"Auroville will be a self-supporting township": I want to insist on the fact that it will be an experiment, it is for making experiments —experiments, research, study. Auroville will be a city that will try to be, or will tend to become, or attempt to be 'self-supporting', that is to say...

Q: Autonomous?

"Autonomous" is understood to mean some kind of independence which breaks off relations with others, and that is not what I mean.


For example, those who produce food, like Aurofood—of course, when we are 50,000 it will be difficult to provide for all the needs, but for the moment we are only a few thousand at most—well, a factory always produces far too much, so it will sell outside and receive money. 'Aurofood' for example wants to have a special relationship with the workers; not at all the old system, something which would be an improvement on the communist system, a more balanced organisation than sovietism, that is, something which does not err too much on one side at the expense of the other.

There is one thing I wanted to say: the participation in the well-being and life of the town as a whole is not something calculated on an individual basis, that is, this individual should give so much, is is not like that. It is calculated according to the means, the activity, the capacity for production; it is not the democratic idea which cuts calculated according to one's means: one who has much gives much,

one who has little gives little; one who is strong works hard, one who is not strong does something else. You see, it is something truer, deeper. That is why I make no attempt to explain now, because people will start to make all kinds of complaints. All this must come about automatically, so to speak, with the growth of the city, in the true spirit. That is why this note is extremely concise.

For example, this sentence: "All who live there will participate in its life and development." All who live there will participate in its life and development according to their capacities and means, not mechanically—so much per unit. That's it, it must be something living and true, not a mechanical thing; and according to each one's capacities, that is, one who has material means, such as those provided by a factory, should give in proportion to its production, not so much per individual, per head.



"The participation may be passive or active.": I do not understand what 'passive' means; I said it in French and it has been put into English. What could that mean, 'passive'?... It would be something more like planes or different levels of consciousness.

Q: You meant that those who are wise, who work within, do not need to...

Yes, that's it. Those who have a higher knowledge do not need to work with their hands, that is what I meant.

"There will be no taxes as such, but each one will contribute to the collective welfare in work, kind or money." So that is clear: there will be no taxes, but each one will have to contribute to the collective welfare by his work, in kind or in money. Those who have nothing but money will give money. But to tell the truth, 'work' can be inner work—but one cannot say that, because people are not honest enough. The work can be an occult, completely inner work,but for that, it must be absolutely sincere and true, and with the

capacity for it: no pretension. But not necessarily a physical work.

NOTE:

- A Newcomer becomes an 'Aurovilian' once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming 'Aurovilian' is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- The formal administrative step of entering new residents into the Register of Residents (RoR), is done by the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation. For this, a B-Form is filled in and signed by the individual and a meeting with the Secretary is arranged by the Entry Secretariat. However, until such time as a new Secretary is appointed, the meetings of Confirmed Aurovilians with the Secretary will be pending.

Dear Friends,

As you may know, the Entry Service has been functioning with reduced capacity since January 2024.

The actions taken to stop the work given to the Entry Service by the Residents' Assembly persist. However, according to the Auroville Foundation Act, the power to admit and terminate names from the register of residents is within the exclusive domain of the Residents' Assembly. The new regulations were challenged before the Madras High Court and have been stayed, but have not been finally heard and disposed.

Be that as it may, the Entry Board team has been reconstituted according to the Residents' Assembly approved process and 3 ongoing members welcomed 5 new members. The team has been meeting regularly since May 2024.

However, we have been advised not to process new applications for the time being.

We intend to use this time to *take up pending work* such as requesting mentor reports, and Newcomer self assessments. We plan to resume completing the Newcomer processes, some of which have been left pending for over 6 months as soon as we are advised to do so.

We apologize for the delays, however, it has been due to circumstances beyond our control.

We pray for relief by the courts in due time.

Jan was the engineer for the Test Lake and was a member of the Lake Task Force that was endorsed by us to review the plan for the Lake, the performance of the Test Lake and propose an alternative and integrated design for the next phases. The results of the work of the Task Force, in the form of an alternative design concept prepared by Mr. Mohan Rao, were presented to the Matrimandir Executives and the 'Lake Team' headed by Michael Bonke but were not integrated or accepted.

We very much hope that the issues with the current design and approach that have become obvious now will lead to positive change.

