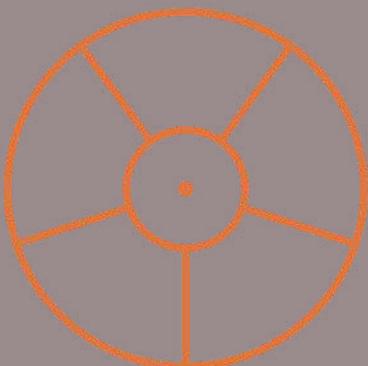

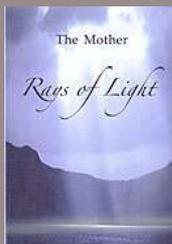

### LEGAL UPDATES

Dear Community,

We wish to share with you information on a new and ongoing court cases –

#### New Writ Petition against the "Residence Criteria":

As per information received by an Aurovilian who has submitted a Writ Petition in the Madras High Court against the Residence Criteria: The matter was discussed for admission on Friday, 13th February, and the High Court has granted an interim stay against these criteria until the next hearing scheduled for 13<sup>th</sup> March. The Madras High Court order was published on Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> February, and is available at this [link](#). The Residence Criteria that were announced through a Standing Order in December 2024 are therefore not applicable until there are different orders from the High Court.

#### Functioning of Residents' Assembly, Working Committee, TDC & ROR:

We take this opportunity to also inform the community that in this month of February the Madras High Court is, after a long period of time since the last hearing in this case, hearing an appeal made by the Auroville Foundation against a verdict by the Hon'ble Justice

Quddhose in August 2022 concerning the Working Committee, the TDC, the functioning of the RA and the RoR.

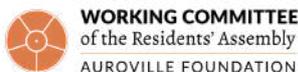
This case initially received a ruling that the three statutory authorities of the Foundation, namely the GB, the IAC and the RA, should work in mutuality. This ruling also quashed a letter of the OSD of the Auroville Foundation that suspended all Residents' Assembly Decisions.

The Secretary of the Auroville Foundation immediately filed an appeal against this ruling and got an interim stay. The interim stay was later modified by the Chief Justice who stated in his order that "The statutory body [the Residents' Assembly] may not be restrained from functioning." His order also stated that "The Residents Assembly may function as provided under Sections 18 to 20 of the Auroville Foundation Act, 1988."

On Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> February, a hearing on this case took place in the Madras High Court. Only one old petition concerning an office order of TDC issued in 2022 was discussed and disposed of since it is now obsolete in view of the Judgement of the Supreme Court in this matter in March 2025. Another old petition concerning a previous Standing Order for the TDC has been left pending for the next hearing. The remaining part of the appeal concerning the main topic of the functioning of the Residents' Assembly may be discussed in the coming days.

We will keep the community updated about further developments.

