CONCEPTION AND BIRTH:

NEW CONSCIOUSNESS

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It is not something one can pretend to have; an individual cannot pretend to have it, either he has it or he hasn't, because *(laughing)* in any circumstance of life, if it is a pretension, it will show clearly! On top of that, it does not give you any material power. There again, X once said—he was speaking of the *true* hierarchy, the hierarchy based on each one's power of consciousness—the individual or individuals who are at the very summit necessarily have the least needs; their material needs become less as their capacity of material vision grows. And that is very true. It is automatic and spontaneous, not the result of an effort: the wider the consciousness, the more it embraces things and realities,—the less its material needs; automatically, because they lose all their importance and value. The need for material necessities is reduced to a minimum, which will itself change with the progressive development of Matter.

And that is easily recognisable, isn't it: it is difficult to act the part.

And the second thing is the power of conviction, that is, the highest consciousness, when it is brought into contact with Matter, spontaneously has a greater power of conviction than all the intermediary planes. By mere contact, its power of conviction, that is, its power of transformation, is greater than that of all the intermediary planes. That is a fact. These two facts together make it impossible for any pretension to last long. I am looking at it from the standpoint of a collective organisation all the play of the various influences (gesture of mixture and conflict)

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and that in itself is a sure sign: even a slight descent—even into the domain of higher mind, higher intelligence—and the whole conflict of influences begins. Only what is right at the very summit and is perfectly pure, has this power of spontaneous conviction. Therefore, whatever one may do instead of that is an approximation and it is not much better than democracy, that is, the system which wants to rule by the greatest number and the lowest level—I mean social democracy, the latest trend.

If there is no representative of the supreme Consciousness that can happen, can't it?—if there isn't any, there could be instead, it could be tried, government by a few—a small number set between four and eight, something like that, four, seven, eight—who have an *intuitive* intelligence: 'intuitive' is more important than intelligence —with an intuition that is manifested intellectually.

This would have its drawbacks from the practical point of view, but it would perhaps be closer to the truth than the lowest level — socialism or communism. Everything in between has proved

to be incompetent: theocracy, aristocracy, democracy and plutocracy, all those have been a 'complete failure'. The other one, the socialist or communist government is proving itself a failure as well.

Basically socialism and communism correspond to a kind of absence of government, because they do not have the power to govern others; they are obliged to transfer their power to someone who exercises it, like a Lenin for example, because he was a brain. All this has been tried and proved to be incompetent. The only thing that could be competent is the Truth-Consciousness which would choose instruments and express itself through a certain number of instruments, in the absence of one—'one' is not enough either, 'one' would necessarily have to choose a group.

Those who have this consciousness may belong to any social class: it is not a privilege of birth, but the outcome of personal effort

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and development. In fact, that is an outward sign, the obvious sign of a change from the political point of view—it is no longer a matter of classes and categories nor of birth—all that is obsolete. It is the individuals who have attained a certain higher consciousness who have the right to govern—not others, regardless of their social class. This would be the true vision.

All those who participate in the experiment should be absolutely convinced that the highest consciousness is the best judge of the most material things. What has ruined India is this idea that the higher consciousness deals with higher things and that lower things do not interest it at all, and that it understands nothing about them! That has been the ruin of India. Well, this error must be completely eradicated. It is the highest consciousness which sees most clearly,— most clearly and most truly—what the needs of the most material things must be.

With that, a new type of government could be tried.

This is to inform that Jean-Marie (Siddhartha Forest) left his body, during the night of 31st December to the dawn of 1st January, at home.


Jean-Marie's remains are resting at Farewell.

NAVROZ MODY



Navroz Mody, environmental activist, died in Pondicherry on Dec. 20, 2024. He was 79.

Born and raised in Bombay, Navroz was the only son of Kersasp and Rati Mody. He attended the Cathedral School, where he was a great sportsman, Head Boy in 1964, and Palmer House Captain. He was awarded the MacDonald Medal for Leadership fin 1963. From 1965 to 1969, Navroz studied at the Dartmouth College, New




Hampshire, USA, under the mentorship of Hans Penner, noted scholar of comparative religion. Returning to India, he worked as Regional Editor for Oxford University Press from 1971-1980. Among his editorial projects were the late volumes of the Handbook of Birds of India and Pakistan by Salim Ali, the renowned ornithologist and natural historian. Their friendship inspired developing Navroz's passion for environmental conservation.