Matrimandir Lake Dam

A few days ago a 14 page write up "The sliding Lego Wall" and the similar text through Matrimandir Bulletin was circulated. It attempts to describe the failure of the dam. REGARDING THE STANDING ORDER ON RESIDENCE CRITERIA AND THE 'HUMAN RESOURCE SERVICE'

Dear Community,

We would like to offer further clarifications regarding the Auroville Foundation (Residence Criteria) Standing Order, 2024, which was issued on November 25, 2024, and the 'Human Resource Service (HRS)' announced by the 'GB FAMC' on 16th of December. This Standing Order and the HRS have no legal basis and raise serious concerns regarding their alignment with Mother's vision for Auroville.

First, we must point out that this Standing Order appears to have been issued without proper legal authority. The order is not issued according to the procedures established in the Auroville Foundation Standing Order Regulations published in the Gazette of India on 5.3.2011.

Moreover The Auroville Foundation Act does not grant the Governing Board powers to establish residence criteria, and the Order was issued without obtaining the required advice from the and International Advisory Council without the required consultation with the Residents' Assembly.

The Order's interpretation of Sri Aurobindo's and Mother's vision is severely flawed. It selectively uses quotes without context and presents a distorted interpretation of their writings, particularly regarding the nature of Auroville as a spiritual experiment. The Mother consistently emphasized the importance of flexibility, plasticity, and suppleness in the development and governance of the community. The rigid and dogmatic nature of these regulations contradicts this fundamental principle of freedom discovery.

We also find many practical aspects of the order, and the HRS, simply wrong. The requirement for residents to participate in "Spiritual mandatory and Refresher programs" goes against the core principles of spiritual freedom that both Sri Aurobindo and the Mother emphasized, .



and for some people to think this is the way forward is shocking. The restrictions on guests, the requirement for permissions for absences over two weeks, and the limitations on external work are neither practical nor aligned with Auroville's reality

The Order also contains provisions that infringe on basic human rights and constitutional freedoms. The restrictions on freedom of expression, assembly, movement, and association raise serious ethical and legal concerns. The threat of expulsion for various infractions, without clear due process, is not in accordance with the legally established regulations of the Auroville Foundation and the orders of the Madras High Court, and therefore is invalid.

On the planning front, we remind the community that Roger Anger, as the Chief Architect of Auroville appointed by the Mother, stated that the physical construction of the city was of "absolutely no importance" compared to building a new humanity.

Details regarding viewing and funeral will be shared when available.



AUROVILLE DOG SHELTER

What to Do If You Find a Puppy or Kitten in Auroville

A recent incident involving a guesthouse dumping a puppy "for the safety of its guests" highlights the ongoing challenges faced by Auroville in managing its animal welfare responsibilities. This action upset a guest deeply and serves as a reminder that dumping puppies is not only unethical but also illegal under Indian law, punishable under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960.

When you dump a small puppy or kitten carelessly on the street, you condemn it to suffer and die a slow agonising death, because it can't survive on its own. Please help it for a few months until it is bigger and can live its life as a normal stray dog or cat without your help.

We encourage all Aurovilians to be inspired by the Mother's teachings, to treat all living beings with loving kindness, respect, and compassion, because also our furry canine friends are fellow inhabitants of this wonderful city of the future.

Auroville Dog Shelter's Current Challenges

The Auroville Dog Shelter is operating beyond its capacity. The shelter, already struggling with collapsing infrastructure, suffered further damage during the recent cyclone. Despite these hardships, we survive on a meagre monthly budget of ₹50,000 from Auroville, which is far below the required ₹3,00,000 to meet basic expenses. While we are doing everything we can to fundraise and provide support, the situation remains dire. We urgently need to start the construction of our new shelter but funds and the building permission have been held back for almost a year.

Thanks to support from AVI USA, we completed a mass vaccination drive in August, vaccinating so far over 1000 dogs, puppies and cats after several confirmed rabies cases. Our longterm plan includes sterilizing at least 1,000 dogs (20 per week) under the guidance of the Department of Animal Husbandry. However, this ambitious project requires both funding (Rs. 15 lakh) and the upgrading of our basic surgery room and adding new ABC enclosures.

Until we achieve sustainable solutions to solve the puppy problem finally for good, we encourage all residents to act responsibly and compassionately if they encounter a stray puppy or kitten:

- 1. Check for its mother. Look around for the mother, as she may be nearby searching for food. If she's present, provide her with food and a safe environment to care for her puppies or kittens.
- Create a Shelter. Use a simple rain-protected box lined with cloth to provide warmth and safety.
- 3. Feed the Puppy. Avoid cow milk, which can cause diarrhea. Instead, use milk powder from the pharmacy and feed the baby 2 to 4 times a day, depending on its age. You can also make a porridge with oats or powdered ragi and a bit of jaggery and milk powder. Older puppies can be fed cooked rice or ragi with chicken or occasional wet food pouches. Always ensure fresh water is available.
- 4. Seek Veterinary Help. While our shelter cannot take in more puppies due to overcrowding, the shelter offers free vet checkups and vaccinations (parvo, rabies) as long as stock lasts.

