Note</u> (and <u>attachment</u>) that was sent out to our contacts in the regional press on 2nd December 2024. Following this, a short article appeared in The Hindu on 3rd December.

On the 4th of December another article appeared in The Hindu stating that according to 'sources', in July 2024 she was extended for a year.

While it is true that there is a letter dated July 2024 stating that she was extended for one year, a subsequent letter dated August 2024 (both letters were obtained through an RTI) states that she was approved for premature repatriation from Secretary, AVF, to her parent cadre in Gujarat, with immediate effect. She assumed her position there on 1 August 2024.

The article of December 4th in The Hindu does not quote any government or public source which confirms that Dr Jayanti Ravi is holding dual charge.

We note that while her repatriation is a matter of public record, the letter extending her for one year has not been made available to the public on the Auroville Foundation website or any other forum. In addition, we have noted that no documents seem to have been signed by her as Secretary, Auroville Foundation, in recent months, including Standing Orders that have been issued lately.

We know Dr Jayanti Ravi has appeared at the 5 December 2024 Governing Board meeting, and are very concerned at the lack of transparency and communication from the part of the Governing Board around the question of her holding dual positions. This intentionally opaque way of functioning continues to be a hallmark of this particular administration, led by the Board and its Chairman. Lastly, the Auronet announcement of the 4th December by the 'Working Committee' (endorsed by the GB), which announces the confirmation of Dr Jayanti Ravi's position as Secretary, is based only on an article in a newspaper.

We extend our heartfelt gratitude for her service and wish her all the very best in her future endeavors.



REMEMBERING VICTOR

Victor (Victor Plotnikov) was born in 1954 and grew up in Moscow, Russia. Since 1993 he had been living in Certitude, with his wife Galina. His son Nikita was born in 1998 in Auroville and since then they lived as a family together till his last day.

He passed away on 27th November, 2024. He was 70 years old.

As a child he was very smart and

inquisitive with varied interests and he loved hiking and rafting through rocky rivers in the Ural region.

In his youth, Victor began to show great interest in Eastern practices, took up Yoga and Karate, attended thematic lectures, and became a vegetarian.

In the early 90s, friends brought Victor a clipping from the newspaper "Komsomolskaya Pravda", which told about the citycommune of Auroville. Since his friends had dreamed of building a similar city in their youth, Victor decided to go to India and see this inspiring vision for himself. From then on, a new stage in his life began.

In his thirties he visited Auroville a few times until he finally moved and settled here. He joined in 1993 and dedicated his entire life to Auroville, especially Matrimandir, which was very dear to his soul. He worked there as an engineer leading a team of workers to manifest the soul of Auroville. From 2019, he worked inside Matrimandir providing peace and guidance for people to meditate.

Victor was an adventurous soul, who kept a smile on his face through any circumstances. He was an extremely dedicated, sincere, honest person, full of passion and joy towards life. He was a good husband and a great father who supported his loved ones through thick and thin of life. He was always ready to help others and supported them with unconditional love. He will be remembered forever as a person with goodwill, good heart, and an eternal smile that radiated positivity and love.

REMEMBERING KARUNA

Karuna Periyaswamy, born in Kuilapalayam, was very young when he joined Auroville, only 14 years old. As a child, he had once met the Mother at the Ashram, as part of a school visit, offering flowers to her. His grandfather was one of the village chiefs of Kuilapalayam. He initially stayed in Fraternity,



then in Aspiration for a while, and then finally settled back in Fraternity with his family. He was partly educated in Auroville (After School), and he became a keen sportsman; kabaddi player, volleyball player and basketball player. He worked at Aurelec for

some time, and later was part of the Solar Service team for a while.

He married Uma in 1991 and had two children, Vidhya and Kishore. Now he has a 4 month old grandson Vihaan, with whom he spent his last months.

At Fraternity, Karuna started a small workshop, producing handicraft items and dolls. He started with one tailor and one lady assistant, and then, in 1993, this became a unit, Discovery, a garment exporting unit with about 60 employees, offering a lot of job opportunities to the surrounding villages of Kuilapalayam, Bommayarpalayam, Edayanchavadi and Alankuppam. The unit specialised in silk hand painted garments and accessories.

Karuna was very actively involved in Auroville life.

