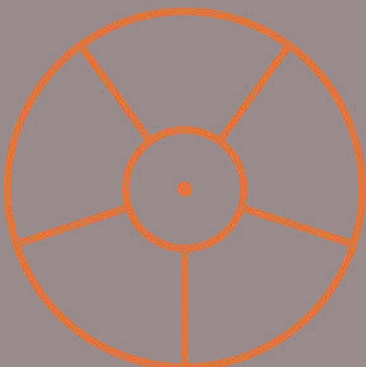

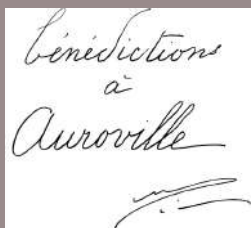

So in this park, I saw the "Pavilion of Love". But I dislike this word, for man has turned it into something grotesque; I am speaking of the principle of Divine Love. But that has changed: it will be "The Pavilion of the Mother", but not this (*Mother points to herself*) —the Mother, the true Mother, the principle of the Mother. I say "Mother" because Sri Aurobindo used that word, otherwise I would have put something else, I would have put "creative principle" or "principle of realisation" or—I do not know.... It will be a small building, not a big one, with only a meditation room downstairs, but with columns and probably a circular shape. I say probably, because I am leaving that for Roger to decide. Upstairs, the first floor will be a room and the roof will be a covered terrace. You know the ancient Indo-Moghul miniatures, with palaces where there are terraces with small roofs supported by columns? You know those old miniatures? Hundreds of them have come into my hands.... But this pavilion is very, very beautiful, a small pavilion like this, with a roof on a terrace, and low walls with couches against them to sit on, to meditate in the open air in the evening, at night. And below, downstairs, at ground-level, a meditation room, simply—something quite bare. There would probably be at the far end something which would be a living light, perhaps the symbol in living light, a constant light. Otherwise, a very peaceful, very silent place.

Nearby, there would be a small dwelling, a small dwelling which would nevertheless have three floors, but not large-sized, and that would be the house of Huta, who would serve as a guardian. She would be the guardian of the pavilion. She wrote me a very nice letter but she did not understand all that, of course.

That is the centre.

All around, there is a circular road which separates the park from the rest of the town. There would probably be a gateway—in fact there must be one—in the park. A gateway with the guardian of the gate. The guardian of the gate is a new girl who has come from Africa, who wrote me a letter telling me that she wanted to be the guardian of Auroville in order to let only the

needs.

servants of Truth" enter (*laughing*). It is a very nice plan. So I shall probably put her there as guardian of the park, with a small house on the road at the entrance.

But the interesting thing is that around this central point, there are four big sections, like four big petals (*Mother draws*), but the corners of the petals are rounded and there are small intermediate zones—four big sections and four zones.... Naturally that is only in the air; on the ground, it will be an approximation.

We have four big sections: the cultural section, to the North, that is to say, towards Madras; to the East, the industrial section; to the South, the international section; and to the West, that is to say, towards the lake, the residential section.

To make myself clear: the residential section, where there will be the houses of the people who have already subscribed and of all the others who are coming in large number to have a plot in Auroville. That will be next to the lake.

The international section : we have already approached a certain number of ambassadors and countries for each one to have its pavilion—a pavilion from every country. It was an old idea. Some have already accepted, so it is on the way.

NOTE:

- A Newcomer becomes an 'Aurovilian' once his/her name has been confirmed by The Admission Committee (aka the Entry Board) after following due process.
- The date of becoming 'Aurovilian' is the date of confirmation. An Aurovilian confirmed by the Entry Board is eligible to participate in all community decision-making processes.
- The formal administrative step of entering new residents into the Register of Residents (RoR), is done by the Secretary of the Auroville Foundation. For this, a B-Form is filled in and signed by the individual and a meeting with the Secretary is arranged by the Entry Secretariat. However, until such time as the court has made its ruling about Admission and Termination Regulations 2023, the meetings of Confirmed Aurovilians with the Secretary will be pending.

LETTER TO GB RE MINUTES OF 68TH MEETING

ATTENTION ASPIRING NEWCOMERS

Dear aspiring Newcomers and others,

We would like to make you aware that the entry process for Auroville is in the courts and has not yet received a final ruling.

However, as per the Auroville Foundation Act, Section 19 (a), the Residents' Assembly (RA) may: "allow the admission or cause the termination of persons in the register of residents..." and an Entry Board chosen by the RA has been functioning for many years. Additionally, a set of Regulations were created by the RA and approved by the Governing Board in 2020, under the AVF Act.

There are now groups of residents, calling themselves the "Admission and Termination Registry" and the "Admission and Termination Scrutinizing Committee", who have not been chosen by the RA. They are taking for themselves the admission and termination powers of the RA, with no delegation or approval from it.

We wish to remind all aspirants that the regulations under which these two groups are formed were stayed by the Madras High Court on 23 February 2024. These groups and their actions are illegal and clearly go against Auroville's ideals of human unity.

In addition, be aware your entry process and life in Auroville under the ATR / ATSC will be subject to "Residence Criteria" which were also created under the stayed Regulations, and include:

- Mandatory "Auroville Spiritual and Material Refresher program" (content undisclosed) created and run by many of the same people as the ATR / ATSC but under the group named "Human Resources Service" (HRS)
- Prior approval from the HRS for any trips, absences from Auroville of longer than 2 weeks
- Permission from the HRS to host people for more than 7 days, even family and friends, in the home you occupy
- Mandatory work up to 7 days a week (5 hours a day) as decided by the "Funds and Assets Management Committee" (GB FAMC)
- And more of such disturbing restrictions and control mechanisms.

Please also be aware that any admission process that is begun by these groups that are created under the stayed regulations may be subject to the final outcome of the case regarding the admissions process for Auroville, which is still in the courts.