Why Sterilization Is Crucial

Mass sterilization is the only long-term solution to Auroville's stray dog population issues, ensuring the safety of both residents and animals. We urge the AV community and Auroville administration to prioritize this initiative and provide adequate funding for sterilizations and vaccinations to keep the AV residents, visitors, and guests safe.



A Call for Action

Together, we can create a better Auroville for both humans and animals. Compassionate actions, community support, and sustained funding will pave the way for effective solutions. Dumping puppies is not just inhumane—it is illegal. Let us work together to foster a community that reflects the spirit of care, kindness,

COMMUNICATION TO THE COMMUNITY ABOUT THE GRATITUDE FARM EXPERIMENT

A group of Auroville farmers recently found out that the Gratitude Farm project has been discontinued early and the keys handed back to the GB-FAMC. We have been unable to find any explanation for this and the land has not been handed back to Demo Farm, as was agreed at the beginning when Gratitude Farm took over the land in 2022/23. Instead it appears that a member of the Farm Service has taken over and is using the land. This is being done with no agreed process or communication with anyone about how the land is to be used.

Below is the email a group of farmers sent to the GB-FAMC which includes links to the original project proposals and the MOU that was signed prior to the project starting. This was meant to be a project with benefits for Auroville farming, but from the information received these have not materialised.

This email was sent on July 18th 2024 and as usually happens, there has been no reply.

We thought the community should know about what is happening

here. If you have further questions or any ideas about the best way to proceed, please let us know by writing to aurovillefarmgroup@gmail.com.

Dear members of the 'FAMC',

It's recently come to our attention that the keys to the half acre of land from Demo Farm allotted to the Gratitude Project in October 2022 were handed over to Farm Service last month. This leaves us to conclude that the project has been abruptly terminated.



Please share the reasons as to why, despite the MoU between yourself and the Gratitude Project clearly stating its timeline as 2 years, has ended in 1.5 years?

From the onset, despite our doubts regarding the project, we have attempted to work together with yourselves and the project holders in the interest of our shared aim - growing healthy food for Auroville. Upon studying the Annual Report of the project after it completed its first year, we also shared with you our reservations on the report to request reasons for the inconsistencies in the actual crop harvest and projected yield (>20%), and information on the training in Natural Precision Farming promised in the project proposal and MoU. We are yet to receive a response but hope this email reminds you of the same and we can know more about the execution of this innovative pilot project.

As mentioned, we were interested in staying connected for the next phase of the project, so we would like to know more about why it has abruptly ended. We assume an amendment may have been made to the MoU as per its Amendment clause which states 'Any changes, modification, revisions or amendments to this MOU, which are mutually agreed upon by and between the Parties to this MOU, shall be incorporated by a written instrument, and become effective when executed and signed by both the Parties to the MOU'. We hope you share this amended MoU with the community for the sake of transparency, but more importantly, we would like to know how you intend to evaluate this project so we may collectively learn from this model.

We would also like to know how Farm Service intends to proceed with work on this land, or if it will be returned to Demo Farm. We look forward to hearing from you or meeting with you to examine this project and working together for the present and future of Auroville's food security.





SOLVING THE 50K PROBLEM

It seems that Mother gave us a tricky problem.

When she cut Roger's population projections short by limiting it to 50,000, it was first a problem of definition. To some it was a way to just cut Roger short but keep him in the project. To others it was a number carved in stone or gold.

Depending on which material it was carved in created another problem. If it was to be 50,000 people of raised consciousness or any 50,000 people. The easier path was to just get to 50,000 residents and await the next unfolding.

Even on this path some Aurovilians continue to have bad dreams.

One had this dream that the target of 50,000 residents was finally achieved. But nothing happened. After a week, after a month ... nothing different. Then a realization came that it has to be 50,000 sadhaks who pass thru the Matrimandir for the supramental to descent. This woke up the person at 2am in a sweat and get onto their computer.



Some calculations were in order:

- · MM is open from 6am to 7pm.
- That means 13 hours.
- · That means 46,800 seconds
- Assume that a person takes 16 seconds to shuffle thru the inner chamber from one door to another.
- Assume that from the entry petal to an exit petal, sadhaks can be herded in pairs, still from end-to-end there will be a gap of 2 seconds between people.

