


PONDERING

For this one must be in contact with one's psychic being, one must be guided by it and the ego's authority and influence must disappear



RA-TDC: LETTER REGARDING GROSS NEGLIGENCE IN URBAN PLANNING IN AUROVILLE

Dear Residents,

On January 5th, a <u>letter</u> was sent to high government officials addressing critical concerns about ongoing developments in the Auroville project area. These issues highlight significant lapses in planning, compliance, and transparency, posing risks to the ecological, social, and legal integrity of our community.

Key concerns include:

- 1. **Contracting Issues:** The contract with the CPWD for 11 radials lacks formal approval from planning authorities and the Residents' Assembly, violating the Auroville Foundation Act. Financial transparency is also absent, with no clarity on funding sources or expenditure.
- 2. Environmental and Safety Risks: Projects such as the Matrimandir Lake and Vikas Radial have proceeded without Detailed Development Plans (DDPs) or Environmental Impact Assessments (EIAs), causing environmental damage, safety hazards, and community disruption. Unauthorised actions, including tree cutting, further threaten Auroville's sustainability.
- 3. Lack of Community Involvement: These developments continue despite strong objections from the Residents' Assembly. The absence of participatory processes undermines Auroville's collaborative values.

We once again urge authorities to halt all ongoing and planned projects until these issues are resolved. Transparency, accountability, and community participation are essential for Auroville's sustainable development.

Thank you for your attention and commitment to Auroville's shared vision.

OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2025 REPORT



Dear Residents,

As we humbly welcome the New Year, we'd like to share with you a reflection on the topics we discussed in the last quarter of 2024. This report also highlights the latest trends, challenges, and future prospects for Auroville, offering a vision for how we can move forward together as a community.

Auroville's Vision and Challenges

Auroville is one big family, and we are building it in a unique way. From how we make decisions to how we learn and create, every action is an opportunity to practice living in unity. Human unity is not just a practice we can adopt once the city is built, nor is it following the dictates of a few, but an essential part of how we build Auroville together. The Council continues to believe that the true spirit of Auroville lies in nurturing self-discipline and inner responsibility, rather than imposing external restrictions.

However, the emphasis on material aspects of city-building has overshadowed the importance of empathy, eroding organically grown trust within our community. To restore this trust, we must reintegrate empathy into our processes, ensuring that every brick laid is not just for a building but for the heart of our collective spirit.

Gratitude

We extend our heartfelt thanks to all who have tirelessly served in working groups, particularly those affected by recent organizational changes, and those who continue to contribute to Auroville's forests, farms, and community initiatives, often with limited or no financial support. We also thank those who are supporting us from afar with their consistent encouragement. We are also grateful to all the Council Room watchers for their perseverance.

The Council Room has been a space of resilience and unity, maintained through the dedication of our community. For the past two years, it has been under 24/7 constant watch, a testament to the strength and commitment of those who have kept the inner fire of truth burning.

RAS Mandate

We thank the community for their active participation in providing feedback on the new RAS mandate. Your input has been carefully incorporated into the draft, which will be presented at the second Resident Assembly Meeting tentatively scheduled for mid-January. We look forward to even greater participation in the final stages of the process for its approval by the community.

RAS Membership

We acknowledge the resignation of Franclin from the Residents Assembly (RAS) due to personal reasons. The current RAS team includes Tatiana, Peter, Vignesh, and Avinash as a new resource person. The RAS plays a vital role in community representation, and we encourage all residents to participate in upcoming processes and consider nominations for future selections.

Selection Process

The Council has initiated discussions with the RAS and working groups to prepare for the selection where new members of the working groups will be chosen. A tentative timeline is being established for the coming months.

Matrimandir Lake

The latest incident of the failure of the lego wall has been extensively reported from different perspectives. Reports: <u>by MM</u> <u>team</u> and <u>RA WCom note</u>. The Council continues to call for greater collaboration with the community to ensure that the work on the lake is done in a safe and environmentally sensitive manner taking into account the valuable inputs already presented to the Matrimandir team.