He was the first Tamil/Indian to start a successful export unit in Auroville. Later on he expanded the business by taking over the Lotus unit (Hammocks). In recent years he was managing the Discovery guest-house. He created Discovery trust and was trustee of Aurosarjan. а Moreover, he used to be a member of the Entry group, one of the Working Committees, and the ABC support group. He was also helping and supporting vounasters. He financially supported a lot of sports activities like tournaments and matches. And he contributed to Auroville schools. For some time he was one of the executives of NESS school and of the water maintenance service.



He will be remembered as a very organised person, straightforward, skilful, very hard working, with great will power, and he was a strong and bold person. He loved to travel the world and has experienced travelling to the USA, England, Germany, France, Switzerland.

For the past 6 years, Karuna suffered from chronic kidney disease and was in dialysis. He passed away on the 5th of December, aged 60. His cremation took place the next day, at Adventure Burial Ground.

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE MATRIMANDIR EXECUTIVES AND MATRIMANDIR LAKE TEAM

Dear Matrimandir Executives and Lake Team,

We were surprised and deeply concerned to learn about <u>the recent</u> <u>breakage</u> of the Matrimandir lake wall.

While it is a relief that no injuries occurred, the failure of the partition 'lego' wall and imported HDPE sheet raises serious questions about engineering accountability and the use of donor contributions.

Failures in experimental projects may be opportunities for learning. However, our primary concerns extend beyond technical or aesthetic shortcomings.

Over the past few years, we have repeatedly appealed for:



- Obtaining proper building permission from the community.
- Conducting and sharing environmental impact assessments for the lake excavation and the mountain.
- Pausing tree-cutting and excavation, supported by our <u>April</u> <u>2024 petition</u>.
- Consider integrating the <u>Alternate lake proposal</u> that addresses ecological and aesthetic values.
- Consider integrating <u>Community feedback</u> for the lake project in October 2023.

 Engaging in constructive dialogue with community volunteers and more.

Unfortunately, these concerns have been largely ignored or rejected outright.

The work continued in a hasty manner by setting an unrealistic time frame of completion.

This neglect highlights a significant failure: the disregard for participatory and collaborative processes, which are fundamental for the work on Auroville's core values.

We consider this to be the biggest failure in this project and yet to be acknowledged by the present MM executives and the lake team.

For the past three years, Matrimandir lake, gardens and related developments have proceeded amidst administrative discord, undermining the values Auroville has upheld for over 50 years. Regardless of different opinions and approaches, Aurovilians have achieved completing Matrimandir in the spirit of collaboration and mutual respect.

We must see this event as a call to manifest our unity and transparency. It is time to reassess the project entirely and for all involved to step back from the current course.

A REBUTTAL TO THE RECENT MATRIMANDIR LAKE INCIDENT REPORT

On 5th December 2024, the MM executives shared <u>a report via</u> <u>the Matrimandir mass bulletin</u>, acknowledging the failure of the test lake retaining wall structure built using prefab "Lego" blocks. The report explained that the structural design did not account for the possibility of the dam experiencing the following four factors simultaneously:

- 1. Heavy rainfall over a short duration.
- 2. Existing site topography channeling water into the newly excavated section.
- 3. Standing water percolating and softening the soil.
- 4. Overflow outlet discharge rates not adequately considering the inflow rate, leading to a potential dam breach.
- It is indeed perplexing that the MM team, which includes some acclaimed international engineers (as stated in previous reports) and long-term residents of Auroville, failed to foresee such risks in Tamil Nadu—a region known for experiencing two primary monsoon seasons each year.



- According to meteorological records, Tamil Nadu has faced over 12 large cyclones comparable to the recent cyclone Fengal (max. wind speed: 90 km/h) in the past 80 years. With the impacts of climate change, the frequency of such cyclones has been increasing each decade, and patterns have become less predictable. Cyclone Nisha (2008) and cyclone Vardah (2016) brought rainfall intensities similar to Fengal (up to 500 mm per day). It is evident that the planned lake design failed to adequately consider these climatic conditions in its structural design and execution plan.
- The report claims that the financial damage is negligible as Lego blocks are not damaged (incorrect - <u>refer to the photo</u>) and they will be saving on the overall cost of the project as instead of building the 3rd dam wall with new material, they will reuse the Lego blocks, eliminating the need for a dam wall between the test lake and newly excavated hole.
- Instead of addressing flaws in the decision-making process, the report shifts blame onto an individual engineer's proposal, ignoring the premature implementation of a mixed and incomplete design.
- Technical and financial accountability, along with public safety and environmental impact, are critical concerns for a project of this scale. However, the report highlights a significant lack of safety awareness in the planning and execution of the lake project.