We understand that these difficult times can be confusing, and we deplore that your aspiration to join Auroville is happening under these circumstances. None of our collective and individual aspirations should be threatened and used in such a way.

We still have faith that these challenging times will pass and Auroville will continue to grow and progress towards manifesting an actual human unity on all levels.

CLARIFICATION RE CIRCULAR BY AVFO ON 11TH APRIL, 2025

Dear Residents, Newcomers and Volunteers,

A Circular was sent out by the Auroville Foundation Office on the 11th of April 2025.

We see that once again the Foundation Office and the groups and individuals who are recognized by them are attempting to erode our sense of community and spirit of unity by sowing confusion and fear.

We wish to clarify some points of this circular:

1. So-called "unauthorized meetings": Community gatherings of residents are not breaking any laws and it is therefore not required to obtain any prior approval. It is fully within the rights of residents to hold meetings to share information and experiences. The fact that the Foundation Office and its appointed groups are trying to stop residents from gathering shows their insecurity in their forcefully assumed positions and in their continuing attempts to control people at all costs. **The community getting together and being united is precisely what we must do.** See you all at the next meeting!

2. The Working Committee and 'office bearers':

- The individuals mentioned in the circular as the 'Working Committee' (**Anu, Arun, Joseba, Partha, Selvaraj, Srimoyi and Tine**) **have not been constituted by the Residents' Assembly (RA) as they claim** and in fact Anu, Arun, Partha

- and Srimoyi **were specifically dismissed by the RA** in a Residents' Assembly decision of May 2022 (attached); Joseba, Selvaraj and Tine were co-opted by those dismissed. Claiming to have been selected by the RA while dismissing its decisions is an incomprehensible hypocrisy.
- According to Section 20 of the Auroville Foundation Act, the RA will determine the manner of choosing and the term of office of its Working Committee. **Neither the Governing Board nor any employee or appointee of the Foundation office has any say in the selection, constitution or 'recognition' of the Working Committee.**
- **Even if (and it is a big IF)** this group were the legitimate Working Committee
 - a. The term of office for which they were originally selected (before having been dismissed) **expired in January 2024, more than a year ago.**
 - b. **Srimoyi resigned** from the group on 21 March 2024 (which was later announced on Auronet) so she is therefore not just 'inactive'
 - c. **Anu also resigned** on 1 August 2024 and was announced on Auronet as a 'resource person' only.
- Therefore, these individuals are the ones impersonating 'office-bearers'. **How can they call themselves the Working Committee of the Residents' Assembly when they have been dismissed by the body they are meant to represent or were not selected at all by that body, the RA?**
- It is unclear which regulations of Auroville are being violated by the unnamed 'people who are impersonating office bearers'. This reference to unspecified regulations is continuing the pattern of threats being issued by the Foundation Office and its recognized groups.

3. Ruling of the Chief Justice (CJ) of the Madras High Court (MHC): The CJ of the MHC has stated that the RA as a statutory body must be allowed to carry out its functions as per Sections 18, 19 and 20 of the Auroville Foundation Act. (Reference modified interim stay order of September 4th, 2023.)

4. Signatory: There is no typed or printed name on this circular, only an illegible signature, so it is not clear who this 'OSD' is, even IF its contents were valid.

The use of fear and coercion threatens to paralyze and silence us all. This is exactly the intention of these actions. Let us not give in to fear, remember that we are a community, that we are there for each other and can reach out, offer support, share, and be joyful together in this wonderful adventure.

IMPORTANT UPDATE FROM THE MADRAS HIGH COURT

Dear Residents,

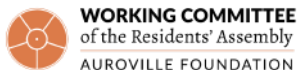
Yesterday, 29th April, evening, four cases concerning Auroville were suddenly listed in the Madras High Court before its closure for summer during the month of May.

- A case filed by a concerned member of the RA concerning the constitution of the Admission and Termination Scrutinizing Committee (ATSC) was basically accepted for debate and the lawyers of the Foundation Office were directed to submit their arguments within six weeks.
- Two cases concerning the Working Committee, our appeal to the ruling on the quo warranto case and the appeal by the AVFO on the stay of the regulations of the Governing Board regarding constitution of the Working Committee, have been postponed by the appeal bench until after summer break.
- One more case concerning the appeal by the AVFO on the interim stay to the 2024 Admission and Termination regulations was discussed and the Madras High Court decided to vacate the interim stay. The case is still alive but this decision means that the new regulations on entry and exit that were previously stayed are now applicable until a final or a different order comes from the Madras High Court. **We are waiting for the written order of yesterday's hearing of the High Court before sharing further comments with the community.**

We understand that these are confusing and insecure times, with contradicting information and orders but the road still goes on and we will hold on to our faith, inner strength and hope for a better future for Auroville, for our community.

RA-TDC: LETTER REGARDING UNLAWFUL TREATMENT OF TREES

Dear Residents,

On April 9th, a [letter](#) was sent to high government officials, the Joint Committee, the GB and the IAC. It addresses concerns about the unlawful activities by the GB-appointed ATDC and the AVFO.

These include the illegal cutting of protected trees—Peepal and Red Sanders—without required permissions, and unauthorised excavation work for the Matrimandir Lake, resulting in vehicle and timber seizure by authorities. These actions violate environmental regulations, lack transparency, and disregard community consultation and legal mandates. We call for immediate corrective measures and compliance with national and local laws to protect Auroville's ecology, spirit, and lawful governance. Let development proceed with integrity, inclusivity, and sustainability.

FROM THE AUROVILLE COUNCIL

AVC REPORT JAN, FEB AND MARCH 2025

Report to the Community

Council Functioning & Challenges

The Council has been operating with only five members, and it has not been easy, given the presence of various parallel groups. Additionally, our official email address has been taken over by the GB FAMC since 2022, and despite multiple requests, we have not received a proper response. Our members have visited several times to the AVFO in this regard and either there is no one there or we are told to meet with the Secretary who has been absent.