Residence Criteria and New Rules

The recent announcement of the new criteria, issued without the RA's approval and implemented through a standing order signed by Dr. Seethraman, is clearly against the principles and ideals upheld by the AV community. The AV Council appeals to the AVFO and GB members to actively engage and communicate with the residents of Auroville before making such significant decisions.

The Council is committed to backing initiatives that resonate with the community's shared vision and values. We are willing to support efforts that align with these ideals and are sincerely executed in a spirit of collaboration and mutual respect.

Wood Sale After Cyclones

Allowing communities to sell wood cleared after cyclones ensures a fair distribution of wealth and resources to all residents. This practice, as done previously, would provide funds for essential communities maintenance and repairs. If allowed, these transactions could be managed properly through established processes, including the issuance of bills, ensuring transparency and accountability. Banning the sale of cyclone-cleared wood without providing an alternative plan is both irresponsible and contrary to the community's interests, especially since these communities receive no financial support from the current administration, relying solely on the monthly contributions of their residents for financial sustainability.

GB-BCC Half-maintenance Contribution

The introduction of retroactive half-maintenance contribution guidelines by the Budget Coordination Committee (GB-BCC) in October 2024 has caused significant financial distress for many residents. This enforcement disregards past waivers and informal agreements, directly contradicting Auroville's ethos of truth and selfless service.

It is important to note that the current BCC was not selected according to its RA approved mandate. Additionally, there's been an increase in the employment of non-Aurovilians by various GB Working Groups, which we feel undermines the unique spirit of Auroville.

The Auroville Council strongly condemns any retroactive policy as unethical and contrary to principles of natural justice. We request that new financial guidelines be applied only prospectively, honoring past agreements.

Afsaneh Guesthouse

In August, the Council wrote to the GB-FAMC (see below) requesting to adhere to due process, yet the GB-FAMC, along with the GH trustees, have been persistently pressuring the current management team to hand over the keys to a new team. This pressure continues despite the requests to follow the valid documentation and follow the due process, to which we never got a response.

"Dear Chandresh, Torkil, Geeta and Margarita,

We hear with concern that the management of Afsaneh Guest House is being changed at the present time. This is surprising since, as we understand it, the present management team of Auradha, Rosy and Enrica has been highly successful in managing the guest house, increasing its turnover and improving the infrastructure and it would seem that their work has been appreciated by their guests. Indeed, it is of concern that Auradha has not been reappointed as an executive and Enrica and Rosy appointed as additional executives despite their repeated requests and with no valid reasons being given for not doing so.

We are concerned that their success has not been fully appreciated by the trustees, nor by the GB appointed FAMC themselves, and that there has now been a decision made by you to replace them with new executives. We have observed that in recent times there have been a number of such replacements of executives in various Auroville units without adequate explanations being given to the executives themselves, nor to those directly affected, and without subsequent improvements in the units being apparent.

As the Auroville Council, responsible for ensuring that decisions are made in a fair and open way in our community groups, we would like to encourage you to please ensure that in this case the decisions regarding the management of the Guest House are made in a fair, transparent manner, that proper process is followed at every stage and that the decision is in the best interests of the organisation concerned and the community as a whole.

When an Aurovilian is asked to leave a Workplace - Guidelines The Auroville Council, together with previous FAMC members, worked on guidelines for units and trusts to use when there are difficulties with individuals in the workplace that may lead to their dismissal.

We shared these <u>guidelines</u> with the community in order to gather feedback. The feedback is being considered by the Auroville Council and integrated as needed, after which it may be issued as guidance.

Council Room Fire

On November 9th, at approximately 2:00 am, a small fire broke out in the electrical panel of the Council room while the room watcher was asleep. The smoke woke him, prompting him to quickly use a fire extinguisher to put out the fire. Although the electrical panel was significantly damaged, the surrounding area only suffered smoke damage. The power was then shut off.

The next day, a safe temporary electrical connection was established from outside the room to maintain essential services like lighting and power, with a warning against using high-energy devices such as the kettle. Information about this setup was shared with all room watchers.