- Assume that 200 white-gloved volunteers trained in the Japanese train system push sadhaks along from the entry petal to an exit petal.
- Assume that the white-gloved volunteers work in one long shift with no bathroom or lunch break.
- · Assume no socks used on that day.
- Assume a continuous line of 50,000 sadhaks is established from the entrance.



The answer was 23,400. The maximum number of people who can visit the inner chamber in one day. And if any of the assumptions break, e.g. socks are not optional, then the number crumbles fast.

So a meeting was called for and the MM team invited ideas from the community, as they were completely stuck. How to get 50,000 people thru the inner chamber?

The first proposal was a conveyor belt. It was 2 people wide and would zoom from the entire path. People could keep their shoes on. It could zoom 46,800 but if you extended visitor hours to 24 hours a day, it could do 86,400. Of course, assume no glitches, no transfers from one belt to another and 8 seconds is enough the inner chamber.

This led to a sarcastic suggestion to use a high-speed train zooming a hundred people past the crystal in 2 seconds.

The Mother's challenge is serious. So the meeting ended, but with an opening for more ideas.

A person walking past the broken lego dam had a brilliant insight. Since the current MM is not designed for this kind of traffic, what if we built another MM?

Recall the pyramids of Giza. There are three of them. The ancient Egyptians improved their earlier designs and built three pyramids increasing the size each time. Why couldn't India build three spheres?

The current lake would be the perfect location. One can imagine many versions of two gold spheres in a blue tub.

The first sphere was built entirely with private funds; Auroville could invite support from the state and national reservoirs to build the next two. They could be bigger, and they could be slightly customized. A state sphere could attract Tamilians and the national sphere could attract North Indians and Hindu devotees.

Quickly, the MM team mobilized. Concepts were drawn up, two of which are are shown. One thing was constant, there had to a sphere with a light beam. The pillars were optional as were carpet and socks. The object was to maximize the number of people exposed to the crystal light. So innovation in people transportation was the key.

One design uses a road, so popular amongst the VIPs and the spenders. The other has a rail, popular amongst technocrats.

The first draft to invite the powers with big money is getting ready. A healthy competition for the two spheres is a good thing. It could be Tamil Nadu v Delhi. It could be Adani v Ambani v Tata.

Of course what to name the spheres is important. MM2? Pitamandir? Secretarimandir? Should Auroville leave it to the sponsors?





Qi Gong - with Lhamo

Qigong can be described as a mind-body-spirit practice that improves one's mental and physical health by integrating posture, movement, breathing technique, self-massage, sound, and focused intent. Specifically, this form of gentle exercise is composed of movements that are repeated a number of times, often stretching the body, and building awareness of how the body moves through space. There are likely thousands of qi gong styles, schools, traditions, forms, and lineages, each with practical applications and different theories about Qi ("subtle breath" or "vital energy") and Gong ("skill cultivated through steady practice"). As Lhamo has a very extensive knowledge of many of them, she will explore different styles according to the students.

As he does every year at the end of December, Marco Saroldi is getting ready to send his 38th greeting card to a circle of family, friends and acquaintances who eagerly await each new creation and collect them with fervour.

It all began as a game almost 40 years ago. A young photographer from Turin, bored with the idea of having to call family and friends for the never-ending chore of New Year's greetings, decided to take a photo of himself with his girlfriend and send it as a greeting card.

It would be the first self-portrait in a series that would span his entire life, different eras and even continents, since after 2015, when Marco moved to Auroville, the wishes would travel from India to the West and not the other way round anymore.

The game of self-portraiture is gradually becoming less selfreferential and more sophisticated. Marco developed a passion for this pastime, which over time turned into a real project.

The figure of the photographer becomes a mirror of time, a punching bag, an identikit for the traveller of our time, which he stages with aplomb, humour and ferocity.

Nothing can escape his merciless gaze, from our technological and consumerist manias to the socio-political blunders of our governments, from ecological concerns to the catastrophic and ridiculous triumph of human individualism, from cloning to the mafia.

He hijacks religious and advertising icons - Nike, Che Guevara, Botticelli, United Colors of Benetton - to create his own personal theatre, sometimes featuring his own family and friends.

A magic lantern in the beam of which Marco Saroldi's self-portraits scroll past, projections of us, his contemporaries, captured in our ironic and slightly desperate essence.