Furthermore, the electrical connection to both the Council office desk and the RA meeting room has been disconnected again affecting the AC in the room. We have requested the ACUR management team to restore the connection, but as we understand, this approval has been refused by GB FAMC. Despite these difficulties, the Council has now managed to secure a safe connection for the AC and it is again fully functional.

The Council needs to repeat that despite claims to the contrary by the Foundation office and others, the Auroville Council is a fully approved working group with a mandate ratified by the Residents Assembly in 2004. The group has made numerous presentations to the Governing Board in past years, and until 2021, the legitimacy of the group was never questioned, either by the Governing Board or the Residents Assembly. The group has a clear [mandate](#), and has continued to be active, particularly in areas such as conflict resolution, creation and oversight of mandates and policies, and the protection of the principles of natural justice.

Community Connect

Our regular Community Connect meetings are currently paused but will resume soon. We encourage more residents to participate in these meetings, as they provide an important platform for voicing concerns, addressing issues, and offering suggestions for a smooth and collective way forward in our organization.

Resignations:

Samrat has stepped down from the Council from Jan 2025 as his term has come to end and he could not continue due to his other commitments in our community. We thank him for holding the community spirit in his heart and for serving the community during his term. We wish him all the best with his new endeavours.

Vignesh has resigned from the RAS as a member and has agreed to continue to serve as resource person for the RAS. We sincerely thank him for his contributions and wish him the very best in his new endeavors!

New RAS Mandate

An RAD was initiated by the Auroville Council in consultation with the RA Working Committee (RA WCom) to seek approval for the new mandate from the Residents assembly. This process took place from **October 4th to February 10th**, and we are happy to report that the new mandate has been approved.

A joint resolution has been passed by the RAS to formalize this process. The community participation, especially in providing feedback, has proved to be valuable, even essential, in the harmonious conclusion to this work.

We sincerely thank all residents for their active participation. It is essential for every member of our community to engage in shaping the organization of Auroville.

New Member in the RAS Team

Avinash, who has been serving as a resource person in the RAS team, has expressed his wish to join as a full member. The RAS team has welcomed his interest and has requested the Council to follow the process outlined in the new RAS mandate.

A separate announcement has been made to the community regarding this and feedback requested on the appointment. March 27th was the deadline for feedback, and there has been no negative feedback. The Council confirms Avinash as a member of RAS.

Silver Fund

It has been reported to us that the Silver Fund, a fund used to provide maintenances for Aurovilians aged over 70 years, has been refused for some of our senior Aurovilians, despite their genuine need. This is of great concern, as many rely on Auroville for their care and security in their later years, as they have no independent resources of their own. The Auroville Council wrote to the GB BCC expressing their concern and asking about the criteria for allocating the Silver Fund to senior Aurovilians, but received no reply. [\[link to letter\]](#).

Zoho

It is of great concern that changes in Financial Services are being imposed on the community with apparently no consultation with community members or prior introduction to Zoho from the FAMC, creating confusion and anxiety. It would appear that even those directly working in Financial Services have not been consulted, and the new system was presented as a fait accompli. Although we understand that training is being given to trustees and executives, we consider such top-down actions as not only contrary to the essence of Auroville's values of true collaboration, but are liable to encounter considerable issues due to lack of consultation with the community. Apart from this, the requirement to use external banking and accountancy services will surely have serious financial consequences for the Auroville economy as a whole, and appear to be a backward step in our aspirations towards a cashless society as the Mother envisioned.

We would emphasise that the Council's role (in collaboration with the RAS) is to facilitate the participation of the community in decisions made by working groups. The Auroville Council is always willing to consider the genuine approach from any group in assisting with such work.

Afsaneh GH

We have been informed by the Afsaneh management team about ongoing communications between them and the GB-FAMC. It is concerning to see that, despite the requests to the guest house trustees and GB FAMC for correct processes to be followed, pressure continues to be exerted on the GH team in various ways. We must reiterate the earlier email sent to them and the guest house trustees.

1. Proper process followed for dismissing or for appointing new executives. The GB-FAMC has been asked more than once, verbally and by email, to provide the required documents to show that due process as outlined in the CoC 2017, and with respect to principles of natural justice, has been followed.
2. A clear decision by the GB-FAMC outlining the event causing the removal of an executive (Section 9(d)) of the CoC.
3. A hearing must be given to those being dismissed to address any mismanagement leading to the decision (Section 9(d(v))) if this is what is being suggested by the GB-FAMC. "Before concluding that a Trust / Unit is mismanaged, the FAMC will give a fair hearing to the Trustees / Executives and thereafter shall submit its findings to the Trustees / Executives and the Working Committee"

4. A joint resolution by the FAMC and the Working Committee, signed by valid members of these two groups, is necessary (Sections 8(a) and 9(d)) to dismiss executives. In the case of the GB 'FAMC', created under Section 16 of the AVF Act, this would be the GB member appointed in the Office Order (Mr. Sanjog Kapoor); in the case of the 'Working Committee' this would be a resident duly selected by the RA as per Section 20 of the AVF Act. The GB FAMC Resolution #926, issued in August 2024, for changing executives, of which Auradha and ourselves came to know about in an indirect manner, was signed by two Aurovilian members of the GB-FAMC, and not by the required appointed member of the Governing Board.

Community Survey

It is proposed by the Council to carry out a community survey to learn more about the issues of most concern to community members and to understand better what motivates them. It is clear that a comparatively small percentage of members engage in community processes, although the number participating is more than it was before the present issues presented themselves. It is of concern to not only understand why many feel unable or unwilling to participate, but to understand their opinions on many issues of concern to the larger community.

A survey is therefore being prepared which will be circulated as widely as possible, with help available to complete, and will be completely anonymous, ensuring the widest possible participation.

A request for respectful behaviour.