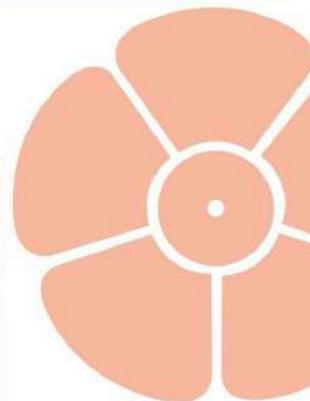

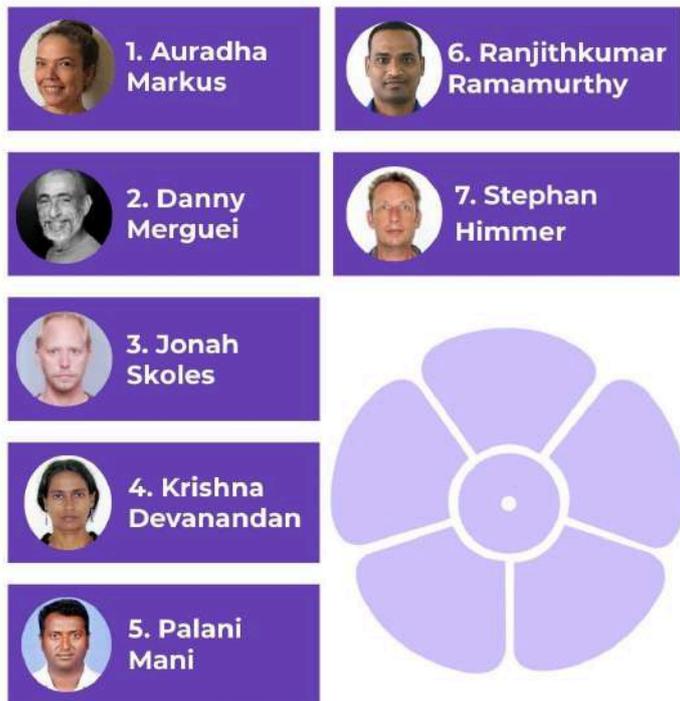

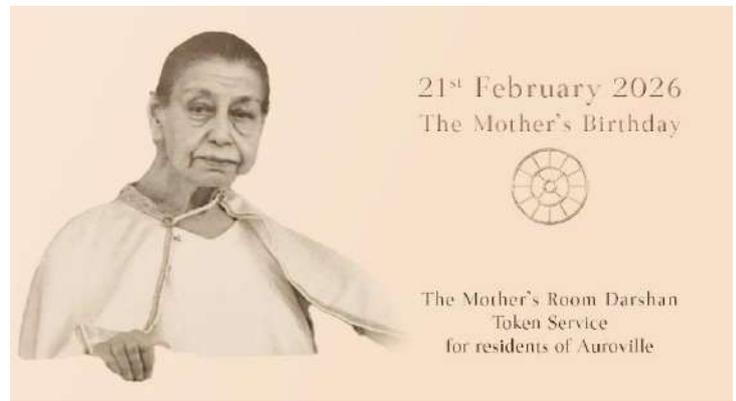

## THE MOTHER'S BIRTHDAY

SATURDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY, MOTHER'S ROOM



Dear Friends,

To celebrate the Mother's Birthday, the Sri Aurobindo Ashram will open both the Mother's Room and Sri Aurobindo's Room on Saturday, February 21<sup>st</sup> for a Darshan.

Everyone is welcome.

Below we share with you the options and guidelines for attending the Darshan:

### 1. Options for a Room Darshan

#### a. Early Morning Darshan (No tokens required):

- Join the general Darshan queue from 4am onwards.
- No tokens will be needed until the meditation at the Samadhi begins.

#### b. Post-Meditation Darshan (Tokens required):

- From 6:40am onwards, tokens will be required for entry.

### 2. How do you obtain a token for the Room Darshan?

- **Volunteers and Guests** of Auroville may collect their tokens directly from the Ashram at the booth near the Ashram Post Office and on the day itself.
  - Please note: You may need to wait or return later at the time indicated on your token.
- **Aurovilians and Newcomers** have the opportunity to pre-register for a token during the timings mentioned below. The Room Darshan with pre-registered tokens will be available from 12pm onward only.

### 3. How can residents pre-register a token?

This goes in two steps:

#### a. Please come for registration on:

**Tuesday, February 10<sup>th</sup>, and Wednesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>.**

- **Venue: Pitanga**
- **Morning: 9am – 12pm**
- **Afternoon: 3pm – 5pm**

#### Important Notes:

- Please come in person to register your token. If you are not known to the organisers, please identify yourself as a resident.
- If you are unable to register personally, please send a representative with a written request stating the name(s) and number of tokens required.
- Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate requests made via email, WhatsApp, or telephone. – Sorry for the inconvenience.

#### b. Please collect your registered tokens on:

**Thursday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, and Friday, February 20<sup>th</sup>.**

- **Venue: Pitanga**
- **Morning: 9am – 12pm**
- **Afternoon: 3pm – 5pm**

- o Please note: Tokens that are not collected by 5pm on the 20<sup>th</sup> will be given to persons on the waiting list.