The ACUR team was called to start repairs, and AVES sent an engineer, but he was sent away by an ACUR executive following instructions from the GB-FAMC. To ensure safety and functionality, a qualified electrician was called to make a safe temporary connection, which later led to a full repair of the electrical system.

However, a member of the GB-FAMC cut this temporary connection, though a permanent fix was quickly implemented allowing the room to remain in use. Simultaneously, the AC unit broke down due to a faulty fan blade, which was subsequently repaired by an external contractor.

The electrician determined that the fire was caused by a malfunctioning fan controller, contradicting an earlier suggestion by a GB-FAMC member that it was due to an overload from misuse of power.

Thanks are due to the room watcher for his prompt action in extinguishing the fire, potentially preventing a larger disaster,

especially since the night watchman was not aware of the fire extinguisher's location. The cooperation from those involved in the repairs is also appreciated. However, there is significant concern regarding the GB-FAMC's refusal to permit repairs, which could have compromised the safety of the building and hindered the operations of official working groups.



This is to inform that Jean-Marie (Siddhartha Forest) left his body, during the night of 31st December to the 1st January, at home.


For those who knew him he was a true disciple of Sri Aurobindo and The Mother. Through and through an Aurovilian with heart and soul.

Jean-Marie was cremated on Sunday January 5th at the Auroville Cremation Ground.

IN MEMORIAM: MARCO FEIRA

Marco Feira passed away in his house in Sharnga community on 26 December 2024 at the age of 75. He had been suffering from pancreatic cancer.

Marco joined Auroville almost 30 years ago. His was a full and varied life, initially shaped by his love for the arts, later by his love for the spiritual.



While growing up in Turin, Italy, he started painting and joined the Arte Povera movement, using everyday materials to create a new pictorial language. In the late 1960s he travelled to Afghanistan, Pakistan and India where he fell in love with the arts and antiques. His focus expanded and he became one of the first Italian dealers in Asiatic art and antiquities, running, by the end of the 1970s, a business with more than 20 employees.

India touched him in other ways as well. He started studying Indian philosophy and the Vedas, with his first book being one by Sri Aurobindo which, he said later, he hadn't understood at all. Together with his wife Liliana, Marco discovered Auroville. After visiting Auroville for many years, they joined in 1997. Here Marco and Liliana started the fashion and jewellery unit Miniature – a name chosen as a living reminder to keep the production small.

Marco will be particularly remembered for his role in stimulating the arts in Auroville. Together with four other Aurovilians, he started the AV Art Service in 2010, aiming at supporting and developing the arts in Auroville. He stressed the importance of art for Auroville and was inspired by what the Mother had said about art:

Art is nothing less in its fundamental truth than the aspect of beauty of the Divine manifestation. ... like a Yogi an artist goes into deep contemplation to await and receive his inspiration. To create something truly beautiful, he has first to see it within, to realise it as a whole in his inner consciousness; only when so found, seen, held within, can he execute it outwardly; he creates according to this greater inner vision. This too is a kind of yogic discipline, for by it he enters into intimate communion with the inner worlds.



He was one of the founder editors of the occasionally-published magazine called MAgzAV, which focused on questions around what the new culture of Auroville was, how art could contribute to the building of the city, and how Auroville artists could foreground critical aspects of the budding values of the community.

Marco also curated many art shows, amongst which was the exhibition Transformation that was part of The Auroville Festival – City for Transformation at the India International Center, New Delhi, in September 2012. The exhibition, which showed works of Auroville artists, was a great success and led Marco to dream about an Museum of Modern Art in Auroville, which would host art that spoke directly to the viewer, who should experience 'something' and ask questions so deep that answers would have to be found at the spiritual level.

Cinema was another art form Marco loved. He brought to life the Cinema Paradiso in Auroville's Multimedia Centre, showing films from different parts of the world, and he started the bi-annual Auroville Film Festival, a platform for movies made by people from Auroville and elsewhere. The experience led to exchange programmes with film festivals in other parts of the world and to the decision to make film making part of the curriculum of some of Auroville's schools.