It has come to our attention that aggressive, even threatening behaviour has been witnessed recently from individuals of authority in the community. We are aware that at times when there is much tension and fear in the community, tempers get strained, and words are spoken which do not reflect our aspirations as a community. However, we believe that it is especially important that those in authority act with restraint and goodwill, even though they may believe that those who they are addressing are wrong. This is surely the minimum expected of members of the community of Auroville. Threatening behaviour is unacceptable in any society, but especially in Auroville which aspires to manifest the Divine Consciousness.

REMEMBERING WALTER

Walter (Walter Wagner) was born in Stuttgart, Germany, on 7.12.1950. He was the only child of two individuals whose lives were broken by the war. His childhood and youth were difficult and he wanted to throw away his life, but there was always a protecting hand over him. That he felt.

His chosen destiny was to work with plants. In 1970 he graduated as a landscape gardener, then studied in Munich and 1975 he became a qualified engineer of landscape architecture and environmental preservation.

At the office where he was employed there was a photo of the Nebula (an earlier design by Roger Anger, which became the Galaxy later) attached to the cupboard. Walter was always feeling attracted to it, not knowing what it was. He had been introduced to the Integral Yoga early through his spiritual friend and guide Heinz Kappes (1893- 1988), a priest who emigrated to Jerusalem with his family in 1933 and stayed there for fourteen years, being a mediator between Arabs and Jews. In a second hand bookshop Heinz found Sri Aurobindo's "The Life Divine". After retiring, he went to Pondicherry, in 1959, and lived in the Ashram for one and a half years. The Mother gave him the task to translate Sri Aurobindo's works into the German language, which he did then in Stuttgart. Heinz was Walter's closest soul friend who taught him a lot.

His passion for photography made Walter travel through Ireland, Northern Ireland and America, doing landscape photography.

From 1981 to 1983 he ran a garden maintenance company in Stuttgart.

His thirst for light, for the sun, guided him to work as an assistant manager in Egypt from 1983 to 1985. There was a German on the farm who had lived in Auroville for some time. Walter became curious. In 1986 he came to stay in Auroville for several months, falling in love with the Matrimandir and the idea of a garden design based on the Mother's Symbol, and came back for good in 1987.



He was welcomed at Matrimandir and jumped full-heartedly into participation in the design of the Matrimandir gardens and the park. Over the years he loved his multiple tasks and was a deeply dedicated and hard worker.

In 2005 he got the chance to be part of an intense garden seminar in Kyoto, Japan. This experience left a deep impact on him.

Mahalakshmi, the Mother's aspect of Harmony and Beauty, became his inner aspiration. And remained it ever since. Mahasaraswati was the other aspect to which he felt always drawn. His love for perfection.

His favourite book from Sri Aurobindo was "The Mother".

End of May 2023 he had an accident from which he recovered well, but not fully.

Walter had an intense inner life with lots of beautiful spiritual experiences.

On the 17.4. early evening the Mother took him into Her arms while he was walking.

I translate here his message which he sent me the same day, at 2.53 pm:

'Our dear friend Heinz has made it clear to me that I will never be able to give back what good deeds other people do or did to me. I can only say "thank you".'

A silent gathering for Walter took place at the Matrimandir Banyan Tree on Monday 21st April, and was buried at the Auroville Burial Ground on Tuesday 22nd April.



IN MEMORIAM ANDRÉ HABABOU



André Hababou, one of Auroville's early architects, arrived in Auroville in 1968, aged 26. On invitation of the Mother, at that time he started working with Roger Anger, Auroville's chief architect, and was his first draughtsman.

André was originally from Tunisia and spent the first 13 years of his life there. At the age of 14 he moved to France,

and attended the Ecole des Beaux Arts, where he studied Arts and Architecture. He became a painter, and worked in architectural offices.

Through a chance meeting with an artist in Marseille, gradually André's interest in spirituality was awakened. He began to read books by Indian spiritual masters, and eventually read *The Adventure of Consciousness*, which drew him, in 1968, to the Ashram in Pondicherry. A brochure on Auroville had just come out. On its first page, there was a picture of the Galaxy, the Charter, The Dream and a photo of Mother. When he saw this brochure, it was like a revelation, an immense joy. "But this is where I must live!"

After selling his paintings in order to be able to travel, and then came to India over land, on the "hippie trail" so to say, which caused some initial difficulties at the Ashram. But after his meeting with Mother, accompanied by Roger Anger, the difficulties were over. When he first came to the Auroville area, he was taken aback because he did not find even the beginnings of a city as he had been expecting after seeing the beautiful model in the brochure. He recollected that "I wasn't disappointed – I wasn't happy either – and I told myself that it was up to us to build the city; that we had to transform ourselves through doing it. It was a process that had meaning."

André began living in Auroville and working under the guidance of Roger Anger, and for the next 40 years, he helped create numerous private residences, apartment buildings and commercial



facilities. He is cited and published, most recently in the journal *Architecture + Design*.

His projects included among others the Centre for Research in Communication and Publication (CRCP) in Fraternity; Surrender community - a residential collective housing project; the Pavilion of Tibetan Culture in the International Zone; commercial units Shradhanjali & Auromode Atelier, both in the Industrial Zone; and the school at New Creation.



For André, expressing beauty and harmony, which is automatically linked with functionality, was his aspiration and the most important aspect of his architectural work in Auroville.

André passed away on the night of 17th to 18th April.

His burial took place at Auroville Burial Ground on Sunday, April 20th, the day he would have been 83.

REMEMBERING BORIS

Boris (Boris Verjoutski), long- time Aurovillian and passionate Nature lover, passed away on Tuesday 22nd April in the late evening, at Marika Home, where he stayed for the past few years. He was 87.



Boris was born in Krasnoyarsk, a city in Siberia, Russia, on 9th June 1937.