During the 1970s, with Shyam Chainani and others, Navroz became a founding member of the Bombay Environmental Action Group (BEAG). For decades, through speaking, writing, and legal advocacy, he worked with BEAG to impact policy and effect change. At his death, he remained Honorable Secretary. In 1980, Navroz moved to Pondicherry to start his own business, Southend Typographics, and in Dec1983, he joined the Auroville community. He developed a grant-funded project to enhance water and crop management for small farmers in the Palani Hills watershed. He played an integral role in the Palani Hills Conservation Council and was instrumental in legal battles to protect the region, including the landmark victory over Pleasant Stay Hotel in 1995. During the 1990s, Navroz worked with the global organization Greenpeace, helping to pursue legal action against the companies responsible for the gas leak disaster in Bhopal. In Kodaikanal, Navroz was instrumental in exposing mercury contamination and seeking justice for affected workers.

In Auroville, he was known as a "fearless soldier" for environmental justice. Navroz was a member of the team that worked on the Auroville master plan. Based on his extensive experience in environmental issues, he focused on the co-development area (now called "outside the Master Plan") and the Auroville Greenbelt. Navroz showed that "Planning" and "Natural Growth" in designing a Master Plan are not contradictory but complementary approaches. In 1999, he became a member of the official representative team for the Master Plan. In 2022, after the destruction of the Youth Center and Bliss forest, he was one of the two Aurovilians who petitioned the National Green Tribunal Southern Bench to preserve Auroville's forests and green spaces, uphold participatory planning and stressing the need for obtaining environmental clearance for the Master Plan area. Navroz was also an artist. In recent times, he has been instrumental in starting the Ecology Action Lab at Aurobrindavan, an innovative citizen science initiative in Auroville. Navroz will be remembered for his fearlessness, kindness, passion, his generosity, his concern for others, his capacity to articulate issues.

For his surviving family, his wife Susan, his sons Nishq and Rik, his grandchildren Zoe and Zorion, and for his friends, his indelible spirit remains. Navroz's remains were cremated on December 26th at the Auroville cremation grounds.

MATRIMANDIR ACCESS INFORMATION

Dear All,

Please note that the Matrimandir Access team has made some small changes to the Access Policy.

- Firstly all Pass Holders and Aurovilians bringing guests will have to sign into a register at the Office Gate.
- Secondly Aurovilians can bring their close family members to the Gardens 4:30pm to 6:30pm daily as long as they inform before 11am on the day of the proposed visit to <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u>.
- Thirdly, all guest houses and home stays please note: Guests only holding Aurocards, who wish to attend the Savitri Readings in the Amphitheatre on Thursday evenings will have to book one or two days in advance at <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u>.
- The Matrimandir Access team also wishes to remind all Aurovilians acting as guides for visitors or guests that your guests can not be treated as friends and brought to the Park of Unity at any time. All Tours and guided individuals and parties should be taken to the Viewing Point.
- The Matrimandir Access team also wishes to remind anyone running workshops and camps that visits to Matrimandir or the Park of Unity are not to be included in the itinerary. All group visits should be to the Viewing Point only. Individuals attending these events who wish to concentrate in the Inner Chamber are welcome to make a booking in the normal way at <u>auroville.org</u>.

Access to the Park of Unity

The Park of Unity:

- The Matrimandir, the Petals, the Lotus Pond and the Banyan Tree are areas of SILENCE.
- The Park of Unity is open to Aurovilians and registered Newcomers daily, 6am-7:30pm.
- Aurovilians may bring close family and friends to the Gardens daily, 9am-3:30pm.
- Aurovilians wishing to bring close family to the Gardens at any other time should inform <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u> before 11am on the day of the proposed visit.
- Savi registered Volunteers and Donors require a pass to enter the Park of Unity. Timings will be indicated on the pass.
- Published events in the Park of Unity are open to Aurovilians, registered Newcomers, Volunteers, Pass holders and Guests. Guests should bring their Aurocards.
- Savitri Readings on Thursday evenings: Guests holding only Aurocards wishing to attend should book at <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u> one or two days in advance.