His focus on art was supported by his focus on Tai Chi Chuan. Marco had spent a year in a Zen monastery in Italy learning breathing techniques, concentration and meditation, which became part of his daily routine. In Auroville he studied Tai Chi Chuan as taught by The School of the Inner Way of Vlady Stevanovitch. He studied this form intensively and became a teacher himself, ultimately training between 20 and 40 people a year for more than 20 years.

Marco's remains were buried on 27 December at the Auroville Burial Grounds with many attending. Auroville salutes a wonderful man whose artistic insights, touch and initiatives will have a lasting impact on the city to come. Our warmest condolences go out to Liliana, Ambra, Alessio, Igor, Ramon, Diego.

A great friend of late Giorgio Molinari, Milan's photographer and an Aurovilian, Marco also experimented with photography. He displayed an exhibition with pics from a baroque church and common life, a theatre of the absurd. Marco had mounted it on elegant satinated aluminium frames; he wished to donate them to Pitanga but, aerially moving by the wind, they indented the walls and this was the end of the adventure, alas.

A joyous occasion was an exhibition in Chennai to celebrate the (50?) years of the Italian Chamber of Commerce. Sauro had invited us Italian photographers: Giorgio, Marco, Pino and myself; it was interesting to see how different were our photographs, though we hailed from the same country. Next to us was a hall with war and slums photographs; I forgot the celebration and merged instead into the world's tragedy evoked by a Chennai photographer. How distant from what we Aurovilians, hosted in a super deluxe hotel with banquets hall and delicious food, presented! Inverting responsibilities? It was surreal.

Marco was a fine cinema critic and his choices showed the impassionate social commitment that characterised our Italian generation. Today, hardly anything of this remains.

OPEN LETTER TO ANURADHA MAJUMDAR LEGRAND

Dear Anu,

You may be surprised that I call you "dear," but I am addressing this open letter to Anu's soul, which is truly dear to me—as is every soul embodied on this little planet.

That said, I must express my surprise at a recent development. During the Special Talk on Good Practices at Auroville, held in Gujarat on January 3, 2025, you introduced yourself as "at present a member of the Working Committee."

This came as a surprise for several reasons. First, your term as a member of the Working Committee officially ended on January 2024. Second, a few months ago, you announced your resignation from the committee, which itself seemed unusual since your term had already concluded.

Given these facts, I am puzzled as to why you publicly presented yourself as still holding this position. Could there be a valid reason I am unaware of? Was there a new selection process that reappointed you for another term? Or is there another meaningful explanation?

Additionally, I am curious about the continued signing of communications from the so-called committee by other former members—Srimoyi, Partha, and Arun—whose terms also ended alongside yours.

I trust you will agree that our actions and communications must reflect these values. Thank you for taking the time to address this matter. I look forward to your response.



One would already have to conceive (it's possible) of a Power sufficient to be at once a protection against aggression or bad will (this would not be the most difficult protection to provide) and a protection (which can just barely be imagined) against infiltration and admixture.... From the social or organizational standpoint, these problems are not difficult, nor from the standpoint of inner life; the problem is the relationship with what is not Supramentalised—preventing infiltration or admixture, keeping the nucleus from falling back into an inferior creation during the transitional period. ...

I am constantly seeing images! Not images, living things-like answers to questions. A magnificent peacock was taking shape (it's the symbol of victory here in India) and its tail opened out, and on it a construction appeared, like this construction of an ideal place ... "

"ANKUR" (THE SEEDLING)

Directed by Shyam Benegal, India, 1974 Cast: Shabana Azmi, Sadhu Meher, Anant Nag...



Synopsis: In a small village in an Andhra Pradesh still marked by feudalism, Lakshmi lives a poor lifestyle along with her husband, Kishtaya, a deaf-mute with а penchant for the bottle.