#### SAIER BUS ON DARSHAN DAYS SATURDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY

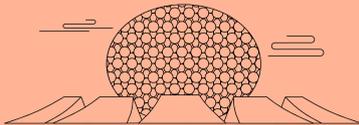

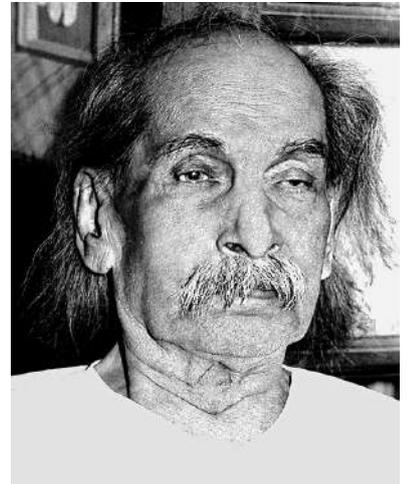
## RESIDENTS SPEAK

### "PARADISE ON EARTH"

Sri Aurobindo Ashram, 1973. An unknown woman of a regal beauty (Mother's granddaughter) walks straight to me; two hours later she escorts me to Nolini Kanta Gupta's room, whom Sri Aurobindo saw as the third one on the supramental path. He asks what I have read of Sri Aurobindo, I reply "The Doctrine of Passive Resistance" (Alipore Conspiracy Case exhibit). Our eyes meet, I see the Infinite... Never again was I able to speak to him; daily, at 5 pm, he did pradakshina around the samadhi, I waited there with a flower taken from the Samadhi; we looked into each other's eyes without exchanging a word. Their Path is real.

Non-material initiation. The highest satsang is silence, as in Dakshinamurti's teaching, the guru of gurus. In one's soul's vastness the psychic threads the Path: one's only guide.

In the wordless, luminous presence of great sadhaks I tangibly felt the Masters. Indra Sen, professor of psychology at Delhi University, the foremost Jungian in India. He introduced the concept of



integral psychology even before joining the Ashram. Sri Aurobindo asked Nolini to read him every page the professor wrote; but when Sen settled in Pondy, for ten years the Mother made him water plants and look after the Ashram Press's machines. Birendra, freshly graduated at Calcutta University; the Mother made him sweep and count bananas for the next sixteen years. Fiery-eyes Parichan, in charge of the Ashram gardens; weeds grew all over his yard, by the end of the day his white clothes turned red: he had no time for his person, the place where he lived. Kishor Gandhi, whom the Mother appointed as the sole editor of Sri Aurobindo's "Letters on Yoga", three volumes; he lived in a tiny room he never changed for a better one, from there he could glimpse Mother's room.

Her sadhaks are this.

Rishabchand wrote a biography on Sri Aurobindo nationalist and a fantastic compendium on Integral yoga for the American audience; both on Mother's request, still are reprinted – but his day-to-day job was to look after the carpentry department. Isn't this the place where doctor Nirod, Savitri's scribe, commenced his yogic career? Rishabchand gave up family and most successful business to live in a few square meters room padded with books. Every afternoon I entered it, to type on Rishabchand's typewriter notes from his biography; he was no more, but his towering presence was everywhere. He had a friend, Purod-da, small, with a child-like face and enchanting smiling eyes: a sweeper, like Birendra. They met every evening to read "Savitri"; when this reached a peak, Rishabchand turned to his friend... invariably asleep, after a full day work for the Mother...

Integral Yoga is an irreversible call that makes drop everything, whatever one's owns and has achieved. Watering plants, working with machines, counting bananas, sweeping the Ashram

compound, looking after the carpentry workshop, just anything the Mother asks. The Italian countess Marta Avogadro lived in one room and worked at the Ashram Press's binding section. "After wasting all my life playing bridge and canasta, only now I am learning to live" the grand lady once commented, laughing.

No priests and classes. No 'teachers', 'counsellors', 'lecturers'. No one can give you clothes if you can't make your own, warned the Mother. Everything is within, no need for external crutches. Utterly alone: the Divine – and oneself. Eternal, immortal, Jivatman!

My only teachings, those magic years, were Sri Aurobindo's "Last Poems", Mother's "Prayers and Meditations" – and the love, empathy, compassion, ineffable peace her sadhaks exuded. Teaching by silent example loyalty, humility, unconditional surrender.

No need to speak: everything is within. Who can define the Eternal, give classes about the Ineffable? We are, the One.

Sat-chit-ananda.