He arrived in Auroville in September 1991 at the age of 54. He came to live in the Aspiration community, and remained there for the next 30 years. About his past life before coming to Auroville, he wrote, humorously, "For more than twenty years I worked legally in the Soviet Science Academy and I practiced, illegally, Yoga for fifteen years." Through Yoga, he realized that "Science is nothing compared to Yoga (...) Yoga gives joy, health, wisdom for all the people of the world. It is from God. Science on the other hand can be, at times, from the asuras."

He described what he saw when he arrived. "I saw a child in every Aurovillian. And now my vision hasn't changed. It is a city of very young people who created their own young world. This reality has a

great perspective. The physical and spiritual atmosphere of the city creates the constant youth of Aurovilians."

His observations of the natural world, and also of human behaviour, appeared very regularly, during many years, in short but often pithy pieces of writing in the weekly News and Notes. Boris's writing has its very own inimitable style. As an entomologist (i.e. a scientist who studies insects) he got plenty of opportunities to observe insect life, not in the least in his own thatched-roof home in Aspiration. In one of his pieces, he makes fun of Auroville's attempts at organisation and governance while talking about termites: "The Working Committee of Aurovilian Termites has decided that all the termites which are residents of the city must work round the clock, all year long, every day including all holidays and festivals, without any salary. The results are obvious. Now the Housing Group of Termites successfully competes with the Human Housing group. In reality, the Auroville land belongs almost equally to man and to insect, although the insects are less serious and do not celebrate Deepavali." (1998)

Lately, Boris seemed very concerned about how the accelerated city development is affecting the life of nature and humans in Auroville. "The planet is in a dangerous sickness. Our Kurukshetra battlefield for its healing is here...", he wrote.

Boris always seemed a happy soul, cycling through Auroville and more recently, walking with support of two long sticks. As one Auronet user put it, "Thank you, Boris, for the sunlit path you embodied in your way, светлой тебе дороги!"



Boris's remains were buried at the Auroville Burial Grounds on Saturday 26th April, 2025.

Boris represented the soul of his travailed nation at the highest: Russian mystic communism. He was like a king of his species, profound, yet with the enthusiasm and innocence of a child. A master, like Mahalingam, the Tamil mystic, another king. And so was French Georges (my Vikas neighbour).

Three mahatma lived among us, in Auroville, free from material needs, radiating the psychic transformation. Just Being. We too can make it, if we drop anything else but That.

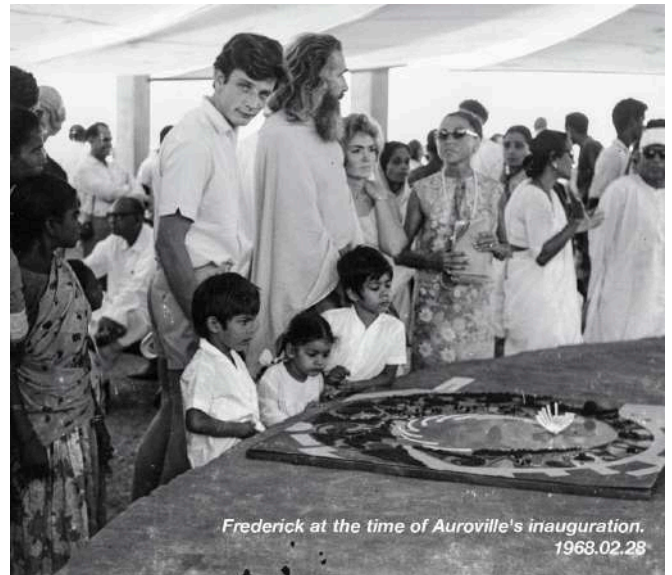

OPEN LETTER: URGENT ACTION NEEDED TO
ADDRESS A SERIOUS RABIES OUTBREAK IN AUROVILLE



Dear Madame Secretary,

The Auroville Dog Shelter is compelled to bring to your urgent attention a recent and serious rabies outbreak in Auroville. Despite extensive vaccination efforts, including the administration of over 1,500 vaccinations following a one-time grant of Rs. 6 lakhs in emergency funding from AVI USA between August 2024 and January 2025, these measures have proven insufficient to adequately protect the residents, visitors, children, and guests of Auroville from the deadly threat of rabies.

Last week, a pet Dachshund, confirmed rabid by post-mortem brain biopsy conducted by specialized veterinarians from Mettupalayam College, attacked and bit more than 30 dogs in heavily frequented areas, including Crown, Solar Kitchen, Bharat Nivas, and the Visitors Centre. This incident caused widespread panic in Kottakarai and underscores the severity of the situation. The Department of Animal Husbandry has been notified again of this latest rabies case. Auroville had already been designated as a rabies outbreak zone last year. The Auroville Dog Shelter is receiving daily calls from concerned residents reporting suspected rabid dogs, which we cannot rescue due to the lack of quarantine facilities!

While a 1,000-dog-per-year sterilization project is underway, still, too many puppies are born and dumped within Auroville and present an ongoing risk, as these animals are potential carriers of the virus. To avert a potentially disastrous mass rabies outbreak that would endanger the lives of residents, visitors, and animals, we implore the Auroville Foundation to provide immediate and substantial funding to contain this grave threat.

The current facilities of the old and crumbling Auroville Dog Shelter are inadequate to cope with this severe crisis. The shelter lacks a

secure quarantine facility, **limiting its capacity to isolate more than one rabies-suspect animal at a time.** With a monthly BCC funding allocation of only Rs. 50,000, the shelter is just barely surviving and struggles to reach its monthly running costs of Rs. 3.5 lakhs. The shelter is only able to employ one veterinarian for half a day and lacks a dedicated emergency rescue and mobile vaccination team for Auroville. Furthermore, our stock of vaccines is nearly depleted, and we urgently require a supply of both canine and feline vaccinations to provide free vaccination services. A petition, signed by nearly 1,000 concerned residents and animal lovers, requesting increased monthly funding for the shelter, has been disregarded for many months. Additionally, the allocation of land, funding, and the granting of building permission for the new Auroville Dog Shelter have been delayed for over 1.5 years while the old shelter is disintegrating.