Access to the Inner Chamber of the Matrimandir

The Matrimandir is a place for silent individual concentration. The Inner Chamber is open to Aurovilians and registered Newcomers:

- Monday-Saturday: 6-8am, 4:30-7:30pm. Sunday: 6am-12pm, 4:30-7:30pm.
- The Inner Chamber is open to SAVI registered Volunteers: Wednesday-Monday, 8-8:40am. Arrival at 7:45am at the Office Gate.
- The Inner Chamber is open to Aurovilians wishing to accompany a maximum of 5 close family members and friends no more than once in two weeks, with booking 3 to 5 days in advance to <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u> any day except Tuesday & Sunday: 8-8:35am. Arrival at 7:45am at the Office Gate.
- The Inner Chamber, the Petals and the Gardens are open to the Children of Auroville and the Outreach Schools: Tuesday 9-11am.
- Auroville units can bring their staff to the Inner Chamber with a prior booking to <u>mmconcentration@auroville.org.in</u> Tuesday 8-8:30am.

The Petals of the Matrimandir

- The Petals are open to Aurovilians, registered Newcomers and Pass holders:
- Daily 7-8am, 5-6pm.

Access to Matrimandir for Visitors and Guests

Matrimandir Viewing Point:

- The Viewing Point is open to the general public on presentation of a Pass.
- Visits to the Matrimandir Viewing Point are free of cost.
- Free passes can be obtained at the Auroville Visitors Centre.
- The Viewing Point lies south of the Park of Unity and offers visitors a panoramic view of the Matrimandir and the Gardens and the Lake.
- Timings starting from the Visitors Centre Daily, 9am-5:30pm.

- The Inner Chamber is open to Visitors and Guests by prior booking only. Visitors and Guests seeking to concentrate in the Inner Chamber are requested to inquire at the Information Desk of the Visitors Centre after first visiting the Viewing Point, or to go to the website: <u>auroville.org</u>

ONCE UPON A TIME, BUT NOT ANYMORE: THROUGH THE THROES OF A HOSTILE TAKEOVER

Before: Era of curiosity

Question: Where are you from? Answer: I am from Manitha Orumaiyin Nagaram. Question: But it's so small, how can it be called a city? Answer: Some like to call it Manitha Orumaiyin Palayam, because it's a work in progress. Question: Aren't we all?

Now: Times of hostility

Assumption: Go back to your country. Response: Idhu thaan en veedu.

Starting with its unique vision and philosophy, Auroville is considered a gem of India. For 50+ years, it was a place for spiritual growth, collective living, and sustainable development. Yeah, but that was before the plot twist.

Designed to promote human unity, it is a hub for global cooperation, hosting residents from over 60 countries who work together to create a harmonious and progressive community, making it a symbol of India's openness and commitment to universal values. Ah, those were the days...



Known for its ecological initiatives, Auroville has transformed barren land into lush forests and promotes sustainable practices in farming, energy, and architecture, serving as a model for eco-conscious development. But that's ancient history now.

SUSPECTED ILLEGAL SMUGGLING OF MATRIMANDIR SOIL OUTSIDE AUROVILLE

I would like to bring certain shocking developments with regards to the soil excavated from Matrimandir to the knowledge of the community.



Please refer to the <u>google drive</u> showing suspected illegal interstate transport of Matrimandir soil from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry.

I have evidence to show that the Matrimandir Executives and Selvam working at Matrimandir are complicit in this exercise. I strongly request the community members to confront these people and protect Mother's resources from being stolen blatantly.

Please read the below email addressed to Dr. Jayanthi Ravi sent Tuesday 31st December (<u>read the original email here</u>).

Dear Dr. Jayanthi Ravi,

On 27 Dec 2024 - Friday at 11 am, I noticed two lorries ferrying soil from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry. On confronting the people loading and transporting the soil, they told me that one Mr. Selvam working in the Matrimandir had asked them to transport soil excavated from Matrimandir to be transported from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry.

I was bewildered by the statements made by the people transporting the soil. I decided to follow one particular truck which was still loading the soil from the loading point to the destination. To my utter shock I saw Auroville soil excavated from the Matrimandir was indeed being transported to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry.