There is but one's daily offering, year in and year out. The yearning and ecstasy of untamed psychic beings is all one needs, the fragrance of flowers growing by humbly serving the Mother.

The great sadhaks and scholars, irreplaceable, are no more. When the few of us, initiated into that world, will be gone as well, who will tell our children and grandchildren what the Sri Aurobindo Ashram was, and the Auroville of the pioneers? How real they were? And that this is the inescapable future?

## UNDERSTANDING THE EXPONENTIAL SURGE OF AI

Chapter One:

On demonstrating and understanding the powerful intense transformative impact of the explosive progress of our AI InfoComm Assistants from the vantage point of the Integral Supramental Yoga, I submitted to Google Gemini for analysis a comment I gave to another Aurovilian's post in our internal Auronet social platform. ## THE AVATAR'S MODEL TOWN



"...The work of achieving a continuity which permits one to go up and down and bring into the material what is above, is done inside the consciousness. He who is meant to do it, the Avatar, even if he were shut up in a prison and saw nobody and never moved out, still would he do the work, because it is a work in the consciousness, a work of connection between the Supermind and the material being. He does not need to be recognised, he need have no outward power in order to be able to establish this conscious connection. Once, however, the connection is made, it must have its effect in the outward world in the form of a new creation, beginning with a model town and ending with a perfect world."

THE MOTHER, *The Supramental Realisation, 1930-1931*

With this quote commenced, forty years ago, my work of research and documentation on what city, Matrimandir, lifestyle and guidelines the Mother determined for Auroville. Alain Bernard and Bhagavadandas, in charge of SAIER, used a leftover budget of Rs.25,000 (at the time, quite a sum) to distribute to the entire community my first compilation, "The Avatar's model town", photocopied and abundantly illustrated.

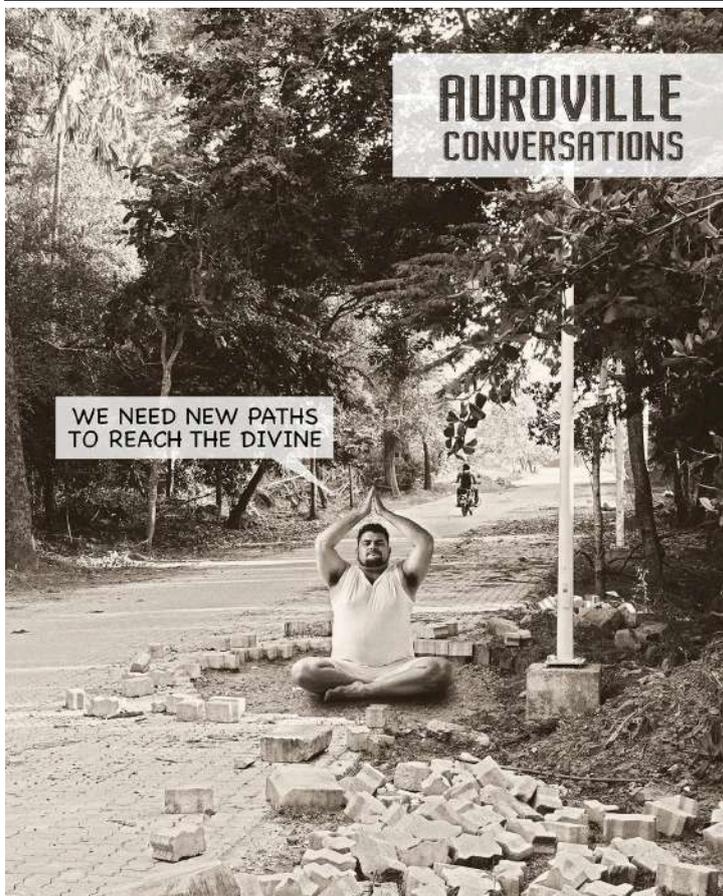
The umbrella was the Laboratory of Evolution/Centre for Human Unity, instituted by Kireet Joshi and funded by the GOI; but my occult inspirer and model was Shyam Sunder, Mother's secretary for Auroville, who used to meet her daily for this purpose and received over 4000 letters and messages from her. He was her last hope, Mother wrote to him. We had never met, but on request of Abey Patel ("Sri Aurobindo's Action") Shyam Sunder granted me the visa so that on Mother's Centenary Day, on the roots of the samadhi tree, I consecrated my life to Integral Yoga and Mother's Auroville. Shyam Sunder, the very embodiment of Mother's guidelines, occultly knew what role I would play in Auroville. He set my svadharma.