The Auroville Dog Shelter urgently calls upon the Auroville Foundation to acknowledge the potential danger and impending disaster facing Auroville in the coming weeks. We implore you to take immediate action by providing the necessary funds to combat this outbreak and safeguard the health and safety of all residents, visitors, guests, children, and animals.

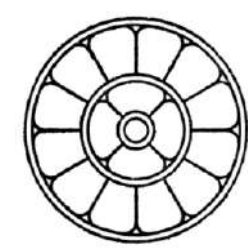

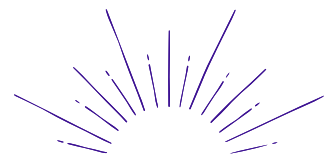

HYDERABAD: AUROVILLE CRIES WITH YOU

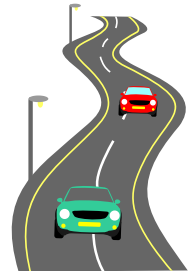
In Auroville we have cried.

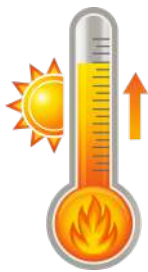

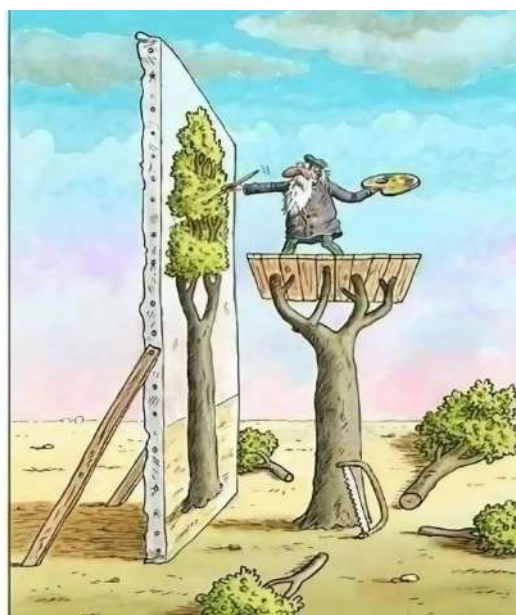

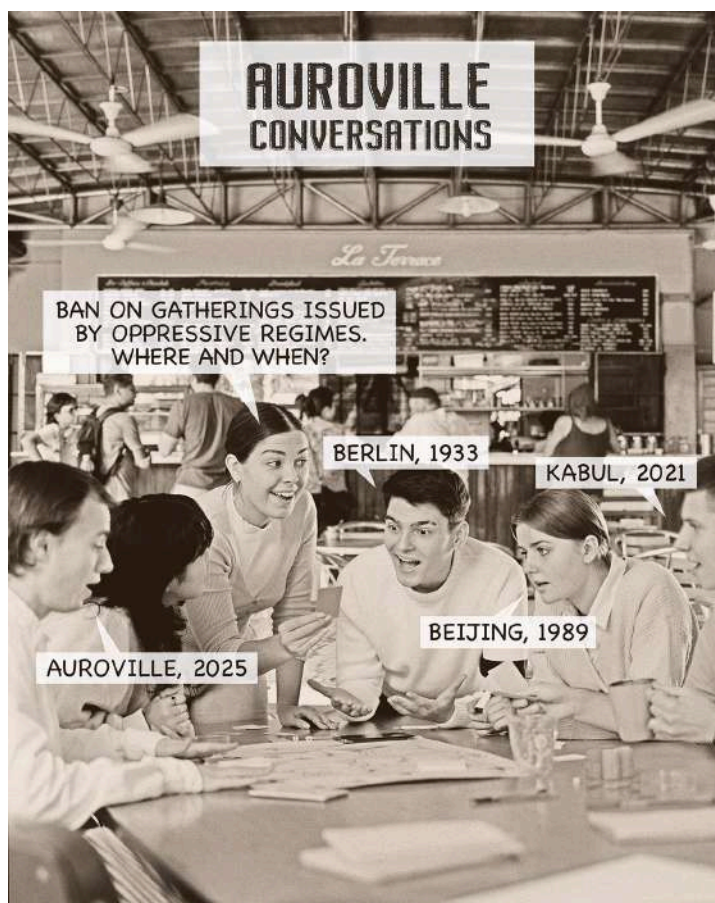

ECOPRO: DISPOSABLE MENSTRUAL PADS BIODEGRADABLE & COMPOSTABLE

Dear Auroville Community,
in particular women in the menstruating age,

As many of us are aware, the widely used disposable menstrual pads on the market contain some plastics which makes it difficult to dispose of used pads in an easy and ecologically sound way. Now a new product has become available, that is menstrual pads made exclusively of biological materials and hence biodegradable or compostable after use. So, as regards disposal, no need to incinerate with dubious emissions from burning plastics, and avoiding pollution from microplastics (when disposed of with other waste in landfills or discarded anywhere in open drains – which is not meant to be the case).

One of the brands is "Bliss". – We have asked a few women to test the pads in regard to reliability (of function) and comfort, and received only positive feedback. The pads are free from sanitizers or artificial fragrances and pose no risk to health.

Concerns regarding composting

In all community and household gardens where some structured and supervised composting of kitchen and garden waste is in operation, used pads can be integrated into it. Concerns about attracting dogs and rodents need to be dealt with in the same way as it applies to fresh kitchen or food waste. (Wild pigs are a separate issue – they plough through our gardens independent of composting activities.) Feel free to ask for guidance at EcoPro.