The report's tone is distressing, reflecting a clear lack of accountability.

To date, decision-making for the MM lake project—spanning funding, design, and engineering—has been vested in a single entity with no independent oversight. The structural failure of the dam exposes systemic failures in this development approach.

As per regulations, an independent third-party assessment must be conducted to evaluate the failure of the test lake wall design and engineering.

Instead, the report proposes using the structural failure as an opportunity to implement the lake without phasing.

Such an approach would make it impossible to detect and repair leaks or mitigate potential embankment breaches.

Notably, even in the first completed section of the planned lake (approx. 5% of the total project), constant water leaks have been reported over the past few years.

A SUMMARY OF EVENTS HAPPENING IN AUROVILLE TODAY

AVFO ANNOUNCES 'CODE OF CONDUCT' TO LIVE IN AUROVILLE

On 25th November 2024, the AVFO Officer on Special Duty, Dr. G. Seetharaman, issued a new <u>Standing Order</u> detailing residence criteria and a code of conduct for Auroville residents. The Standing Order comes after the recent Gazette of India notification regarding <u>Admissions and Terminations</u> regulations and for the <u>selection of the Working Committee</u>, which were published in January 2024. Both sets of regulations were subsequently <u>stayed</u> by the Madras High Court in February 2024 following legal challenges from the RA WCom.

The Standing Order establishes strict guidelines for residents, newcomers, volunteers and permanent guests. It outlines "General principles of life in Auroville" and a detailed code of conduct, presenting them as mandatory requirements rather than guidelines, with the stated threat of "termination" of status if the 'rules' are breached.

After the Standing Order was issued, the RA WCom released a <u>massbulletin</u> stating that the Order "has no grounds" and is "blatantly in contradiction with the Charter, the Dream and the quoted works of Sri Aurobindo." The RA WCom noted that the Order does not respect proper procedure, the spirit of Auroville, or the letter and spirit of the Auroville Foundation Act as recognized by various orders of the Madras High Court.

Some key aspects of the new code of conduct include:

Residency Requirements:

- Full-time residence in Auroville is mandatory
- Any trips must be reported to the Human Resources Service
- Absences exceeding two weeks require prior approval -Unauthorized absences beyond two weeks may result in "status termination"

Guest Accommodation Rules:

Guests may only stay in allocated residences for a maximum of seven days

Aurovilians must acquire permission from Human Resources Service to:

- Host family members beyond seven days
- Host a spouse
- Live with elderly parents and minor children as "Permanent Guests"

Other rules:

- Only the AVFO media body can issue press releases about Auroville
- All Aurovilians have mandatory work for 6 hours per day for 6 days per week, or 5 hours per day for 7 days per week
- Pregnant women, nursing mothers, the elderly and the disabled will be offered work "suitable to their condition"
- All those residing in Auroville must attend the Auroville Spiritual and Material Refresher program, organized by the Human Resources Service
- Social gatherings can only be organized in authorized locations that are published by the Funds and Assets Management Committee.

The RA WCom indicated that they will share more information about the Standing Order in the coming days.

CYCLONE FENGAL CAUSES CHAOS

Cyclone Fengal made landfall over Puducherry late in the night of 30th November 2024, causing a large amount of damage to the forest, roads, electrical power lines and other infrastructure in and around Auroville. It took several days for the electrical supply to be fully restored, with some homes in Auroville still without power as of 9th December.

Damage to MM Lake

In addition to the loss of several hundreds of trees, the MM lake was severely damaged. The wall of the first lake area, holding water 10m deep, cracked and spilt water into the second lake area which is currently undergoing excavation. At the other end of the lake wall, the HDPE (plastic) lining ripped. These events raise serious concerns about the construction of the lake and its ability to withstand extreme weather conditions.

An <u>open letter</u> was sent to the MM Executive Team, repeating previous calls to follow proper processes and proceed with an Environmental Impact Assessments (EIA) when building the MM lake.