"The Avatar's model town" – Mother's announcing the supramental realisation in 1930-1 – is the most perfect definition of Auroville. The Avatar and its circle: these are the builders.

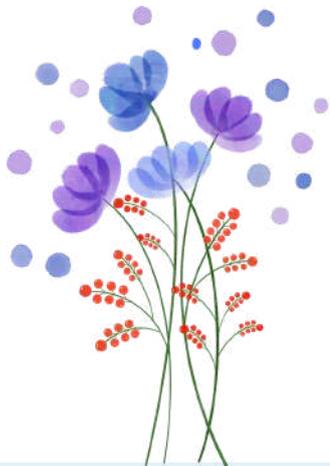

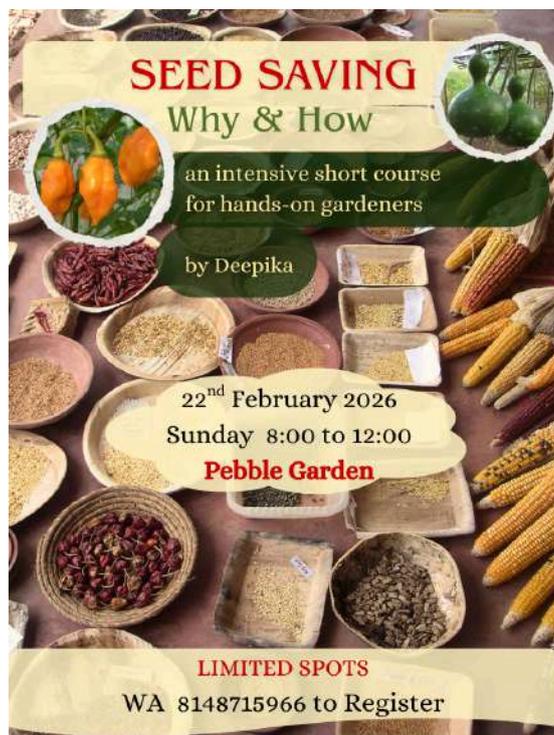

## HEALING PRACTICES FOR TRAUMA FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF INTEGRAL YOGA

### WHAT IS TRAUMA?

In the light of Integral Yoga, trauma can be seen as a deep imprint left on our being by experiences that overwhelm our ability to assimilate, integrate, or respond harmoniously. More generally, trauma refers to the physical, psychological, and emotional response to deeply distressing or disturbing events that exceed a person's capacity to cope. It is the lasting impact of experiences that threaten one's safety, identity, or wellbeing, or that fall outside the range of typical human experience.

### Causes of Trauma

Life events causing trauma may be personal or collective: sudden shocks, long-term stress, abuse of power or authority, violence of any type (physical, emotional, or psychological), extreme pressure, painful relationships (personal or professional), political abuse, threats, displacement, loss of loved ones, loss of home or work, forced changes, witnessing violence, accidents, illness of oneself or others, diagnosis of a serious disease, and many other situations.

### Healing Practices for Trauma from the Perspective of Integral Yoga

There are a few ways, inspired by Integral Yoga, to approach trauma with gentleness and the Mother's presence. These are not quick fixes, but steady movements of consciousness that invite healing and transformation over time.

### #15 A soothing night Practice after experiencing Trauma

Before sleep: lie comfortably, relax the body with slow breaths. Place your hands on your heart or sides. Turn inward to the Mother, feeling Her as light or presence. Whisper:  
*"Mother, I give myself to You for the night. May Your peace protect and heal me."*

Review the day without judgment and place all burdens in Her hands:

*"Mother, I give You this day. Please transform all that was troubled into peace and light."*

Visualize Her light descending like a veil over you, surrounding body, nerves, and mind. Fall asleep repeating: *"Mother, I rest in You."* Over time, this practice brings peace to the subconscious, calms dreams, and lessens inner burdens.