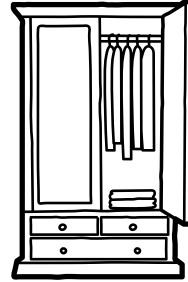

REGULAR CLASSES:

Qi Gong - with Lhamo

- Monday-Wednesday and Friday 7 - 8:30am, drop-in class

Qigong can be described as a mind-body-spirit practice that improves one's mental and physical health by integrating posture, movement, breathing technique, self-massage, sound, and focused intent. Specifically, this form of gentle exercise is composed of movements that are repeated a number of times, often stretching the body, and building awareness of how the body moves through space. There are likely thousands of qi gong styles, schools, traditions, forms, and lineages, each with practical applications and different theories about Qi ("subtle breath" or "vital energy") and Gong ("skill cultivated through steady practice"). As Lhamo has a very extensive knowledge of many of them, she will explore different styles according to the students.

Hatha Yoga with Ramesh

- Monday and Thursday 5:30 - 6:30pm, and Saturday 7:30 - 8:30am, drop-in class

Ramesh offers hatha yoga classes with some vinyasa flow and include pranayama, traditional Sanskrit mantra chanting, and meditation. The style is gentle, adaptive and progressive where passive, gravity-assisted poses are mingled with dynamic vinyasa-style flow as needed. He places a lot of focus on breathing and body-mindfulness during the practice. It is ideal for beginners to intermediate-level practitioners. You will be exposed to authentic Sanskrit terms and their correct pronunciation. The practice will be rejuvenating and restorative. These specific classes will be on donation basis, even for guests.

Tibetan Bowls - Sound Healing with Pratik

- Tuesday from 5 - 6:30pm, drop-in class

Tibetan singing bowls are crafted from a blend of metals, each carefully tuned to produce unique harmonic sounds. When played, these bowls generate vibrations that interact with the body's energy field, encouraging a meditative state and fostering

overall well-being. The practice is based on the principle that everything in the universe, including the human body, is in a state of vibration. Disruptions or imbalances in these vibrations can lead to stress, illness, and discomfort. By aligning the body's frequencies through sound, Tibetan bowl healing seeks to restore harmony and vitality.

Traditional Sanskrit Mantras with Sonia

- Thursday from 9 - 10am (Drop-in class); and Friday from 5 - 6pm (Regular students only).

In the recitation of Sanskrit Mantras the sound is very important, and the specific pitches and strict rules of intonation and syllabic length should be learned according with the tradition of the great masters of the past, who figured out how to use the voice to calm the mind and attune the practitioner to the more subtle levels of the "sadhana" or spiritual path. Through the harmonic rhythm, repetition and participation in the singing, the mind reaches more clarity, concentration and tranquility.

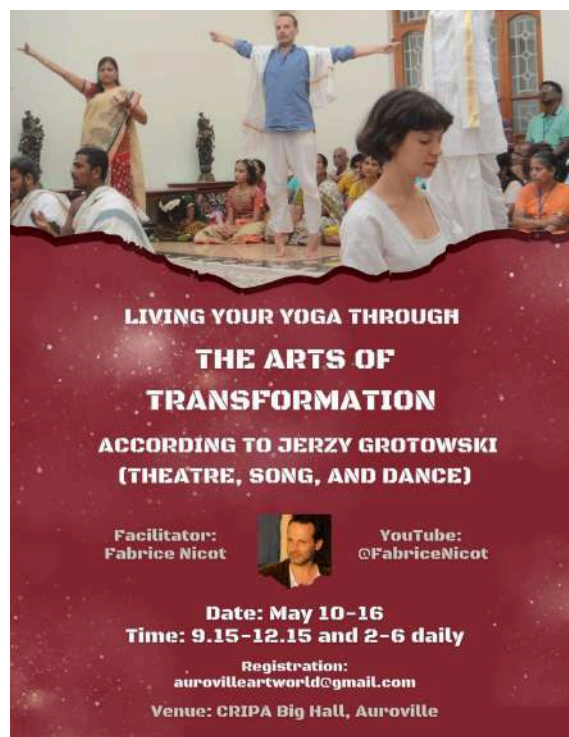

WORKSHOPS

LIVING YOUR YOGA THROUGH THE ARTS OF TRANSFORMATION ACCORDING TO JERZY GROTOWSKI (THEATRE, SONG, AND DANCE)

10-16 MAY, CRIPA



(Body and vocal explorations based on songs, dances, and spiritual texts from around the world)

About the workshop:

The first part of the workshop will be devoted to exploring the musical and rhythmic foundations of texts from various spiritualities (Song of Songs, Gita-Govinda, Bhagavad Gita, etc.) as well as learning vibrational songs and dances from around the world (Latin Gregorian chants, Ukrainian and Georgian polyphonies, African and Afro-Caribbean songs, etc.).

Biographical narratives from the participants may be used, particularly for emotional exploration.

The second part will consist of physical and vocal training to release tension while strengthening the participant. They will explore their simple presence in space, holding themselves in an energetic physical body, listening and watching. They will achieve a balance between a position anchored within themselves and one entirely open to the outside world. In total availability, the trainee will then be able to offer their attention, their body, and their presence to the space, to the partners, and to the artistic materials that will "pass through" them. In the words of Jerzy Grotowski (Polish theatre director and teacher, 1933-1999), the text will "read" the trainee, the song will "sing" them, and the dance will "dance" them.

A collective "organic" action will be developed, composed of texts, vibrant songs, and movements.

The facilitator:

Fabrice Nicot is a director and teacher associated with the Grotowski Institute (Wroclaw, Poland). Holder of the French State Diploma of Theater Professor (D.E.), he teaches theater practice at the Cours Florent in Paris (professional cycle), at the University of Paris 8, at the Faculty of Arts of Strasbourg (France), and in conservatories. He is also teaching anthropology at the State University of Haiti.

A graduate as an actor of the E.N.S.A.T.T. (French State National School of Theater Arts and Techniques) and in theater studies from the University of Paris 3 Sorbonne - Nouvelle, actor, director, and Professor, Fabrice Nicot teaches and produces his performances in France and abroad.