On the 5th December, the MM executives and the lake team shared a report via mass bulletin acknowledging the structural failure of the test lake retaining wall, built using prefab "Lego" blocks. They stated that they had not anticipated the possibility that the dam could experience the following 4 factors simultaneously:

- 1. Heavy rainfalls over a short time span
- 2. That the existing site topography would channel the water to the newly excavated section
- 3. That standing water tends to percolate and soften the soils and
- 4. Overflow outlet discharge rates need to take into account the inflow rate to prevent a dam breach.

The report states that the financial damage is negligible as the Lego blocks were not damaged (this is incorrect according to photos of the damaged wall). They also stated that they will be saving on the overall cost of the project as they will reuse the Lego blocks for the next section, eliminating the need for a dam wall between the test lake and newly excavated hole.



The decision making of the MM lake project from funding to implementation, including design and engineering has been vested in a single agent. However, instead of undertaking an independent assessment to evaluate the causes for the breaching of the test lake wall, the report states that they intend to use this as an opportunity to implement the lake without phasing. This approach would make it impossible to detect and repair leaks or mitigate an embankment breach. Even in the first completed section of the planned lake, which constitutes approximately 5% of the overall project, constant water leaks have been reported over the past few years.

As well as the damage to the MM lake, there was <u>observable</u> <u>slippage</u> of the mud hill inside the fence next to Town Hall.

Other Cyclone Damage

The cyclone affected a number of farms and forests across Auroville. Several farms reported loss of fruit trees, flooding of grains and vegetables, loss of poultry, and damage to vital infrastructure. The financial losses from the damages and the costs of repairs are expected to be borne by the farmers, despite maintenances and financial support being cut off from these vital community resources for over 1.5 years. The <u>Alankuppam-Kottakarai kolam</u> also overflowed, causing severe flooding to homes and farms in the neighbouring villages.

Many roads were blocked due to fallen trees in the cyclone, most of which were cleared by the tireless efforts of individual residents. The AVFO did not initiate any clearing or service to the affected community and the AVFO 'FAMC's initial response to the cyclone was to send an <u>email</u> informing the community that "Individual wood sale is strictly prohibited". A follow up <u>email</u> was shared one week after the cyclone, with telephone numbers to call in case of emergencies and information about how to receive funds.

ONGOING DESTRUCTION

Revelation

The construction of Radial 1 from Lilaloka through Revelation Forest continued on 21st November 2024, with CPWD workers using JCBs to break the fence around Revelation, and clear the path of the planned road. As highlighted in <u>this post</u> from N&N no. 1052, the destruction of this fence means that the forest area is now vulnerable to animal grazing and wood theft. It was also entirely unnecessary, as there was access available via Revelation main gate.

The AVFO reacted strongly to the Revelation Management Team, who attempted to intervene in the destruction and requested to see the relevant paperwork authorising the works. The OSD, Dr Seetharaman, sent a <u>letter</u> to Arun of Revelation, terminating his position in the AVFO 'GreenBelt Services'. The letter stated that "the obstruction of government authorized works on government property is a criminal offense". Please see <u>here</u> for a clarification as to why Auroville land is not government property.

On the same day, the OSD also sent a <u>letter of complaint</u> to the Inspector of the Auroville Police Station demanding that they file FIRs against the Revelation Management Team. The letter stated that their actions were "criminal in nature" and that "the CPWD [and] by extension the AVF Authorities are ... obstructed from performing the duties with regards to the building of the Auroville city which is mandated to the Governing Board by the Auroville Foundation Act". <u>The AVF Act</u> states that the role of the GB is "to prepare a Master-Plan of Auroville in consultation with the Residents' Assembly and to ensure development of Auroville as so planned". The police went on to file a <u>Community Service Register</u> (CSR) against Arun.

As mentioned previously, work began on the Vikas Radial in October 2024 without any prior notification to the residents of the nearby communities. The removal of the road pavers meant that access to homes and parking were seriously affected. The AVFO 'ATDC' claimed they would rectify the situation and open up alternative access by widening the Grace-Arati cycle path, but the pathway quickly <u>became impassable</u> due to the monsoon rains.