Both work for a wealthy landlord. The landlord's son, Surya, having to stop his studies, returns home to look after the estate as well as to formalize his pre-arranged marriage to the young Saroj. When Kishtaya is punished for a petty theft and absconds from the place, Lakshmi is left alone to fend for herself ... Shyam Benegal creates a sublime and provocative examination of hypocrisy, economic disparity, and the social status of women in Ankur. The film was highly acclaimed and went on to win 43 prizes including the Golden Bear at the 24th Berlin Film Festival. It also happens to be the debut feature film of Shyam Benegal, introducing the actors Anant Nag and Shabana Azmi.

devastating humor, legendary drunkenness, and infinite humanity! The film is the first in Kaurismäki's Finland trilogy, the other two films being The Man Without a Past and Lights in the Dusk.

INDIAN - MONDAY 13 JANUARY, 8:00 PM: KOTTUKKAALI (THE ADAMANT GIRL)

India, 2024, P.S. Vinothraj w/ Soori, Anna Ben, Nirosha, and others, Drama, 100mins, Tamil w/ English subtitles, Rated: R

From the maker of Koozhangal (Pebbles) comes a story of a young woman Meena's love for a man - Pandi from a lower caste. It sparks conflict with her family, who believe she is possessed. The story explores her struggle against societal prejudices, with her family attempting to cast out her perceived "spell" of forbidden love. On a journey to an exorcist, accompanied by her betrothed, the trip unveils tensions between tradition and personal freedom, exposing her silent rebellion. A rooster, tied to a stone, but managing to break free for a moment, is like a powerful symbol of Meena's limited life. *It is not action packed. It is a film to watch, observe, and reflect upon.*

Senegal, 1973, Writer-Dir. Djibril Diop Mambéty w/ Magaye Niang, Myriam Niang, Christoph Colomb, and others, Drama, 85mins, Wolof-Arabic-French w/ English subtitles, Rated NR (G)

Mory, a cowherd who rides a motorcycle mounted with a cow's skull, and Anta, a university student, have met in Dakar, Senegal's capital. Alienated and disaffected with Senegal and Africa, they long to go to Paris and work up different con schemes to raise the money. Mory steals clothing and money from a wealthy gay man who had brought him home, and he and Anta book passage on a ship to France.

SELECTION - WEDNESDAY 15 JANUARY, 8:00 PM: • THE MOST RELUCTANT CONVERT

USA, 2021, Dir. Norman Stone w/ Max McLean, Nicholas Ralph, Eddie Ray Martin, and others, Biography-Drama, 73mins, English w/ English subtitles, Rated: NR (PG)

C.S. Lewis' journey from atheist to believer begins with his turbulent childhood. After losing his mother and becoming estranged from his father, Lewis deems existence bleak. His tutelage under atheist William T. Kirkpatrick and experiences in The Great War solidify his materialist views. However, friendships with J.R.R. Tolkien and Hugo Dyson challenge him to consider Christianity, forcing a choice between materialism and faith.

S.Korea-Taiwan-Bulgaria-UK, 2022, Dir. Haru Lev, Experimental-Documentary, 74mins, Korean-English-Japanese w/ English subtitles, Rated: PG-13

This film is an omnibus of 15 music videos created for liberation for all, involving 35 musicians and 15 performers/artists. The original soundtrack, released first by Korean-based musicians, addresses worldwide issues such as animal massacres, speciesism, excessive capitalism, and climate change. *This screening has been made possible by the director, visiting Auroville, and Kyonghyon Lee. There will be a brief Q&A with the director after the screening.*

Italy-France-Belgium, 2024, Writer-Dir. Maura delpero w/ Tommaso Ragno, Roberta Rovelli, Martina Scrinzi, and others, Drama-History, 119 mins, Italian w/ English subtitles, Rated: NR (R)

In a remote Alpine village during World War II, a deserting soldier disrupts a local family's life by falling in love with the eldest daughter, Lucia. Drawn from the director's own family history. Their unexpected romance transforms the family's life, set against a breathtaking landscape that captures the transition from a traditional way of life to a new era, revealing intimate human stories of love, survival, and personal transformation. *A must watch*!