As producer of international artistic events, he has co-founded and co-directed, among other things, the Iranian Springs for the municipality of Paris and the Iranian Center for Dramatic Arts, then the Andrei Tarkovsky Academy and Festival of Sacred Arts in cooperation with the Andrei Tarkovsky International Institute and Andrei Andreievitch Tarkovsky.

He has organized international educational exchanges for the CNSAD (The National State Drama School), the Cours Florent, and various universities. He has conducted fieldwork over several years as an anthropologist of the arts among artistic communities around the world (India, Africa, the Caribbean, Eastern Europe, etc.), publishing articles (in the journals Arts Sacrés, Le Monde des religions, Europe, Danse conservatoire, etc.) and organizing seminars.

TIME TO SUMMERNATE

AYURVEDA HEALTHY TIPS



According to Ayurveda, the qualities of summer are hot, sharp, and penetrating. That's why our *pitta dosha* - the subtle fire that controls metabolism and transformation - can cause us to overheat. The sun saps the energy from the body, from the plants and the earth, increasing heat and dryness.

Pitta needs to be looked after to maintain a good energy, mental clarity, joyfulness, good digestion and blood circulation, a beautiful glow of the skin and a sound sleep.

When Pitta is out of balance it will give skin problems, hot flashes, exhaustion, indigestion or loose stool. Emotionally, excess Pitta manifests through irritation, short-temper, impatience, judgement/criticism, perfectionism...

Before Pitta reaches uncontrollable heights, remain cool, calm and pamper the liver:

With the food: As Agni (digestive fire) weakens, it is better to eat light, unctuous (slightly oily), cooling food such as salads and juices.

- Favorable taste: Bitter taste, Sweet taste (to take moderately in case of diabetes and high triglycerides). Salty taste should be taken reasonably.
- Drink water stored in earthen pot.
- Raw food/salads are taken at lunch mainly.
- Proteins: mungdal, chickpeas, beans, sprouts, nuts and seeds, non-veg: white meat, fish, seashell, dairies for breakfast or lunch, eggs.

- Cereals for energy: jasmine rice, barley, red rice, millet (fermented ragi).
- Vegetables: pumpkin, bittergourd, bottlegourd, snakegourd, ashgourd, cucumber (taken separately), salads, green leafy vegetables, broccoli, cabbage, celery, carrots, drumstick (moringa), zucchini, plantain.
- Fruits: amla, pomegranate, banana, ramphala, chiku, papaya, apple, grape, date, watermelon and melon (to be taken separately), coconut.
- Beverages: buttermilk, sweet lassi, coconut water, mint, lemongrass, cardamom, chamomile, nannari (sarsaparilla), amla juice, watermelon juice, vegetable juice, cucumber milk (blend ½ cup of peeled cucumber in 1 cup of milk - cow or other veg milk - with a pinch of sugar), electrolyte (1 lemon juice + 1tsp of sugar + 1 pinch salt in a glass of water).
- Lipids: ghee, olive or sunflower or coconut oil.
- Spices: cumin, coriander, black pepper, turmeric, fennel seeds, fresh aromatic herbs (dill, coriander, fennel, mint, parsley, saffron).



Avoid:

- Pungent and sour tastes (especially for people who are Pitta dominant).
- Pitta increasing items: chillies, fermented food (apart from idli and dosai), deep-fried, sour buttermilk or curd, red meat, alcohol (strong liquor, red wine), coffee ...
- Drinking beverages coming from the fridge or freezer during meals.
- Ice-cream at the end of a meal (best to be taken when the digestion is finished, around 4pm).

Routine to favour:

- Avoid direct sun contact specially between 11am and 4pm, and protect from the heat by keeping a humid towel/cap on the head.
- A nap of half an hour after lunch is allowed.
- Body massage with coconut oil – if there's no time every day to apply oil on the body, then massage ears, hands and feet + pour 4-5 drops of coconut oil on the fontanelle.
- Bath with cool water and apply a paste of sandalwood on the face, heart and lower abdomen (these are the 3 main parts that should remain fresh to maintain the coolness in the whole body); foot bath in the evening with vetiver roots, rose water or hibiscus flowers.
- Swimming, aquagym, any water activities. Qi-Gong, Tai Chi, light running: max 30 minutes early morning or late evening; walks in green environment, forest.
- Soft yoga, pranayama (Sheetali, Sheetakari, ida nadi inhalation-left nostril inhalation), meditation with Gayatri mantra.
- Walk under the moonlight, full moon bath.
- Wear loose and comfortable cotton or linen clothes (white, blue, green, gray colours).
- Cooling jewellery: sandalwood beads, jade, pearl, amethyst crystals, moonstone, silver, aquamarine.
- To refresh the ambiance use lemon or orange peel, jasmine flowers, lavender, wet cloth hanging at the open window, vetiver curtains.

Cooling plants for the summer:

- **Amalaki – Amla:** refrigerant and full of Vitamin C, rejuvenative fruit.
- **Aloe vera:** rejuvenates blood and tissues.
- **Aegle Marmelos – Bael fruit:** make juice from the pulp and decoction with leaves, it calms body and mind. It is slightly laxative, do not take during pregnancy.
- **Coriander:** seeds soaked in water for urinary infections, kidney weakness.
- **Red Hibiscus:** leaves and flowers for shampoo and conditioner; flowers for herbal tea.
- **Manduka parni – Centella asiatica leaves:** rejuvenative and tonic for brain and nerves.
- **Pudina – Mint leaves:** herbal tea or dishes.
- **Radha consciousness – Clitoria Terneata flowers:** herbal tea or juice.
- **Sarsaparilla – Nannari syrup:** soothing and cooling.
- **Shataavari – Asparagus racemosus:** cooling, calming Pitta, very good for Vata women to harmonize hormones.
- **Vetiver roots:** for bathing.
- **Yashtimadhu – Licorice:** to refresh the body and to calm irritation, inflammation or ulcer in the digestive tract.