After three days of work residents from several communities emailed the AVFO 'ATDC' and convinced the contractor engineer to stop work until there was a <u>response</u>. AVFO 'ATDC' agreed to a meeting to discuss the situation. On 19th November, members of the AVFO and their 'ATDC' as well as CPWD engineers and their contractors, met with members of nearby communities. Amongst <u>several other points</u>, those at the meeting agreed that the work would not continue until after the end of the monsoon. However, on 21st November workers using a JCB began taking apart more of the road. After a couple of residents objected in person, Sindhuja, Antim and a large group of Town Hall workers came to the site and threatened the residents with legal action. However, a few of the 'ATDC' members who had been present at the meeting two days before eventually agreed that they had promised to stop the work for the time being, and the group left. Reportedly, the same group of people from Town Hall then went to Revelation Forest to oversee the removal of the fence.

Subsequently Prashant, who is a Landscape Architect and Regional Planner as well as a member of the RA WCom, sent <u>an</u> <u>email</u> to the AVFO and their 'ATDC'. The email raised a number of pertinent questions about the current roadworks happening across Auroville, both ongoing and planned.

Solar Kitchen Parking Lot

Other recent development works include the partial destruction of the new parking lot opposite Solar Kitchen, for a radial which follows a line of force. The parking lot was built just 2 years ago using some of the paver blocks that were removed from the Crown Road.



EVERGREEN LAND GRAB UPDATE

Since PKS won his appeal, which ruled in his favour and handed him Auroville lands inside Evergreen community, he has been actively claiming the land and has cleared a large area of trees and constructed a wall. There has been no official survey carried out to mark the land, nor have the AVFO or their 'Land Service' made any moves to verify the boundaries. They have also not filed an appeal against the decision. Residents of Evergreen have made repeated pleas for assistance to the Land Board and AVFO working groups to secure the land, highlighting that they are facing harassment on a daily basis from PKS's workers, which included a rock being thrown at one resident. The workers also trespass freely through the Evergreen community, even at night.

There is no clarity as to why the AVFO and their 'Land Service' appear unconcerned about such a valuable piece of Auroville land, which has been in the possession of Auroville for over thirty years. The land lies inside the MasterPlan area and it is prime for development due to its roadside location.

UNCERTAINTY ABOUT JAYANTI RAVI'S REPATRIATION

A <u>response</u> to an RTI request has confirmed that Dr. Jayanti Ravi was repatriated back to her parent cadre in Gujarat in August 2024. Uncertainty about her repatriation had remained due to her occasional presence in Auroville as well as a number of <u>press</u> <u>reports</u> that named her as the Secretary.

The RA WCom sent out a press note, informing the media that her status was clarified, which led to a <u>report</u> in The Hindu on 3rd December 2024. The article stated that she had been "prematurely repatriated", a reference to her one year extension that started in July 2024 which has apparently been cancelled.

On 2nd December, questions regarding the status of Dr. Ravi were asked in the Lok Sabha by VCK MP Ravikumar. The questions referred to whether the position of the Secretary of the AVF was vacant and the reply from the Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan was that the "Ministry of Education has issued tenure-related orders on July 4 [2024]"(a reference to her one year extension).

On 4th December, a <u>Hindu article</u> based on information from an unnamed source claimed that Dr Ravi's repatriation had not interfered with her one year extension and she was therefore still the Secretary. The article was later <u>posted</u> on Auronet by the AVFO 'WCom', who claimed that this "confirmed" that Dr Ravi was still the Secretary.

Dr Ravi was present at the 68th GB meeting which was held in Auroville on 5th December. <u>Press reports</u> after the meeting mentioned that she was present in the Secretary role.

The RA WCom sent a <u>massbulletin</u> which noted that the August 2024 order was for premature repatriation from the Auroville Foundation to Gujarat, and no orders that show that she holds a dual role have been seen. They also highlight that there is no evidence that Dr. Ravi has signed any documents since the repatriation order, as visa letters of recommendation and the recent residence criteria Standing Order have all been signed by the OSD. The email continues "[We] are very concerned at the lack of transparency and communication on the part of the Governing Board around the question of her holding dual positions. This intentionally opaque way of functioning continues to be a hallmark of this particular administration, led by the Board and its Chairman".