I then asked ATDC member Mr. Govind if ATDC, appointed by the Governing Board, has given any permission to transport soil from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry?

He mentioned that he was not aware of any such permission or sanction. To verify my claims, he immediately sent Mr. Rajendran from ATDC to see if soil is being transported from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry. Mr. Ranjedran also witnessed the lorries ferrying soil from Auroville in Tamil Nadu to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry. Infact, when Mr. Ranjendran confronted the villagers supervising the unloading, they mentioned that the soil transport has the support of all five executives of Matrimandir.

In recent times, I have also noticed that multiple piles of soil from the Matrimandir excavations are suddenly going missing at a rapid pace. One can clearly observe JCB bucket marks on these soil piles indicating transportation of these soils. I also noticed that some of the plots where these soils are dumped do not belong to Auroville and belong to a private diamond company called Aditi Diamonds.

I request you to clarify the following:

- If any permission or sanctions have been accorded to Mr. Selvam working in Matrimandir to transport soil excavated from Matrimandir (Tamil Nadu) to be transported to Pondicherry?
- If any permission or sanctions have been accorded to Matrimandir executives or any other individuals to transport soil from Auroville Lands to Non-Auroville Lands?
- In case such permissions have not been accorded by you, I
 request you to take immediate action to investigate this matter
 and take necessary actions against the people involved in
 illegal inter-state smuggling of soil from Auroville in Tamil Nadu
 to Sanjeevi Nagar in Pondicherry.

I further request you to immediately stop any further unauthorised excavation and transportation of soil from Auroville lands to non-Auroville lands.

Lastly, I request you to audit the total volume of soil excavated from the Matrimandir site thus far, and corroborate it with the total volume of soil stored in the various piles across Auroville and protect the existing piles of excavated soils dumped at various sites in Auroville.

Requesting early action please.

DESPITE THE HORROR OF DETAILS


"One suddenly sees... It's a certain region, there, a region in the earth atmosphere, vast and imperishable, where things take on a new importance, which sometimes belies appearances, and one sees a sort of great, immense current carrying circumstances and events along towards a goal... always the same goal, and through very unexpected paths. It becomes very vast, and despite the horror of details, as a whole it takes on a very smiling Rhythm....

Now I know, I remember, this whole experience came after I saw a book that was published quite recently in India, in English, which they entitled The Roll of Honour, and in which there is a photo and

a short biography of all those who died in the fight against the British, for India's freedom. There were photos everywhere, lots of them (some were only photos the police took after they had just been killed and were lying on the ground). And it all brought a atmosphere: the atmosphere of those disinterested certain goodwilled people who meet with a tragic fate. It had the same impression on me as the horrors of the Germans during the war over there. These things are obviously under the direct influence of certain adverse forces, but we know that the adverse forces are, so to say, permitted to work-through the sense of horror, in fact-in order to hasten the awakening of consciousness. So then, that experience, which was very strong and was very like the one I had when I saw the photographs of German atrocities in France, put me in contact with the vision of the human, terrestrial, modern error (it's modern: it began these last one thousand years and has become more and more acute in the last hundred years), with the aspiration to counterbalance that: How to do it?... What is to be done?... And the answer: "That's why you have created Auroville."

WHO IS SEEING WHEN SEEING: THE KENA UPANISHAD AND THE SENSATION OF LOGIC

TUESDAY 7 JANUARY 2025



Who in our consciousness experiences sensations? How are sensations synthesized? How do matter, vibration, consciousness, and self connect? And how can we share sensations through art? Aurobindo introduced the uncommon notion of intermiscence at a central point in his interpretation of the Kena Upanishad. This concept invites deeper speculation about the power of art and provides a profound tool to understand postmodern theories like Gilles Deleuze's provocative reinterpretation of the notions of concept, percept, and affect. The Logic of Sensation (Deleuze) is an analysis of the forces in modern painting as an encounter. It will become clear that Aurobindo's interpretation of the Kena Upanishad as a key text of the Vedanta can hold space for one of the most profound rhizomatic postmodern thinkers.

On a deeper level, I want to explore how Aurobindo's idea that sensations can 'operate without bodily organs' relates to Deleuze's notion of body without organs (BwO). Both philosophers point at the forces of consciousness on a plane of immanence.