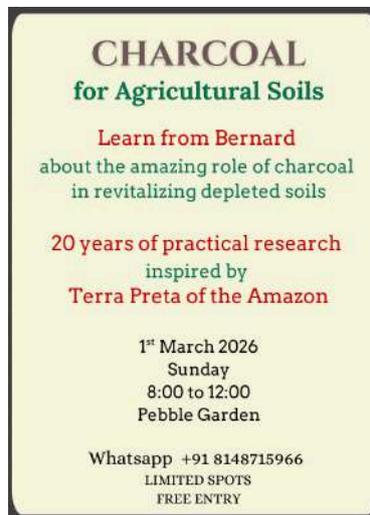

Singing naturally slows and deepens your breathing. This activates the parasympathetic nervous system (your "rest and restore" mode), reducing stress and anxiety.

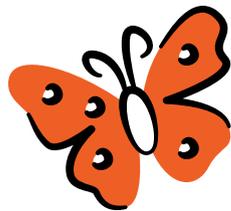

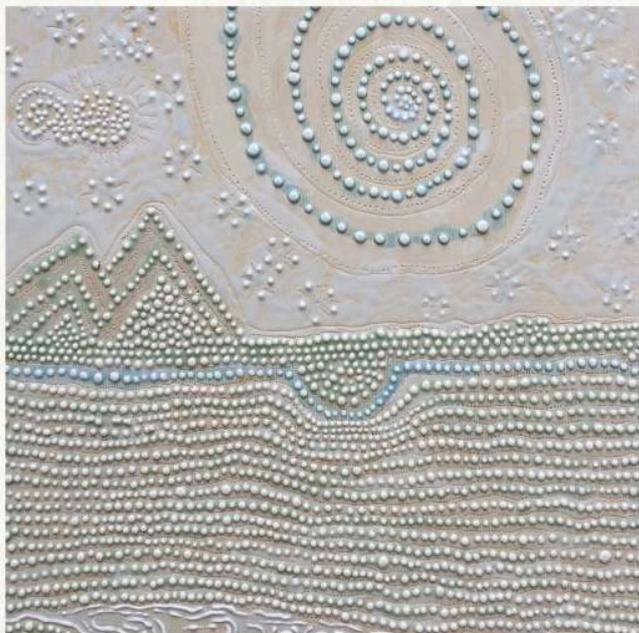

Time, in the physical world, is one of the few universally shared dimensions—beyond ownership or control, at least for the time being. Spiritually, however, I experience time as neither linear nor fixed, but as multidimensional and all-encompassing. It often feels supple and fluid. In my artistic practice, time functions as a fundamental medium, shaping conception, process, and creation. Establishing a conscious relationship with time is essential to transforming inspiration into form. My ongoing series, A Time Trilogy, explores and visualizes these layered perceptions of time.

Drawing from Eastern landscape traditions such as *Sansui* (山水), my paintings dissolve the boundary between subject and background. Nature dominates the frame, while human presence is minimal or symbolic, emphasizing inner nature and spiritual connection. These landscapes reflect my inner states and invite the viewer into the work, rather than positioning them as a distant observer.

This approach is central to Archaeology of Transcending Light (A.O.T.L.), in which I reimagine landscape through contemporary abstraction, inspired by introspection and an inward process of concentration. The act of finding the Self feels like an archaeological excavation—as if uncovering ancient treasures. In this sense, past and future appear fluid and, ultimately, interchangeable.

The Japanese concept of *Ma* (間)—the space between—also deeply informs my practice. I understand *Ma* as a realm where duality comes to rest, where silence, space, and subtle perception allow meaning to emerge. In Tibet, the intermediate state between life and death is called *Bardo*—a realm in which different forms of life force are encountered and engaged. I find these cultural connections deeply resonant. This sensibility extends into my sound installations, which focus on atmosphere, frequency, and silence rather than structure, inviting deep listening and introspection.