CPWD TENDERS AND WORKS UPDATE

The CPWD has issued <u>55 tenders for works</u> in Auroville over the past three years, with a combined estimated value of 60 crores, according to the government's E-Tender Portal as of July 2024. Recent tenders include for LED street lighting (1.3 crore), construction of the Outer Ring Road (ORR) from Certitude to VC parking (6.35 crore) and the installation of an elevator in the Town Hall building (55 Lakh). The necessity and the quality of some of these works have been questioned, for example the number of street lights seem to be far more than is needed. Questions have also been asked as to why the ORR is a narrow road made with paver blocks when it is intended for heavy traffic use.

Prior to 2022, development projects in Auroville were generally carried out by Auroville units. This allowed project funds to recirculate within the community's economy and drew upon decades of home-grown expertise in tropical sustainable construction. The current shift to external contractors represents a significant change in both how development funds flow and how construction expertise is sourced, with favour now being shown for unsustainable materials like cement.

Transparency remains limited for these projects. While the CPWD website contains certain documents, other standard construction documentation such as detailed cost estimates, road project cross-sections, survey reports, and construction drawings have not been shown despite repeated requests from residents.

The matter of environmental clearances for these works remains under legal consideration. While the AVFO 'ATDC' maintains that such clearances are not required for <u>Patta lands</u>, the National Green Tribunal (NGT) had previously ruled that Auroville must follow Government of India environmental regulations due to the scale of development and potential impact on the surrounding villages and agricultural lands. This NGT order was challenged by the Secretary in the Supreme Court and in December 2023 the Supreme Court placed a stay on the NGT order, after which the AVFO began large-scale land clearing.

The RA TDC have also repeatedly expressed concern about the permanent nature of tree removal while the legal status of environmental regulations remains unresolved.

ELECTRICAL FIRE IN COUNCIL ROOM

On 9th November 2024, an <u>electrical fire</u> caused by faulty wiring broke out in the Town Hall Council Room. The fire happened during the night, and was brought under control thanks to the quick actions of one of the Council Room vigil watchers, who retrieved a fire extinguisher and put the fire out.

Despite the fact that the presence of a member of the watch helped prevent serious damage, the AVFO 'FAMC' has ordered AVES not to repair the electrical connection. However, another electrician came forward and fixed a connection to the room.

For 2.5 years, a small group of residents have maintained a 24/7 presence in the Council Room. The room has strategic and symbolic significance as the only space in Town Hall still available to the residents and their working groups. More help is always needed, if you can offer any assistance please see above in the 'ongoing actions' section for contact details.

COMMERCIAL PROJECTS SIGNAL SHIFT IN AVFO DEVELOPMENT PRIORITIES

Two new projects - one operational and one planned - indicate a growing emphasis on tourism-focused development in Auroville. Le Paradis D'Auro, recently opened, and a Southern Service Node (SSN) mobility hub planned by the AVFO 'FAMC', highlight a shift in priorities for Auroville's growth.

The <u>Southern Service Node project</u>, announced by the AVFO 'FAMC' in September 2024, outlines plans for a large commercial complex featuring seven restaurants, boutique shops, and parking facilities for 90 cars and 420 bikes. According to the project documents, the complex aims to centralize the visitor activities that are currently spread along the Kuyilpalayam road, although the vast majority of those businesses are privately-owned.

Le Paradis D'Auro, which opened recently, markets itself as an educational hub and functions primarily as a display center for various animals including 30 cows, 350 birds across 8 species, horses, guinea pigs, rabbits and other creatures. While the project claims to promote environmental awareness, concerns have been raised about the ethics of confining animals in artificial environments for visitor entertainment.

The AVFO's mobility hub proposal plans to restrict visitor and resident vehicle access beyond the facility, requiring transfer to internal transport. The project documents state that "visitors and residents will switch from fossil-fuel vehicles to e-vehicles or non-polluting modes of transport or public transport". This may not be practical for all road users, and is likely to increase traffic at other entrances.

The planned restriction of the current Certitude entrance in favor of the new Southern Gate would funnel visitors through designated commercial zones before reaching other parts of Auroville. This will highlight Auroville as merely a tourist attraction. The AVFO has apparently secured funding for the SSN building construction but it is not stated from whom. N&N 1053 - 12 December 2024

FOREST GROUP RESPONSE TO TORKIL IN AV TODAY

The Forest Group has released a <u>detailed statement</u> responding to claims made by Torkil, a member of the AVFO 'FAMC', in a recent Auroville Today interview regarding the management of Auroville's forests. The statement addresses several key points, including the AVFO 'FAMC's' refusal to release gratuity payments for 60 forest workers laid off in July 2023, and disputes Torkil's assertion that the Forest Group was unwilling to discuss changes.

