Emergency RAD to reject all Orders from the Secretariat

Following a pulse by those in attendance at the emergency General Meeting held on 13th August, the Working Committee of the RA is calling for an emergency decision of the Residents' Assembly:

“We, members of the Residents' Assembly of the Auroville Foundation, agree to pass a resolution that states that we, as one of the authorities of the Auroville Foundation as affirmed by the honorable Madras High Court, confirm that orders (Office Orders, Standing Orders and any other form of orders) from the Office of the Secretary and her appointees are not the result of a collaborative work with the RA, and have been issued without consultation with or approval by the Residents' Assembly, and affirm our support for the groups and appointees by the RA.”

Legal implications of the recent judgment

[The recent judgment](#) in the cases of the Wcom, ATDC, and Outreach Media at the Madras High Court has far-reaching implications for how the community can move forward. There is now in circulation a short overview of these implications, explaining key parts of the judgment in non-legal terms. Highlights include:

- The RAD of 10th May is valid: Aurovilians who were confirmed by the Residents' Assembly to serve in the Working Committee on that date are the lawful Working Committee. These members are: Aravinda, Bharathy, Chali, Hemant, Maël, Sauro, Valli
- The attempt by the GB, through an Office Order signed by the Under Secretary, to unilaterally reconstitute the ATDC was rejected. Instead, the learned judge noted that “The reconstitution of members for the Auroville Town Development Council under the Office Order dated 15.07.2021 definitely requires the consent of the Residents' Assembly...”
- The RoR update is to be done, and no policy decision can be taken by any of the three authorities of the Auroville Foundation until this work is complete “after giving wide publicity”.
- The GB's argument that it was “the Supreme authority under the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988” was rejected. [...] “The relationship between the three authorities is of mutuality” said the learned judge.
- Auroville Trusts are non-governmental organisations.

Town Hall locked

Directly following the results of the court case on 12th August, the doors to the Working Committee offices were locked. On the morning of 16th August when people were returning to work after the holiday, they discovered that all doors to the Town Hall except for the front doors were locked and chained. Mr Mathi, the AVFO's 'Vigilance Officer' was sitting by the front doors observing who was entering and leaving the building. After a few hours the doors were unchained and unlocked. When the management were asked why these actions were felt necessary, no clarification

The Working Committee of the RA released a [statement](#) via massbulletin asking the community to “meet this [provocation] with perfect equanimity. Our answer should be a calm distance from the conflict zone. At the Working Committee we are taking necessary next steps and will keep you informed.”

The illegitimate ‘ATDC’ indicated in their [Auronet announcement](#) on 16th August that the AVFO likely intends to ignore the decisions of the Madras High Court and will appeal. In order to support AVFO’s narrative that Aurovilians are ‘problematic’ and ‘blocking development’, there may be attempts to portray interactions with community members in that light. In their statement the Wcom requests the community to ignore any provocations.

If interactions occur, please try to make sure that you are not alone and that everything is calmly documented by video.

Land issues

Issues of land encroachment continue in several places without communication or intervention from the Foundation Office to support the affected residents. For any land encroachment issues, make sure to alert the Auroville Foundation Office and the Land Board, as the Land Officer (the Secretary) has the final responsibility to protect the lands of Auroville.

Concurrently, there is no clarity about the Secretary’s plans for land sale and/or exchange, creating uncertainty. [Pebble Garden](#), the well known permaculture project of Deepika and Bernard next to Aurobrindhavan, received some unidentified visitors on the 14th of August ‘to see the land’. They were accompanied by the Secretary’s personal assistant. The reason for their visit remains unknown.

Second report on Crown Road work by Satprem of the Auroville Earth Institute

Last week Satprem Maini of the Auroville Earth Institute wrote a technical evaluation of the quality of the work done on the Crown Road. He has now written a follow-up report which points out more issues with the sublayer, pavers, materials and techniques used to implement the road.

In [his accompanying email](#) to the Secretary, GB, and IAC, he reiterates his final conclusion: “[...] you should immediately stop this road, get a proper study and survey done, remove what has been badly done and resume the construction of the road once this study has been completed. We cannot go on wasting public funds from the Government of India.” You can [find the follow-up report here](#). Since Satprem’s first report was published, some of the area which had been laid on the Bliss-Horizon road has been pulled up to be relaid. Additionally, a [sign](#) has been placed in the area of the roadworks stating that “photography [is] prohibited in this area”.

Stewards not informed about ‘calisthenics’ area in Mahalakshmi park

On 15th August in Mahalakshmi park, a new project was inaugurated by the Secretary. It consists of a ‘calisthenics’ area with outdoor sports equipment. While such a project could be considered worthwhile for the Auroville community, it was implemented without informing the steward of the land at any stage.

The entire Mahalakshmi park area has been previously planned and mapped with TDC approval, including a phase-wise development plan of the park with different spaces and activities. With the implementation of the calisthenics area, the previously approved plan was completely ignored. Additionally, part of the equipment consists of a large advertisement for a Chennai-based company. When the steward arrived on site to inquire why he had not been consulted, he was accused by Jaya (member of the illegitimate ‘ATDC’) of ‘ownership’ and his queries remained ignored.

Kalabhumi meeting update

On 13th August the main Working Groups called an emergency [General Meeting](#) at Kalabhumi. Approximately 500 residents were in attendance. Speakers representing the WCom, TDC & FAMC plus the AV Council informed the community of the actions that have been carried out by the AVFO and their 'Working Groups' since the Secretary came into office in July 2021. They also shared recent actions that many in the community are unaware of, such as the attempted takeover of Afsanah Guest House (an Aurovilian entity which has never received any GOI funding) by the AVFO. The implications of the Court ruling were also outlined.

The Working Committee outlined their proposal for an emergency RAD to 'reject all of the Office Orders that have been issued by the Office of the Secretary' - this proposal was accepted by an overwhelming majority of the residents in attendance. The proposal has now been formulated into a resolution and can be viewed [here](#). The said resolution is currently open for a vote of the Residents' Assembly.