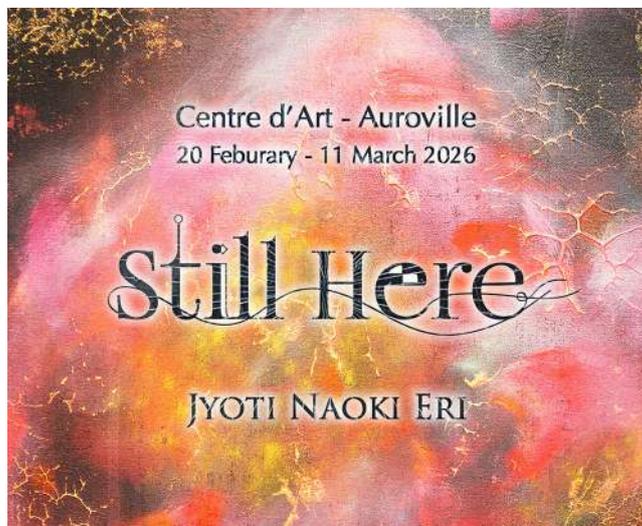
Rooted in Eastern philosophy and informed by modern science, my work seeks a meeting point between spirituality and contemporary thought. This exhibition offers a contemplative space in which viewers may encounter stillness, expanded awareness, and unseen dimensions of reality.

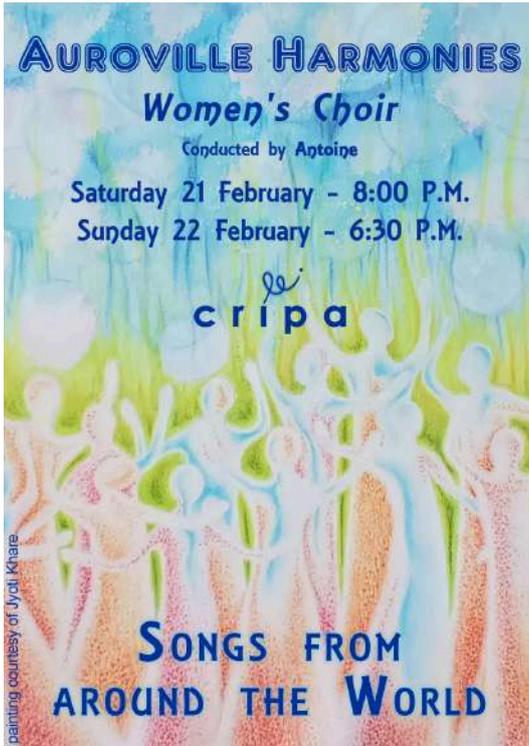

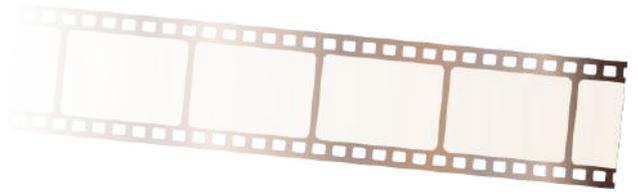

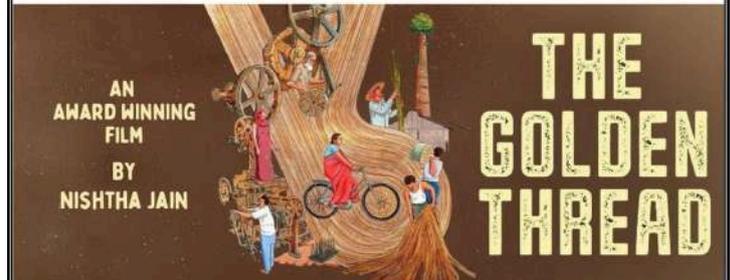

Alma eventually confesses her secrets to a seemingly sympathetic Elisabeth and finds that her own personality is being submerged into Elisabeth's persona.

## SPRING AND LIVER SUPPORT

### WITH AYURVEDA AND HEALTHY PLANTS



The sun comes back to the northern hemisphere and days are warmer but nights are still chilly. The change of season makes the body vulnerable. Spring is part of a 3-season period (late winter, spring, summer) where the sun becomes stronger and sap the energy we regenerated during monsoon and early winter.