The statement strongly challenges Torkil's claim that only 12-18 people are needed to manage Auroville's forests, pointing out that Auroville's afforestation project is unique in India, with no comparable government or non-government initiatives. The Forest Group emphasizes that their successful approach involves continuous planting of rare and endangered species, maintenance of extensive fence lines, and management of nurseries and seed banks. Torkil's statement suggests that the abrupt cutting of funds in July 2023 appears to be part of a larger strategy to silence the Forest Group's voice regarding ongoing development projects in forested areas, rather than purely an economic measure as suggested by Torkil.

MISCELLANEOUS NEWS

- Issue 7 of the Voice of Auroville: RA WCom have shared the latest issue of the Voice of Auroville, available at <u>this link</u>. Previous issues are available <u>here</u>.
- Removal of News & Analysis from Auronet: The removal of a group which provided relatively unbiased updates about Auroville news demonstrates that the censorship of Auronet continues. Jothi Charles <u>shared</u> that his group "News and Analysis" had been removed in November 2024. The group was notable for occasionally sharing information that was critical of the AVFO, in particular the criticism by the Central Information
- An Offering to the Community: A short booklet, written in English, French and Tamil, has been anonymously circulated in Auroville. Called 'An Offering to the Community' it outlines "some notes and propositions to be shared, contemplated, developed so as to commit, each and all, to a more conscious and more humble process of evolution, offered to the task before us all, at the service of Truth."
- Hindu Articles: Two articles on Auroville, written by Aurovilians with differing opinions about the takeover of Auroville, appeared in The Hindu in November 2024. The first, titled <u>"A case for the organic, harmonious growth of Auroville"</u> was written by Francios Gaultier and the second, titled <u>"Land consolidation for the city area is being overseen in a professional way"</u> was written by Anu Majumdar.

POUR TOUR WATER (PTW) EMERGENCY SERVICE

Dear Residents,

Pour Tous Water is providing the following emergency services free of charge, as decided by the Resident assembly in January 2014.

The recent Cyclone Fengal inflicted damage in Auroville. Please contact us: Pipe broken, booster pump/pump; generator supply for filling up water in your tank; sludge removal/coordination due to Cyclone Fengal.

Yes, Cyclone Fengal caused power outages, and residents suffered from water shortages. Some Auroville community

members or individuals who brought diesel (In kind) to the generator have been filling water at their community water tank or individual tanks.

We were unable to attend to several urgent calls, such as "pump the water out of the flats on the ground floor that have been completely flooded and have no outlet to go." With only two or three employees, we were unable to handle all emergency calls.

Cyclone Fengal has wreaked havoc on our shelter, causing significant damage to our infrastructure and tragically leading to the loss of several dogs and injuries to others. While electricity, water, and Wi-Fi have been restored, the road to recovery is still long.

The day after the cyclone, some compassionate Aurovilians, undeterred by the devastation, walked on foot to our shelter to provide urgently needed cloth to protect puppies from hypothermia. Their courageous intervention helped save lives. We are immensely grateful for their kindness and support.

Our team has been working tirelessly to clear the debris, repair damaged enclosures and buildings, and restore essential services. However, our electrical infrastructure remains compromised, hindering our operations as only a temporary fix could be applied. The much-anticipated Rs. 2 crore funding for building the new Auroville Dog Shelter is still held back. We are hopeful that this situation can be resolved soon by working together with the Auroville Foundation.

Due to the urgent need for repairs and upgrades to our surgery and ABC facilities, we have been compelled to temporarily halt our sterilization program. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. Our goal of sterilizing 1000 dogs annually remains crucial to address the ongoing puppy crisis and ensure the safety of residents, visitors, and guests.

We implore your support to help us rebuild our shelter and continue our vital work for the AV community. We urgently require supplies such as **cloth, cardboard, newspaper, and pedigree dry food, as well as monetary donations**. 



HEEDING THE SILENCES OF THE MOTHER



AUROVILLE'S BUREAUCRATIC CIRCUS: A SPIRITUAL UTOPIA TURNED ADMINISTRATIVE ZOO

In a plot twist that would make even the most seasoned cynic laugh, Auroville, the once-celebrated experiment in human unity and spiritual freedom, has become the stage for a bureaucratic circus. The latest "Standing Order" from the Auroville Foundation, under the watchful eye of Dr. G. Seetharaman, has transformed this utopian dream into a Kafkaesque nightmare.



This document reads less like an invitation to spiritual awakening and more like a manual for surviving a bureaucratic dystopia. It insists that residents pledge allegiance to texts with the passion of zealots, turning Auroville from a place of spiritual exploration into a mandatory study group for "The Dream" and "To be a True Aurovilian". Here, your enlightenment is measured by your ability to recite doctrine, not by the depth of your soul's journey.

The Code of Conduct? It's a list of commandments so rigid, you'd think they were chiseled by a bureaucrat with a personal vendetta against joy. "Avoid malign discrimination"? Sure, but without a definition, it's like playing spiritual Russian roulette. You're left guessing, hoping your interpretation matches the unseen, bureaucratic ideal.

Social life in Auroville now requires more permissions than a highsecurity prison. Want to host a friend for a weekend? Better hope your application gets approved. It's not community living; it's community controlling. Auroville's social fabric is now woven with red tape.

And let's not overlook the gag order on politics and media. Engaging in political discourse or shaping your own narrative about Auroville? Forbidden. It's the kind of control that would make Orwell nod in approval, where the only story told is the one approved by the powers that be.

Dr. G. Seetharaman, in his quest for order, seems to have forgotten that the essence of Auroville was about liberating the mind, not caging it in bureaucratic red tape. His approach suggests that the path to enlightenment now involves navigating through a labyrinth of administrative hurdles rather than exploring the infinite possibilities of human consciousness.

willing participant in the bureaucratic process.

If Auroville is to preserve its original spirit, it needs to transcend this absurdity. It must rediscover the balance where bureaucracy serves the community's spiritual and communal aspirations, not dictates them. Otherwise, Auroville might well become known not for its dawn of human unity but for its endless night of administrative drudgery.

"The supramental eye can see a hundred meeting and diverging motions in one glance and envelop in the largeness of its harmonising vision of Truth all that to our minds is clash and opposition and the collision and interlocked strife of numberless contending truths and powers. Truth to the supramental sight is at once single and infinite and the complexities of its play serve to bring out with an abundant ease the rich significance of the Eternal's many-sided oneness." 1 — Sri Aurobindo

And from the Mother (please be mindful of the chronological order of events in the ever-hastening and intensifying unstoppable Supramental evolution now in motion):

"It's not that I don't see anything, but I don't see in the same way.

In a way, I think I see better. But in a particular way. If, for instance, I have to thread a needle (I have experimented with this kind of thing), well, if I try to thread the needle while looking at it, it's literally impossible. But sometimes (when I am in a certain attitude), if I have to thread a needle, it threads itself—I have nothing to do with it: I hold the needle, I hold the thread, and that's that.

I think (*in fact, it's quite simply a matter of experience*), I think that if this state gets perfected one should be able to do everything in the OTHER way, the way that doesn't depend on external senses. And


then, well, it will clearly be the beginning of a supramental expression. Because it's a sort of innate knowledge which DOES things. When That comes, you know, you can act.

But you mustn't think; the minute you start thinking or wanting to use your sense organs, it vanishes completely."²



Qi Gong - with Lhamo

Monday - Wednesday and Friday 7 - 8:15am, drop in class

Qigong can be described as a mind-body-spirit practice that improves one's mental and physical health by integrating posture, movement, breathing technique, self-massage, sound, and focused intent. Specifically, this form of gentle exercise is composed of movements that are repeated a number of times, often stretching the body, and building awareness of how the body moves through space. There are likely thousands of qi gong styles, schools, traditions, forms, and lineages, each with practical applications and different theories about Qi ("subtle breath" or "vital energy") and Gong ("skill cultivated through steady practice"). As Lhamo has a very extensive knowledge of many of them, she will explore different styles according to the students.

Hatha Yoga with Ramesh

Ramesh offers hatha yoga classes with some vinyasa flow and include pranayama, traditional sanskrit mantra chanting, and meditation. He places a lot of focus on breathing and body-mindfulness during the practice. It is ideal for beginners to intermediate-level practitioners. Traditional Sanskrit Mantras with Sonia