In winter, Kapha (water and earth elements) accumulated in the body to protect us from the cold. With the warmer days, Kapha starts moving, cheerful with good energy, waking up from a restful winter and wants to get rid of its layer of fat that is no longer in need to keep warm.

**A healthy Kapha** shows in the body with lots of strength and stamina, a strong immune system and a steady and stable mind with a sense of duty, Kapha has goodwill, is warm hearted, generous and receptive, accommodating.

If Kapha is imbalanced, it becomes stagnant and heavy, it shows lethargy, fatigue, loss of appetite or low digestive power leading to colds, cough with mucus, slight fever, tonsillitis, sore throat, lung congestion, allergies, hayfever, frontal dull headaches, sinusitis, cravings for sweet, heaviness/overweight...

And in the mind, Kapha feels sad, confused, dull, lazy, feeling of not being loved/cared/heard, greedy...

Kapha characteristics (gunas) are cold, heavy, oily, sticky, dense, stable (imbalanced, it changes to stagnant). To rebalance Kapha,

we need to give the opposite characteristics: hot/warm, light, dry, mobile and fluid in the food (to stimulate the digestive power Agni) and the activities to decongest Kapha and to help the liver to remove the stagnation:

### With the food:

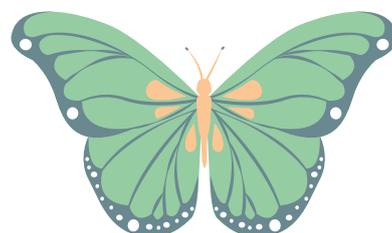
- Most beneficial: Fasting a day a week
- Eat warm, cooked, easy to digest with predominantly bitter, astringent and spicy tastes
- **Proteins:** Black beans, chickpeas, lentils, mung dal, dals, dried peas, dried beans, pinto beans, red beans (rajma), soya beans (green gram), tempeh, cooked tofu, horse gram, white meat, eggs, small fishes, pumpkin seeds, goat milk
- **Vegetables:** Bitter vegetables: bittergourd, fenugreek (mehti), green leafy vegetables (cabbage, steamed green salads, lettuce, rucola, spinach), artichokes, ashgourd, beetroots, bottlegourd, broccoli, carrots, cauliflower, celery, chow-chow, drumstick (moringa: leaves of drumstick tree), eggplant, green beans, leeks, peas, peppers, pumpkin, radish, cooked tomato, zucchini
- **Good source of sweet taste:** in the cereals (amaranth, barley, buckwheat, red rice, millets, dry oats), in the fruits (pomegranate, apple, dry apricot or raisin, chiku, papaya, grape, pear, figs)
- **Spices:** all the spices are good, red chilli with moderation
- Ghee or cold pressed sesame/olive/sunflower oils
- **Beverages:** herbal teas (camomile, cinnamon, fennel, ginger, peppermint, tulsi, karpooravali, yerba mate, roibos), warm water with honey, cranberry juice, barley grain coffee, grape juice, pomegranate juice, warm and spiced soya milk, masala tea (without milk), green tea
- **Ayurvedic plants and preparations:** Neem, Tulsi, Amla, Triphala, Karpooravali, Panchakola (ayurvedic digestion booster), Trikatu (ginger, black pepper, pippali), Sitopaladi churna (for cold, coughs), Talispatradi Vayam (for chest congestions, coughs with mucus), Mix powders of ginger, turmeric, black pepper, all above can be mixed with honey
- **Liver support:** Bhumyamalaki (Keezhanelli) decoction – 20-30ml in the morning before breakfast. Apple Cider vinegar (1tsp) + grated fresh turmeric (1/2tsp) + sip of water: before lunch for 3 weeks
- **Walk 100 steps after lunch.**

### Daily routine:

- **Great principle:** keep the stamina strong
- Early morning, clean the nasal cavity and sinuses with Anu Tailam (2-3 oil drops in each nostril)
- Shower or bath with warm water
- Keep body warm (especially at night)
- Physical exercise: min 30 minutes per day
- Yoga (sun salutation, forward bends, chest openers, and backward bends as well as poses that stretch, compress, stimulate, and cleanse the solar plexus)
- Pranayama (Kapalabhati, Bhastrika)
- Fumigation: eucalyptus, neem, sage.
